This document summarizes the information needed by the National Federations concerning the participation of their riders at the 2023 UCI Cyclo-cross World Championships.

Mainly intended for National Federations and Team Managers, this document focuses on the purely sporting aspects of the 2023 UCI Cyclo-cross World Championships.

The Cyclo-cross Team Relay is introduced from 2023 in the official programme of the event and will award the first UCI World Champion title to the 6 teammates winning this new format. You will find more information on that format in the following text.



For all categories, the maximum number of riders per national team shall be determined by the ranking by nation of the category at the UCI Cyclo-cross World Cup as calculated per article 5.3.013bis and published after the round of the 2022-2023 UCI Cyclo-cross World Cup in Zonhoven (BEL) on 08 January 2023:

 For the Continental Champion, this facility is limited to the first World Championships following the awarding of the title of Continental Champion.
- 9.2.044 The national federations concerned may additionally enter the outgoing UCI cyclo-cross world champions and the leaders of **the final UCI cyclo-cross world cup standings** men elite, men under 23, men junior, women elite, women under 23 and women junior.



5.5 RIDERS' ASSISTANTS AND STAFF

UCI rules

Attendants

5.1.041 Each rider may be accompanied by a paramedical assistant and two mechanics.

The paramedical assistant and the mechanics must be provided by the organiser with a free accreditation, which gives them access to the area reserved for them by virtue of their office.

The accreditations must be distributed outside the circuit, in a clearly indicated place.

For the UCI cyclo-cross world cup and world championships, accreditations for rider's paramedical assistant and two mechanics will be distributed by commissaires exclusively, after that the license's check of each paramedical assistant and the mechanics has been completed.

Note that assistant and mechanics of riders are not mandatorily accredited, but they need to wear a bracelet that will give them access to the venue and then to the specific area they are expected to work.

Each National Federation shall designate a Team Manager who shall represent the National Federation during the World Championships and at meetings. Any contact with the National Federation teams shall be made through the Team Manager.

Objective

The presentation of the main rules and technical information will be explained to Nations during that meeting. National coach will announce their pit box' choice, category per category.

The commissaires panel will deliver the race numbers as well as the pit area passes.

7- START ORDER / RACE NUMBERS (INDIVIDUAL RACES)

The starting procedure for the first 8 riders will "classic" with the 8 first riders called first from the call-up zone. For each category, the top 8 riders will be invited by the UCI to record a short video presenting them with their national outfit. They will be contacted individually.

7.1 START ORDER

5.1.043 The start order of events is determined as follows:

1 The first 8 riders of the most recently published UCI cyclo-cross world cup standings of the current season. For the women under 23 race of the UCI world championships, the first 8 riders aged 19-22 years from the women elite UCI cyclo-cross world cup standings.

2 As per the most recently published UCI cyclo-cross individual ranking of the current season, 3 Unclassified riders: by nations in rotation (*).

7.2 RACE NUMBERS

- 5.1.046 The allocation of race numbers at UCI World Championships and UCI World Cup events shall be as follows:
 - Race numbers in sequence from 1 upwards to the country of the world champion of the preceding season;
 - Race number 1 shall only be allocated to the reigning world champion of the category concerned;
 - The other race numbers are issued to nations on the basis of their classification in the UCI world championships of the preceding season;
 - For nations not ranked or not having taken part in the UCI world championship the preceding season, the allocation shall be by drawing lots by the commissaires' panel.

8- ALLOCATION OF BOXES (INDIVIDUAL RACES)

- 5.1.036 The pit boxes are allocated [...] during the team managers meeting for the UCI cyclo-cross world championships as follows:
 - 1. Separately for each category on the basis of the most recently published UCI cyclo-cross ranking by nation of the current season for the category concerned (or the final ranking of the previous season if no ranking has yet been published for the current season);
 - 2. The allocation of boxes to teams that do not feature in the relevant ranking shall be by drawing lots;
 - 3. The president of the commissaires' panel shall prepare per category the number of pits allocated to each nation, taking into account the number of riders. Three boxes maximum will be allocated to one nation. Nations with a small number of riders may be grouped in the same box;
 - 4. The national team managers shall select their preferred boxes in the order determined by points 1 and 2. Any nation that is allocated 2 or 3 boxes must chose the numbers of these boxes back to back;
 - 5. In case of absence of reply of the team manager or blocked situation, the president of the commissaires panel shall fix the relevant boxes allocation. The final distribution of boxes per nation will be communicated to teams and commissaires.

10-CYCLO-CROSS TEAM RELAY UCI WORLD CHAMPIONSHIPS

The Cyclo-cross Team Relay UCI World Championships are organized on:

Friday 03 February 2023 12h30 CET.

The following UCI rules articles have been introduced in June 2022: articles 5.1.094 bis and 9.2.045 bis.

10.1 Participation, REGISTRATION

For the team relay, each nation may enter only one team. Each National Team shall be made up of:

- 1 Men Elite or 1 Men Under 23,
- 1 Men Under 23 or 1 Men Junior,
- 1 Men Junior,
- 1 Women Elite or 1 Women Under 23,
- 1 Women Under 23 or 1 Women Junior,
- 1 Women Junior.

Incomplete teams are not allowed. One rider cannot race in more than 1 of the above-listed categories. Each rider selected must already be entered for the individual UCI Cyclo-cross World Championships events.

The registration of nations to the Cyclo-cross Team Relay event will be as following:

- by Thursday 19 January 2023, 09h00 CET: reply of nations to the participation intention form ("yes", "no", "do not know yet")
- by Friday 27 January 2023, 16h00 CET: registration of nations with 6 riders by e-mail to christelle.reille@uci.ch
- by Thursday 2 February 2023 at 16h30 CET: team composition and start order must be confirmed by e-mail to christelle.reille@uci.ch.

The Team Manager must use the form provided to notify the names and categories of the riders making up their team and their start order to the chief commissaire's panel before the above-mentioned deadline. The start order may not be altered subsequently.

10.2 BIB NUMBERS, GRIDDING, START

The order of Nations is drawn on the basis of the results of the team relay event in the preceding UCI World Championships: for the 2023 UCI Cyclo-cross World Championships, the results of the Cyclo-cross Team Relay test event of the 2022 Walmart UCI Cyclo-cross World Championships, Fayetteville Arkansas (USA) will be taken as a reference:

5 Czech Republic

The order of Nations not placed will be determined by drawing lots.

This order of Nations for the UCI cyclo-cross world championships team relay shall determine the following elements:

- the order of Nations on the entry list and the allocation of bibs numbers: the first nation will receive the number 1A, 1B, 1C, 1D, 1E, 1F, the second nation the number 2A, 2B, 2C, 2D, 2E, 2F, and so on;
- the call-up order of the first riders to start the team relay: the first rider to start of the nation number 1 of the order will be called first, then the first rider to start of the nation number 2, and so on;
- the number of the start box of the relay zone;
- the number of the pit box of the pit area.

Teams are responsible for determining the order of riders and for their timely presence in the relay zone.

10.3 TEAM RELAY RACE

Riders waiting for the relay will have the opportunity to stay sheltered in a tent near the relay area. This space will be heated in case of low temperature or wet weather. The timely arrival of the rider in the relay zone remains the responsibility of the national team.

Each rider shall race during one complete lap of the parcours used for the individual races of the UCI Cyclo-cross World Championships. At the end of his lap and in the official relay zone, he shall give the relay to the next teammate.

The finishing rider must touch the hand, arm or shoulder of the next racing rider, when he is standstill in the relay box. No flying relay shall be accepted. When he is touched by the finishing rider, the next racing rider can start and ride his lap.

If the rider finishing his relay passes his teammate without touching him, he must immediately make a u-turn and come back to the box allocated to his nation. The riders racing after the last relay shall finish their lap by crossing the finish line of the venue.

The information of the logistic conditions of the Relay zone (location of relay boxes, location of warm-up and waiting boxes) will be communicated to National Federations between the 09 and the 16 January 2023.

10.4 PIT AREA

4 Mechanics per nation will be allowed in the pit area, they will receive a bracelet that will give access to the pit area for the Team Relay only.

The boxes allocation will be allocated following the above-mentioned order of Nations: the Nation 1 receive the boxe nr 1, the Nation 2 the boxe nr 2 and so on...

10.5 AWARDS CEREMONY, PRIZES

The 6 riders of each of the 3 first ranked nations will have to present to the Team Relay UCI Cyclo-cross World Championships awards ceremony. The riders of the 1st nation will all receive one UCI World Champion jersey. Gold, silver and bronze medals will be awarded to the 18 riders following their Nations' rank.

The following prize money will be paid by the UCI to the 3 first nations:

UCI points are allocated to the nation's women elite and men elite rankings only and not to the riders individually. A minimum of 5 nations must compete in the cyclo-cross team relay for UCI points to be awarded.

11-OTHER UCI RULES

11.1 Participation in World Championships

- 9.2.001 It is the National Federations who select riders to participate in World Championships.
- 9.2.003 National Federations shall enter with the UCI via its website.
- 9.2.005 Save in the case of an act of God, a National Federation that has enrolled by returning the enrolment form for a World Championship and that does not participate shall be liable to a fine of CHF 500 to CHF 2'000.
- 9.2.007 Federations shall announce the names of the riders who are to take the start to the commissaires panel by noon at the latest on the eve of the first race of the competition. .../...
 - A rider declared unfit following an abnormal blood test cannot be replaced.
- 9.2.008 Unless prevented by an act of God, a rider once announced as taking the start and who fails to present, shall be liable to a fine of CHF 500 to CHF 5'000.
 - An injury or sickness shall be recognized as an act of God only if the rider is declared incapable of taking the start by the UCI Medical Delegate.

11.2 EQUIPMENT

- 1.3.031 Wearing a rigid safety helmet shall be mandatory during competitions and training sessions.
- 2.2.023 The article on the maximum gear ratio for junior- Part 2 road races is not valid for Cyclo-cross events.
- 5.1.059 For the UCI cyclo-cross world cup and world championships, men elite and women races only, the use of radio-communication from the rider to his/her mechanics is allowed. The use of radio-communication from staff to the rider is forbidden. The use of such a system is subject to any relevant legal provisions.
- 1.3.025 Disc brakes are allowed in cyclo-cross training and competition.

 For races on the road and cyclo-cross, the use of fixed sprocket is forbidden: a braking system that acts on both wheels is required.
- 1.3.018 Wheels of the bicycle may vary in diameter between 70 cm maximum and 55 cm minimum, including the tyre. For the Cyclo-cross bicycle the width of the tyre (measured between the widest parts) shall not exceed 33 mm and it may not incorporate any form of spike or stud.
- 5.1.034 Personal high-pressure cleaners are forbidden in the pit area during the UCI cyclo-cross world championships, the UCI cyclo-cross world cup and the continental cyclo-cross championships.

11.3 RACE CLOTHING

Wearing of national team clothing is mandatory during the UCI World Championships.

- 1.3.056 National federations shall submit to the commissaires' panel of events as specified in art. 1.3.059, a sample of their national team clothing for validation. The design, color, place and size of the advertising spaces of the validated equipment must be identical for all athletes participating to the applicable events.

 We encourage you to present to the UCI your national apparels before sending them for final production. The apparel of the riders of a national team must always be identical to the last sample submitted.
- 1.3.057 Advertising matter, as detailed in the <u>"UCI jerseys visual guidelines"</u> brochure published on the UCI Website, shall be used at the national federation's discretion.

Advertising matter on jersey and shorts may vary from one rider to another.

The design of the jersey and shorts may vary from one category of rider to another.

Additionally, the rider's name may appear on the back of the jersey.

The above measures also apply to other items of clothing worn during competition (rain jackets, etc.).

1.3.029 No item of clothing may hide the lettering on the jersey or the rider's identification number, particularly in competition and at official ceremoniesIn accordance with the clarification provided by the UCI Material Department, the use of net or plastic pocket to hold the bib or arm number on the rider's jersey is prohibited. If such a device exists on the

rider's outfit, then the rider will have to pin his numbers above the pocket.

11.4 AWARDS CEREMONY

- 9.1.044 Within 10 minutes following the end of each race (unless otherwise provided and duly recorded in an official communiqué), the World Champion, as well as the second and the third placed riders shall be ready for the official ceremony that shall be conducted under the responsibility of the president of the commissaires' panel.
- 9.1.046 Riders shall appear in racing attire, wearing their national jerseys but bare-headed and without headband or glasses, until they leave the official ceremony enclosure.
- 9.1.050 A World Champion may not wear the jersey identifying his title and bearing the regulation advertisement of his main sponsor(s) until, at earliest, the day following that on which he received it.
- 9.1.0.51 Any infringement of the provisions of articles 9.1.044 to 9.1.050 shall be punished by a fine of CHF 2'000 to CHF 10'000 minimum. A higher fine may be imposed depending on the advantage derived from the offence.
- 9.2.045 ter A ranking by nations for the cyclo-cross world championships shall be drawn up by summing the points of the first three riders from each nation.

The system for awarding points is based on the total number of rider starting in each category. If 100 riders start, the winner will score 100 points while the 100th placed rider would score 1. Should some starters not be given a finishing position, the last rider to be classified shall score the points for his position without taking account of the unclassified riders. Example: if 100 riders start and 80 riders are classified, the last of them will score 21 points.

Nations with three finishing riders shall be ranked first, then nations with two finishing riders and finally nations with one finishing rider. In case of equal points in this classification, the place of the best ranked rider will break the tie.

If one or more riders of one age category take place to the cyclo-cross team relay, then the nation will receive for that age category one bonus of points. The system for awarding points is based on twice the total number of nations starting in the cyclo-cross team relay. If 15 nations start, the winning nation will score 30 points while the 15th placed nation would score 2 points.
