### **Nature of Work:**

As part of a Design-Build team with J2 Engineering and Construction, Borrelli + Partners was selected by the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers to design a 21,000 square foot Child Development Center at Fort Sam Houston in Fort Sam Houston, TX.

The LEED® Silver targeted facility now accommodates up to 180 children ages six to ten. This project was funded through the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act.

Borrelli + Partners' scope of work included providing complete architectural and engineering services from schematic design through construction administration. This Child Development Center is a one-story building with three large atrium spaces, performing arts studio, arts and science classrooms, a computer lab and homework center. It also contains a commercial kitchen, demonstration kitchen and gymnasium. All administrative facilities are housed within the building as well. A large exterior playground was also designed on site.
