
About the Velodrome

Welcome to Ballerup Super Arena, a world-class sports and entertainment venue located in Ballerup, Denmark. Our arena has a proud history of hosting major international events, including the UCI Track World Championships in 2002 and 2010. During these two events, Ballerup Super Arena had the privilege of welcoming the world's best cyclists as they competed for the title of world champion. The events were a huge success and demonstrated our arena's capability to host major international competitions.

The 2002 UCI Track World Championships were particularly significant, as they marked the first time the event was held at Ballerup Super Arena. The competition featured over 300 athletes from 38 countries, who competed in a range of track cycling disciplines, including sprint, keirin, and pursuit. In 2010, Ballerup Super Arena once again hosted the UCI Track World Championships, with over 400 athletes from 42 countries competing for the world title. The event was a spectacular display of athleticism and skill, further showcasing our arena's capacity to host world-class events.



Ballerup Super Arena Layout




Ballerup Super Arena Layout

Team Storage containers:

All teams will be able to access storage containers located south of the arena. There will be two types of storage options. Large teams will be provided with a 145 sq. m. container, while smaller teams will have storage available in a smaller tow trailer. The keys for the containers/trailers can be picked up at the race office, which is open duing training hours. A deposit of 50 Euro in cash to cover keys and possible damages will be needed from the nations.

Parking:

All teams will assign 1-2 parking permit in a designated area south of the arena. The permit for parking can be picked up in the race office located in Ballerup Super Arena (south end) in Thorvald Ellegaard Lounge. Teams can park from the start of the training days to the end of competition days.
