The price for one position is 100 USD. Please note that places need to be booked within the established deadline to guarantee a place with access to power and internet connection, since spaces are limited. Requests made after this date may not be accommodated.

STORAGE AREA

Access to the infield for teams will be possible from the first official training day, Saturday 18th October 2025.

Outside storage will be accessible during the event. A security deposit of 50 USD per cabin must be paid (in cash) when picking up the key at the accreditation. The deposit will be returned once the team cabin has been inspected and is left in the condition in which it was issued to you. Your deposit will not be returned if there is any damage to the team cabin and you may incur additional repair costs if the damage exceeds the initial deposit.

Lost Keys - if your team misplaces the key for your team cabin, a replacement key is available from the Team cabin coordinator. Teams will be responsible for the cost of replacing lost keys. Key replacement cost is 50 USD per key.

VISAS

The details of the nationalities that require entry permits to Chile are published on the <u>website of</u> the Chilean consulates.

Should one or more members of the delegation require a visa, each Federation must contact the local Organising Committee (santiago2025@track.ind, subject "Invitation Letter for a Visa Request") and attach a Visa Request Letter, detailing the long list of participants who require prior authorisation or visa to enter Chile according to the current immigration legislation. The Federation must use the Invitation Letter Model, which can be found at the end of this document.

With this information, the Organising Committee will send a letter of invitation that must be attached to the visa application that each Federation or member must process. In addition to the letter, we will attach the Visa and Entry Guide to Chile, the official document that details the step-by-step request process that is done virtually on the official website of the National Migration Service.



Be aware of visa application processing times and ensure that all passports—whether for visa-required or visa-exempt travelers—have at least six months of validity remaining at the time of application.
