9.2.013. *Under 23 riders who have participated in the Men Elite individual road race at a previous UCI World Championships may not participate in the individual road race for Under 23 riders.*

Under 23 riders who are registered with a UCI WorldTeam or a UCI ProTeam are not authorised to participate in the individual road race for Under 23 riders. Such restriction does not apply to Under 23 riders registered as trainees with UCI WorldTeams or UCI ProTeams according to articles 2.15.110bis or 2.16.033.

Reminder new UCI Regulations

9.2.020. Under 23 riders who have participated in the Men Elite individual Time-Trial or Women Elite individual Time-Trial at a previous UCI World Championships may not participate in the Men Under 23 or Women Under 23 individual Time-Trial.

Under 23 riders who are registered with a UCI WorldTeam or a UCI ProTeam are not authorised to participate in the individual road time trial for Under 23 riders. Such restriction does not apply to Under 23 riders registered as trainees with UCI WorldTeams or UCI ProTeams according to articles 2.15.110bis or 2.16.033

Clarification new UCI Regulations

As the 2025 UCI Road World Championships will mark the first Women Under 23 individual time trial at the UCI Road World Championships, clause 9.2.020 of the UCI Regulations will only take effect starting from the 2026 UCI Road World Championships.
