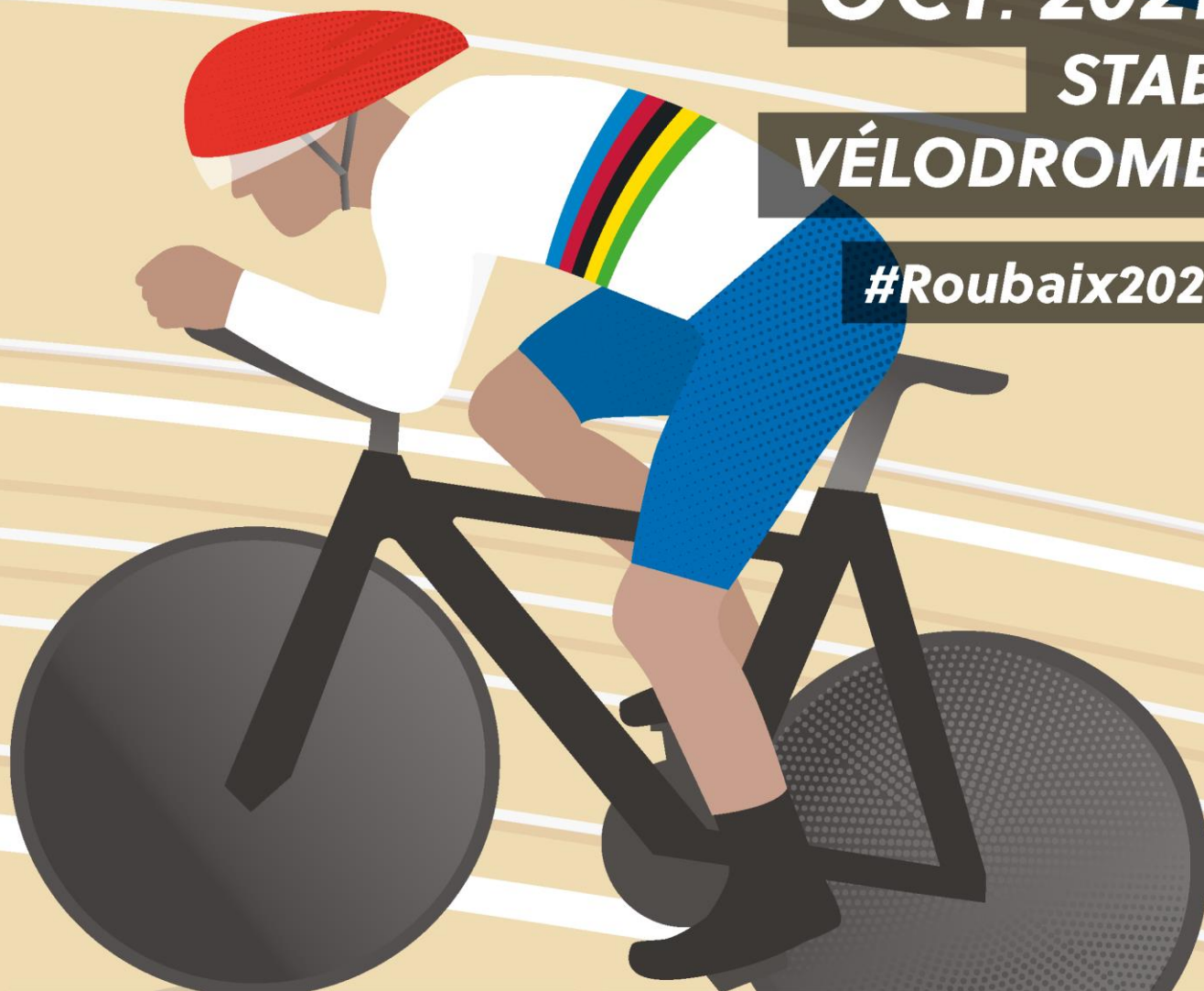

2021 TISSOT UCI Track Cycling World Championships 20-24 October 2021

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1. WELCOME

WELCOME TO THE 2021 TISSOT UCI TRACK CYCLING WORLD CHAMPIONSHIPS



This year's UCI Track Cycling World Championships are historic in more ways than one.

As part of the Union Cycliste Internationale's reform of track cycling, we are holding them on new October dates instead of the traditional early-year period of February-March. In addition, from 2021 the athletes will have a double incentive: not only to earn the prestigious rainbow jersey of UCI World Champion but also to qualify for our new UCI Track Champions League, which gets under way with the opening round just

two weeks after these UCI World Championships.

The stakes this week are high, and the venue is a more than worthy one for an event of this importance. Indeed, the Vélodrome Couvert Régional Jean-Stablinski (known locally as "Le Stab") is in an iconic location, next to the Vélodrome André-Pétrieux which we all know so well as the finish of the famous Paris-Roubaix. Just a few weeks ago it welcomed some of the world's best Classics riders, including the women's professional peloton for the first time.

The 2021 UCI Track Cycling World Championships are organised in collaboration with the French Cycling Federation (FFC) and with the support of the City of Roubaix, Lille European Metropole, the department du Nord, and the region of Hauts-de-France.

We have worked together to ensure that our 2021 UCI Track Cycling World Championships are of the highest quality, and that the athletes can compete in excellent conditions. But our efforts are also for you, the media, who we rely on to relay the racing to fans worldwide. Your role in this event is extremely important which is why we have produced this Media Guide to facilitate your work. We hope that you will find all the necessary information and contacts you need to ensure your stay goes smoothly.

We wish you all the very best for an enjoyable and memorable edition of the 2021 TISSOT UCI Track Cycling World Championships.

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3. NOTES TO THE MEDIA

To facilitate a safe and smooth holding of the **2021 TISSOT UCI Track Cycling World Championships**, accredited media are invited to pay attention to the following:

- A Media Centre located in the track centre infield will be equipped with working spaces, cabled internet and power points;
- Media representatives will not have access to the team areas;
- Media interviews with the top 3 riders can only be conducted once the Rights holder interviews are done at the mixed zone;
- Media representatives should display their accreditation badges and wear their media vests given by the Organiser/UCI on the top layer of clothing in a visible manner at any time;
- Media pass will be distributed at the Accreditation Centre, by presenting a hard copy of their PCR Test;
- The Organiser/UCI reserve the right to cancel any media accreditation in case of violation of the above;
- Media must refer to the Covid-19 protocol before their arrival – please refer to **Section 4. Covid-19 protocol**.

BROADCAST MEDIA

- Media vests for representatives of the Radio TV are distributed at the Host Broadcaster Booking office, first opening from Tuesday, October 19, 2021 at 16:00 CET;
- Return of the media vests will be possible app 45 min after each final session in the evening, at the latest on Sunday after the last session.
- There will be a deposit for the bibs of € 50 in cash only. In case one or several vests are not returned, UCI will keep the deposit.



PHOTOGRAPHERS

- Bibs can only be picked up at the accreditation centre (AC) during opening hours and will require payment of a deposit of 50 Euros payable in cash (no official documents will be accepted).
- There will be a deposit for the bibs of 50 Euros in cash only. In case one or several vests are not returned, UCI will keep the deposit.



4. COVID-19 PROTOCOL

Given the health situation, we all need to take responsibility to protect each other and to stop the spread of the virus. Working conditions for all participants at the event therefore need to follow [Covid-19 counter-measures](#). These counter-measures for hosting the TISSOT UCI Track World Championships are organised according to the principle of protective "bubbles" around the teams and groups of individuals in interaction with the teams, including the media attending the Championships. All participants at the event, including media, are included inside an unique bubble, i.e. the Track bubble.

All of the areas reserved for the media in Roubaix (in particular the media centre, the TV compound, mixed zone and photographer platform) will be maintained but with restricted access to ensure a safe environment for everyone involved.

ALL ACCREDITED PERSONS WILL BE REQUIRED TO:

- **respect the French Ministry of Europe and Foreign Affairs countries entry restrictions and the different zones (GREEN, ORANGE and RED countries)**
- **identify which zone they are arriving from and follow the respective Covid-19 counter-measures (GREEN, ORANGE and RED countries).**
- **Photographers, cameramen and journalists arriving from an ORANGE or RED country must be accommodated in official hotels offered by the organizer and use official means of transport for commuting inside the Track bubble (railway station / airport, to the hotels, to the venue).**
- **to withdraw their accreditation, all media (GREEN, ORANGE and RED) will need to present a hard copy of a negative PCR test from less than 72 hours to withdraw accreditation.**
- **photographers and TV's crew from GREEN ORANGE OR RED zone (whatever the country of origin) will need to upload their vaccination certificate to a dedicated platform before their arrival (if they have been vaccinated)**
- **respect social distancing and wear a mask at all times including outdoors and in all areas of the UCI Championships. It is reminded that the mask must be worn correctly, covering the mouth and nose.**

ENTRY CONDITIONS IN FRANCE

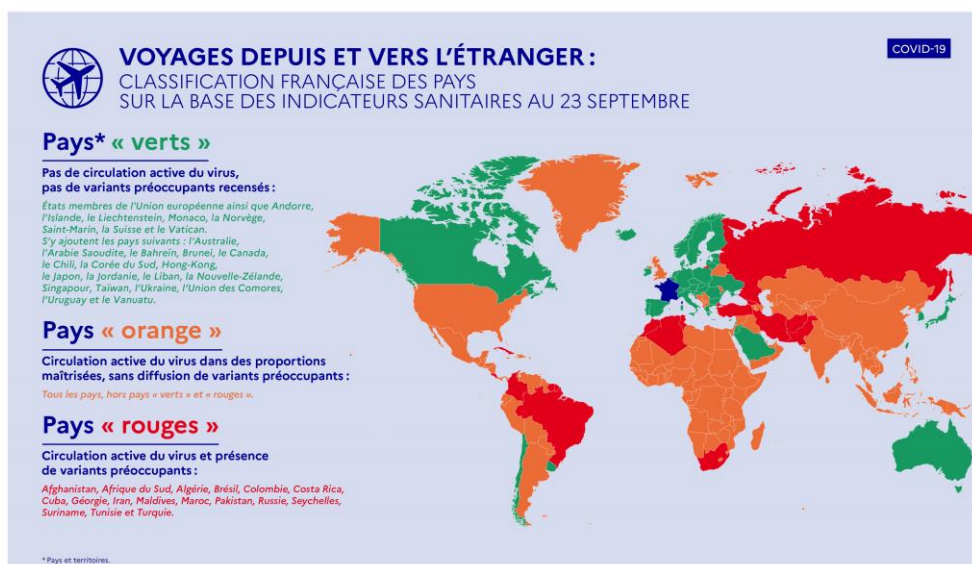
Following the French Ministry of Europe and Foreign Affairs measures of the entry conditions for foreign nationals wishing to enter France, the French Government released a list of countries and territories epidemic situation:

Countries/territories on the "green" list: countries in the European space (European Union, Andorra, the Holy See, Iceland, Liechtenstein, Monaco, Norway, San Marino and Switzerland), and Australia, Bahrain, Brunei, Canada, Chile, Comoros Islands, Hong Kong, Japan, Jordan, Lebanon, New Zealand, Saudi Arabia, Singapore, South Korea, Taiwan, Ukraine, Uruguay and Vanuatu.

Countries/territories on the “orange” list: every country/territory in the world, except those on the green list and red list.

Countries/territories on the “red” list: Afghanistan, Algeria, Brazil, Colombia, Costa Rica, Cuba, Georgia, Iran, Maldives, Morocco, Pakistan, Russia, Seychelles, South Africa, Suriname, Tunisia and Turkey

Before media’s arrival in France, it’s recommended to verify the condition entry on France Diplomacy website.

ACCOMMODATION

ORANGE AND RED COUNTRIES

Photographers, cameramen and journalists arriving from an **ORANGE** or **RED** country must be accommodated in the official hotel offered by the organizer **the Kyriad Lille Nord Roncq** and use official means of transport for commuting inside the Track bubble (railway station / airport, to the hotels, to the venue).

Information will be sent to the hotels in order to enable social distancing between groups. Moreover, specific preventive measures will be implemented by hotel staff, such as room cleaning, maintaining physical distancing from guests, hand washing, wearing a mask during service, etc.

GREEN COUNTRIES

Photographers, cameramen and journalists arriving from a **GREEN** country are not required to be accommodated in official hotels offered by the organizer or to use official means of transport.

Specific prices are proposed for media if they want to stay at the **J - Park Inn By Radisson**.

COVID-19 CERTIFICATE

Before arriving at the Championships, **photographers and TV Crew from GREEN ORANGE OR RED zone** (whatever the country of origin) will need to **upload the official vaccination certificate on the dedicated platform**, using the following link:

Please note that only files named in this way will be taken into account.

ORANGE AND RED COUNTRIES

For all photographers, cameramen and journalists arriving from an ORANGE AND RED COUNTRIES (vaccinated or not), a daily rapid antigen test is mandatory. These rapid tests will be carried out by the official laboratory designated by the organizer and the financial support will be provided by the organiser. Additional information will be provided later.

GREEN COUNTRIES

For all vaccinated photographers, cameramen and journalists arriving from a **GREEN** country, no additional COVID test is mandatory. To be valid, the vaccine used must be recognized by the European Medicines Agency (i.e. Pfizer, Moderna, AstraZeneca, Vaxzevria, Covishield and Johnson & Johnson.).

For unvaccinated photographers (red and yellow bibs) and cameramen authorized to access the track or the box area arriving from a green country, a daily rapid antigen test is mandatory. These rapid tests will be carried out by the official laboratory designated by the organizer and the financial support will be provided by the organiser. Additional information will be provided later.

For unvaccinated written and spoken journalists arriving from a green country, the EU digital COVID certificate is mandatory. The EU COVID certificate, is issued by national health authorities in digital or paper form, and authenticated by a QR code. The people concerned here, not being vaccinated, it is used to prove either,

- that they are not carriers of the SARS-CoV-2 thanks to the negative results of a PCR (less than 72 hours) or an antigen test (less than 48 hours),
- that they have recently recovered from the COVID-19 disease for more than 15 days and less than 6 months.

ACCREDITATIONS

One negative PCR Test is required for EVERYONE GREEN ORANGE RED (whatever the country of origin) dated less than 3 or 2 days previously upon withdrawal of their accreditation, for all journalists, i.e. photographers, cameramen, written and spoken journalists. A **hard copy** of the analysis report will be presented upon arrival at the venue, for the use of shuttle, access to the official hotel and accreditation withdrawal.

Without following the mentioned procedure, the organisation will be forced to refuse the journalist's entry.

MEDIA CENTRE

The lay-out of the Media Centre will follow social distancing rules, in particular in the spaces between the workstations (150 centimetres). Alcohol-based gel will be made available by the organisers at the entry and exit zones. **It is mandatory to wear a mask throughout the event for all media representatives. This means that they must wear a face mask covering the mouth and nose, during the entire time they are on the event site (no spatial or area exceptions).** This also applies to their workstation in the Media Centre, where masks must be worn. The walkways between the rows of tables should only be used for getting around (and not to stand and chat). Journalists will be placed according to the organisation they work for and their nationality. As was the case in the past, photographers who need a LAN network will have a special area set aside for them. To guarantee social distancing, media using the Media Centre will not be permitted to move any furniture (tables, chairs).

MIXED ZONE

The concept of the mixed zone (MZ) is being maintained for all journalists (except for photographers, as is customary). The dimensions of the MZ will be adapted to meet safety requirements (to provide space and ventilation). **Access to the zone will be conditional on journalists wearing masks.** The required space will be maintained between the athletes and the media areas, and journalists will have to use a boom to attach their recording device.

CONCLUSION

These arrangements may need to be adapted to reflect the prevailing health situation, scientific knowledge and any decisions taken by the relevant authorities at the time of the event. The organising committee and the UCI insist on the application of these necessary measures to prevent the spread of the virus and maintain optimal sanitary conditions.

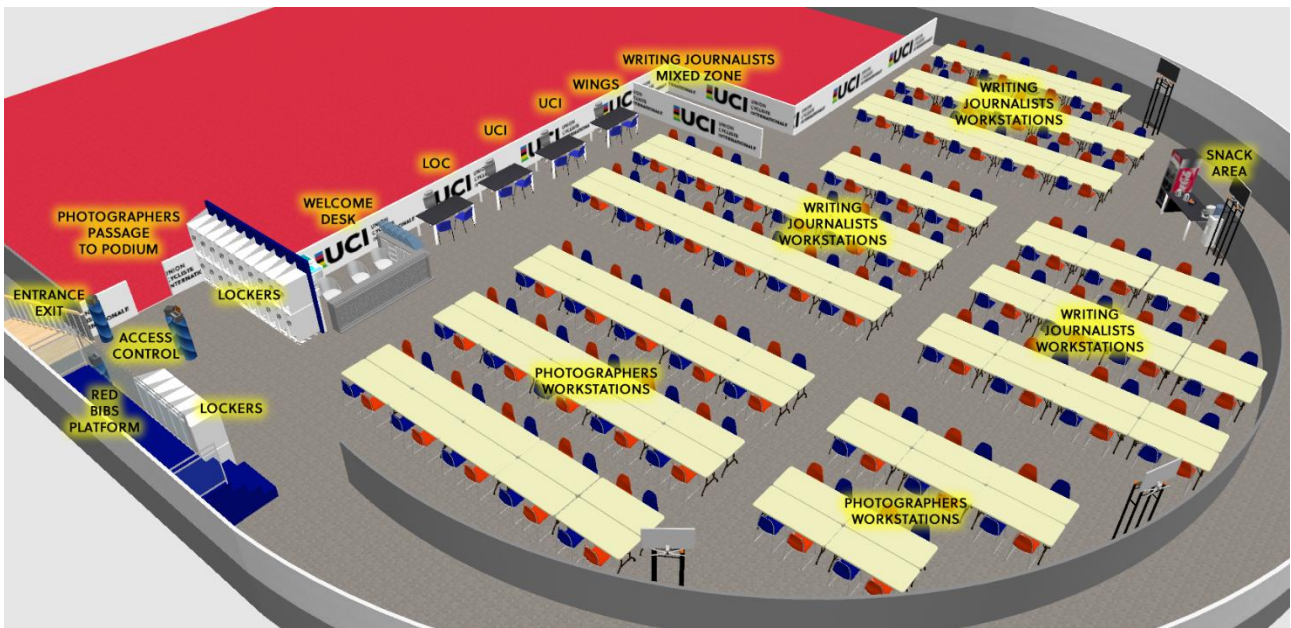

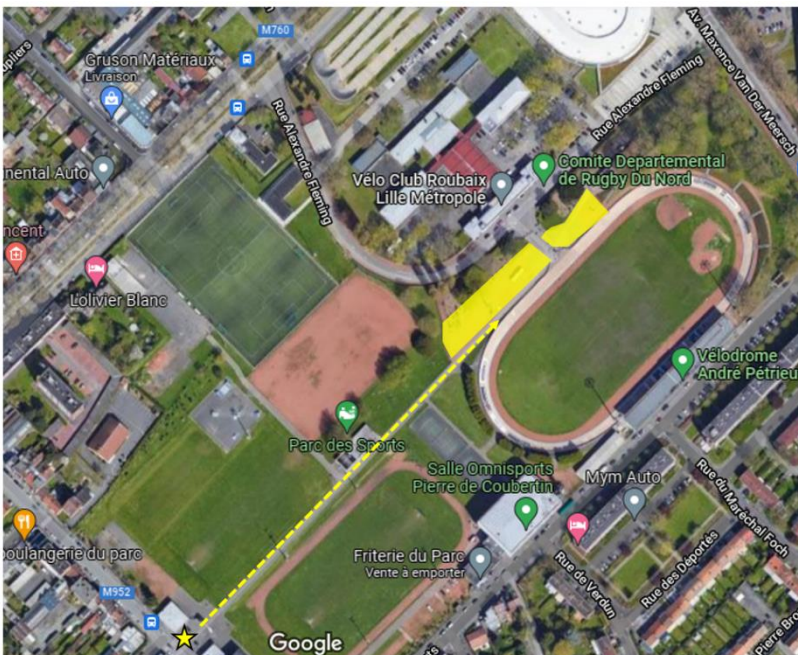

Bibs and accreditation are required to be worn by photographers during the Championships. The bibs are numbered, strictly personal and cannot be replaced in the event of loss. They are separated into different colour categories according to the group they represent.

The bib distribution and collection procedure has been adapted. Bibs can only be picked up at the accreditation centre (AC) during opening hours and will require payment of a deposit of 50 Euros payable in cash (no official documents will be accepted).

Bibs will then need to be handed back at the AC or at the Media Centre (to the UCI Media Centre Coordinator Laura Folchi: I.folchi@wingsmedia.it). The bibs must be returned in the plastic bag that they were provided in, otherwise the deposit will not be refunded.

Bibs can only be worn by the named person. Any change in photographer within an organisation during the event will require a new bib which will be provided under the same conditions as mentioned above (i.e. the same bib cannot be used by more than one photographer). Importantly, if a photographer does not return his bib, the second bib for the same media company will not be given to his colleague.



Photographers allocated a red bib will have access to the track apron, track centre infield and the spectators' concourse. They will have access to the Media Centre in the track centre which will be equipped with working spaces, cabled internet and power points. Please check the covid protocol.



Photographers allocated a yellow bib will have access to the track centre infield and the spectators' concourse. They will have access to the Media Centre in the track centre which will be equipped with working spaces, cabled internet and power points. **Yellow bib photographers do not have access to the apron track.** Please check the covid protocol.

Please note that Bib delivery for Photographers is subject to a 50 Eur deposit (Cash only). Neither credit cards payments nor documents deposit are accepted.

Guidance for photographers

- Photographers must always follow the instructions of race officials. Race officials may remove photographers from the track apron at their discretion.
- Photographers shooting on the track apron must always wear their red bib.
- **No media are allowed to shoot from the track apron without official permission.**
- Photographers on the track apron are responsible for themselves and any consequences of their behaviour and must stay within 1.5 metre of the inner fence at all times.
- Photographers may not place any equipment including tripods, bags, and clothing on the apron in case a rider needs to exit the track unexpectedly.
- During bunch events photographers are not allowed to stand on the track apron (corner 1) but a platform will be available to shoot at the corner 1 behind the fence.
- Please be aware of what is happening on the track at all times and never turn your back on the cyclists who will always travel in an anti-clockwise direction on the track. Please also take care not to impede race officials in their management of the event.
- Please do not step in front of the infield cameras as the event is being broadcast live on television.
- Photographers must not be in front of the HB cameras on the track apron.

9. BROADCAST MEDIA

All access to the infield for broadcast media (TV and radio personnel) will be organised according to the different tiers detailed below. In order to provide the broadcast crews with the best service possible, bibs should be collected as soon as possible upon arrival. Broadcast media bibs come into 4 colors. The Bibs for broadcast media can be picked up and returned in the TV Booking Office, close to the main entrance.

HOST BROADCASTER

- As dedicated production partner, the host broadcaster's team will be allowed to access all areas in order to ensure a first-class television signal at European Broadcasting Union's standard. The host broadcaster's team is therefore, the only audio-visual media allowed to access the security zone (apron) during the event.

RIGHTS HOLDERS

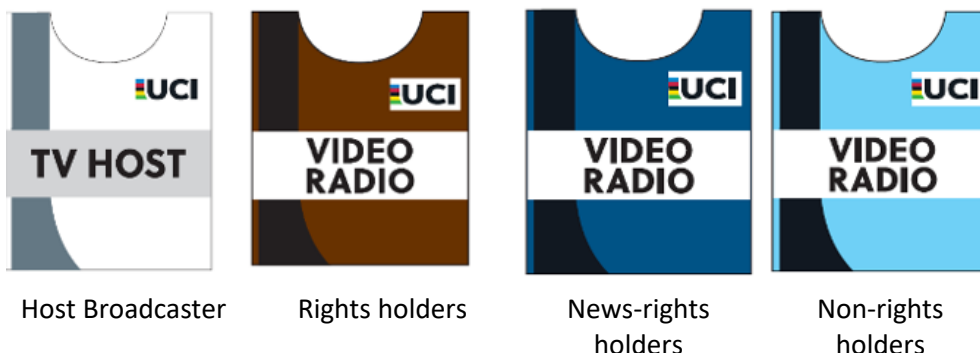
- After the end of a race all riders are supposed to leave the track through the exit at the back straight and they will pass the reserved dedicated positions of the Rights Holders (RH) and the Rights Holders box.
- RH who have reserved a position have the opportunity to do interviews with all riders there.
- RH who have not reserved a position have the opportunity to do their interviews with the non-podium riders after the race when these riders have passed the reserved dedicated positions.
- RH who have not reserved a position have the opportunity to do their interviews with the podium riders ONLY after the podium ceremony. After the podium ceremony, top 3 riders will be brought back to the mixed zone.
- Rights Holder camera operators do not have by any means access to the track security zone / apron.

NEWS RIGHTS HOLDERS

- Access to the mixed zone in between the Rights Holders and the Written Media.
- Interviews in the mixed zone only.
- No access to the team boxes for interviews

NON-RIGHTS HOLDERS

- Non-Rights holders are only allowed to film interviews in the mixed zone but no racing / no podium as confirmed in the accreditation process
- Access to the mixed zone for Interview only after the end of the final session
- Non rights holders have got to organize with the press officers or directly with athletes that they come back the Mixed zone after the end of the respective session.

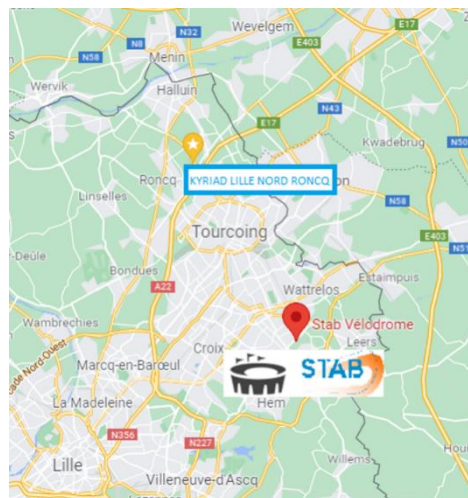

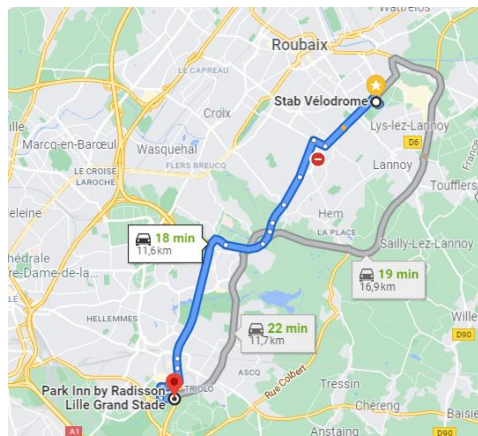

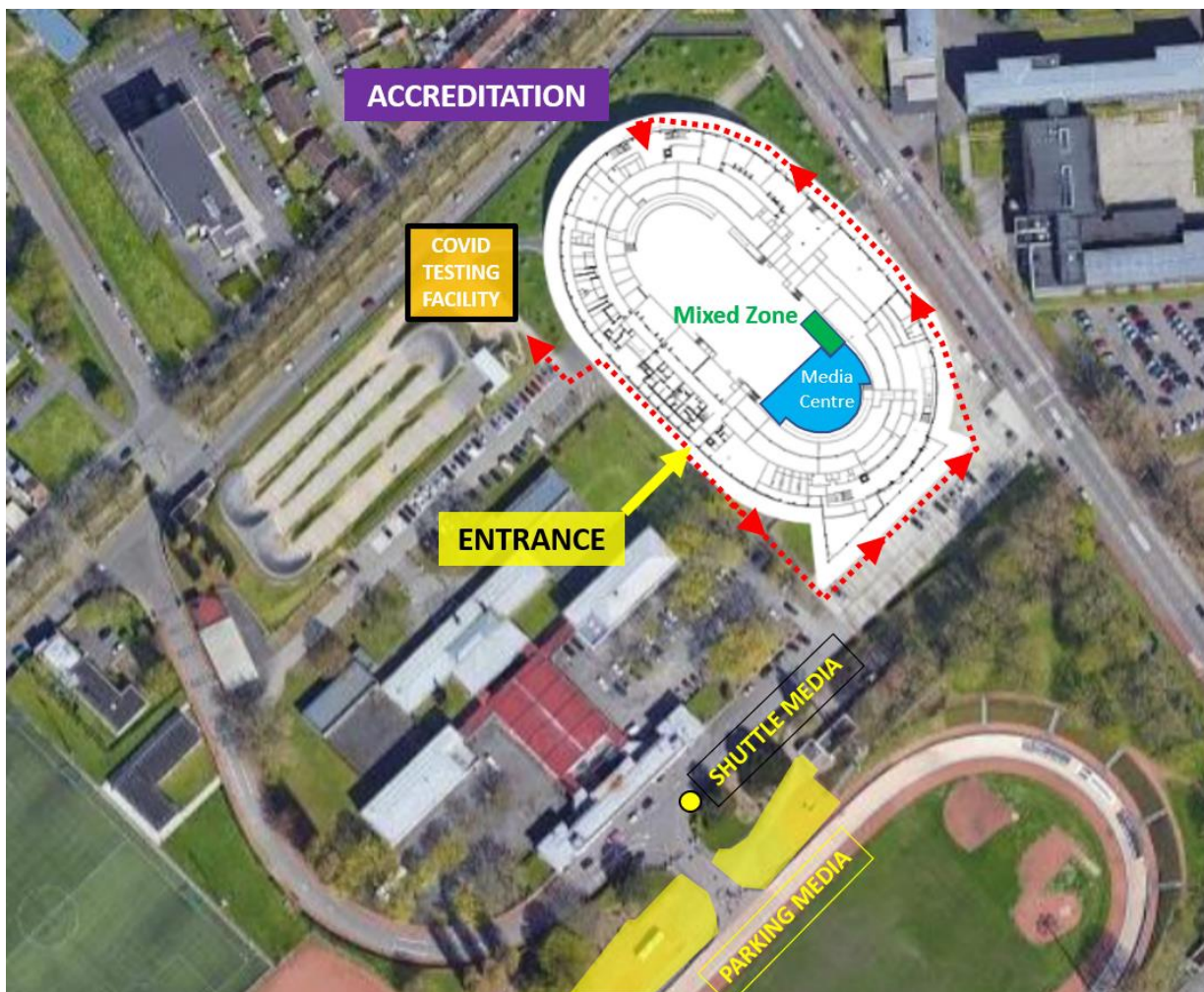
