

ACCREDITATIONS FOR NATIONAL FEDERATIONS

After having registered your riders to take part in the 2024 Tissot UCI Track World Championships, please do not forget to submit accreditations requests for your delegation.

A maximum number of accreditations is allocated for each National Federation. It is up to each National Federation to adapt their accreditation requests depending on their needs.

The total number of accreditations is based on the number of quotas allocated to each National Federation for the 2024 Tissot UCI Track World Championships:

Total number of quotas	Maximum overall accreditation quota per National Federation
1-5 quotas	5
6-10 quotas	8
11-15 quotas	12
16-20 quotas	15
21-25 quotas	18
+26 quotas	25

Within the above-mentioned maximum number of accreditations, each National Federation may accredit the following individuals according to their function within the delegation:

**Please note the following rules put in place regarding Team Videographers:*

- **Each National Federation Team Videographer shall contact Susanne.lenz@uci.ch in order to sign a WAIVER.**
- *National Federation team videographer are not allowed to film race action (including warm-up, start preparation, start, race, finish of qualifying and/or finals), live flash interviews or podiums.*
- *They may film practice, interviews and behind the scenes, may request access to race footage from the HB (at technical cost) and can publish clips with up to 3min race footage in total per day (across all races and all publications of the day) with an embargo of 24h after the last podium of the day.*
- *Any clips which are including race footage can have a maximum length of 6min and it is not allowed to do compilation of race footage across different days. In case the National Federation wants to combine race footage from different days in one clip they need to request UCI for approval.*

The riders registered in the 2024 Tissot UCI Track World Championships receive an accreditation automatically. They are not included in the quota of the delegation and there is no need to apply for them.

The accreditation procedure is made of two separate processes:

1. fill out the staff data that will be stored and be ready for use for all the UCI competition
2. apply for accreditation for a single competition

Opening date of the accreditation system: 9 September 2024, 12:00 pm (CET)

Closing date of the accreditation system: 23 September 2024, 12:00 pm (CET)

National federations must collect their accreditations from the Accreditation Centre located at the **Thorvald Ellegaard Lounge** (south entrance of the Velodrome).
