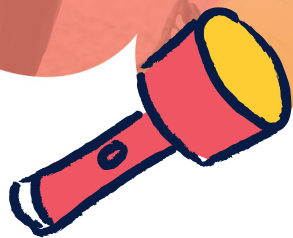

So who exactly is a 'Changemaker'?
