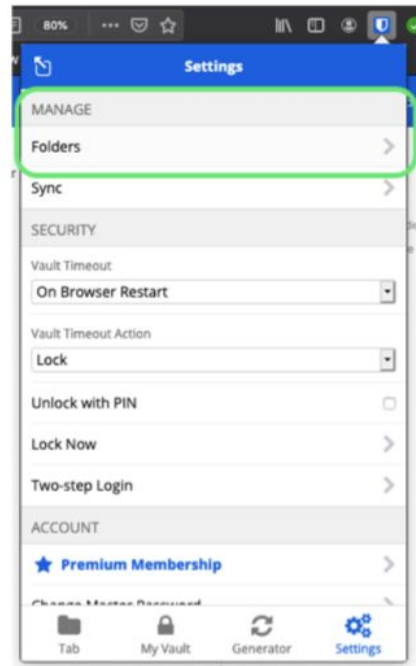
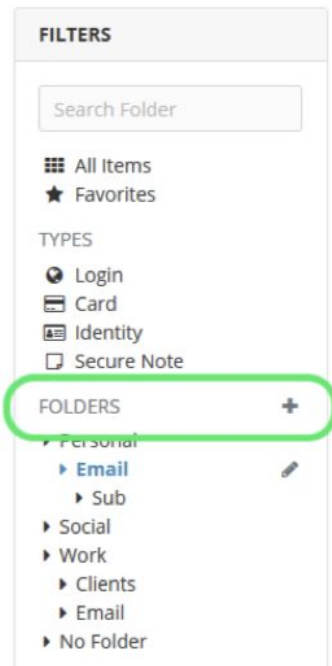
Browser Extension

- Access items by type:
 - Login
 - Card
 - Identity
 - Secure Note
- Folders for your Individual Vault
- Assigned Collections for Organization Vault
 - Admins/Owners can access other collections via the Web Vault.
- Trash (items stay for 30 days)



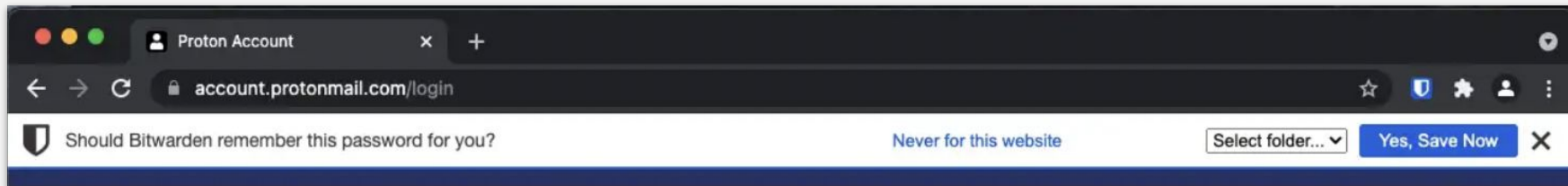
Folders

- Folders can help organize your Individual Vault by gathering together
- Using Folders is a great way to make all Vault items easy to find
- Folders can be created, renamed, and deleted from any Bitwarden client app

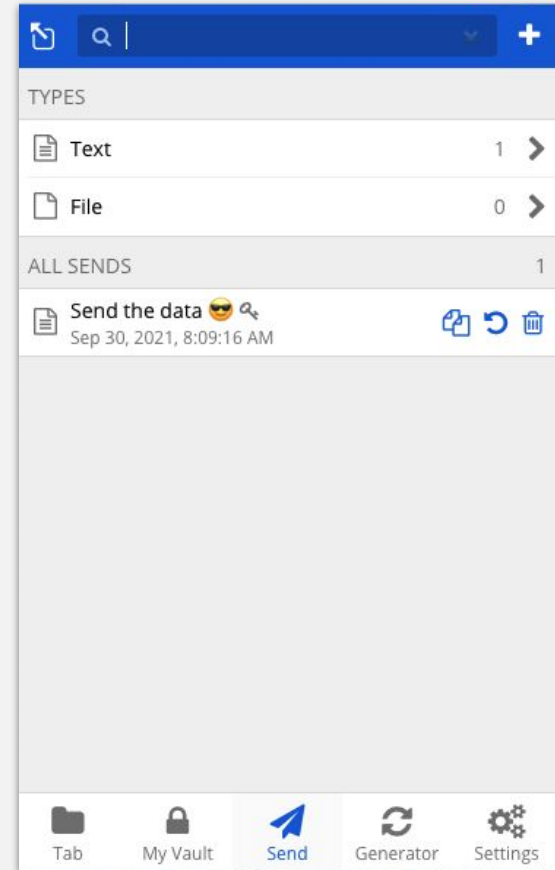
Select Folder from Save Bar

 - Choose Folder > Save to Folder



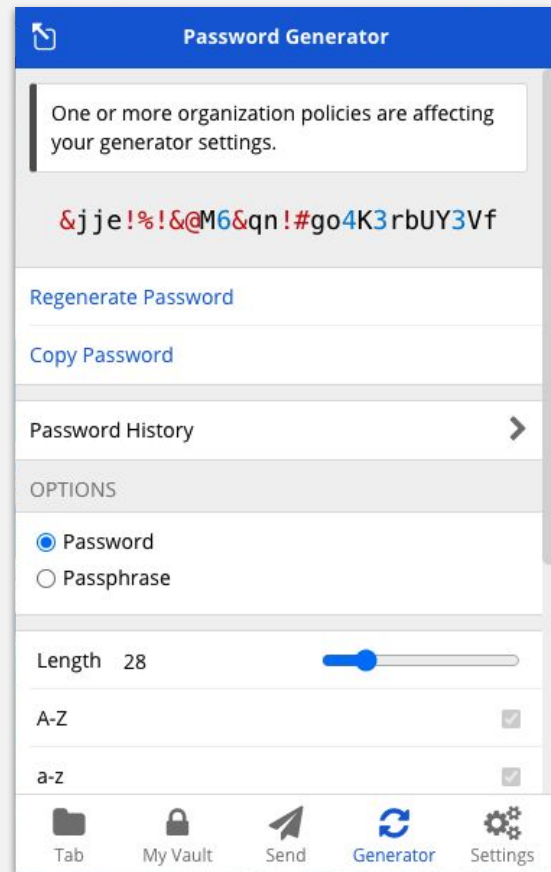
Bitwarden Send

- Bitwarden Send allows you to upload and share encrypted text or files securely.



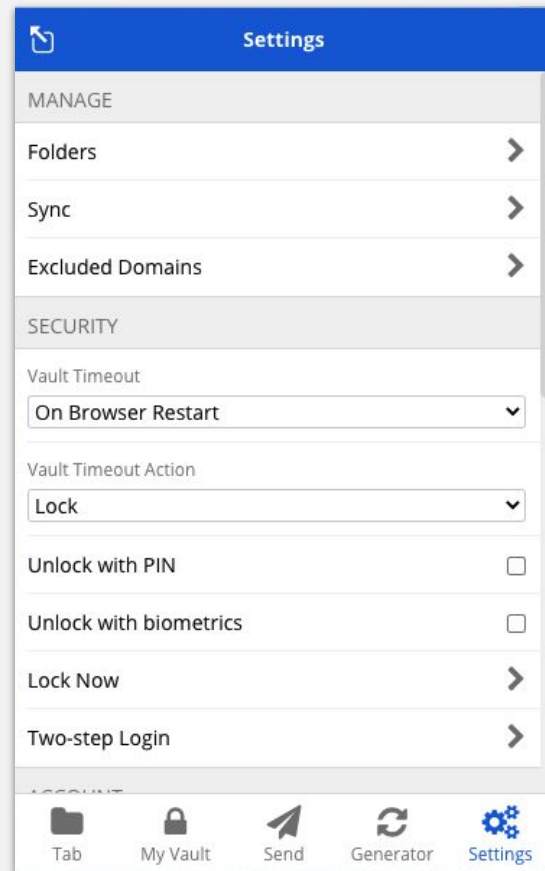
Password Generator

- Bitwarden can generate passwords for you that are Strong & Unique for all logins



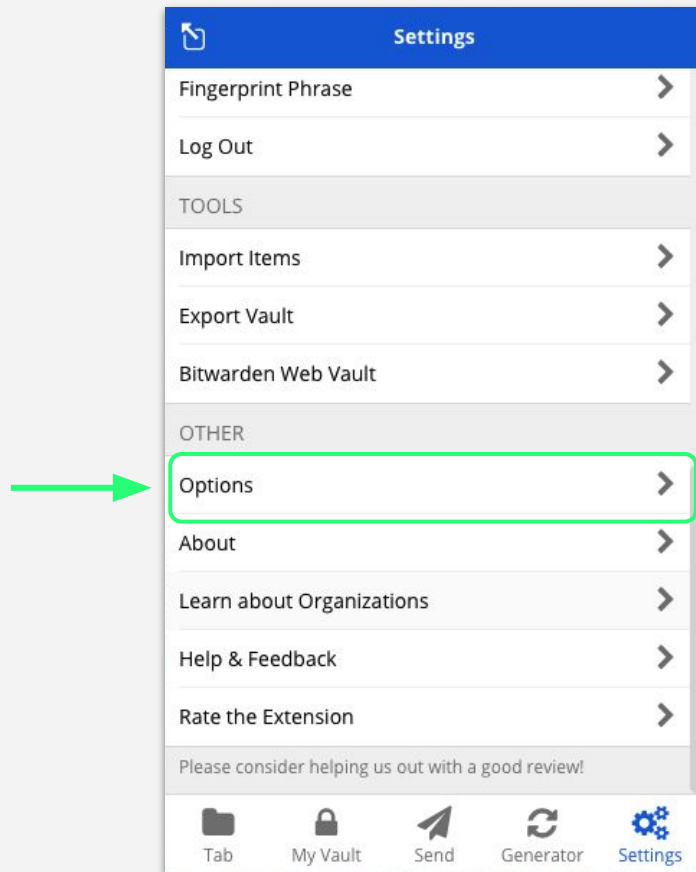


