SUNSHINE AND COWBOYS – This weekend, for the seventh time ever and the first time since 2021, PBR’s elite 2024 Unleash The Beast travels to Jacksonville, Florida, for the U.S. Border Patrol PBR Jacksonville, the thirteenth event of the 24-event 2024 individual season. VyStar Veterans Memorial Arena will host the PBR for two days of action on Friday, February 23, starting at 7:45 p.m. EST, and Saturday, February 24, starting at 6:45 p.m. EST.

DIAS ENDS MAN HATER’S STREAK IN MONSTROUS FASHION – No. 1 Cassio Dias continued his Hollywood-worthy season in La-La land last weekend, going 2-for-3 to win his fourth event of the season and extend his lead over No. 2 Austin Richardson. The rising superstar topped Hell Storm for 87.25 points in Round 1, the second-best score of the evening, but was dispatched by Ghost Face in 3.04 seconds in Round 2 on Saturday. Knowing he most likely needed a monstrous score to take over the No. 1 spot, Dias showed no fear and selected the 2024 YETI PBR World Champion Bull frontrunner, Man Hater, who hadn’t been covered before. The dynamic duo burst out of the gate in the championship round in front of a roaring Crypto.com Arena, posting a mind-boggling, 94.75-point score, the highest-marked ride since Jose Vitor Leme topped Ridin’ Solo for 94.75 points in Oklahoma City in February of 2022 and the highest ride in PBR history in California. A Top-50 ride in premier series history, Dias put a stamp on his season that seems destined to end with a gold buckle.

After sitting atop the standings for a month early in the season, Dias briefly lost his hold on the top spot to Richardson after the Texan won back-to-back titles in the Empire State at the beginning of the new year. However, Dias bounced back in Chicago, going a perfect 3-for-3 and winning his premier series-leading third event of the season. The MVP runner-up for the Kansas City Outlaws in the PBR Camping World Team Series, Dias finished tied for fourth in the first round with an 87-point ride on IHOP. Now on a roll, the Brazilian tied for second in Round 2, scoring 86.75 points on Grey Fox to earn the second pick in the championship pen. Choosing Do Dat Eddie, Dias saved his best for last, storming out of the gates for an event-high-tying 89 points to overtake Cort McFadden, who was making his PBR debut, in the event standings. After the young Texan was bucked off Polar Express in 5.26 seconds, Dias knew he was back on top in the race for a gold buckle. Currently, the Brazilian has tallied three straight Top-10 finishes and has placed inside the Top 10 in six of his last seven events. After making it clear he wants to keep his foot on the gas and is taking the season one bull at a time, the young phenom is next tasked with facing Big Worm in Round 1 on Friday.

ROOKIES STILL ROLLING – Rookies make up almost half of the Top 30 of this year’s championship race, as 12 sit in the Top 30 of the Unleash The Beast standings. Two currently sit in the Top 10 of the Unleash The Beast standings (No. 1 Cassio Dias and No. 3 John Crimber), and No. 13 Kaiden Loud and No. 37 Marco Rizzo joined them to round out the Top 4 spots in Los Angeles.

Crimber got out to an early lead inside Crypto.com Arena, as the young gun topped Badger for 87 points in Round 1 and secured the pick of the pen in the championship round by riding Show Me for 86.5 points in Round 2. Selecting Ricky Vaughn, he thundered out of the chutes and looked like he was going to finally seal his first premier series title before losing the bull rope after a heart-stopping 7.21 seconds. The rising superstar has now finished second in three of his past five events to move into third in the standings, but he is still doubled up by Dias in the gold buckle race. While he has posted just one 90-point ride this season, Crimber showed complete mastery over his first two bovine competitors in Los Angeles with a 2.5 rider over bull score. Crimber takes on Rustic Pearl in Round 1 on Friday.

Right on Crimber's spurs was Rizzo, who bounced back after being shutout in his last two events to go 2-for-3 and finish a career-best third. His second Top-10 finish of the season, the Georgian cowboy rode Ah Hell for 86 points in Round 1 and Bubba G for 84.5 points in Round 2. Despite being bucked off by Manaba in 4.48 seconds in the championship round, he netted 65 points to push him into the Top 40 in the standings.

Rounding out the Top 5 rookies was the Nashville Stampede's Kaiden Loud, who also went 2-for-3. A staple inside the Top 20 after finishing a career-best second in Albany, New York, in December, Loud has quietly crept up the standings by recording three straight Top-20 finishes, including two consecutive Top-10 performances in Los Angeles and Salt Lake City. The Texan topped Bouchon for 84 points inside Crypto.com Arena in Round 1 and then rode No Cigar for 85.75 points in Round 2. Looking for his first event title, Loud rocketed out of the gate on DirtyBru in the championship round but was unseated after 2.81 seconds. Loud rematches Air Marshall in Round 1 on Friday.

BACK IN THE SADDLE – Several notable names return to action in Jacksonville, Florida, this weekend as the elite Unleash The Beast switches coasts.

The most notable name returning is No. 9 Dalton Kasel, who was unable to defend his unofficial title as the PBR King of Cali last weekend. The Muleshoe, Texas, native is looking to rediscover his top form after making the 8 just once in his last seven outs. Before that seven-out stretch, Kasel recorded back-to-back 90-point rides in Tulsa for his second consecutive Top 5 finish. Cool under pressure and always capable of putting together monstrous streaks, the Texan looks to begin a second-half surge up the standings against Mama's Boy in Round 1 in Florida.

Rookie No. 14 Caden Bunch also returns to action in the Sunshine State. The Oklahoman and member of the Florida Freedom squad qualified for three straight championship rounds before being sidelined in Los Angeles. After breaking out of a 17-out buckoff streak, Bunch appears to have found the form that won him the first event of the season in Tucson, Arizona, covering at least one of his animal athlete opponents in his past three events. He duels Lost Pearl in Round 1.

Lucas Divino, who hasn't ridden on the top tour since going 0-for-2 in Tulsa, caught fire on the Pendleton Whisky Velocity Tour. After back-to-back Top-20 finishes in Laredo, Texas, and North Charleston, South Carolina, the Austin Gamblers veteran racked up five straight rides, winning the event in Cedar Park, Texas, and finishing second in Memphis, Tennessee, last weekend. He faces The Judge in his return to the elite tour.

While he now calls Dublin, Texas, home, Jesse Petri returns to the premier series in Florida, which he has called home for half of his life and where he began his professional career. The soft-spoken cowboy went 2-for-3 and finished third the last time the PBR stopped in Jacksonville and has gone 5-for-6 across his brief two-weekend stint on the Pendleton Whisky Velocity Tour. Petri went 2-for-3 in Cedar Park, placing seventh, before punching his ticket back to the top tour by going a perfect 3-for-3 and finishing second in Youngstown, Ohio, last weekend.

Right ahead of Petri the last time the PBR bucked into Jacksonville was Marco Eguchi, who joins the elite Unleash The Beast for the first time since riding at the 2022 PBR World Finals. The veteran cowboy was one of just two riders to go a perfect 3-for-3 in Jacksonville in 2021, finishing second to Cooper Davis. Topping six of his last nine bovine competitors en route to three-straight sixth-place finishes in Reno, Nevada, Laredo and North Charleston, the Brazilian has tallied five consecutive Top 10 finishes on the Pendleton Whisky Velocity Tour to earn his spot back on the premier series. He takes on Black Tie in Round 1 in Florida.

Dawson Branton also makes his return to the elite Unleash The Beast after a brief stint on the Pendleton Whisky Velocity Tour. The Oregonian went 5-for-6, including a 3-for-3 performance that secured him the event title in Youngstown last weekend and appears to have found the form that earned him a Top-10 finish in Tulsa in January. He tries to stay hot on Stone Cold in Round 1 on Friday.

After finishing 10th in the Unleash The Beast standings last season, including finishing third at the 30th Anniversary PBR World Finals, Ramon de Lima looks to catapult up the standings to qualify for his third-straight World Finals. One of the most consistent bull riders over the past three years, Lima has three Top-10 finishes on the Pendleton Whisky Velocity Tour this season and he has ridden six of his last nine bovine competitors. He shares a chute with Chute Boss to begin his weekend in Florida.

Finally, veteran Michael Lane rejoins the ranks of the best bull riders in the world for the first time since going 0-for-2 in Milwaukee, Wisconsin, in 2021. In an odd twist of fate, the Virginia cowboy's last premier series ride was in Jacksonville, Florida, in 2021, where he rode Super Duper for 85 points in Round 1. Lane has covered five of his last 10 animal athlete opponents and won his first event of the season in Reading, Pennsylvania, going 2-for-3, earlier this month. Now a thirty-year veteran of the sport after beginning to ride at the age of four, Lane attempts to make himself a staple on the top tour once again by taking on Risky Business in Round 1 in Jacksonville.

NOTABLES – Here are several other notable stats and storylines:

- **Don't Get it Twisted:** Dana White's Twisted Steel looms in the pen in Jacksonville for the first time since dispatching Eli Vastbinder in 3.00 seconds in Houston, Texas, in January. The powerful bovine competitor has allowed just one ride in his nine premier series outs (88.9% buckoff percentage) dating back to the beginning of the 2023 PBR Teams season and has bucked off all three riders who have faced him during the 2024 Unleash The Beast campaign. Last month in Tulsa, Twisted Steel shed Vitor Losnake in two seconds flat, the second straight out he bested the Brazilian cowboy. Set to buck in Round 2, the rank animal athlete looks unstoppable leading into his celebrity showdown with UFC Hall of Famer, Donald "Cowboy" Cerrone.

FAMILIAR WATERS – Round 1 of the 2024 PBR event in Jacksonville, Florida, will feature three rematches.

- Veteran Joao Ricardo Vieira tries to get out of the gate for the first time on Hoka Hey after the pair was unable to leave the chutes in Nashville, Tennessee, last August.
- Kaiden Loud battles Air Marshall for the second time after being bucked off in 3.27 seconds in Manchester, New Hampshire, in December.
- Lucas Divino faces The Judge for the first time since he was bucked off in Manchester, New Hampshire, in 1.91 seconds in December.

PAST JACKSONVILLE EVENT WINNERS – When the PBR was last in Jacksonville in 2021, Cooper Davis went a perfect 3-for-3 to win the event title. The 2016 World Champion began his perfect performance by topping Experiment 626 for 88.25 points and then punched his ticket to the championship round aboard Amy's Pet for 85 points in Round 2. The Texan, in search of his second-straight event win after dominating the previous weekend in Omaha, Nebraska, roared out of the gates on Mike's Motive for a monstrous 91.75 points to win his second event of the year, edging out Marco Eguchi, who also went a perfect 3-for-3. Jesse Petri rounded out the Top 3, going 2-for-3.

WORLD CHAMPION BULL RACE – The 2024 YETI PBR World Champion Bull race has been dominated by Man Hater with just a few months left in the year-long campaign. Spanning back to the 2023 PBR Camping World Team Series' season, the powerful bovine competitor had bucked off all 15 of his cowboy opponents until Cassio Dias covered him for a season-high 94.75 points in the championship round in Los Angeles to take the event title. Man Hater currently holds a 1.38-point lead over UTZ BesTex Legend in the standings. After being marked 46.25 points for his buck-off of Brady Fielder in the championship round in Tulsa, Man Hater currently boasts seven of the Top 10 bull scores this season and he has won the Bull of the Event title eight times. Putting that into perspective, the reigning back-to-back World Champion Bull, Ridin' Solo, was named the Bull of the Event just five times during the 2023 campaign. In Houston, Red Demon became the first animal athlete other than Man Hater to claim more than one Bull of the Event title this season, marked an impressive 47 points for bucking off Joao Ricardo Vieira in 2.3 seconds in the championship round, and has risen to fifth in the standings. After surrendering an 88.5-point ride to Alan de Souza in St. Louis, Missouri, Legend has put together a five-out buck-off streak to somewhat close the gap on Man Hater. A member of the 2023 PBR Stock Contractor of the Year Blake Sharp's pen, Legend has bucked off 14 of the 15 riders he has faced so far. Right behind him in the standings is Flyin Wired, who sits 1.64 points back of the leader. While he has given up two rides in his six outs, both went for 90 or more points, as Wingson Henrique da Silva covered him for 92.5

points at the PBR Teams Championship in Las Vegas while Joao Ricardo Vieira topped him for 91.75 points to win the event in Tulsa.

2024 POINTS TABLES – The 2024 PBR Unleash The Beast season keeps the same point structure as 2023 but adds PBR Majors while removing 15/15 Bucking Battles and having two separate aggregates at the PBR World Finals. The 2024 World Champion will be the rider who earns the most points only at Unleash The Beast (UTB) events, including at the 2024 PBR World Finals on May 10-19 in the Dallas-Fort Worth Metroplex. The three PBR Majors in New York City (January 5-7, won by Austin Richardson), Sacramento, California (February 2-4, won by Leonardo Castro Ferreira), and Albuquerque, New Mexico (March 22-24), offer increased payouts and points. There will be three PBR tours in the U.S. in action for the first half of 2024: PBR Unleash The Beast (November 10 – May 19); Pendleton Whisky Velocity Tour (Jan. 5 – May 4) and PBR Touring Pro Division (Oct. 19 – May 19). Points accumulated in non-UTB events domestically, as well as PBR’s international tours, will be tallied as Velocity Global points. Velocity Global points, which will also be used to crown the 2024 PBR Pendleton Whisky Velocity Tour Champion, will help determine the athletes who can earn a future draw spot on the elite Unleash The Beast following the tour’s first four events.

Those with the most points earned during their four most recent Velocity Global or Unleash The Beast events will join the UTB, replacing riders who had fallen to the bottom of the pack during select cuts throughout the season. Riders ranked in the No. 36-40 range in the UTB standings will be subject to being cut. During each cut, the open positions will first be filled with those riders having injury exemptions, followed by the Premier Series Qualifier List, based on Velocity Global points. Following each cut, these riders will take the place of the demoted riders in the sport’s top series to make up the 40-rider field heading into the next event. Riders ranked No. 1-35 on the UTB will remain on the PBR’s elite tour. Following the initial cut after the event in Manchester, New Hampshire, subsequent cuts will be held every two weeks. The second cut will drop the bottom six riders from UTB, the third cut will drop the bottom seven riders, and the fourth and remaining cuts will remove the bottom eight riders from UTB.

Points will be awarded as follows for the Unleash The Beast, including World Finals, as well as Tier 1 Velocity Global events:

Bonus points are awarded across all levels of PBR competition. A rider who scores 70-79.75 points will earn 7 bonus points, 80-89.75 8 bonus points and 90-99.75 9 bonus points. The exception is if a contestant declines a re-ride due to an inferior bull. In that case, he does not earn bonus points.

The 12 bull riders with the top combined ride scores following Rounds 1 and 2 will then advance to the championship round following Round 2 on Saturday.

Additionally, riders at all events receive bonus points via their ride score. A rider who scores 70-79.75 points will earn 7 bonus points, 80-89.75 8 bonus points and 90-99.75 9 bonus points.
