



2024 PBR Unleash The Beast Tractor Supply Co. PBR Chicago Allstate Arena – Rosemont, Illinois Friday, January 12 at 7:45 p.m. CST Saturday, January 13 at 6:45 p.m. CST

BUCKING BY THE BEAN – This weekend, PBR’s elite 2024 Unleash The Beast returns to Allstate Arena in Rosemont, Illinois. The seventh stop of the 24-event 2024 individual season will mark the 14th time in history the top tour has bucked into the Windy City. Chicago will host the PBR for two days of action on Friday, January 12, at 7:45 p.m. CST and Saturday, January 13, at 6:45 p.m. CST.

RICHARDSON RISES TO NO. 1 – Courtesy of back-to-back event wins in the Empire State fueled by strong rider-over-bull scores, Austin Richardson rose to the No. 1 spot in the Unleash The Beast Standings, overtaking No. 2 Cassio Dias, who had held the top spot for the past month. The young Texan is 6-for-7 across his past two events in Albany and New York City, making the most of his outs by averaging an impressive 2.5 rider over bull score in his six rides. Richardson is the third rider to climb to No. 1 this season.

Under the bright lights of Madison Square Garden, Richardson rocketed out of the gates in Round 1 on Moonlight Party for 88 points before covering Bangarang for 86.75 points in Round 2. Despite being bucked off in 2.33 seconds by The Undertaker in Round 3, the ever-calm Richardson bounced back, making the 8 for 83.5 points on Moonlight Party once again in the championship round to take the event lead with just one out remaining. Koltin Hevalow attempted to complete a perfect weekend in the final out, but he was bucked off by the powerful Red Scorpion in 7.39 seconds, and Richardson was able to hoist the Charging Bull trophy. It is the second time this season that Red Scorpion has spoiled a perfect, possible event-winning ride in the final out as a re-ride bull. Previously, Cody Jesus was called for a slap in 2.00 seconds in Johnstown to end his perfect start to the season. Richardson shares a chute with Slingin’ It in Round 1 on Friday, while Dias takes on IHOP.

The Dallas, Texas, native began his surge up the standings by claiming the No. 2 spot in the Unleash The Beast standings courtesy of a flawless 3-for-3 performance in Albany, New York, during the final weekend of 2023. He kicked off a perfect ending to the year by covering Martini Houdini for a round-high-tying 86.5 points in the opening round. The 23-year-old cowboy then locked in on championship Saturday, winning Round 2 with 88 points on Magic Trick before completing the clean sweep of the event and winning the final round with an event-high 88.75 points on Ivy League. Claiming at least a share of the top spot in every single round, Richardson became the first rider this season to win multiple rounds in an event. Richardson’s third and fourth career premier series victories netted him a colossal 367 UTB points.

WELCOME TO THE SHOW – Two rookies make their much-awaited UTB debut in Illinois this weekend with 18-year-old Clay Guiton and 19-year-old Cort McFadden joining the top tour.

Hailing from Cherryville, North Carolina, a small town just an hour southeast of Statesville, home of PBR legend J.B. Mauney and No. 24 Eli Vastbinder, Guiton enters the premier series after winning his first PBR event buckle by going 3-for-3 in Lexington, Kentucky, on the Pendleton Whisky Velocity Tour. He is currently ranked No. 1 in the early Velocity Tour standings and was the 2023 Southern Extreme Bull Riding Association (SEBRA) Finals Champion, an organization that has produced PBR mainstays such as Michael Lane, Gage Gay and Marcus Mast.

McFadden, a reserve rider for the Austin Gamblers in the separate PBR Teams league, enters PBR Chicago red-hot, topping 8 of his last 10 bulls, including going 2-for-3 earlier this week in Denver to win the Denver PBR Chute Out at the

National Western Stock Show. Currently ranked No. 3 in the Velocity Tour standings, the Novice, Texas, native has been a staple at the weekly PBR Stockyards Showcase in Fort Worth, including winning the event on December 27 and coming in second last Thursday. He is the son of five-time PBR World Finals qualifier Cory McFadden, who had two very memorable rides against three-time PBR YETI World Champion Bull Yellow Jacket, both resulting in 95+ point scores.

NO EXPERIENCE, NO PROBLEM – Three rookies currently sit in the Top 10 of the Unleash The Beast standings, as No. 2 Cassio Dias, No. 7 Julio Cesar Marques and No. 10 Kaiden Loud have all put together a strong start to their individual premier series careers. Dias’s remarkable season has been well documented as the No. 1 rider in the standings for a month. Marques and Loud have both posted solid outings in recent weeks, breaking into the Top 10 for the first time in their respective careers.

A member of the Kansas City Outlaws in the PBR Camping World Team Series, Marques finished a career-best third in Albany last weekend before finishing seventh in Madison Square Garden last week. The Brazilian is currently four for his last seven and is set to face My Bad in Round 1 on Friday.

Loud, a protected rider for the Nashville Stampede, has already proven his resilience on the premier series early in this season. After going 1-for-2 in Tucson, Arizona, in his UTB debut, the Texan was mired in a seven-out buckoff streak but finally found his top form in Albany to end the year, going a perfect 3-for-3 and finishing second. Parlaying that into another Top 15 finish in New York last weekend, Loud is starting to show the talent that led him to be the first pick in the second round by the Stampede in the 2023 PBR Teams Draft. He is paired with God Bless America in Round 1 on Friday.

FAMILIAR WATERS – Round 1 of the 2024 PBR event in Rosemont, Illinois, will feature three rematches.

- Boudreaux Campbell takes on Skeeter Peter for the third time after the powerful bovine competitor bucked the Texan off in 4.29 seconds in Guthrie, Oklahoma, in April of 2020 and in 4.66 seconds in Nampa, Idaho, in April of 2021.
- Eli Vastbinder shares a chute with Whatever once again after being bucked off in 5.26 seconds in Tucson, Arizona, last November.
- Silvano Alves settles the score with Viper on Friday, as the animal athlete bested him in 3.58 seconds in Little Rock, Arkansas, in March of 2019 before the three-time PBR World Champion rode him for 86 points in Tulsa, Oklahoma, in October of 2020.

PAST CHICAGO EVENT WINNERS – When the PBR Unleash The Beast last bucked into the Windy City and Allstate Arena in January 2023, a rejuvenated and healthy Jose Vitor Leme dominated, going a perfect 3-for-3 to secure his second event buckle in as many performances during the 2023 campaign. After missing the first two months of the year due to injury, the two-time PBR World Champion rocketed up the standings in his return, beginning his flawless weekend in Chicago by covering Reinstatement Hank for 83.5 points. Unsatisfied with the low-eighties score, Leme then topped Knucklehead for 87 points in Round 2 before riding Cliff Hanger for 88.25 points in the championship round. Making the most of his animal athlete opponents, the Brazilian posted an incredible 7.25 rider over bull score in his three outs, catapulting him into the No. 2 spot in the standings.

WORLD CHAMPION BULL – The 2024 YETI PBR World Champion Bull will be determined by both the 2023 PBR Camping World Team Series season and the 2024 Unleash The Beast (UTB) season. The 2024 YETI World Champion Bull will be determined by their Top 8 outs during the Team Series and UTB regular season and two outs at the PBR World Finals. The Top 7 eligible bulls at the end of the PBR UTB regular season shall be entered into the World Finals and be guaranteed three outs. In the event two or more bulls are tied based on the scoring criteria after the World Finals, the World Champion Bull shall be awarded to the bull who has achieved the highest average score from their two best outs at the World Finals. If a tie still

exists after a review of the scores described in the preceding sentence, the bulls will share the title of World Champion Bull, and the prize money will be evenly distributed among the stock contractors who own said bulls.

For avoidance of doubt, if the score that is dropped from the World Finals is higher than the lowest regular season out, the score at World Finals will still be dropped. The top eight (8) regular season outs and top two (2) World Finals outs are to remain in the calculations for the World Champion Bull award.

MAJORS RETURN – The 2024 PBR Unleash The Beast season keeps the same point structure as 2023 but adds PBR Majors while removing 15/15 Bucking Battles and having two separate aggregates at the PBR World Finals. The 2024 World Champion will be the rider who earns the most points only at Unleash The Beast (UTB) events, including at the 2024 PBR World Finals on May 10-19 in the Dallas-Fort Worth Metroplex. The three PBR Majors in New York City (January 5-7, won by Austin Richardson), Sacramento, California (February 2-4), and Albuquerque, New Mexico (March 22-24), will offer increased payouts and points. There will be three PBR tours in the U.S. in action for the first half of 2024: PBR Unleash The Beast (November 10 – May 19); Pendleton Whisky Velocity Tour (Jan. 5 – May 4) and PBR Touring Pro Division (Oct. 19 – May 19). Points accumulated in non-UTB events domestically, as well as PBR’s international tours, will be tallied as Velocity Global points. Velocity Global points, which will also be used to crown the 2024 PBR Pendleton Whisky Velocity Tour Champion, will help determine the athletes who can earn a future draw spot on the elite Unleash The Beast following the tour’s first four events.

Those with the most points earned during their four most recent Velocity Global or Unleash The Beast events will join the UTB, replacing riders who had fallen to the bottom of the pack during select cuts throughout the season. Riders ranked in the No. 36-40 range in the UTB standings will be subject to being cut. During each cut, the open positions will first be filled with those riders having injury exemptions, followed by the Premier Series Qualifier List, based on Velocity Global points. Following each cut, these riders will take the place of the demoted riders in the sport’s top series to make up the 40-rider field heading into the next event. Riders ranked No. 1-35 on the UTB will remain on the PBR’s elite tour. Following the initial cut after the event in Manchester, New Hampshire, subsequent cuts will be held every two weeks. The second cut will drop the bottom six riders from UTB, the third cut will drop the bottom seven riders, and the fourth and remaining cuts will remove the bottom eight riders from UTB.

Points will be awarded as follows for the Unleash The Beast, including World Finals, as well as Tier 1 Velocity Global events:

Bonus points are awarded across all levels of PBR competition. A rider who scores 70-79.75 points will earn 7 bonus points, 80-89.75 8 bonus points and 90-99.75 9 bonus points. The exception is if a contestant declines a re-ride due to an inferior bull. In that case, he does not earn bonus points.

THIS WEEKEND’S FORMAT – Tractor Supply Co. PBR Chicago, the seventh Unleash The Beast event of the 2024 season, will feature three rounds of bull riding. Each of the 45 competing riders will get on one bull in Round 1 on Friday and Round 2 on Saturday. The 12 bull riders with the top combined ride scores following Rounds 1 and 2 will then advance to the championship round following Round 2 on Saturday.

VELOCITY TOUR, INTERNATIONAL AND TOURING PRO DIVISION POINTS – All non-Unleash The Beast (UTB) events award Velocity Global points, including Pendleton Whisky Velocity Tour events, Touring Pro Division events and events held internationally in Australia, Brazil, Canada, and Mexico. The only exception is National Finals held abroad, which will only award national points, not Velocity Global points. The point system at each event is tiered based on added money in USD, and other factors determined by the PBR. Each event, depending on the tier will get points in accordance with the tables below.

- Tier 1 Events – \$20,000 or more USD in added money.
- Tier 2 Events – \$10,000 - \$19,999 USD in added money.
- Tier 3 Events – \$9,999 USD or less in added money.

Additionally, riders at all events receive bonus points via their ride score. A rider who scores 70-79.75 points will earn 7 bonus points, 80-89.75 8 bonus points and 90-99.75 9 bonus points.
