GENERAL INFORMATION

Rio de Janeiro is located in the state of the same name in the southeastern part of the country's Atlantic Coast. It is one of the most visited cities in the southern hemisphere. Rio is a postcard city, with lush green mountains, lakes, and long white sandy beaches. It is home to the Sugarloaf Mountain (Pão de Açúcar), the Maracanã stadium, the Guanabara Bay, and, overlooking it all, the statue of Christ the Redeemer. It's no wonder Rio is known as the "Marvelous City". The hospitality of the locals can be witnessed on the streets, in bars, and on the beach.

COMPETITION VENUE

The competition venue will be the Rio Olympic Velodrome, located in the Barra Olympic and Paralympic Park. The velodrome's 250m track is made with Siberian pine trees inclined at an angle of 12 degrees at its shallowest point and 42 degrees at its steepest. The track and all equipment will be presented in accordance with UCI regulations. The spectator capacity is approximately 5,600.

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REGISTRATION

Registration fees will be handled by the Organizing Committee and TBA Sports Management at the appropriate time. Do not pay registration fees in advance, wait until you receive the invoice from the Organizing Committee. Please ensure that the invoice number will be indicated in the payment details. Athletes and staff will not be able to enter the competition if registration fees have not been paid by the time of event confirmation.

Registrations will be open from 1 September 2025 until 15 September 2025 at 12:00 (CEST), and teams can register through the [Regonline platform](#).

The registration fee per participant is €125.00 (one hundred and twenty-five euros).

Late registrations can be paid on-site at the competition, but the person responsible for payment must contact the Organizing Committee in advance with justification. In this case, payment must be made in cash and local currency (R\$ - Brazilian Reals), or payment may be made in euros plus the currency conversion rate into Reals.

Registration fee to be paid at the time of accreditation:

In Euros €175.00 (one hundred and seventy-five euros)

SLOTS EARNED

Regarding the allocation of athlete slots per nation, please note that an exemption has been granted specifically for this event. As a result, all participating nations will automatically receive three athlete slots per category per event. The athlete must meet eligibility by competing in one para-cycling event in the 12 months prior to the championships as detailed in regulation 9.2.067 on either road or track.

Official eligibility exemption requests need to be submitted through [this link](#), and all the requests will be taken into consideration by the UCI on case to case basis.

TRAVEL INSURANCE

Each team is responsible for ensuring health insurance for its athletes. This coverage must cover property damage, bodily injuries and/or health problems, and third-party liabilities. The Organizing Committee is not responsible for stored material or any loss.

VISA APPLICATIONS

Each team is responsible for organizing the necessary procedures to obtain a visa to enter Brazil in accordance with the rules and regulations defined by the Brazilian Ministry of Foreign Affairs.

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For detailed information about the need to issue a visa and the necessary documentation, please visit the website of the Brazilian Embassy in your country.

If you need an official invitation letter to assist with the visa application, please contact the Organizing Committee by email: tubiba@2025uciparatrack.com.

In order to issue the invitation letter, you will need to provide the following information for each person needing a visa:

- Full name as it appears in the passport.
- Passport number.
- Passport expiration date.
- Role of the traveler within the team.
- Duration of stay in Brazil.

ACCOMMODATION

All expenses with accommodation, meals, and transportation for the 2025 UCI Para-Cycling Track World Championship should be covered by the participants.

Rio de Janeiro is a tourist city and has a wide range of hotels, but it is also a city with heavy traffic jams, therefore, choosing a hotel in an unfavorable location can be inconvenient for teams and athletes.

The Organizing Committee appointed the company *TBA Sports LTDA* to manage the accommodation, meals, and transportation services for the event.

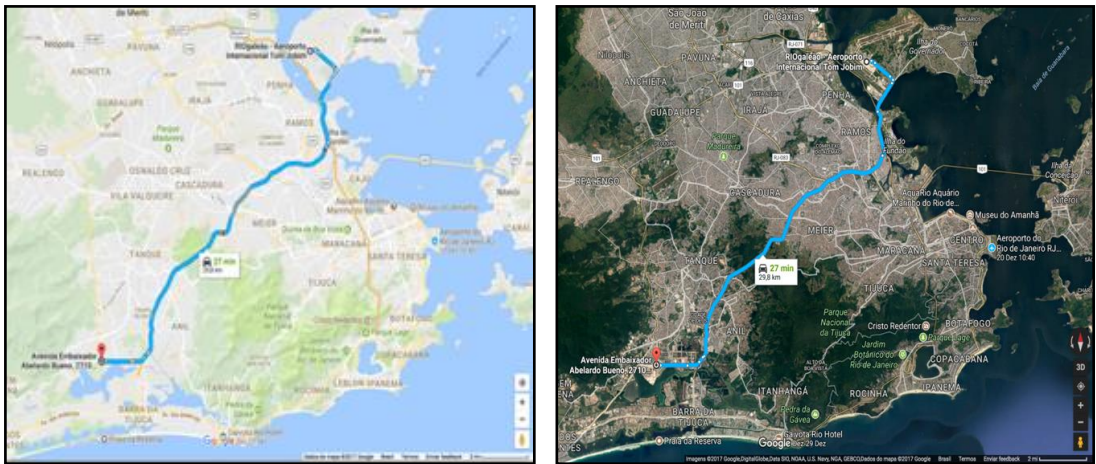

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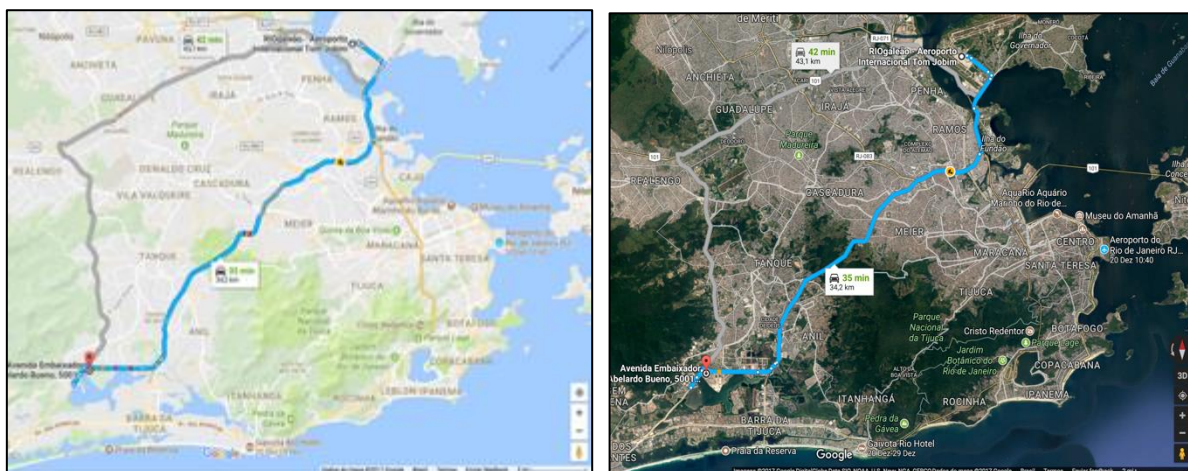
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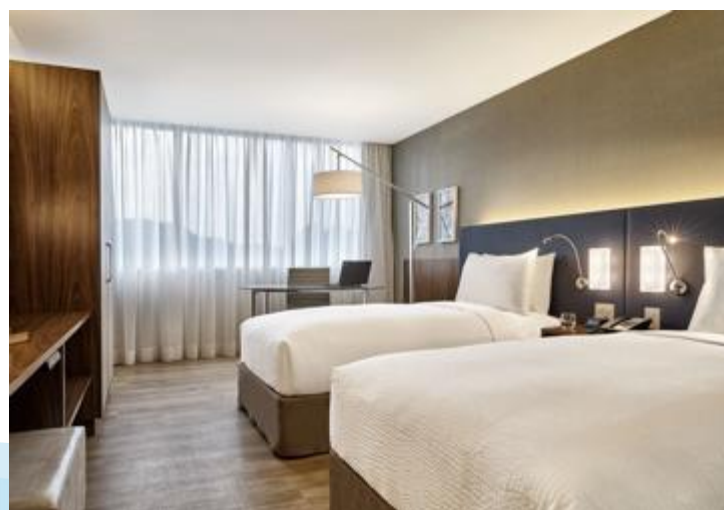
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Travel time and distance Airport/Hotel



Courtyard by Marriott Barra da Tijuca (4 - Star)



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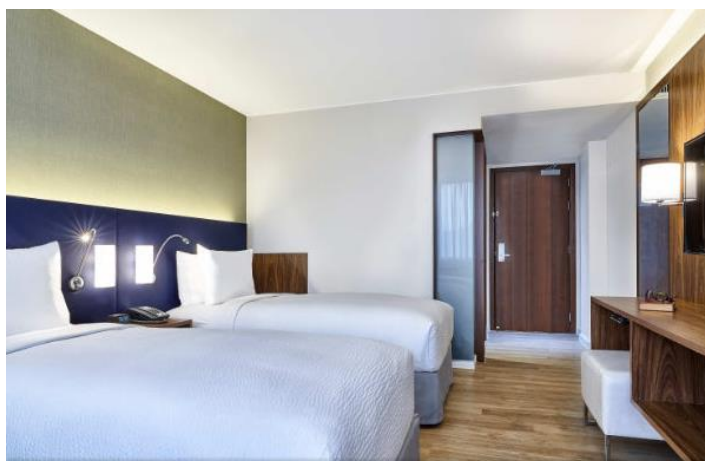
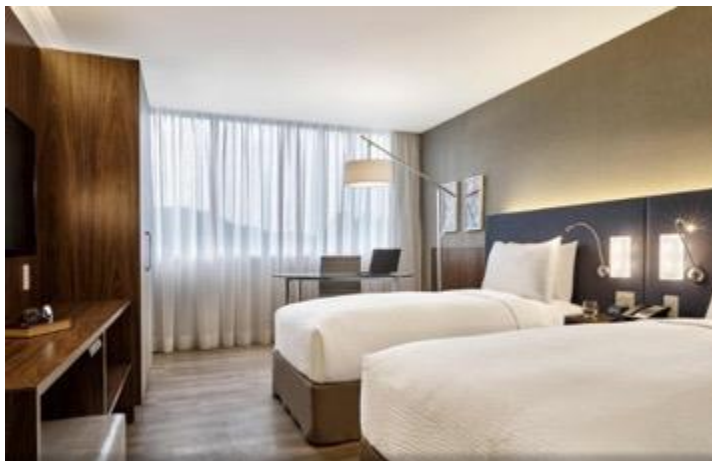


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Room rates for hotels include:

- Free Wi-Fi in public areas and /or in the rooms.
- Daily breakfast buffet.
- Optional lunch and dinner packages at selected hotels suited to the competition schedule.
- On-site management team.
- Airport/hotel/airport transfer service, for teams that adhere to the hosting services offered by the OC.
- Full transport service for bicycles and equipment between the airport and hotel on arrival and departure days for teams that subscribe to the hosting services offered by the OC.

TRANSPORTATION

Traditionally, in cycling competitions, teams hire their vehicles from regular car rental companies (i.e. Europcar, AVIS, HERTZ, etc.), however, in Brazil, unfortunately, this service is not possible.

Brazilian laws only allow drivers who have a special professional driver's license to drive vehicles with more than 9 seats, so regular rental companies do not offer vehicles with more than 7 seats in their portfolio.

The Organizing Committee will offer, free of charge, transfer services (airport/hotel/airport) and transportation of sports equipment for teams that contract accommodation services directly with the OC.

Transport reservations **must** be requested through a specific transportation form, which will be made available to all teams by email.

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IMPORTANT: Transport services will not be offered between the hotels and the velodrome due to the short distance between the hotels and the competition venue.

HIRING OF TRANSFER AND TRANSPORT OF SPORTS EQUIPMENT

For teams that **do not contract** accommodation in one of the official hotels and want to contract transfer services (airport/hotel/airport) and equipment transport, there is an option to hire those services separately, according to the service table below:

- EQUIPMENT TRANSPORT SERVICE**
 Box truck
 Transfer airport/hotel and velodrome/airport

 Fee from 6 to 12 items: € 600,00
 Fee from 13 to 20 items: € 1.000,00
 Fee from 21 to 30 items: € 1.500,00
 Fee for over 30 items: € 2.500,00

Note: The fees above are considered for two trips, one upon arrival and another upon departure from the team.

Bikes and equipment will be transported according to vehicle capacity and may arrive at the hotel/velodrome after the team. Every four hours the truck will make the trip, even if it has not completed the capacity. The staff at the airport will inform the team of the equipment's departure time and estimated arrival time at the hotel/velodrome, with possible delays due to traffic.

Climate

October is warm and sunny in Rio de Janeiro, with temperatures ranging from 21°C at night to 27°C in the afternoon

The fog which has been common over the summer starts to ease off a little, although the city does experience heavy periods of mist year-round, and precipitation levels remain relatively moderate. The total amount of rainfall is 88mm, making this the sixth driest month of the year. There are 13 days with precipitation.

The probability that any type of rainfall occurs rises from 45% to 50% in the course of October. Light rain is still the most common type, occurring on 41% of those 13 wet days. Moderate rain, drizzle and thunderstorms are likely as well, respectively observed on 22%, 19% and 18% of the days with rainfall.
