



#### WHAT ABOUT THE CITY?

Enoshima is a small Japanese island measuring 4 kilometers and located in Salami Bay. It is connected by a bridge to the main island Honshu, attached to the city of Fujisawa and only about 10 kilometers west of Kamakura. The island is part of Shonan, the very touristy coastal area of Kanazawa prefecture, considered the seaside resort of Tokyoites.

Regarding the weather in February, temperatures during the day are generally between 10 and 20 degrees and between 0 and 10 at night. By this way, we recommend you to bring some warm clothes during the event.

#### **VISA**

The registration fee will be directly paid online via card.



#### Rider eligibility

As a reminder, every UCI licence rider who want to register to a UCI BMX Freestyle Park World Cup category have to fill one of the following conditions:

- have on your name a minimum of 50 points in the UCI BMX Freestyle Park Individual Ranking
- Ranked in the Top 50 UCI BMX Freestyle Park World Cup Ranking of the previous year
- If no other rider from a national federation register with a minimum of 50 points on the UCl BMX Freestyle Park Individual ranking, this national federation can send a rider under confirmation of a letter issued by the federation

Please note that each National Federation taking part in the event must register all persons included in the team staff delegation to have access to the athletes area.

Each member of Team staff delegation is mandatory to have a valid UCI Licence at the moment of competition.

To avoid misunderstandings, Hurricane has decided to grant <u>a maximum number</u> of accreditations according to the following list:








#### **Format**

The UCI BMX Freestyle Park World Cup as part of Enoshima Wave Fest, follows the rules as defined by the UCI. Please refer to the UCI Rulebook for any question regarding the competition format.



<sup>\*</sup> Following the registration conditions (Part VI. Bis BMX Freestyle Competition, 6bis.9.002) and limit number of participants.

In case of schedule issues (for climatic reason or other), format and planning could be adapted.

In case of a canceled phase, the results from the last completed phase will be considered as final results.

#### Judging criteria

The performance of each rider is judged on overall impression including, but not limited to:

- Difficulty,

- Height,

- Flow,

- Originality (tricks and lines) and versatility,

-Style,

- Progression,

- Variety of tricks,

- Risk factor,

- Landings,

- Use of the course,

- Execution.

The overall composition of the runs is most important as the judges evaluate the sequences of tricks, the amount of risk in the routine, and how the rider uses the course. The judges take errors such as falls and stops into consideration.

The results of the competition will be published on the FISE Website within an hour of the end of the competition.

#### PRIZE GIVING CEREMONY

The award ceremony will take place just after the end of the final, be sure to stay on the park for the announcement of the final results.

The presence of participants in the awards ceremony is compulsory under penalty of sanction. The participant called who does not show on the podium will not receive his award and prize money.

#### **AWARDS**

The top 12 riders will receive the amount corresponding to their result in Euro by Wire Transfer/PayPal within 60 days.

#### **ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEDURE**

Prize Money Certificate have to be filled within a maximum of 30 minutes after the Prize giving ceremony at Sports Office.

In case of a rider didn't show up during this period, the prize money certificate will be sent by email and a deduction of 10% of the amount will be applied.







# Regulations UCI REGULATIONS

The full text of the version of the UCI Regulations presently in force which is found on www.uci.org shall always apply, save for any specific regulation or special derogation found within this competition guide.

#### • Licence

A valid cycling license, as defined in Part I of the UCI Regulations will be required and must be presented at riders confirmation to check their identity. An identity card or passport is also mandatory.

Once all the terms of the registration are completed, the organization will give riders a wristband allowing them to enter the competition area. It is imperative that all the riders keep their band throughout the event, otherwise the access to the park will be denied. A rider whose license could not be verified and whose status as a non-suspended license

A rider whose license could not be verified and whose status as a non-suspended license holder cannot be established in any other manner may not start and may not figure in the classification of the event. »

UCI Rules Book - Part 6bis, Chapter VI: Riders Confirmation, 6bis.3.017 Entry in the competition implies agreement with the event schedule, regulations and all provisions of the Technical Guide.

#### · Riders eligibility

50 points on rider's name at the UCI Individual Ranking are required before the Ranking Deadline (09/01/2024) to register. Rankings:  $\underline{www.uci.org}$ 

It is important that the 31-12-2023 UCI BMX Freestyle Park World Cup ranking is used to determine the Top 50 riders who are free to enter even if they do not currently have the 50 UCI points.

In case a Park rider does not have 50 or more points his/her registration will be refused. In case a national federation does not presently have any riders with 50 or more points as of the ranking deadline for any particular event, that federation nevertheless has the right to enter a single rider for the category in question. In this case, it is up to the national federation to choose which rider is entered, if any.

#### Exceptions:

- Riders ranked in the top 50 of the final UCI BMX Freestyle Park World Cup ranking of the season prior (2023) may enter if they do not presently have 50 or more points as of the ranking deadline for any particular event in the season following.
- In case a national federation does not presently have any riders with 50 or more points as of the ranking deadline for any particular event, that federation nevertheless has the right to enter a single rider for the category in question.
- \* Rider needs to have 50 UCI ranking points to his/her name on that day.







#### **HURRICANE REGULATIONS**

Participants agree to unconditionally transfer their image rights to SAS HURRICANE and the FISE association, which are free to use them for an indefinite period.

By signing the registration forms, each participant gives authorization to SAS Hurricane and the FISE association, organizer of the event, as well as to all their partners:

- To film and/or photograph all of its performances (sports or not),
- To use its image and the said content produced, whether for commercial purposes and/or promotional,
- To reproduce, exploit and distribute, whatever the medium, the content produced.

The participant grants this authorization from the day of registration for the competition and for a period of 10 years for the whole world, free of charge.
