Shanghai

Located on China's eastern coast at the mouth of the Yangtze River and facing the Pacific Ocean, Shanghai, together with neighboring Zhejiang, Jiangsu, and Anhui provinces, forms the Yangtze River Delta region - one of China's most economically dynamic, internationally open, and innovative areas. By the end of 2024, Shanghai covered an administrative area of 6,340.5 square kilometers, governed 16 districts, had a permanent population of 24.8026 million, and recorded a per capita GDP of 217,100 yuan.

Shanghai is making every effort to safeguard and enhance the quality of life for its residents, carefully shaping a livable, resilient, and smart city, while further advancing the modernization of urban governance. The city continues to promote urban renewal, deepen refined urban management, and achieve new progress in ecological civilization development. Dongtan in Chongming, a key habitat for migratory birds, was recognized as Shanghai's first UNESCO World Natural Heritage site.

STORAGE AREA

Access to the infield for teams will be possible from the first official training day, Saturday 10th October 2026.

Outside storage will be accessible from October 7, 2026, 9:00 to October 19, 2026, 17:00.

A security deposit of 1000 CNY per cabin must be paid (in cash) when picking up the key at the accreditation. The deposit will be returned once the team cabin has been inspected and is left in the condition in which it was issued to you. Your deposit will not be returned if there is any damage to the team cabin and you may incur additional repair costs if the damage exceeds the initial deposit.

Lost Keys - if your team misplaces the key for your team cabin, a replacement key is available from the Team Cabin Coordinator. Teams will be responsible for the cost of replacing lost keys. Key replacement cost is 300 CNY per key.

INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT

Shanghai Pudong International Airport (PVG) → Venue:

approximately 66 km, about 1 hour 10 minutes by car; taxi fare around 230 CNY.

Shanghai Hongqiao International Airport (SHA) → Venue:

approximately 80 km, about 1 hour 20 minutes by car; taxi fare around 300 CNY.

Should participants require a visa, the Federation must contact the Organising Committee (track2026shanghai@163.com, subject "Invitation Letter for a Visa Request") and attach a Visa Request Letter, detailing the long list of participants who require prior authorisation or visa to enter China according to the current immigration legislation. The Federation must use the **Invitation Letter Model**, which can be found at the end of this document.

With this information, the Organising Committee will send a letter of invitation that must be attached to the visa application that each Federation or member must process.

Be aware of visa application processing times and ensure that all passports—whether for visa-required or visa-exempt travellers - have at least six months of validity remaining at the time of application.
