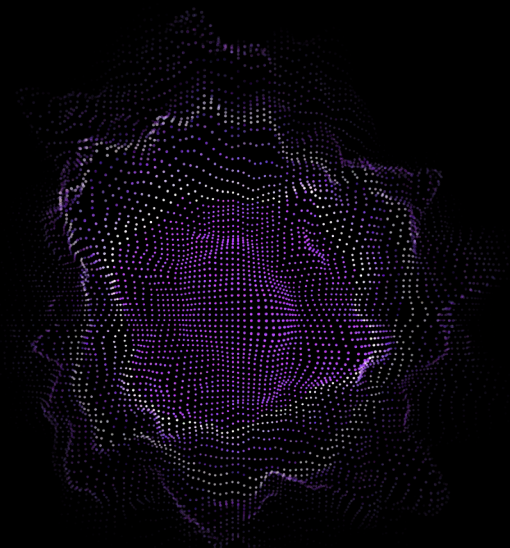

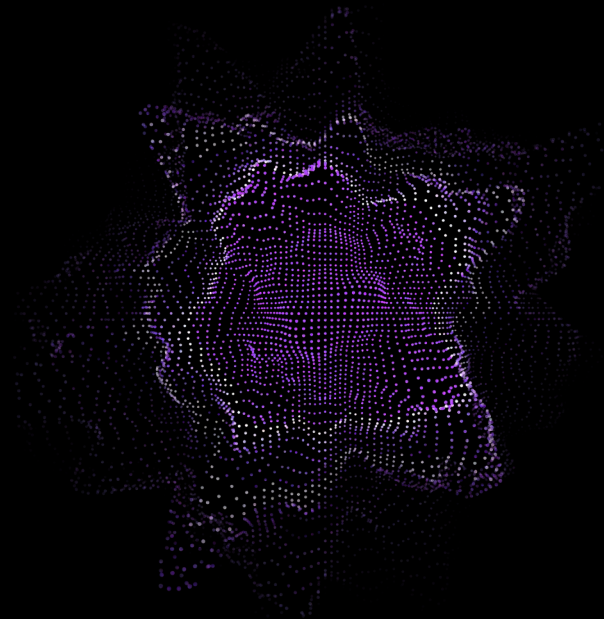


# HOW IT WORKS

Unlike other programs, founders retain all IP to their business or solution, and the LawTech Hub does not own an equity stake in the business.

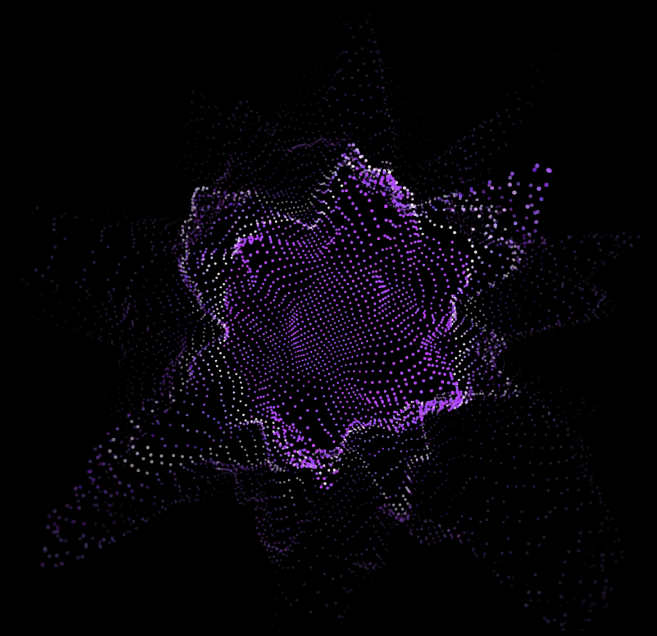
- Duration: Six months

The startups and scaleups program focuses on solutions centred primarily on:

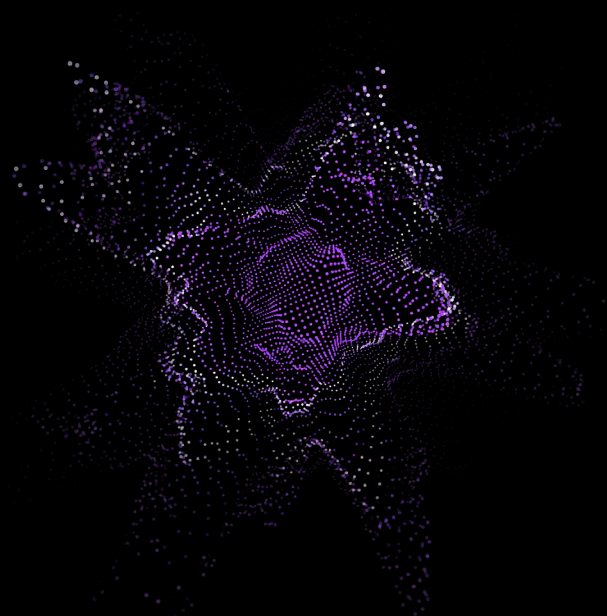

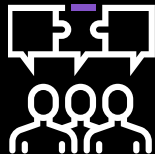
The LawTech Hub program offers opportunities for collaboration; access to mentors, legaltech entrepreneurs and other residents; continuing alumni support and more.

Access coaching from mentors and advice from industry experts and program alumni with real-time feedback from clients, lawyers and technical teams.



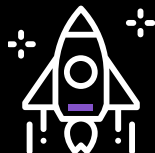
