GENERAL INFORMATION

Luoyang, the first national historical and cultural city announced by The Chinese State Council, is an important birthplace of Chinese civilization, the eastern starting point of the Silk Road, and the centre of the Sui and Tang Grand Canal. Since the Xia Dynasty, 13 dynasties have established their capitals here, with a civilization history of more than 5000 years, a city history of more than 4000 years, and a capital history of more than 1500 years. It is an ancient capital with the earliest, longest and most dynasties in China, and has entered the ranks of the world's metropolitans for five times in China's history.

Luoyang is the national regional central city and the sub-central city of the Central Plains City cluster. It has jurisdiction over 7 counties and 7 districts, 2 national development zones and 11 provincial development zones, with a total area of 15 200 square kilometres and a permanent population of 7 079 million. Among them, the urban area is 2 280 square kilometres, the permanent population is 3 602 000, the urbanization rate of the city is 66.48%, and it has won the titles of National civilized City, National Health City, and China Excellent Tourism City.

Luoyang is an excellent tourist city with a blend of mountains and rivers, reflecting both ancient and modern beauty. Luoyang is bordered by Qinling Mountains in the west, Songyue Mountains in the east, Taihang Mountains in the north, and Funiu Mountains in the south. Five rivers, Yi, Luo, Chan, Jian, and the Yellow River run through the city. Since ancient times, Luoyang has a reputation of being a superlative place of beauty adorned by rivers and mountains. There are 66 A-grade scenic spots, including 5 5A-grade and 30 4A-grade scenic spots. In recent years, Luoyang has implemented the strategy of integrating culture, innovation and tourism, which has resulted in a massive brand building campaign that highlights Luoyang being the source of Heluo culture, the root of the Confucian etiquette-music culture, and the starting point of the Silk Road, continuously forging the city's strong suits, including the capital of peony culture, the capital of art and creativity, and the capital of screenplay entertainment. The concepts of revolutionary innovation, immersive experience, youthful consumption, and interactive communication have been emphasized in the efforts of leveraging such valuable assets as prosperous Sui and Tang Dynasties, Yellow River culture, Funiu Mountain and Water, national flower peony, and industrial heritage to accelerate the construction of a national immersive cultural tourism destination. The Provincial Cultural Tourism Group and the Provincial Cultural Tourism Cultural Innovation Integration Innovation Base have positioned in Luoyang. Taking the lead in creating a 3.0 version of the National Heritage Park of Luoyang City in the Sui and Tang Dynasties, where the Heavenly Hall and Yingtian Gate have reproduced the magnificent atmosphere of the prosperous Tang Dynasty. The latest newcomers are The Sui and Tang Grand Canal Culture Museum and the peony themed museum, the only one in the country. Tang Palace Banquet, Rhapsody on the Luo River Goddess, Longmen Vajra, and Wind Rising from Luoyang have joined forces and built an "IP Universe" for Luoyang. Luoyang Sancai, Peony Porcelain, and Pingle Peony Painting are renowned for their craftsmanship and cultural creativity. The world geological park Daimei Mountain, the national forest park Baiyun Mountain, Jiguan Cave, the First Karst Cave in the North, Laojun Mountain, a classic of mountain sceneries, a ten-mile painting screen, and the Water Town in the North, Chongdu Ravine that features the charm of both northern and southern scenic styles, among others, are the representatives of top-notch scenic attractions in Luoyang. The China Luoyang Peony Culture Festival, reputed as one of the four grandest such events and celebrated 39 times since 1983, has been entitled a national intangible cultural heritage. China Yituo Dongfanghong Farming Museum is the first museum featuring farming in China and has been included in the list of national industrial tourism demonstration bases. Luoyang has successfully developed a four-season tourism brand mix, including the Peony Culture Festival in spring, the Xiaolangdi Waterfall Viewing Festival in summer, the Heluo Culture Tourism Festival in autumn, and the Funiushan Ski Festival in winter.
