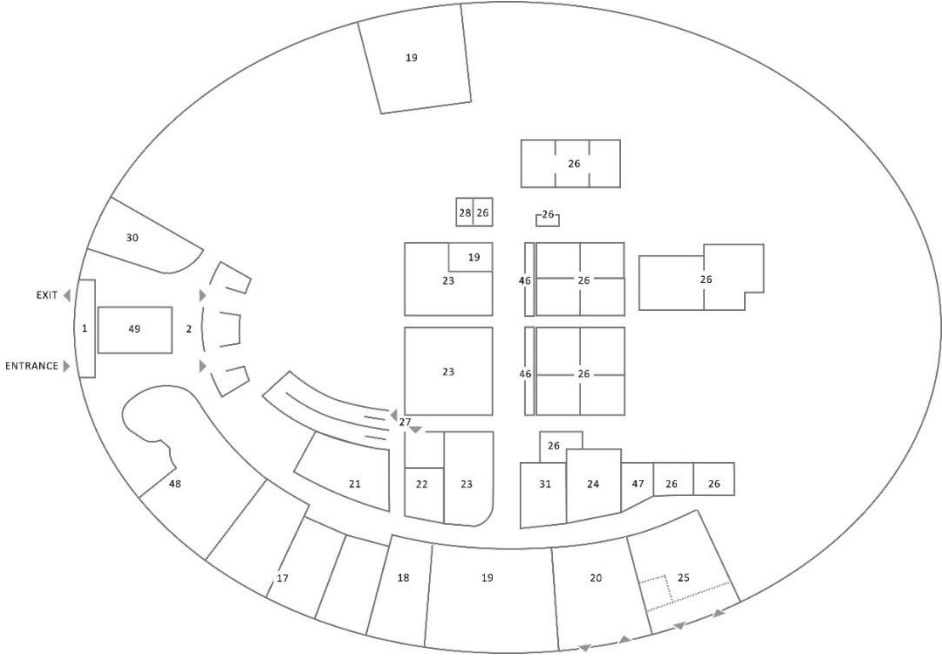

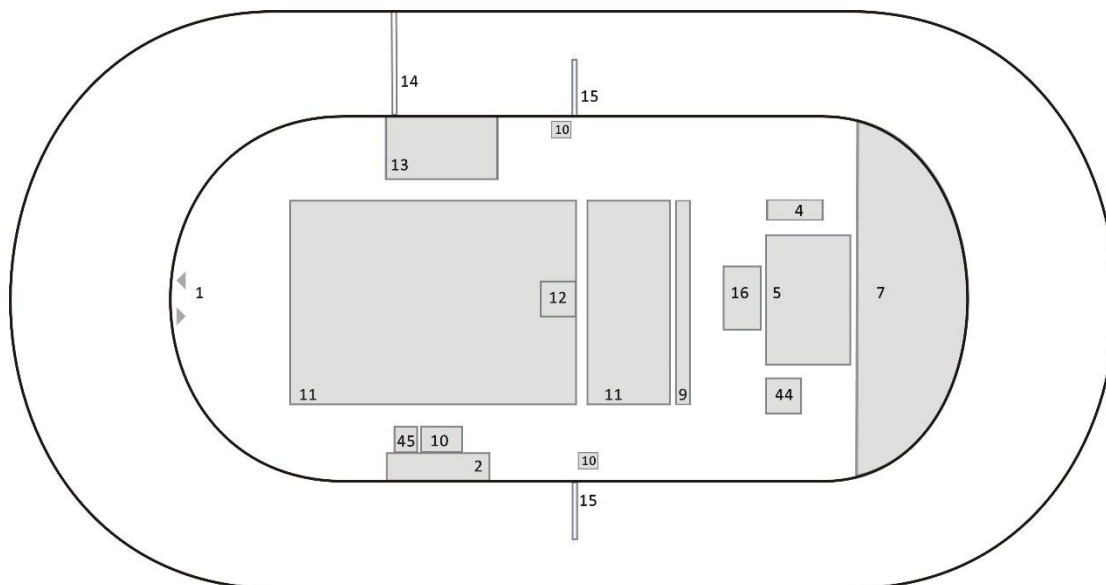

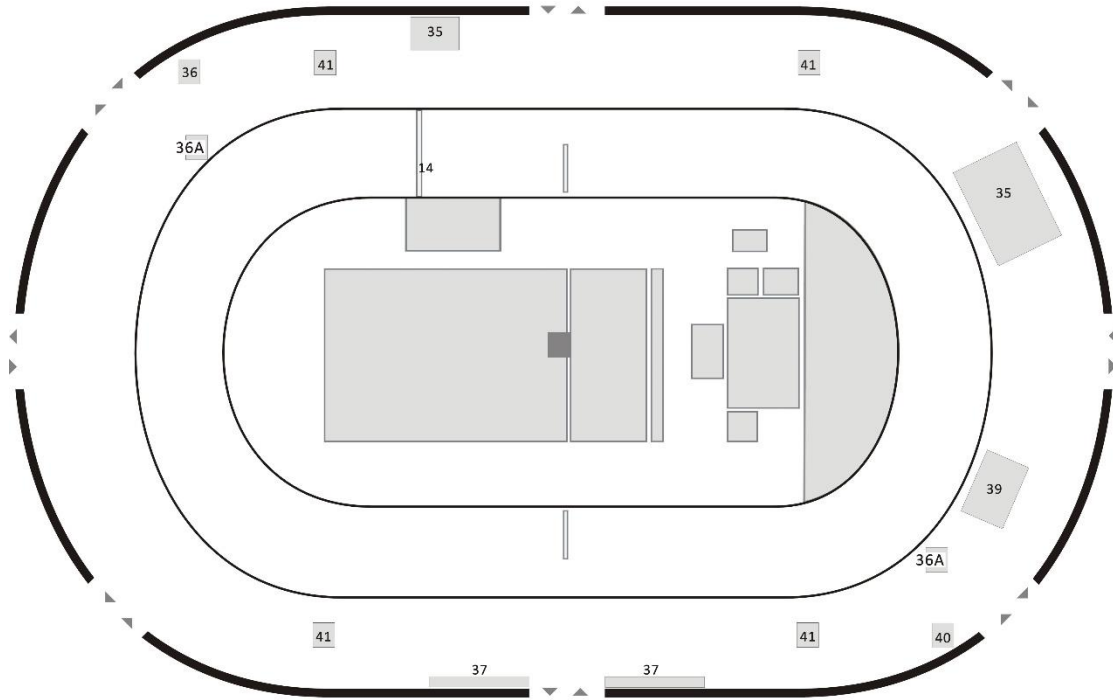

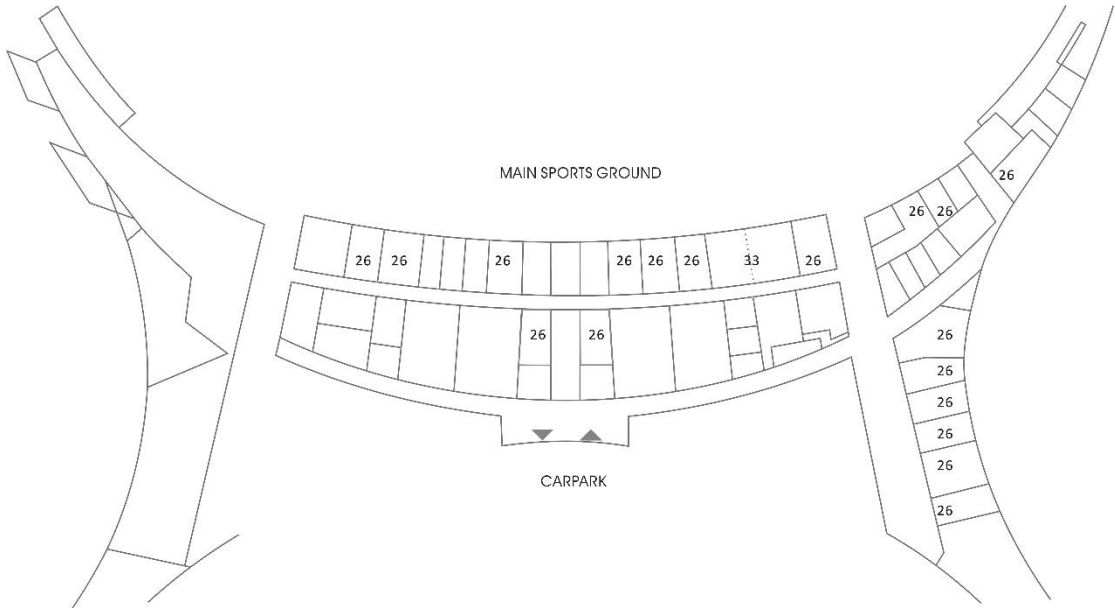

Please note that the schedule has been structured to allow more spectators the opportunity to see the racing across the Nations Cup and to create the best atmosphere possible for the finals on each day. All days are split into separate ticketed sessions so during the gap between the sessions the velodrome seating will be closed and cleared of spectators and all personnel. Doors open approximately of 30 minutes before each session.

ACCREDITATION

Local Organiser Office – Accreditation centre

The Local Organiser Office located in the Velodrome is open at the following times:

12 March:	14:00-18:00 (only for teams, officials and volunteers)
13-14 March:	09:00-18:00
15 March:	09:00-20:00
16 March:	09:00-20:00
17 March:	09:00-18:00

Accreditation will be available upon your arrival for the first time as per official team lists only.

All accreditations must be picked up and distributed before further access to the venue is allowed and all payments, including track bookings for unofficial training and sports analysts' platform, will need to be settled before accreditations are released. All team members will need accreditations to access the venue and track centre.

Teams who arrive on 9th -10th March 2024 will not be allowed to access the infield and the allocated storage area because of the venue setup. Instead, temporary storage area will be arranged at the designated area which is covered by a security guard. ACCREDITATION ZONES

Accreditation access zones are defined as follows:

- 1 Field of Play
- 2 Infield
- 3 Media Area
- 4 VIP Area

Please wear your accreditation at all times when inside the venue. Please do not argue with the stewards and security personnel who have been instructed to maintain access controls which allow the best conditions for people to do their jobs, keep equipment and personnel safe etc. Any abuse towards stewards will not be tolerated and all incidents will be reported immediately to UCI and may result in your accreditation being withdrawn.

If you feel that you do not have clearance for a zone which is necessary for your work, please contact the Accreditation Centre.

All accreditations grant you access to the spectator concourse but not to the spectator seats. A steward will ask people without tickets to make way for spectators. Designated seating areas are reserved for teams at the spectator concourses.

Please also note that venue procedures dictate that spectators are not allowed to stop and watch from the concourse area and people will be kindly asked to move back to their seats from this area.

Please be reminded that many event personnel you encounter at the Hong Kong Velodrome are volunteers so please treat them with courtesy, as the event would not be as smooth without their assistance.

PRIZE MONEY

Prize money will be distributed by cash in Local Organiser Office from 12h00 – 20h00 on Saturday 16 March and 12h00 – 21h00 on Sunday 17 March only. Please go to Local Organiser Office to collect your prize money along with passport on time. No Bank TT will be arranged after the above schedule.

TRAINING SESSIONS

Track Closed: 9th - 10th March

For any teams arriving early, there will be no training available on the track and no access to the track centre until 11th March. This is due to set up of the Race.

Unofficial Training: Monday 11th – Tuesday 12th March

There will be unofficial training available on the track for two days. These sessions will not be covered by a commissaire and paramedic. Only officials of Hong Kong Velodrome will be in place.

2-hour slots available between 09:00-19:00 each day
Cost is HKD300 / slot / team for non-exclusively use.

All unofficial training must be confirmed by **Monday, 4th March 2024**. Unofficial

training slots need to be booked through the Competition Manager by email at tcmgr@cycling.org.hk in advance.

Official Training: Wednesday 13th – Thursday 14th March

The track will be available for official team training on Wednesday 13 March, and Thursday 14 March. The UCI will allocate time for each team between 9:00 and 19:30 during these two days. Warm - Up and In-competition training sessions:

The schedule for training and warm-up session on competition days will be made available at the Team Managers meeting on Thursday 14th March and will be published on www.tissottiming.com.

Training behind Deryn or motorbike will not be permitted in any session. The use of starting gate will also be prohibited.

PARKING AT THE HONG KONG VELODROME

Due to the limited parking space available, teams, media and visitors should use public transportation or shuttle available with the hotel package (for Nina Hotel Kowloon only).

TEAM MAINTENANCE AND STORAGE AREAS

Storage rooms are allocated to teams according to the numbers of riders. These are located at ground floor of the Hong Kong Velodrome and Tseung Kwan O Sports Ground as per the floor plan. Each room is provided with power and lighting. Access to storage room will be from 09:00am Tuesday 12 March unless specific arrangement has been made with the Local Organising Team. The team storage area is covered by a security guard 24 hours a day until Monday 18 March 12:00nn. The Organising Committee official will meet each team on arrival and show you to your allocated room.

It is important that teams only use the rooms allocated to them. Due to space limitations, it will be necessary for some smaller teams to share rooms.

Rooms need to be cleared by Monday 18 March 12:00nn. Please ensure you return your key at the end of the event. A deposit of USD100 will be requested for the key. Lost/unreturned keys will be charged at USD100 per key.

TRACK CENTRE TEAM PENS

Track centre pens will be available from Sunday 12th March at 09:00am. Team pens are allocated in the track centre taking into account the size of each team. There are a large number of people in track centre and space is limited therefore teams must keep the area allocated to them. Fire Regulations also insist that some corridors in the track are maintained for emergency evacuation purposes.

Teams are reminded that the team storages are used for the storage of equipment not required for competition in that session.

To ensure track centre can be cleared quickly and safely in an emergency, please ensure equipment does not excessively narrow or block walkways.

The access to the track must also be kept clear at all times. All ramps shall be kept free of any material and team personnel.

Power

Each pen will be provided with one 3 pin socket (13A) providing approximately 5 amps, enough to charge a phone/ laptop/ small compressor. Please **do not plug extension leads into this socket or kettles, coffee machines or fan heaters** as they use high power consumption and may cause the supply to fail.

Please ensure you bring adequate adapters for the 13A socket. **DO NOT** plug 2 pin plugs into 13A sockets as this is unsafe and will break the electricity supply.

RIDER SAFETY

Do not ride your bike indoors at the Hong Kong Velodrome Park.

Whilst out on the roads, remember we drive on the left-hand side here in Hong Kong and after dark you will require a front and back light fitted to your bike. Red traffic signal lights mean “stop”. If there is a cycle lane on, or an adjacent cycleway beside the main roadway, you must ride on it and not on any other part of the roadway. Ensure you adhere to all road signs and do not ride on the footway this is illegal and may result in a fine.

TEAM PERFORMANCE ANALYSTS

An area is provided for sports analysts on the back straight concourse. Availability is limited. Teams wishing to utilize this facility **must book** their position with the Competition Manager by email at tcmgr@cycling.org.hk prior to arrival by the Thursday 15 February 2023. The cost of this service will be HKD500 with internet cable (access to intranet only) and power outlets (13A socket).

TEAM CHANGING ROOMS

There are male and female changing rooms and shower facilities available at ground floor of the Hong Kong Velodrome (see floor plan).

WATER

To protect our environment and minimize plastic wastage, LOC are reducing the amount of single use plastics at the event. LOC will prepare several refill water dispensers near the team pen at infield. Teams and staff are encouraged to fill their re-usable bottles at these areas.

ICE

Teams and riders can collect ice in the First Aid Room, located at the Ground Floor of Hong Kong Velodrome.

MEDICAL (COMPETITION)

A team of doctors and paramedics will be present throughout official training and competition. The team will be based in the track centre during official training and racing.

The medical team will also have the exclusive use of a first aid room on the ground floor. The medical team will also be available to treat riders, team officials and race personnel for a short period before and after racing.

First aid services for spectators will be located near the entrance of home straight on the spectator stand.

Outside official training and competition times, emergency medical care is available through the public healthcare service. They are contacted in an emergency by dialing 999 or 110.

HOSPITALS

The following hospitals are within 22km of the velodrome (listed by proximity):

Accident and Emergency

Tseung Kwan O Hospital, No. 2 Po Ning Lane, Hang Hau, Tseung Kwan O, N.T. (2.6 km from the venue)

Urgent care facilities

United Christian Hospital, 130 Hip Wo Street, Kwun Tong, Kowloon
(8 km from venue)

Union Hospital, 18 Fu Kin Street, Tai Wai, Shatin, N.T.

(21.6 km from venue)

An ambulance is on site to transfer very serious injuries to hospital. We ask that teams help ensure this resource is only utilised in serious circumstances. A map and directions to the venues and designated hospital can be provided by the venue. There are separate medical services for spectators.

LOST PROPERTY

Any lost property should be handed in to the nearest volunteers or to the Hong Kong Velodrome reception on the ground floor where they will keep a record of any property handed in.

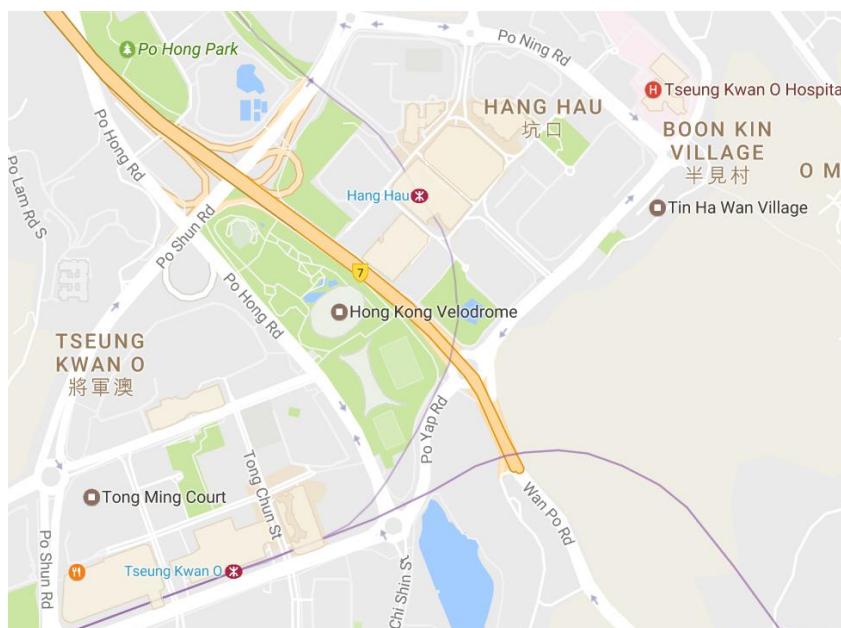
CASH WITHDRAWAL / ATM

The nearest ATM is located 8 minutes' walk away at Sheung Tak Plaza on Tong Ming Street, and Tseung Kwan O Plaza on Tong Chun Street.

There are several banks located in the plaza mentioned above.

PUBLIC TRANSPORT AND ROUTES

We strongly recommend travelling by public transport to Hong Kong Velodrome, allowing plenty of time to get to the venue and please plan your journey ahead of your visit to check for any planned closures or engineering works.



By MTR (Tube):

Hang Hau MTR Station Exit B, 10 minutes' walk from the Velodrome.

Tseung Kwan O MTR Station Exit A, 12 minutes' walk from the Velodrome.
