

	FIDO U2F Security Key Premium Use any FIDO U2F enabled security key to access your account.	Manage



Open the authentication app on your mobile device to link it to your Twitter account. When the app prompts you, scan the following QR code with your camera. [Learn more](#)




← **Two-factor authentication**

Two-factor authentication

Text message

Use your mobile phone to receive a text message with an authentication code to enter when you log in to Twitter.

Authentication app

Use a mobile authentication app to get a verification code to enter every time you log in to Twitter.

Security key

Use a physical security key that inserts into a USB port when you log in to twitter.com using a security key to log in to the Twitter app.

Backup codes

Get single-use backup codes so you can log in to Twitter if you don't have access to your two-factor authentication options.




Get single-use backup codes so you can log in to Twitter if you don't have access to your two-factor authentication options.


