B+P's scope of work included creating two large classroom spaces separated by an operation partition wall, a lounge area and a built-in check-in desk for reception and five office spaces. The improvements include updating life safety and ADA requirements as well as replacing two existing storefront double doors with brand new code compliant storefront double doors.
