
ELIGIBILITY – NATION VS RIDER

GENERAL

Distinction between eligibility of a nation and eligibility of a rider:

- Nation
 - For UCI Track World Championships
 - To be allocated a quota for a specific event at the UCI Track World Championships, a nation must have fulfilled the eligibility requirements. If the nation hasn't fulfilled the eligibility criteria (general or for a specific event), a quota will not be awarded to the nation.
- Rider
 - Age
 - Minimum points for certain events at certain competitions (UCI Track World Cup)

GENERAL

Article 3.2.001 – Participation

Eligibility by Competition Category									
Category	Eligible Riders								
Elite	Elite, Under-23, & junior riders aged 18 (2 nd year junior)								
Under 23	Under 23 & junior riders aged 18 (2 nd year junior)								
Junior	Junior riders*								

Can I register a rider who is 17 at the time of the UCI Track World Championships but turns 18 in November (same year)? Yes, if all other eligibility conditions are met.

The age in the UCI regulations refers to the age as of 31st December of the year in question.

*Article 1.1.035

Only riders 17 and over can enter competitions on the international calendar.













PARTICIPATION

UCI TRACK WORLD CHAMPIONSHIPS



Steps leading to participation at the UCI Track World Championships:

- The nation must ensure all eligibility criteria has been fulfilled, in due time.
- The nation must be awarded a quota, by qualifying through the UCI Rankings.
- Registration

CRITERIA – UCI TRACK WORLD CHAMPIONSHIPS



ELIGIBILITY OF THE NATION

3 conditions:

- Hosting of an international competition (9.2.025)
- Participation UCI Track World Cup (9.2.027bis)
- Participation Continental Championships (9.2.027bis)

Note:

As of 2025, there is no more minimum points requirements for riders' eligibility for the UCI Track World Championships.


HOSTING OF AN INTERNATIONAL TRACK COMPETITION

UCI TRACK WORLD CHAMPIONSHIPS - ELIGIBILITY

Article 9.2.025

 Nations must register and host at least one international track competition on the UCI calendar between the last edition of the World Championships and six weeks before the upcoming World Championships.

Example for 2025:





HOSTING OF AN INTERNATIONAL TRACK COMPETITION

UCI TRACK WORLD CHAMPIONSHIPS - ELIGIBILITY

- What happens is the UCI Track World Championships is moved earlier in a calendar year?
 - o Article 9.2.025: a competition held after the UCI Track World Championships will be considered, on condition that this competition has taken place at minimum for several seasons on that date.

E.g.:

In 2027, the UCI Cycling Word Championships will be organised in August. Will the UCI consider that an international competition organised for several seasons in September fulfil this criteria, even though it is being organised after the UCI Cycling Word Championships?

Yes, it will be considered.

UCI TRACK WORLD CHAMPIONSHIPS - ELIGIBILITY

Article 9.2.027bis

- A nation must have participated in the specific event & gender in at least one round of the UCI Track World
 Cup to be eligible in this event and gender.
 - o Note: this only applies when the specific events are scheduled at each round of the UCI Track World Cup
 - o TS, SP, KE, TP, MA, OM, EL
- Example:
 - Nation A had women only competing in all 7 events in the first round of the UCI Track World Cup, and had men compete in all sprint events (TS, SP, KE) in the 2nd round of the UCI Track World Cup. Nation A did not participate in the 3rd round.
 - o As such, the nation has fulfilled this specific criteria and is eligible for quotas for all 7 women's events but is only eligible to obtain quota for the TS, SP and Keirin for men.

REMINDER:

THIS SPECIFIC CRITERIA IS NOT APPLICABLE FOR THE 2025 TISSOT UCI TRACK WORLD CHAMPIONSHIPS

(no need to submit a request for exemption)

3.4 PARTICIPATION AT THE ELITE CONTINENTAL CHAMPIONSHIPS

UCI TRACK WORLD CHAMPIONSHIPS - ELIGIBILITY

Article 9.2.027bis

The nation must have participated in this specific event & gender in the most recent Elite Continental Championships.

Example:

 Nation "A": No participation in the Women's Elimination in the 2025 Elite Continental Championships. Can the nation be allocated a quota for the Women's Elimination during the 2025 Tissot UCI Track World Championships?

UCI TRACK WORLD CHAMPIONSHIPS - ELIGIBILITY



A'S

Requests may be submitted in cases of exceptional circumstances, but acceptance is not guaranteed.

Article 9.2.025 - Hosting of an international track competition

- Deadline:
 - o 6 weeks before the upcoming World Championships.

Article 9.2.027 bis – Participation in one round of the Word Cup and in the Elite Continental Championships

- Deadline:
 - \circ Within 3 days following the end of the competition in question.



ALLOCATION OF QUOTAS

• UCI Track Rankings used for the establishment of qualification quota are calculated **six weeks** before the World Championships. The maximum number of riders/teams qualified through the UCI Track Ranking is shown in the following table:

Keirin	30
Omnium	24
Scratch Race	24
Points race	24
Elimination	24
Madison	18




MADISON

UCI TRACK WORLD CHAMPIONSHIPS - QUOTA

- Maximum: 18 teams
- Allocated through the UCI Track Ranking by Nation.
 - o Quota awarded to the top 18 eligible nations in the ranking
- Outgoing champions: if the nation of outgoing champions is not qualified in the top 18 eligible teams, the number of qualified teams through the rankings will be reduced to accommodate the outgoing champions. Nominative quotas (specific athletes only).





OTHER ENDURANCE EVENTS (BUNCH RACES)

UCI TRACK WORLD CHAMPIONSHIPS - QUOTAS & ELIGIBILITY

- Scratch Race, Points Race, Elimination Race and Omnium
- Maximum: 24 riders in each race
- Allocation:
 - o First 2/3 quota allocated through the UCI Track Ranking by Nation Endurance
 - o The top 16 eligible nations in the ranking will obtain a quota for each of the 4 events
 - Last 1/3 quota: allocated through the UCI Track Individual Ranking Endurance.
 - The top 8 riders of eligible nations, which have not already qualified through the UCI Track Ranking by Nation – Endurance, will qualify a quote for their nation
- Important to note: different riders can be entered in these events.
- Outgoing champions: if the nation of outgoing champions is not qualified through the rankings, the number of quota allocated through the rankings will be reduced to accommodate the outgoing champions. Nominative quotas (specific athletes only).




SPRINT & KEIRIN

UCI TRACK WORLD CHAMPIONSHIPS - QUOTAS & ELIGIBILITY



- Allocated through the UCI Track Individual Ranking Sprint.
- Important to note: riders in the Sprint and Keirin can be different riders
- Outgoing champions: additional champions quotas (nominative quotas).
 - Total number of riders: Up to 36 (or up to 37 in the edition following the Olympic Games)






KILOMETRE & INDIVIDUAL PURSUIT

UCI TRACK WORLD CHAMPIONSHIPS - QUOTAS & ELIGIBILITY

- Maximum: -
- The Kilometre TT (KT) & Individual Pursuit (IP) are open to one rider per eligible nation.
- In addition:
 - Kilometre TT: top 10 nations in the UCI Nations Ranking of the Team Sprint (6 weeks before the World Championships) can enter a second rider.
 - Individual Pursuit: top 10 nations in the UCI Nations Ranking of the Team Pursuit (6 weeks before the World Championships) can enter a second rider.
- Outgoing champions: additional champions quotas (nominative quotas).






TEAM PURSUIT & TEAM SPRINT

UCI TRACK WORLD CHAMPIONSHIPS - QUOTAS

- Maximum: -
- The Team Pursuit and Team Sprint are open to one team per eligible nation.
 - o Although there is a ranking, all nations may enter a team as long as the **eligibility** criteria has been fulfilled.







RESERVE QUOTAS

UCI TRACK WORLD CHAMPIONSHIPS - QUOTAS & ELIGIBILITY



- National Federation hosting the UCI Track World Championhips (article 9.2.028):
 - 1st reserve quota, if not already qualified
 - Note: the eligibility criteria remains applicable (9.2.025, 9.2.027bis)
- Reallocation of unused quotas: 48h after the close of registration



During this period, it is important for National Federations/Team Managers to monitor their emails, as the deadline to accept/decline quotas is limited.


OUTGOING CHAMPIONS

UCI TRACK WORLD CHAMPIONSHIPS - QUOTAS

In addition to the quotas allocated to nations through the UCI Track rankings, quotas may also be granted to the following:

- Outgoing World Champions (article 9.2.009)
- Continental Champions (article 9.2.027)
- Olympic Champions (9.2.009)
 - In the edition of the UCI World Championships following the Olympic Games only
- Nominative quotas: can only be used by the actual champions






OUTGOING CHAMPIONS

UCI TRACK WORLD CHAMPIONSHIPS - QUOTAS

- Additional quotas
 - Sprint, Keirin, Individual Pursuit, Kilometre TT
- Quotas allocated only if the nation is not already qualified through the UCI Track rankings
 - Omnium, Points Race, Scratch Race, Elimination Race, Madison
 - Basically, when there is a maximum number of riders/teams allowed on the track (bunch races)






OUTGOING CHAMPIONS

UCI TRACK WORLD CHAMPIONSHIPS - QUOTAS

Keirin – 30 Riders (2 riders in blue are from the same nation, "ABC"






- Can the Elite Continental Champion compete in the Elite World Championships, even if nation "ABC" already has 2 riders? Yes. Additional quotas.
- Will the number nations/riders be reduced in order not to exceed the applicable maximum number? No.



OUTGOING CHAMPIONS

UCI TRACK WORLD CHAMPIONSHIPS - QUOTAS

Omnium – 24 Riders







Nation "ABC" has an Elite Continental Champion in Omnium



Nation "XYZ" also has an Elite Continental Champion in Omnium

- Can the Elite Continental Champion from nation "ABC" be entered in the Elite World Championships, even if nation "ABC" already has a quota? No. Maximum 1 rider per nation in bunch races.
- Nation "XYZ" hasn't qualified for the Omnium through the rankings, however they have the Continental Champion in the Omnium. Can the Elite Continental Championships in Omnium from "XYZ" compete? Yes.



The number of nations/riders qualified through a UCI Track Ranking shall be reduced in order not to exceed the applicable maximum number.



- How can the National Federation register the selected riders?
 - o UCI Regonline (Link: <u>Sign In</u>)








UCI TRACK WORLD CHAMPIONSHIPS



- Opens shortly after the quotas are finalised, six weeks before the World Championships.
- o The registration platform remains open for 2 weeks.
- Registration period for 2025: from 15 to 29 September 2025
- (See the <u>document</u> for all key deadlines)


Article 3.4.004


- When shall a rider have the minimum number of UCI points to be eligible?
 - Two possibilities:
 - o 6 weeks **before the first round** of the UCI Track World Cup
 - Valid for all rounds

or

- In the latest update of the respective UCI Track Ranking, before each round of the UCI Track World Cup
- What is the minimum number of points necessary?
 - o Individual events: at least 500 points in the respective UCI Track Ranking (elite).
 - Sprint, Keirin, Omnium, Elimination Race
 - Madison: at least 250 points in the respective UCI Track Ranking (elite).







TOP 4 UCI JUNIOR TRACK WORLD CHAMPIONSHIPS

UCI TRACK WORLD CUP- ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

- Top 4 Junior riders at the most recent UCI Junior Track World Championships in any
 of the following events can participate in the UCI Track World Cup without the
 minimum points required:
 - Omnium, Elimination Race, Scratch Race, Points Race, Sprint, Keirin
- For the Madison, only riders who were in the top 4 teams in the Madison at the most recent Junior World Championships are eligible without the minimum number of point.
















- Only 1st and 2nd year juniors may participate
- No additionnal eligibility criteria






UCI JUNIOR TRACK WORLD CHAMPIONSHIPS - REGISTRATION

- Who can register the riders?
 - National Federation
- How can the National Federation enter the select riders?
 - UCI Regonline (Link: <u>Sign In</u>)
- When does registration take place?
 - o Registration closes at least 3 weeks before the date of the competition.
 - The registration remains open for 2 weeks
 - Registration period for 2025: from 14 to 28 July 2025
 - (See the <u>document</u> for all key deadlines)

















MAIN CONSIDERATIONS FOR PARTICIPATION

UCI INTERNATIONAL CALENDAR – ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

Eligibility by Competition Category		
Category	Eligible Riders	
Elite	Elite, Under-23, & junior riders aged 18 (2 nd year junior)	
Under 23	Under 23 & junior riders aged 18 (2 nd year junior)	
Junior	Junior riders	

Younger athletes (minimum 17 years old, 1st year junior) can participate in elite races to expand the bunch (must be included in the results). But:

- will not score UCI points and
- must not be taken into account in the analysis of the minimum number of participating nations and riders (Article 3.8.003).



MAIN CONSIDERATIONS FOR PARTICIPATION

UCI INTERNATIONAL CALENDAR – ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

Article 1.2.052

National, regional and club teams and their respective riders may not start in competitions abroad unless they hold **authorisation in writing issued by their federation** (...). This authorisation must carry the dates of validity and the name(s) of the rider(s) concerned. (...)

Article 3.8.003

Riders must have minimum 10 UCI points to be eligible for Class 1 competitions.



Important to note: as of 01.01.2026, riders will no longer be required to hold 10 UCI Track points to be eligible in Elite and Under-23 Class 1 competitions.
