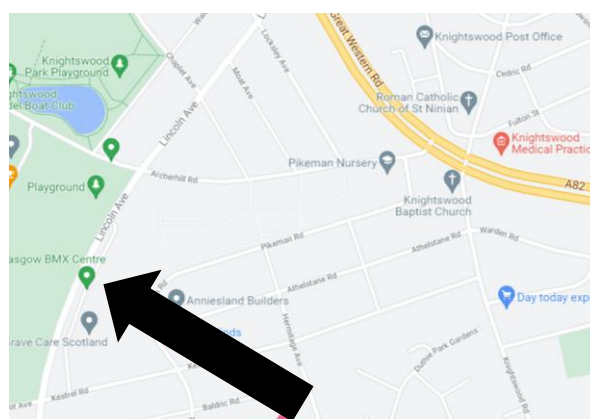
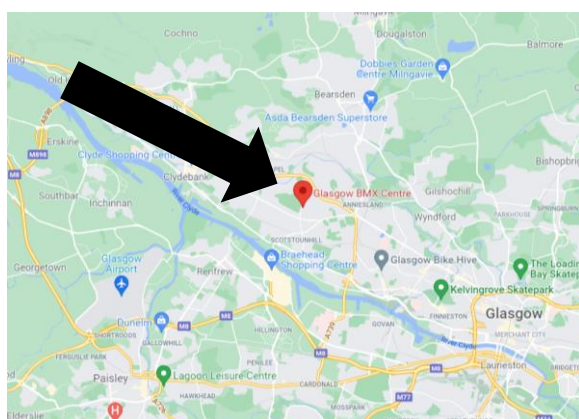

## 2. GENERAL INFORMATION

The UCI BMX Racing World Cup - Glasgow will take place at the Glasgow BMX Centre located in the Knightswood area of the city. The elite and community facility was purpose built for the 2018 European Championships and adds to Glasgow's strong portfolio of cycling venues, many of which will play host to events at the first multi-cycling World Championships in 2023.

The venue is situated North West of Glasgow equal distance between the city centre and the airport. It is best accessed by vehicle from the Great Western Road (A82).

## 3. COVID 19

Like many parts of the world the UK is being impacted by the Covid 19 pandemic. The landscape is ever changing, and it is currently too early to fully understand what (if any) restrictions might be in place in May.

Over the last two years the UK and Scottish governments have supported elite sport events with exemptions and so there is a very high degree of confidence that the event will go ahead. However, it is likely that there will be mitigations and additional rules that federations, athletes and support staff must adhere to. More detail will be communicated in due course.

#### 4. REGISTRATION

All riders must enter through their National Federation or UCI BMX Racing Team; no individual entries will be accepted. Only Junior, Under 23 and Elite riders can participate at the 2022 UCI BMX Racing World Cup. Registration deadlines are indicated in the General Race Parameters, accessed on the UCI webpage under 2022 UCI BMX Racing World Cup – Official Documents using this [LINK](#)

Federations and UCI BMX Teams can register their rider entries through the UCI Reg-Online system by clicking this link: [UCI Reg-Online](#). **The name of the hotel where the riders will overnight must be given during the online registration.**

The entry fees for the 2022 UCI BMX Racing World Cup when using the Reg-Online system is **€250** for the Elite category and **€150** for the Under 23 category.

Once the entry deadline has passed federations and teams will be issued with an invoice which can be pre paid before travelling to the UK, alternatively it will be possible to pay by cash or credit card on site at rider confirmation. In case of prepayment, the receipt needs to be taken to the competition. Please note pre-payments, if done, must be made so that the entry fee is received into the organisers bank account before rider confirmation starts. If paying electronically Team Managers should bring proof of transfer to Rider confirmation to assist with any issues.

All Team Managers must attend the riders' confirmation on Thursday 26<sup>th</sup> May between 18:00 and 20:00 presenting licenses and identification for their riders and picking up the race numbers and transponders. Riders not being confirmed before the indicated deadline did not complete the registration procedure and will not be able to compete at the event.

Riders that were registered through the online system but that are unable to participate will still need to pay their entry fee to the organiser if their registration was not cancelled before the on-line registration deadline.

##### Late Registration

Late registration is only possible through the National Federation or UCI BMX Racing Team of which the rider is a member. The entry fee for a late registration is **€500** for an Elite category rider and **€300** for an Under 23 rider. The entry fees must be paid immediately on site. Late entries are entries handled after the online registration deadline and before the riders' confirmation deadline, which is Thursday 26<sup>th</sup> May at 20:00. Once the riders' confirmation deadline has passed, no more late entries will be accepted.

## 5. TEAM BIBS



Team Bibs will be provided for National teams and UCI BMX Racing Teams by the Secretary during the rider's confirmation.

Normally 1 bib is available for each team. Larger teams may request a second bib, should supplies allow (subject to confirmation during the Team Managers' meeting).

Teams will be asked to pay €100 deposit per team bib.

The team bibs gives access to allocated places explained by the PCP during the team managers meeting. This will include the Team Managers Area.

The bibs need to be returned to the Secretary at the end of the competition. The deposit will be refunded when the bib is returned.

## 6. ACCREDITATION

All rainbow passes are delivered to the teams during the first event. If additional sporting passes are necessary, the request needs to be sent before the event to [norm.mccann@uci.ch](mailto:norm.mccann@uci.ch)

For the request, please indicate the reason, the name and the contact details of the person for whom they are requested.

Rainbow Passes will be distributed during riders' confirmation in the registration room.

## 9. TEAM AREAS

In line with other events in the 2022 UCI BMX Racing World Cup series team areas will be available to hire.

All **pre booked** team spaces will be on the north side of the venue and include tent hire, power and Wi-Fi access as well as a premium parking spot close by. Spaces will be allocated on a first come first served basis on receipt of the booking form.

Two options are available:

- Small (approx. 9m<sup>2</sup>)
- Large (approx. 20m<sup>2</sup>)

For small teams and individual riders an unreserved area with no power or Wi-Fi will be available.

Power will be available until 30 minutes after the end of competition each day.



Parking on site will be very busy, teams are not permitted to set up tents/gazebos/structures in the car park area or take extra space for storage of cycles.

The deadline to book is **Friday 13th May 2022** to allow arrangements to be made. Bookings are non-refundable and payment must be received before or at the latest during Rider Confirmation.

**Teams are not permitted to bring their own structures / tents / gazebos.**

### **Travel**

Transfers from the airport are not provided by the LOC, teams are required to make their own travel arrangements to and from the point of arrival.

#### **Glasgow International Airport**

Glasgow International Airport is located approximately 8 miles and 15 minutes from the Glasgow BMX Centre. There are no direct public transport links from the airport to the venue but teams can arrange a transfer through the official accommodation agency.

There is also the option for a taxi directly to the track from the airport which would cost approximately £20 sterling for a standard car depending on traffic conditions.

Glasgow Prestwick and Edinburgh International Airports are both within an approximate 1 hour drive.

### Notes:

*In case the total number of entries in the event following riders' confirmation is less than 160 including all categories (both genders, Elite/Junior combined and Under 23), the above 'per round' amounts for all categories are reduced by 25%, and semi-final positions are not paid. If the total number of entries defined in the same way is greater than 300 following riders' confirmation, the above amounts are increased by 25% for all categories.*

*In case the same rider wins both stages of a world cup in the same weekend in the Under 23 category for their gender, the UCI will pay that rider a bonus of 1'000 euros.*

### Rider & Team Manager Seating

A reserved standing area will be available for team managers and riders to watch the racing. This will be accessed using an accreditation or wristband.

Please note that all general seating is ticketed and therefore there is no seating in the spectator stands for riders and team staff.

During competition accreditation will not grant access to the spectator seating, a ticket will be required.

### Performance Analysts

Analysts, with accreditation will be able to film from the Rider and Team Manager Seating area as noted above.

Due to COVID-19 constraints, Analysts will not be able to enter or film from the Public areas at the BMX Centre.

### 13. ABOUT GLASGOW

Glasgow is a truly cosmopolitan city, known for its friendly people it has beautiful architecture, numerous cultural attractions and is one of Europe's greenest urban areas with 90 parks and gardens. Glasgow is also the gateway to Scotland with some of the world's most breath-taking scenery right on its doorstep.

It's Scotland's most accessible city with visitors able to fly direct to one of 3 international airports surrounding Glasgow, or take the train from any UK transport hub.
