SWIFT transfer OUR fees

With the OUR fee structure, as the sender, you pay all fees for the transfer, including the fees charged by the intermediary and recipient bank.

An intermediary bank is a bank that acts on behalf of the sending bank to facilitate international money transfers via the SWIFT network. This type of bank is needed when the sending and beneficiary banks don't have an established relationship. They'll often charge their own fee for their services, which will impact the amount your recipient gets.

The fee payable for **SWIFT OUR** transfers is determined by which country the recipient's bank is located in, as well as the currency that the money is transferred in.

Please use the table below to look up the transfer fee for your transfer based on the recipient bank's country and the currency you want to transfer:
