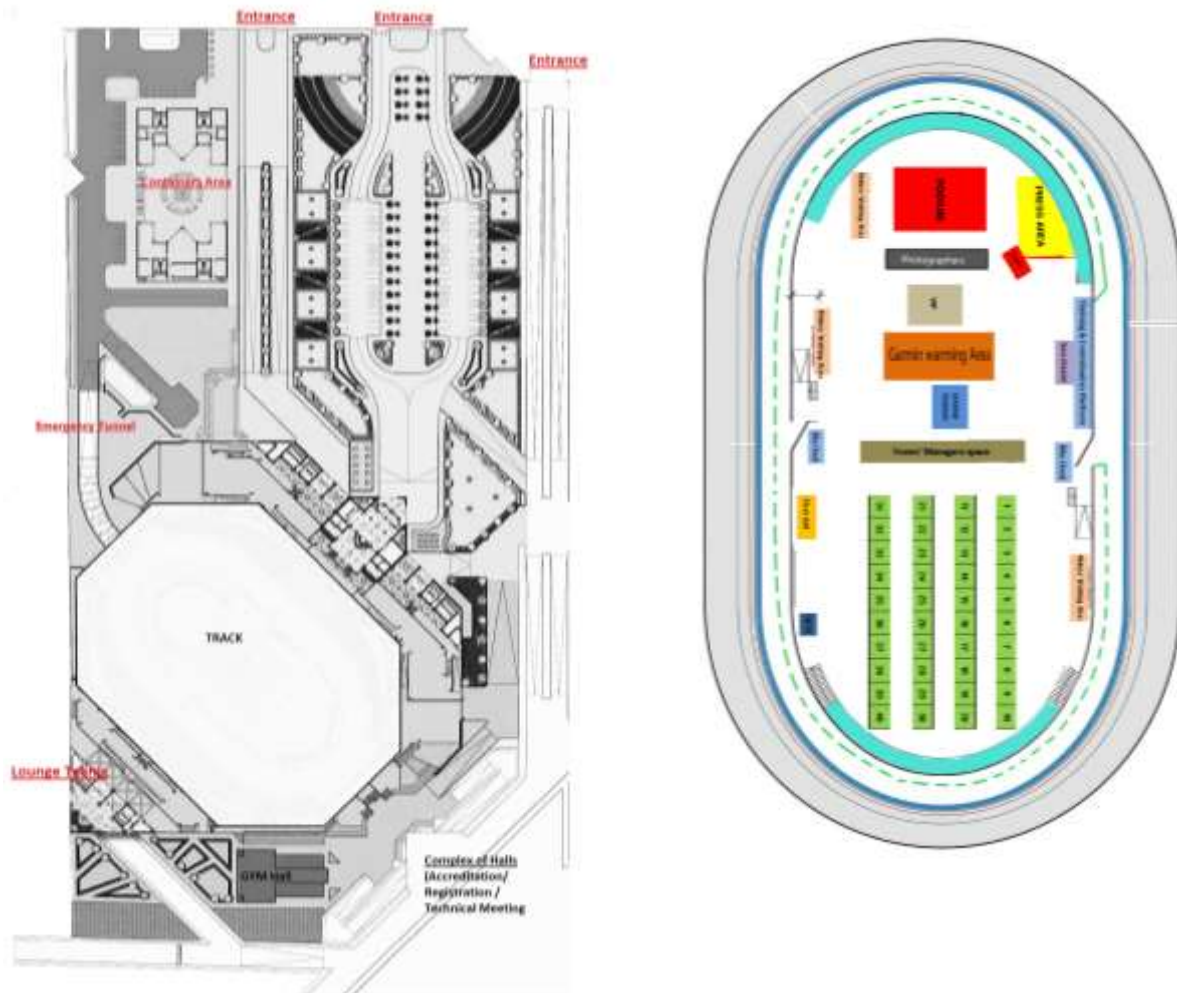
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VENUE PLAN

WELCOME FROM THE ORGANISING COMMITTEE

To be in a position to be able to welcome teams to Cairo, Egypt for the 2021 UCI Junior Track Cycling World Championships after such a long and tumultuous time is a privilege and a blessing.

As the local organizing committee, we have been faced with challenges over the last while, but we know too, that riders, family members, support staff and all linked to all national federations have also faced many challenges that have needed to be overcome to bring us all to the brink of being able to celebrate our young riders and their respective achievements.

The term “An Ancient Land, Today’s Champions, Tomorrow’s Legends” encapsulates this year’s event ideally. Egypt is indeed an ancient land that has always been at the forefront of development and innovation and has given the modern world so many things that are taken for granted in today’s age. We know that the champions of this event – and even many of the participants who may not end up on the podium in 2021 – are among those that will be spoken about and who will be heroes in the years ahead – it is exciting to think that these young riders will collectively earn titles and medals and accolades across the board for many years to come.

It has been a long road and it has been a long time coming but we are now here, and we welcome all the participating nations to the 2021 UCI Junior Track Cycling World Championships in Cairo with great joy and anticipation of the excellent competition ahead.

1. INTRODUCTION

The purpose of this Event Manual is to ensure participating teams are fully prepared for the 2021 UCI Junior Track World Championships. Mainly intended for team managers, this document focuses on the purely sporting aspects of the organisation. For more information on other matters, see the end of this document for other useful addresses and links.

2. VENUE

Distance from the Airport to the Velodrome:

13km with a journey time of 15 – 30 minutes by car depending on time of day and traffic conditions.

Transport shuttles will be in place from all official hotels throughout the day on a regular basis.

3. PARKING AT VELODROME

The teams will use the parking area reserved for them should they need parking for any vehicles. Each team will receive between 1 and a maximum of 3 parking passes for the parking area depending on the size of the team and will have to display these clearly behind the windshield to be able to gain access.

Vehicles that do not comply with the rules may and will be removed without notice by the relevant authorities, and all costs will be borne by the team. All other vehicles must be parked in the relevant designated parking areas.

A separate parking area will be in place for any other “team linked” people’s vehicles and these parking passes will be available at the accreditation centre and can be applied for through the national federations at loc@juniortrackworldscairo.com

4. ACCREDITATIONS

Accreditation will be required to access the venue from 08:00 on Saturday 28th August.

Please ensure that you collect your accreditations as soon as you arrive at the velodrome as it will be required for access to all parts of the venue.

ACCREDITATION ZONES

Accreditation access zones are defined as follows:

- 6 **VIP**

Accreditations are provided with a lanyard and must be always worn and visible when inside the venue.

Stewards and security personnel have been instructed to maintain access controls which allow the best conditions for everybody to be able to do their job. Any abuse towards stewards or security personnel will not be tolerated and all incidents will be reported immediately to the LOC and the UCI and may result in your accreditation being withdrawn.

If you feel that you do not have clearance for a zone which is necessary for your task at the event, please contact the Permanence/Accreditation Centre.

Strict Covid – 19 regulations will be in place allied to the event, and should these regulations not be adhered to by riders and team support crew and national federation representatives at all times – at the official hotels as well as at the competition venues – accreditation may be withdrawn.

All accreditations grant you access to the spectator concourse but not to the spectator seats. A

steward will ask people without tickets to make way for spectators. Designated seating areas are reserved for teams at the spectator concourses as applicable.

Please also note that venue procedures dictate that spectators are not allowed to stop and watch from the concourse area and people will be kindly asked to move back to their seats from this area.

Please be reminded that many event personnel you encounter at the velodrome are volunteers so please treat them with courtesy as without them the event would not be able to happen.

5. SCHEDULE

Competition schedule will be updated following the Rider Confirmation. Please see the latest version on UCI website: www.uci.org > Track > Events > [UCI JUNIOR TRACK CYCLING WORLD CHAMPIONSHIPS > Official documents](#) and **Daily Schedule** displayed in the infield.

The official opening ceremony will take place on the evening of Tuesday 31st August 2021 and all participating teams are expected to be in attendance. The time and venue including transport arrangements will be confirmed in due course.

6. TICKETS

Due to the ongoing worldwide Covid – 19 pandemic, various strict regulations have been put in place around events and activities. In line with these regulations, no spectator tickets will be available for general spectators, but a limited number of invited guests will be allowed into the velodrome on a daily basis to attend the competitions.

Applications for invitations for those people not already receiving an accreditation as part of the official delegation but who may be accompanying the team must be submitted by the national federations to loc@juniortrackworldscairo.com by 15th August 2021 at the latest so that these applications can be processed and managed timeously.

Only teams booking through CSE will be able to use the event transport services being supplied. If teams have hotel or transport queries, please speak to the CSE representative at the event welcome desk located in their team hotel.

In line with the Covid – 19 regulations and parameters, all non – Egyptian citizens who require an accreditation of any kind to enter the velodrome and environs, must be resident at one of the officially designated hotels so as to be able to be included in the strict testing and monitoring regimen that will be in place for all associated with the event. This will include any supporters and / or family members.

8. TEAM MEALS

For teams booked via CSE at the official event hotels, a daily hot and cold buffet breakfast is included within their accommodation package and served at each hotel.

The same will apply for lunch and dinner and these meals will be served at times to suit the training and competition schedule. The buffet selection includes vegetarian options served at each team hotel.

Please check hotel information board for breakfast times.

Should it be desired, packed lunches can be pre-ordered for competition days but please note that orders will need to be placed by 10am the day prior to meals being required. Further information will be available during the event from the CSE Accommodation & Transport welcome desk located at each hotel.

9. TEAM MAINTENANCE AND STORAGE AREAS

Storage containers are allocated to teams according to the number of riders and will be located in the large tarred area alongside the entrance of the emergency tunnel at the Cairo International Velodrome. Each container will be provided with a power point and lighting.

Access to the storage containers will be from 10:00am Friday, 27th August until Tuesday 07th September 12:00pm. However, if any teams arrive prior to this and need access to the storage facility, if it is available, special arrangements can be made but notice of this is required timeously before the team's arrival.

A representative from the LOC Infrastructure and Logistics Commission will meet each team at the velodrome upon arrival and allocate the facility accordingly. It is important that teams only use the containers allocated to them. Due to space limitations, it will be necessary for some smaller teams with fewer riders to share containers.

All containers need to be cleared by midday on Tuesday 7th September at the latest. Please ensure you return your key back to the office of the Infrastructure and Logistics Commission in the velodrome at the end of the event.

Each team will be required to pay a deposit of \$50 US or 500 Egyptian Pounds in order to be allocated a storage container and padlock and keys – Lost / unreturned keys will be charged for and the deposit will be returned once the team cabin has been inspected and is left in the condition in which it was issued to you. Your deposit will not be returned if there is any damage to the team cabin and you may incur additional repair costs if the damage exceeds the initial deposit.

Teams will be able to access the storage compound from 07h00 to 23h00 each day.

10. TRACK CENTRE TEAM PENS

Track center pens will be available from **Friday 27th August at 13h00.**

Team pens are allocated in the track centre taking into account the size of each team. Space is limited so please keep to your allocated area. Teams are reminded that the team storage facility outside are to be used for the storage of equipment not required for competition in that session.

Fire Regulations insist that corridors in the track are maintained for emergency evacuation purposes. To ensure the track center can be cleared quickly and safely in an emergency please ensure equipment does not narrow or block walkways.

Team Pens will have one table and chairs. No furniture is to be removed from the allocated pit, from the infield. Please ask the organizer if you need additional equipment and this will be provided if available.

Power

There are some power sockets in the velodrome - enough to charge a phone / laptop / small compressor. Please **do not plug extension leads into these sockets - nor kettles, coffee machines or fans** as these high-power consumption appliances may cause overloading of the systems leading to short circuits and power outages eventually.

Wifi:

Wifi will be available for teams in the velodrome. Passwords will be given on site.

Please note: National Federations will not be able to set up their own wireless networks as they will interfere with other equipment in use.

11. TRAINING SESSIONS

Track Closure

For any teams arriving early, please note that no training will be available on the track without prior arrangement. Every effort will be made to accommodate early training sessions, but it must be understood that event preparations are required including the various branding elements etc, and these will take precedence. There will no access to the track centre from 21st - 25th August due to the set up of the infield area.

UNOFFICIAL TRAINING:

It is possible to book the track during the days before the Official Training days. Please contact William Newman at newmaxcycling@intekom.co.za. The costs and the schedule will then be accorded dependent on requirements and duration.

OFFICIAL TRAINING: from Saturday 28th to Tuesday 31st August

The track will be open for Official Training Sessions from Saturday to Tuesday, from 09:00 to 19:30 with 1h30 slot per group.

The detailed time schedules of the official training sessions will be established at the closing of the online registration system and published on the [UCI website](#).

OFFICIAL TRAINING AND WARM UP SESSIONS ON COMPETITION DAYS

On competition day the track will open at least 2 hours before the first session of each day (except Sunday). On Sunday, the track will open 1 hour before the start of the session. These sessions are open to all riders. The track will also be open for warm up between sessions one hour before the start of the competitions for riders competing in the upcoming session only.

Please refer to Communiqué 6 for detailed times of training on competition days (available onsite and on [UCI Website](#)).

Safety reminder: The use of the derny and the use of starting blocks during the official training are not permitted. During these sessions, standing starts are permitted for single rider only. The standing start shall take place on the home straight only, in the sprinters' lane and only with the assistance of someone waving a flag at the exit of the bend. **It will not be permitted to practice the Madison relay during these sessions.**

During the training sessions, UCI Rules must be respected. The UCI Technical Delegate has the power to take the necessary measures to ensure security on the one hand and equity among the other teams on the other. All riders must wear the national team apparel.

12. RIDER SAFETY ON THE ROADS

It is strongly suggested that riders use only the demarcated and secured areas for any riding on the roads.

A secured route of approximately 1.5km will be in place within the confines of the Cairo International Stadium Complex and will be available for warm up and leg turning sessions to all riders. A map of the route will be provided at the accreditation centre.

13. OFFICIAL MEETINGS

CONFIRMATION OF STARTERS

Team managers must confirm all starters, present all valid licenses and provide a sample of the team kit. **The passport or ID of each participating rider must also be presented – if all documentation is not available and presented, the rider will not be eligible to compete.**

Unless prevented by an act of God, a rider once announced as taking the start and who fails to be present, shall be liable to a fine of CHF 500 to CHF 5000.

Injury or illness will not be accepted as a valid circumstance unless the rider is declared unfit to start by the official UCI doctor.

In line with the UCI ReCycling initiatives and environment preservation elements, all communiqués, results and start lists will be displayed on a whiteboard in the infield. **Hard copies will only be distributed upon request only.**

15. TEAM PERFORMANCE ANALYSTS

An area will be provided for sports analysis on the back straight. This area will be a shared area for team representatives and no positions will not be booked nor reserved for any team. For more information or if there are any specific queries, please contact newmaxcycling@intekom.co.za or loc@juniortrackworldscairo.com

Internet connection will be available on request for analysts. We discourage teams from setting up their own wireless networks as they may interfere with the track centre wifi system provided to teams. Wifi activity will be monitored throughout the event.

16. COMPETITION CLOTHING

Riders of the same national team must wear identical racing shorts during the same event, except for advertising space included in a lateral band 9 cm wide, which may differ from one rider to another. This means that National Federations must also provide their riders with national racing shorts.

Team Managers must therefore present the national apparel to the College of Commissaires at the confirmation of participants.

17. TEAM CHANGING ROOMS

There are male and female changing rooms facilities available at the velodrome on the ground floor. Please follow the directional signage.

18. ADDITIONAL TEAMS SERVICES

Due to the time of the year, arrangements have been made to have two "Chill Out Areas" within the velodrome and surrounds. Both areas will have air conditioning and relaxation facilities – one room being adjacent to the medical facility and the other being in the training gym in the building alongside the velodrome where riders will also be able to use their own rollers if desired.

19. TEAM SEATING

Athletes and staff are free to sit in the grandstands on the area demarcated for this purpose – these areas will be clearly marked. There are no seat numbers, and no areas may be reserved.

It must be noted that due to the Covid – 19 regulations that will be in place, apart from those specifically accredited for such purposes, no one may enter the different seating areas – this includes riders seating with family guests etc.

20. AWARD CEREMONIES

The World Champion, the second and the third placed riders must be ready for the official ceremony that shall be conducted under the responsibility of the Chief Commissaries. For team events, the additional reserve rider will be allowed on the podium (art. 9.1.045).

Riders shall appear in racing attire, wearing their national jerseys but bare-headed and without headband or glasses, until they leave the official ceremony enclosure.

As per art. 9.1.050, a World Champion may not wear the jersey identifying his title and bearing the regulation advertisement of his main sponsor(s) until, at earliest, the day following that on which he received it. Any infringement of the provisions of articles 9.1.044 to 9.1.050 above shall be punished by a fine of CHF 2'000 to CHF 10'000. A higher fine may be imposed depending on the advantage derived from the offence.



Approval of World Champion's jersey

Besides, it is reminded that the right to the rainbow colours remains the exclusive property of the UCI, including the **design of the World Champion's jersey**. Strict rules must be observed in the manufacture of your World Champion's jersey ([UCI Jersey Guidelines](#)). It is thus **compulsory** to have the jersey and other equipment using the rainbow colours approved by the UCI prior to manufacture, otherwise severe penalties may be imposed (art. 1.3.072). 22. DOPING CONTROL

Doping Control tests will be carried out according to the 2015 Anti-doping Rules of the UCI and CADF procedures and instructions.

Riders selected for anti-doping will be identified on a list by their race number or their ranking. If applicable, the list will be posted on the infield and at the entrance of the doping control station immediately after the race.

The riders selected for the controls will be notified by a chaperone; the notified rider shall remain within sight of the chaperone at all times from the moment of in-person notification until the completion of the sample collection procedure.

Even if there are chaperones present, ultimately **IT IS THE RIDERS' RESPONSIBILITY TO CHECK IF THEY HAVE BEEN SELECTED FOR ANTI-DOPING CONTROLS.**

23. COVID – 19 ARRANGEMENTS & PARAMETERS

It is noted that the 2021 UCI Junior Track Cycling World Championships will not be operated under a “full bubble” protocol, but will rather be operated under the “protected event” status whereby various strict protocols will be in place and enforced at all event linked facilities and functions.

At all times, in all areas, the personal protection measures such as wearing of masks, hand sanitizing and physical distancing must be strictly adhered to. These parameters apply for those vaccinated or not vaccinated inclusive.

Travelling to Egypt

- To travel to Egypt, all travelers require a negative PCR test to be carried out within 72 hours of travel
- If the person is fully vaccinated with a W.H.O or Egyptian Health Ministry approved vaccine and in possession of the relevant certificate with the QR code, a PCR test is not required to enter Egypt
- The Egyptian Health Ministry approved vaccines over and above the W.H.O approved vaccines are as follows:
 - Sputnik V
 - AstraZeneca
 - Covishield
 - Sinopharm
 - Sinovac

Hotels

- To protect the integrity of the Covid – 19 protocols, accreditations of all types will only be issued to those people that are residing in one of the officially linked hotels to the event, namely:
 - Sonesta Hotel
 - Triumph Plaza Hotel
 - Lotus Hotel (Engineers Authority House)
- This will apply to riders, team representatives as well as any supporters
- At each hotel, separated areas for event related elements will apply such as resident floors, dining areas etc.

Testing

- To ensure the protection of all, a strict testing protocol will be in place for all associated with the event – riders, team representatives as well as any supporters.
- The testing regimen will be as follows:
 - Upon arrival, all people will have a PCR test – regardless of whether they have been fully vaccinated or not
 - Every three days thereafter, a saliva antigen test will be carried out for all
 - Dependent on the regulations of the individual person's home country, a PCR test will be carried out to allow for travel
 - All tests will be carried out at the hotels where the individual is residing
 - The costs of the PCR test upon arrival and the saliva antigen tests will be covered within the event organisation, but the costs of the departure PCR test will be the responsibility of the individual being tested.

Event Guests

- General event spectators will not be able to attend the event
- However, guests may be invited to attend which may include supporters of the riders
- Invitations should be applied for through the respective national federations
- within the velodrome, demarcated seating areas will be in place for the following groupings:
 - VIP Guests
 - Egyptian Guests
 - International Supporters Guests
 - Riders
- Dependent on the type of accreditation each person has will determine which area they may access at the velodrome and no persons from one group may enter the area demarcated for a different group

24. MEDICAL ARRANGEMENTS

The general medical arrangements and plans associated with the event – independent of those in place related to the Covid – 19 pandemic protocols, and outlined as follows:

Hotels

The medical commission will appoint at least one person to be resident at each of the official hotels for the duration of the event, including from when the first team and riders arrive at the hotel and through until all teams and riders and officials have departed, who will be the contact person in order to resolve any medical situation – be it on site or to arrange for outside care if required.

Practice Sessions & Competition Days

There will be a medical team at the velodrome on each of the recognised official practice and competition days which will include ambulances and all requisite medical staff.

During unofficial training sessions, a medical team will be operational dependent on the schedule put in place by the competitions manager.

Medical Room – Velodrome

The official medical facility at the Cairo International Velodrome will be in operation during the attendant time period which will include all necessary equipment, running water and basins and aircon units.

Official Hospitals

Two of the largest hospitals in Egypt have been identified and contracted as the official hospitals to be utilised for the event. The first of these is the **Dar Al Fouad Hospital in Nasr City**, which is approximately five minutes travel from the velodrome, and the other being **The Arab Contractors Hospital**, which is approximately fifteen minutes away from the velodrome.

A representative appointed by the medical commission will be present inside each of the hospital receptions to receive any case transferred from the medical team at the venue and facilitate their care.

On Site & Off Site Care

Treatment and any necessary medication will be provided for cases at any of the official hotels and at the velodrome.

It must be noted that should any riders or federation representatives require transport by ambulance to any hospitals, or if they require any tests or hospital admission, the individual or their federation will be responsible for any such costs and all federations must ensure that all their riders and associated squad members have the requisite medical insurance cover to be able to cover such instances prior to their arrival at the event.
