

Round #1 – TISSOT UCI Track Nations Cup - Jakarta February 23-26, 2023**GENERAL INFORMATION**

Jakarta is the capital and largest city of Indonesia, located on the northwest coast of Java, the world's most populous island. Host to the 2018 Asian and Para-Asian Games, Jakarta has a population of 10.5 million people and is one of the oldest continuously inhabited cities in Southeast Asia.

The Jakarta International Velodrome is the only velodrome of its kind in Indonesia and only the second in Southeast Asia that meets top international standards. Purpose built for the 2018 Asian and Para-Asian Games, it replaced the previous outdoor Jakarta Velodrome that was spiritual home to the discipline of track cycling in Indonesia for almost four decades.

How to get to the venue**Nearest International airport:**

Soekarno Hatta International Airport – CGK (Official Airport)
Approximately 40 km (between 30 and 60 minutes by car, depending on traffic)

Transportation between venue and hotels:

A shuttle service will be provided between the velodrome and official hotels, only for teams booking through the Local Organising Committee (LOC). The service will be available starting in the morning of the first day of official training, Wednesday 22 February.

COVID-19 INFORMATION

The COVID-19 pandemic continues to impact activities in various places. With the ever-changing landscape, it is difficult to understand what (if any) restrictions and protocols that may be in place during the event in February. More details of event specific protocols and resources regarding local health restrictions will be communicated in due course.

As of 1st December 2022, a fully vaccinated certification is required to enter Indonesia.

TRAINING SESSIONS**Official Training at the velodrome**

The track will be available for official training on Wednesday February 22nd and Thursday February 23rd inclusively. Training schedules will be published on the UCI website once all teams have confirmed their arrival details.

Training Venue – prior to the start of Official Training

The Jakarta International Velodrome may be able to accommodate teams arriving early and those who wish to train on the track prior to Wednesday February 22nd. Please note that availability is limited and will depend on regular bookings and event set up.

ACCREDITATIONS

Permanence – Accreditation Centre

Accreditations will be available at the Jakarta International Velodrome from Tuesday 21 February 2023 as per official entry lists only.

The Permanence will be open according to the following schedule:

All accreditations must be picked up and distributed before further access to the venue is allowed. All team members will need accreditations to access the venue and track centre.

PERFORMANCE ANALYSTS

There will be a reserved area for performance analysts on the back straight. Availability is limited and bookings will be made on a first come, first serve basis. The cost of this service is **500,000 IDR** (cash). Teams wishing to book a spot must send an email titled PERFORMANCE ANALYSTS to info@jknationscup2023.com. Additional spots could be available, but without access to power.

STORAGE

On-site storage will be accessible for free from noon (12:00pm) on Tuesday 21 February to 11:59pm on Monday 27 February. All teams must empty their storage area by this time. Should you need access to storage prior to Tuesday 21 February, please contact us at info@jknationscup2023.com.

A **1,000,000 IDR** deposit will have to be made in exchange for the key to access storage which must be paid in cash. The deposit will be returned at the end of the event once the key is returned.

PARKING

Traffic is very heavy in Jakarta and self-driving is therefore not recommended for obvious safety reasons.

Nevertheless, on-site parking is limited, and teams will receive a maximum one (1) team vehicle parking pass. The parking pass will have to be presented to access the parking and must be visible at all times in the parked vehicle. Parking passes will have to be picked up at the Permanence – Accreditation Centre.

ANTI-DOPING CONTROLS

The doping control room will be well identified in the velodrome, with signage from the track centre and from the accredited entrance. The doping control room will be in an accredited area.

The Local Organising Committee guarantees issuance of a visa on arrival for all registered participants and supporting staff, provided an official invitation letter with the details of registered participants and supporting staff is procured from the Local Organising Committee prior to arrival into Indonesia.

Procuring a visa on arrival is the more economical choice and adds a 20-30min administrative component to your arrival at most.

Customs clearance

There will be mandatory requirement for an issuance of a temporary import permit for all equipment accompanying teams. It is in the teams' interest to be as exhaustive and descriptive as possible to this list of equipment to facilitate the entry procedure.

The relevant form will be available on the UCI Tissot Nations Cup webpage early January which will have to returned to the LOC by no later than the online registrations' deadline.
