STORAGE AREA

Team pens in the field will be available from the first official training day, Saturday 12th October 2024.

Outside storage will be accessible from Friday September 11th at 15:00 until Sunday September 20th at 18:30.

A security deposit of €50 per cabin must be paid (in cash) when picking up the key at the accreditation. The deposit will be returned once the team cabin has been inspected and is left in the condition in which it was issued to you. Your deposit will not be returned if there is any damage to the team cabin and you may incur additional repair costs if the damage exceeds the initial deposit.



Lost Keys - if your team misplaces the key for your team cabin, a replacement key is available from the Team cabin coordinator. Teams will be responsible for the cost of replacing lost keys. Key replacement cost is €50 per key.

Each Federation/Team is responsible to obtain for their delegation the appropriate entry documentation to gain entry into Denmark.

Denmark is a member state of the European Union (EU). As such, all accredited participants who are citizens of the European Union are granted access to Denmark without requiring a visa. Participants (typically outside the Schengen area) who require a visa to enter Denmark will, upon request, receive an invitation letter from the Danish Cycling Federation, sending our confirmation of participation. Please be aware that there are strict and early deadlines on requesting a visa. We encourage you to consult with the embassy as soon as possible.
