ROCKIN' IN LITTLE ROCK – This weekend, for the eleventh time and ninth consecutive season, PBR's elite 2024 Unleash The Beast travels to Little Rock, Arkansas, for PBR Little Rock, the sixteenth event of the 24-event 2024 individual season. The City of Roses will host the PBR for two days of action on Friday, March 15, starting at 6:45 p.m. CDT, and Saturday, March 16, starting at 7:45 p.m. CDT.

CADEN BUNCH SEIZES VICTORY IN MILWAUKEE – No. 7 Caden Bunch went 2-for-3 to win his second career premier series event last weekend in Milwaukee, Wisconsin. A rising star for the Florida Freedom on the separate PBR Camping World Team Series, Bunch roared out of the gates on Cookies & Cream in Round 1 for 87 points, tying fellow rookie No. 2 John Crimber for the opening round win. Now on a roll, the Oklahoman covered Magic Trick for 86.75 points in Round 2 to maintain his hold on the event lead. Choosing Ricky Vaughn as his final animal athlete opponent, Bunch thundered out of the chutes but was unseated after 1.63 seconds.

After winning the first event of the season in Tucson, Arizona, Bunch toiled through a 17-out-buck off streak before finally making the 8 again in Houston, Texas, for 86.75 points on Don't Come Easy in January. Since that ride, the young cowboy is 8-for-16 (50%) and he has recorded four Top-10 finishes, including his victory last weekend. That stretch has helped propel the Oklahoman up the standings, where he currently sits 481 points behind No. 1 Cassio Dias. Bunch has done more than just make the 8 in his past 16 outs, posting an impressive 2.44 Rider Over Bull score. This weekend, he hopes to keep it rolling on Heavy Lifting in Round 1 on Friday.

DIAS MAINTAINS NO. 1 RANKING – While both Caden Bunch and John Crimber may have made up some ground in Milwaukee, Cassio Dias still holds a commanding lead in the gold buckle race after going 1-for-3 and finishing seventh in Milwaukee. After being shut out for just the third time this season in Indianapolis, Dias rebounded in Round 1, topping Trump Train for 86.75 points. While he was bucked off by Reinstate Hank in 2.91 seconds and Cy Young in 5.98 seconds in the final two rounds, his opening-round performance was enough to net Dias his tenth finish inside the Top 10. Last month in Los Angeles, the Brazilian cowboy had extended his lead, going 2-for-3 to win his fourth event of the season. The rising superstar topped Hell Storm for 87.25 points in Round 1, the second-best score of the evening, but was dispatched by Ghost Face in 3.04 seconds in Round 2 on Saturday. Knowing he most likely needed a monstrous score to take over the No. 1 spot, Dias showed no fear and selected the 2024 YETI PBR World Champion Bull frontrunner, Man Hater, who hadn't been covered before. The dynamic duo burst out of the gate in the championship round in front of a roaring Crypto.com Arena, posting a mind-boggling, 94.75-point score, the highest-marked ride since Jose Vitor Leme topped Ridin' Solo for 94.75 points in Oklahoma City in February of 2022 and the highest ride in PBR history in California. With the Top-50 ride in premier series history, Dias put a stamp on his season that could end with a gold buckle.

After sitting atop the standings for a month early in the season, Dias briefly lost his hold on the top spot to Austin Richardson after the Texan won back-to-back titles in the Empire State at the beginning of the new year. However, Dias bounced back in Chicago, going a perfect 3-for-3 and winning his premier series-leading third event of the season. The MVP runner-up for the Kansas City Outlaws in the PBR Camping World Team Series, Dias finished tied for fourth in the first round with an 87-point ride on IHOP. Now on a roll, the Brazilian tied for second in Round 2, scoring 86.75 points on Grey Fox to earn the second pick in the championship pen. Choosing Do Dat Eddie, Dias saved his best for last, storming out of the gates for an event-high-tying 89 points to overtake Cort McFadden, who was making his PBR debut, in the event standings. After the young Texan was bucked off Polar Express in 5.26 seconds, Dias knew he was back on top in the race for a gold buckle. Despite missing the

championship round in Jacksonville, the young gun's 10 championship round outs lead the field by a wide margin, as the next-highest rider has just seven round outs. Dias tries to extend his lead atop the standings on T-Wrecks in Round 1 Friday.

KASEL KEEPS ROLLING – While he didn't take home the win, No. 3 Dalton Kasel continued to stay hot in Milwaukee to jump up one more spot in the standings. After being bucked off in 5.55 seconds in Round 1 by Gucci, Kasel battled back, tying for second in Round 2 by riding The Judge for 88 points. While unseated by Dark Thoughts in 5.19 seconds in the championship round, the third-place finish pushed him to within 318.33 points of Dias.

The previous weekend in Indianapolis, Kasel went a perfect 3-for-3 for the second consecutive weekend to take home the event buckle. He began his flawless performance by covering Dream Walkin for 86.25 points, tying him for third entering championship Saturday. Looking completely locked in, the Texan roared out of the chutes on Unhinged in Round 2 for 86.25 points, earning the pick of the pen heading into the final round. There, the Austin Gamblers' star sealed the event victory by riding I'm Legit Too for 88.25 points.

Prior to Indy, the Texan began his hot streak in Jacksonville, Florida, where he also went a perfect 3-for-3 and finished second. Recording his third Top 5 finish of the season after being shut out in Salt Lake City and missing the event in Los Angeles due to injury, Kasel showed no rust by riding Mama's Boy for 87 points in the opening round. Starting to find his groove, the Texan then topped Don't Come Easy for 84.25 points in Round 2 and UTZ BesTex Smokestack for 89.5 points in the championship round to net second place and rise to No. 4 in the standings. "Mr. 90 pointer" is currently 17-for-36 (47%) on the season and has been a staple inside the Top 20 of the Unleash the Beast standings since starting the season with three straight Top 20 outings, and he hasn't been ranked outside the Top 10 since placing second at the UTB major in New York City in January. Kasel shares a chute with TBR's Buffalo Joe in Round 1 on Saturday.

ABBI CLASSIC ROUND – The first round of the Little Rock Unleash The Beast event will feature an American Bucking Bull Inc. (ABBI) Classic event. There will be 36 bulls competing for a prize purse of nearly \$30,000 with the winning bull collecting more than \$6,000. The four-year-old bulls competing in Little Rock have been approved by the Livestock Director and are deemed the best young bulls in the nation to try their ability against the best bull riders in the world. This weekend will be the second major ABBI Classic competition of the season held in conjunction with the elite Unleash The Beast.

The first matchup to keep an eye on is Triple Aught, who shares a chute with Julio Cesar Marques on Friday. The powerful bovine competitor bucked off rookie sensation Clay Guiton in 2 seconds in Tulsa during the animal athlete's first premier series out. Earlier this month in Knoxville, Tennessee, on the Pendleton Whisky Velocity Tour, Triple Aught bested Dylan Smith in just 5 seconds. Double 00 Buck also competed in Knoxville before heading to Little Rock, unseating Max Castro in 2 seconds in his first PBR out. He is matched up with Keyshawn Whitehorse in Round 1.

Son of Ridin Solo and sharing a mother with Big Black is Goin Solo, who is paired with Wyatt Rogers this weekend. Solo has a 100% buck off rate in his three PBR outs, and no cowboy has been able to cover him for more than two seconds. The rank bovine shed Thiago Salgado in 2 seconds in Las Vegas, Nevada, last October on the Challenger Series, then unseated Briggs Madsen in 2 seconds in Tulsa on his first premier series showing. Most recently, Goin Solo competed in Knoxville, bucking off Lucas Fideles Souza in 2 seconds.

2022 Junior Futurity World Champion Rip roars out of the chutes beneath Mauricio Gulla Moreira in the opening round. The son of Canadian Mist, Rip bucked off AJ Gamboa in 2 seconds in Fort Worth, Texas, at the weekly Stockyards Showcase earlier this March. Another bull making his Unleash The Beast debut is Firewater, the maternal brother of four-time PBR World Finals competitor Air Time. Like Rip, he made his PBR debut at the PBR Stockyards Showcase, besting Jaxton Mortensen in 1 second in January.

The final bull to keep an eye on is Quick Show, who Vitor Losnake covered for 86 points in Jacksonville, Florida, in February. The Co-champion of the Tulsa PBR Unleash The Beast Classic Round, where he bucked off Boudreaux Campbell in 1 second, Quick Show has forfeited just the ride to Losnake in his four PBR outs. In his last showing in Knoxville, the animal athlete bucked off Claudio Montanha Jr. in 1 second.

- **Rank n' Ready:** The event in Arkansas this weekend will feature each of the Top 3 bulls in the World Champion Bull race, as No. 1 Man Hater, No. 2 UTZ BesTex Legend and No. 3 Flyin Wired all await the best cowboys from the first two rounds this weekend. In his last out, Man Hater was covered for the first time this season by No. 1 Cassio Dias for a monstrous, season-high 94.75 points in Los Angeles. Legend is currently on a five-out buck-off streak, including besting No. 9 Alan de Souza in three seconds in his last out in Tulsa, Oklahoma, in January. Flyin Wired was also last seen in January, bucking off No. 24 Ednelio Almeida in five seconds in Houston after he was ridden for 91.75 points by Joao Ricardo Vieira in his previous out in Tulsa. In addition to the Top 3, No. 6 UTZ BesTex Smokestack is also waiting in the pens this weekend.

FAMILIAR WATERS – Round 1 of the 2024 PBR event in North Little Rock, Arkansas, will feature two rematches.

- Paulo Eduardo Rossetto takes on King Tut for the second time after being bucked off in 1.95 seconds in Los Angeles, California, earlier this season in February.
- Vitor Losnake shares a chute with Spendin' Cash for the first time since he was unseated in 4.19 seconds in Tulsa, Oklahoma, in January.

PAST LITTLE ROCK EVENT WINNERS – When the PBR was last in Little Rock, Dalton Kasel went a perfect 3-for-3 to take home the event title. He began the weekend by topping Old School Cool in Round 1 for 85.5 points, putting him in a three-way tie for fifth entering Saturday. Locking in, the Texan roared out of the chutes for 88.25 points in Round 2 to secure a spot in the championship round before capping his perfect weekend with a monstrous 91.25-point ride on UTZ BesTex Smokestack to take home the event buckle. The victory propelled Kasel from No. 4 to No. 2 in the Unleash The Beast standings.

Right on the Texan's spurs were Dener Barbosa and Joao Ricardo Vieira, who also posted perfect outings. Barbosa started slowly with an 85.25-point ride on Cool Hand Luke in Round 1 before rallying to split a Round 2 win with an 89-point showing on John 14:6. Looking to catapult to the top of the leaderboard, he shot out of the gates on I'm Legit Too for 90 points, but it wasn't enough to top Kasel. Vieira was similarly flawless, covering Joker's Alibi for 87 points in Round 1 and Choc Tease for 81.75 points in the second round. Now in a groove, the veteran matched Kasel's championship round ride, scoring 91.25 points on Chateau Montelena's Montana Jacket to move into third in the event standings. The 3-for-3 performances catapulted Barbosa from No. 19 to No. 10 in the standings, while Vieira rose from No. 22 to No. 16.

WORLD CHAMPION BULL RACE – The 2024 YETI PBR World Champion Bull race has been dominated by Man Hater with just a few months left in the year-long campaign. Spanning back to the 2023 PBR Camping World Team Series' season, the powerful bovine competitor had bucked off all 15 of his cowboy opponents until Cassio Dias covered him for a season-high 94.75 points in the championship round in Los Angeles to take the event title. Man Hater currently holds a 1.38-point lead over UTZ BesTex Legend in the standings. After being marked 46.25 points for his buck-off of Brady Fielder in the championship round in Tulsa, Man Hater currently boasts seven of the Top 10 bull scores this season and he has won the Bull of the Event title eight times. Putting that into perspective, the reigning back-to-back World Champion Bull, Ridin' Solo, was named the Bull of the Event just five times during the 2023 campaign. In Houston, Red Demon became the first animal athlete other than Man Hater to claim more than one Bull of the Event title this season, marked an impressive 47 points for bucking off Joao Ricardo Vieira in 2.3 seconds in the championship round, and has risen to fourth in the standings. After surrendering an 88.5-point ride to Alan de Souza in St. Louis, Missouri, Legend has put together a five-out buck-off streak to somewhat close the gap on Man Hater. A member of the 2023 PBR Stock Contractor of the Year Blake Sharp's pen, Legend has bucked off 14 of the 15 riders he has faced so far. Right behind him in the standings is Flyin Wired, who sits 1.64 points back of the leader. While he has given up two rides in his six outs, both went for 90 or more points, as Wingson Henrique da Silva covered him for 92.5 points at the PBR Teams Championship in Las Vegas while Joao Ricardo Vieira topped him for 91.75 points to win the event in Tulsa.

2024 POINTS TABLES – The 2024 PBR Unleash The Beast season keeps the same point structure as 2023 but adds PBR Majors while removing 15/15 Bucking Battles and having two separate aggregates at the PBR World Finals. The 2024 World

Champion will be the rider who earns the most points only at Unleash The Beast (UTB) events, including at the 2024 PBR World Finals on May 10-19 in the Dallas-Fort Worth Metroplex. The three PBR Majors in New York City (January 5-7, won by Austin Richardson), Sacramento, California (February 2-4, won by Leonardo Castro Ferreira), and Albuquerque, New Mexico (March 22-24), offer increased payouts and points. There will be three PBR tours in the U.S. in action for the first half of 2024: PBR Unleash The Beast (November 10 – May 19); Pendleton Whisky Velocity Tour (Jan. 5 – May 4) and PBR Touring Pro Division (Oct. 19 – May 19). Points accumulated in non-UTB events domestically, as well as PBR’s international tours, will be tallied as Velocity Global points. Velocity Global points, which will also be used to crown the 2024 PBR Pendleton Whisky Velocity Tour Champion, will help determine the athletes who can earn a future draw spot on the elite Unleash The Beast following the tour’s first four events.

Those with the most points earned during their four most recent Velocity Global or Unleash The Beast events will join the UTB, replacing riders who had fallen to the bottom of the pack during select cuts throughout the season. Riders ranked in the No. 36-40 range in the UTB standings will be subject to being cut. During each cut, the open positions will first be filled with those riders having injury exemptions, followed by the Premier Series Qualifier List, based on Velocity Global points. Following each cut, these riders will take the place of the demoted riders in the sport’s top series to make up the 40-rider field heading into the next event. Riders ranked No. 1-35 on the UTB will remain on the PBR’s elite tour. Following the initial cut after the event in Manchester, New Hampshire, subsequent cuts will be held every two weeks. The second cut will drop the bottom six riders from UTB, the third cut will drop the bottom seven riders, and the fourth and remaining cuts will remove the bottom eight riders from UTB.

Points will be awarded as follows for the Unleash The Beast, including World Finals, as well as Tier 1 Velocity Global events:

Bonus points are awarded across all levels of PBR competition. A rider who scores 70-79.75 points will earn 7 bonus points, 80-89.75 8 bonus points and 90-99.75 9 bonus points. The exception is if a contestant declines a re-ride due to an inferior bull. In that case, he does not earn bonus points.

THIS WEEKEND’S FORMAT – PBR Little Rock, the sixteenth Unleash The Beast event of the 2024 season, will feature three rounds of bull riding. Each of the 37 competing riders will get on one bull in Round 1 on Friday and Round 2 on Saturday. The 12 bull riders with the top combined ride scores following Rounds 1 and 2 will then advance to the championship round following Round 2 on Saturday.

NEXT UP – The PBR Unleash The Beast next travels to The Pit in Albuquerque, New Mexico, for PBR Albuquerque Ty Murray Invitational, the third and final major of the 2024 season. The event is on Friday, March 22, at 7:45 p.m. MST, Saturday, March 23, at 6:45 MST and Sunday, March 24, at 1:45 p.m. MST.

- Tier 2 Events – \$10,000 - \$19,999 USD in added money.
- Tier 3 Events – \$9,999 USD or less in added money.

Additionally, riders at all events receive bonus points via their ride score. A rider who scores 70-79.75 points will earn 7 bonus points, 80-89.75 8 bonus points and 90-99.75 9 bonus points.
