

# 2024 PBR Unleash The Beast Express Ranches PBR Tulsa Presented by Hard Rock Hotel & Casino – Tulsa BOK Center – Tulsa, Oklahoma Friday, January 19 at 7:45 p.m. CST Saturday, January 20 at 6:45 p.m. CST

**TULSA TWO-STEP** – This weekend, PBR's elite 2024 Unleash The Beast returns to BOK Center in Tulsa, Oklahoma. The eighth stop of the 24-event 2024 individual season will mark the 20th consecutive year the PBR has bucked into Tulsa. Oklahoma will host the PBR for two days of action on Friday, January 19, at 7:45 p.m. CST and Saturday, January 20, at 6:45 p.m. CST.

**DIAS DAZZLES TO TAKE BACK NO. 1** – After sitting in the No. 1 spot in the standings for a month, No. 1 Cassio Dias briefly lost his hold on the top spot to now-No. 2 Austin Richardson after the Texan won back-to-back titles in the Empire State. However, Dias bounced back in Chicago, going a perfect 3-for-3 and winning his premier series-leading third event of the season.

The MVP runner-up for the Kansas City Outlaws in the Camping World Teams Series, Dias finished tied for fourth in the first round with an 87-point ride on IHOP. Now on a roll, the Brazilian tied for second in Round 2, scoring 86.75 points on Grey Fox to earn the second pick in the championship pen heading into the final round. Choosing Do Dat Eddie, Dias saved his best for last, storming out of the gates for an event-high-tying 89 points to overtake Cort McFadden, who was making his PBR debut, in the event standings. After the young Texan was bucked off Polar Express in 5.26 seconds, Dias knew he was back on top in the race for a gold buckle. The rising superstar is slated to take on Lansky in Round 1 on Friday.

**LIKE FATHER, LIKE SON** – While there is only one rematch in Round 1 on Friday, veteran Joao Ricardo Vieira faces King Tut for the first time after facing the animal athlete's sire, SweetPro's Bruiser, five times. The Brazilian cowboy went 2-for-5 on the legendary bovine competitor throughout both of their storied careers. Vieira bested Bruiser in the first matchup for 88.75 points in Thackerville, Oklahoma, in August of 2014, but the bull got his revenge at the PBR World Finals in Las Vegas, Nevada, later that year, bucking him off in 3.4 seconds.

In February of 2015 at the Iron Cowboy in Arlington, Texas, Vieira topped Bruiser for a monstrous 90.5 points, going on to win the event. However, the 2023 PBR Brand of Honor inductee once again got his revenge, bucking off the perennial gold buckle contender twice in 2017, first in 6.49 seconds in March, and finally in 6.95 seconds in October. Bruiser was in top form in both outings, marked 46 points in March and 46.25 points in October.

NO EXPERIENCE, NO PROBLEM – Rookies continued to shine in the early race for a gold buckle, as three sit in the Top 10 of the Unleash The Beast standings: No. 1 Cassio Dias, No. 9 Julio Cesar Marques and No. 10 Kaiden Loud. Dias once again put together a perfect showcase to take back the top spot in the standings last weekend in Chicago. However, he wasn't the only rookie to shine in the Windy City, as Cort McFadden went 2-for-3 in his Unleash The Beast debut, finishing fourth. A reserve rider for the Austin Gamblers in PBR Teams, the rookie entered PBR Chicago red-hot, topping 8 of his last 10 bulls. Currently ranked No. 6 in the Pendleton Whisky Velocity Tour standings, the Novice, Texas, native

is the son of five-time PBR World Finals qualifier Cory McFadden, who had two very memorable rides against three-time PBR YETI World Champion Bull Yellow Jacket, both resulting in 95+ point scores.

Showing he has what it takes to follow in his father's footsteps, McFadden thundered out of the chutes on Nightmare for 86.75 points in Round 1. The young Texan followed that up by topping Sly for a round-winning 87.25 points in the second round, earning his pick of the pen heading into the championship round. Choosing Polar Express as his final animal athlete opponent, McFadden initially sat tall aboard the powerful bovine competitor but was unseated after a thrilling 5.26 seconds. McFadden faces Sucker Pop in Round 1 on Friday.

**FAMILIAR WATERS** – Round 1 of the 2024 PBR event in Tulsa, Oklahoma, will feature just one rematch.

- Alex Cerqueira faces off against Buckshot for the second time after being bucked off in 2.9 seconds at the weekly PBR Stockyards Showcase in Fort Worth, Texas, in September of 2023.

**ABBI CLASSIC ROUND** — Once again in Tulsa, Round 1 will be an American Bucking Bull Inc. (ABBI) Classic event. There will be 40 bulls competing for a prize purse of nearly \$40,000 with the winning bull collecting more than \$7,500. The four-year-old bulls competing in Tulsa have been approved by the Livestock Director and are deemed the best 40 young bulls in the nation to try their ability against the best bull riders in the world. This weekend will be the first major ABBI Classic competition of the season.

In addition to the son of SweetPro's Bruiser King Tut taking on Joao Ricardo Vieira, there are several other animal athletes to keep an eye on in Tulsa. Watch Out battles Oklahoman Wyatt Rogers in his second out on the premier series this season. Making his premier series debut in Johnstown, Pennsylvania, in December, he paired with Cody Jesus for a monstrous 90.75 points. Also making his debut in Johnstown was Mercy, who bucked off Bob Mitchell and Ednei Caminhas in an even 2 seconds. He takes on Eduardo Aparecido in the opening round Friday. While Thunderstruck hasn't had an out this year, he had three outs during the 2023 PBR Teams season. He bucked off just one of his cowboy compatriots, as Silvano Alves topped him for 88.5 points in Greensboro, North Carolina, and Brady Fielder covered him for 86.75 points at the PBR Teams Championship in Las Vegas. He takes on Alan de Souza in his 2024 premier series debut. The 2023 ABBI Derby World Champion faces off with Felipe Furlan on Friday in his UTB debut. Sava bucked off two of the three cowboys he faced during the PBR Teams season but was ridden by Brady Oleson of the Texas Rattlers for 87 points in Greensboro.

BLOODLINES ON DISPLAY - In total, there are three Bruiser sons as well as four Ridin' Solo sons scheduled to buck on Friday Night. Goin Solo, son of the reigning two-time PBR Bull of the Year Ridin' Solo, shares a chute with Briggs Madsen. Another son of Ridin' Solo, Thriller, is paired with Luciano De Castro after bucking at the 2023 National Finals Rodeo. Facing Jesse Petri on Friday, another anticipated PBR debut is that of T-Wrecks, who bucked off all eight cowboys he faced in the PRCA and made the National Finals Rodeo in 2023. 2022 ABBI Futurity World Champion Mr. Vaquero, who has earned \$186,216.33, also bucks Friday, taking on Kaique Pacheco. Son of four-time PBR World Finalist Air Time, Fast Flow dances with three-time PBR World Champion Silvano Alves. The rank bovine competitor has earned \$228,788.73 in his career, including \$110,000 at his very first competition as a yearling bucking bull, and was marked 45 points in his only PBR out in Woodstown, New Jersey, on the Touring Pro Division last year. Finally, the 2023 ABBI Derby World Finals Event Winner, It's Cherry, and Brady Fielder square off on Friday. The animal athlete was covered by Eli Vastbinder for 83 points in October of 2023 at the Challenger Finals in Las Vegas.

PAST TULSA EVENT WINNERS – Once again proving he belonged among the best bull riders in the world, Eli Vastbinder went a perfect 3-for-3 to win the event the last time the PBR bucked into BOK Center in 2023. Sitting right on the cut line heading into the event, Vastbinder rocketed out of the gates in Round 1 on Lapua for 85.25 points. Taking advantage of a re-ride opportunity, the North Carolinian cashed in aboard Mighty Mike for 87.75 points. In search of his first career PBR event win, Vastbinder then locked in on the aptly named Tulsa Time, topping the animal athlete for a monstrous 90.5 points to win the event buckle and propel himself to the No. 16 spot in the standings.

WORLD CHAMPION BULL – The 2024 YETI PBR World Champion Bull will be determined by both the 2023 PBR Camping World Team Series season and the 2024 Unleash The Beast (UTB) season. The 2024 YETI World Champion Bull will be determined by their Top 8 outs during the Team Series and UTB regular season and two outs at the PBR World Finals. The Top 7 eligible bulls at the end of the PBR UTB regular season shall be entered into the World Finals and be guaranteed three outs. In the event two or more bulls are tied based on the scoring criteria after the World Finals, the World Champion Bull shall be awarded to the bull who has achieved the highest average score from their two best outs at the World Finals. If a tie still exists after a review of the scores described in the preceding sentence, the bulls will share the title of World Champion Bull, and the prize money will be evenly distributed among the stock contractors who own said bulls.

For avoidance of doubt, if the score that is dropped from the World Finals is higher than the lowest regular season out, the score at World Finals will still be dropped. The top eight (8) regular season outs and top two (2) World Finals outs are to remain in the calculations for the World Champion Bull award.

MAJORS RETURN – The 2024 PBR Unleash The Beast season keeps the same point structure as 2023 but adds PBR Majors while removing 15/15 Bucking Battles and having two separate aggregates at the PBR World Finals. The 2024 World Champion will be the rider who earns the most points only at Unleash The Beast (UTB) events, including at the 2024 PBR World Finals on May 10-19 in the Dallas-Fort Worth Metroplex. The three PBR Majors in New York City (January 5-7, won by Austin Richardson), Sacramento, California (February 2-4), and Albuquerque, New Mexico (March 22-24), will offer increased payouts and points. There will be three PBR tours in the U.S. in action for the first half of 2024: PBR Unleash The Beast (November 10 – May 19); Pendleton Whisky Velocity Tour (Jan. 5 – May 4) and PBR Touring Pro Division (Oct. 19 – May 19). Points accumulated in non-UTB events domestically, as well as PBR's international tours, will be tallied as Velocity Global points. Velocity Global points, which will also be used to crown the 2024 PBR Pendleton Whisky Velocity Tour Champion, will help determine the athletes who can earn a future draw spot on the elite Unleash The Beast following the tour's first four events.

Those with the most points earned during their four most recent Velocity Global or Unleash The Beast events will join the UTB, replacing riders who had fallen to the bottom of the pack during select cuts throughout the season. Riders ranked in the No. 36-40 range in the UTB standings will be subject to being cut. During each cut, the open positions will first be filled with those riders having injury exemptions, followed by the Premier Series Qualifier List, based on Velocity Global points. Following each cut, these riders will take the place of the demoted riders in the sport's top series to make up the 40-rider field heading into the next event. Riders ranked No. 1-35 on the UTB will remain on the PBR's elite tour. Following the initial cut after the event in Manchester, New Hampshire, subsequent cuts will be held every two weeks. The second cut will drop the bottom six riders from UTB, the third cut will drop the bottom seven riders, and the fourth and remaining cuts will remove the bottom eight riders from UTB.

Points will be awarded as follows for the Unleash The Beast, including World Finals, as well as Tier 1 Velocity Global events:

Bonus points are awarded across all levels of PBR competition. A rider who scores 70-79.75 points will earn 7 bonus points, 80-89.75 8 bonus points and 90-99.75 9 bonus points. The exception is if a contestant declines a re-ride due to an inferior bull. In that case, he does not earn bonus points.

**THIS WEEKEND'S FORMAT** – Express Ranches PBR Tulsa, the eighth Unleash The Beast event of the 2024 season, will feature three rounds of bull riding. Each of the 40 competing riders will get on one bull in Round 1 on Friday and Round 2 on Saturday. The 12 bull riders with the top combined ride scores following Rounds 1 and 2 will then advance to the championship round following Round 2 on Saturday.

**VELOCITY TOUR, INTERNATIONAL AND TOURING PRO DIVISION POINTS** – All non-Unleash The Beast (UTB) events award Velocity Global points, including Pendleton Whisky Velocity Tour events, Touring Pro Division events and events held internationally in Australia, Brazil, Canada, and Mexico. The only exception is National Finals held abroad, which will only award national points, not Velocity Global points. The point system at each event is tiered based on added money in USD, and other factors determined by the PBR. Each event, depending on the tier will get points in accordance with the tables below.

- Tier 1 Events \$20,000 or more USD in added money.
- Tier 2 Events \$10,000 \$19,999 USD in added money.

- Tier 3 Events – \$9,999 USD or less in added money.

Additionally, riders at all events receive bonus points via their ride score. A rider who scores 70-79.75 points will earn 7 bonus points, 80-89.75 8 bonus points and 90-99.75 9 bonus points.
