## STORAGE AREA

Team pens in the infield will be available from **Saturday, October 8<sup>th</sup> at 8:00am.**

Outside storage will be accessible Thursday October 6<sup>th</sup> (14:00-18:00) until Monday October 17<sup>th</sup> at 10:00 (to be available for the 2022 UCI Para-cycling Track World Championships\* as of Monday October 17<sup>th</sup>, 11:00). From Friday October 7<sup>th</sup> to Sunday October 16<sup>th</sup>, key storage can be available between 8:00 and 20:00 or during velodrome opening hours.

A security deposit of 100€ per cabin must be paid (in cash) when picking up the key at the key issuing room located in the infield at the Team Desk. The deposit will be returned once the team cabin has been inspected and is left in the condition in which it was issued to you. Your deposit will not be returned if there is any damage to the team cabin and you may incur additional repair costs if the damage exceeds the initial deposit.

Lost keys – if your team misplaces the key for your team cabin, a replacement key is available from the Team cabin coordinator. Teams will be responsible for the cost of replacing lost keys. Key replacement cost is € 50 per key.

(\*It is possible for a team to keep the same storage container for both World Championships. Please note that in this case, additional keys for the same container will not be issued and it is the responsibility of the teams' staff to communicate between them for access to the container. When picking up the key on arrival, please inform the Team cabin coordinator)
