

2024 PBR Unleash The Beast PBR Milwaukee presented by Cooper Tires Fiserv Forum – Milwaukee, Wisconsin Saturday, March 9 at 6:45 p.m. CST Sunday, March 10 at 1:45 p.m. CDT

BREW CITY BUCKOFF – This weekend, for the fifth time ever and third consecutive season, PBR's elite 2024 Unleash The Beast travels to Milwaukee, Wisconsin, for the PBR Milwaukee, presented by Cooper Tires, the fifteenth event of the 24-event 2024 individual season. Fiserv Forum will host the PBR for two days of action on Saturday, March 9, starting at 6:45 p.m. CST, and Sunday, March 10, starting at 1:45 p.m. CDT.

KASEL VICTORIOUS IN INDIANAPOLIS – No. 4 Dalton Kasel stayed red-hot in Indianapolis last weekend, going a perfect 3-for-3 for the second consecutive weekend to take home the event buckle and move to 341.33 points behind No. 1 Cassio Dias. He began his flawless performance by covering Dream Walkin for 86.25 points, tying him for third entering championship Saturday. Looking completely locked in, the Texan roared out of the chutes on Unhinged in Round 2 for 86.25 points, earning the pick of the pen heading into the final round. There, the Austin Gamblers' star on the separate PBR Camping World Team Series sealed the event victory by riding I'm Legit Too for 88.25 points. It is the second consecutive season that Kasel has entered Milwaukee coming off a victory, as his last event win was in Little Rock, Arkansas, last March the weekend before the PBR headed to Brew City.

Prior to Indy, the Texan began his hot streak in Jacksonville, Florida, where he also went a perfect 3-for-3 and finished second. Recording his third Top 5 finish of the season after being shut out in Salt Lake City and missing the event in Los Angeles due to injury, Kasel showed no rust by riding Mama's Boy for 87 points in the opening round. Starting to find his groove, the Texan then topped Don't Come Easy for 84.25 points in Round 2 and UTZ BesTex Smokestack for 89.5 points in the championship round to net second place and rise to No. 4 in the standings. Mr.-90-point is currently 16-for-33 (48%) on the season and has been a staple inside the Top 20 of the Unleash the Beast standings since starting the season with three straight Top 20 outings, and he hasn't been ranked outside the Top 10 since placing second at the UTB major in New York City in January. Kasel shares a chute with Gucci in Round 1 on Saturday.

DIAS MAINTAINS NO. 1 RANKING – While John Crimber may have closed the gap for the second consecutive weekend, No. 1 Cassio Dias still holds a commanding lead in the gold buckle race after being shut out in Indianapolis. It is just the third time this season Dias has been kept off the leaderboard, as he was blanked in both Manchester, New Hampshire, and Houston, Texas. In Los Angeles, the Brazilian cowboy had extended his lead, going 2-for-3 to win his fourth event of the season. The rising superstar topped Hell Storm for 87.25 points in Round 1, the second-best score of the evening, but was dispatched by Ghost Face in 3.04 seconds in Round 2 on Saturday. Knowing he most likely needed a monstrous score to take over the No. 1 spot, Dias showed no fear and selected the 2024 YETI PBR World Champion Bull frontrunner, Man Hater, who hadn't been covered before. The dynamic duo burst out of the gate in the championship round in front of a roaring Crypto.com Arena, posting a mind-boggling, 94.75-point score, the highest-marked ride since Jose Vitor Leme topped Ridin' Solo for 94.75 points in Oklahoma City in February of 2022 and the highest ride in PBR history in California. With the Top-50 ride in premier series history, Dias put a stamp on his season that could end with a gold buckle.

After sitting atop the standings for a month early in the season, Dias briefly lost his hold on the top spot to Austin Richardson after the Texan won back-to-back titles in the Empire State at the beginning of the new year. However, Dias bounced back in Chicago, going a perfect 3-for-3 and winning his premier series-leading third event of the season. The MVP runner-up for the Kansas City Outlaws in the PBR Camping World Team Series, Dias finished tied for fourth in the first round with an 87-point ride on IHOP. Now on a roll, the Brazilian tied for second in Round 2, scoring 86.75 points on Grey Fox to earn the second pick in the championship pen. Choosing Do Dat Eddie, Dias saved his best for last, storming out of the gates for an event-high-tying

89 points to overtake Cort McFadden, who was making his PBR debut, in the event standings. After the young Texan was bucked off Polar Express in 5.26 seconds, Dias knew he was back on top in the race for a gold buckle. Despite missing the championship round in Jacksonville, the young gun's 10 championship round outs lead the field by a wide margin, as the next-highest rider has just seven round outs. Dias looks to return to form in Milwaukee this weekend, taking on Wicked Warrior in Round 1 on Saturday.

MAKIN' THE 8 – Veterans and rookies alike have been putting on a show for bull riding fans across the past two events, proving they are the best in the world. Riders are currently 465-for-1,358 (34.24%) at just past the halfway point in the season, just a hair down from the 470-for-1335 (35.21%) mark at the same point last season. However, bull riding's best have started to find their groove of late, posting back-to-back weekends with a better than 40% riding percentage for the first time this season, something that only happened twice in 2023.

The major difference between this season and last is the first-half performance of the rookies. In 2023, no rookie was ranked inside the Top 5 of the Unleash The Beast standings, while in 2024, both of the top spots are held by first-year riders, and No. 10 Julio Cesar Marques adds a third rookie inside the Top 10. In addition, seven different riders have won their first premier series event this season, and 24 different riders have won at least one round. 13 different riders have also recorded at least one 90-point ride and 54 different riders have competed in a championship round.

NOTABLES - Here are several other notable stats and storylines:

- <u>Aparecido, Marques Perfect in Indy:</u> In addition to Dalton Kasel, both No. 5 Eduardo Aparecido and No. 10 Julio Cesar Marques went a perfect 3-for-3 in Indianapolis. In thirteen premier series events this season, Aparecido has been shut out just twice (Salt Lake City, Utah, and Jacksonville, Florida), and his second-place finish in Indy marks his fourth inside the Top 10. The Brazilian also recorded the only 90-point ride of the weekend, covering Mike's Motive for 90 points in the championship round to briefly take the event lead. Right on his spurs in the event standings was Marques, who has now recorded at least one ride in five consecutive events. In that stretch, the rookie is 7-for-13 (53.8%). Aparecido takes on Sky Walker in Round 1, while Marques battles Mike's Motive.
- <u>Tough as Nails</u>: A fourth rider was also perfect in Indianapolis, as No. 7 Alan de Souza went 2-for-2 last weekend. While it appeared the Brazilian would have the opportunity to ride for his first event buckle of the season in Indy, he was thrown hard to the dirt after covering Fat Randy for 83.5 points in Round 2 and was unable to continue in the championship round. Proving his mettle, the resilient cowboy has bounced back, as he is slated to face 2 Words in Round 1 on Saturday.

FAMILIAR WATERS - Round 1 of the 2024 PBR event in Milwaukee, Wisconsin, will feature four rematches.

- Daylon Swearingen faces Sneaky Situation in a trilogy bout after the animal athlete bucked off the 2022 PBR World Champion in 3.82 seconds in St. Michael, North Dakota, in July of 2022 and in Salt Lake City, Utah, in 2.47 seconds earlier this year in February.
- Eduardo Aparecido takes on Sky Walker for the second time after covering him for 89.25 points in Oklahoma City, Oklahoma, in September of last year.
- Hunter Ball shares a chute with Mr. Excavator once again. The powerful bovine competitor bucked him off in 3.22 seconds in the pair's first outing in Shipshewana, Indiana, in July of 2023.
- Wingson Henrique da Silva has bucked off Salty Brindle in both previous matchups, lasting 6.89 seconds in Indianapolis in January of 2023 and 5.13 seconds last December in Johnstown, Pennsylvania.

PAST MILWAUKEE EVENT WINNERS – After Joao Ricardo Vieira denied him the back-to-back Milwaukee event win in 2022, Kaique Pacheco bounced back and won in the Brew City for the second time in 2023. The only rider to go a perfect 3-for-3, the Ice Man roared out to an early lead, winning the opening round courtesy of an 89-point ride on Alter Ego. Now in a groove, Pacheco hung on to Midnight Flyer for 81 points in Round 2 before bringing Fiserv Forum to an

uproar with another 89-point ride, this time aboard Moonlight Party, in the championship round. The victory propelled Pacheco from No. 3 to No. 2 in the Unleash The Beast standings, bringing him within 71.5 points of the No. 1 spot

Previously, the PBR's premier series has traveled to Milwaukee thrice, visiting Brew City in 2011, 2018 and 2022. Prior to Joao Ricardo Vieira's perfect 3-for-3 performance in 2022, Pacheco again went a perfect 3-for-3 to win the event en route to capturing his career-first PBR World Championship at season's end in 2018. After covering Get Smoked for 86.25 points in Round 1 and Magic Mike for 85.75 points in Round 2, Pacheco clinched the victory when he rode Canadian-born Stunt Man Ray for a monstrous 91 points in the championship round. The event win was Pacheco's fifth of the season, while the 90-point score was his third. For Pacheco, the win marked the third time in 2018 that he went from being shut out during a tour stop to winning the very next weekend.

WORLD CHAMPION BULL RACE - The 2024 YETI PBR World Champion Bull race has been dominated by Man Hater with just a few months left in the year-long campaign. Spanning back to the 2023 PBR Camping World Team Series' season, the powerful bovine competitor had bucked off all 15 of his cowboy opponents until Cassio Dias covered him for a season-high 94.75 points in the championship round in Los Angeles to take the event title. Man Hater currently holds a 1.38-point lead over UTZ BesTex Legend in the standings. After being marked 46.25 points for his buck-off of Brady Fielder in the championship round in Tulsa, Man Hater currently boasts seven of the Top 10 bull scores this season and he has won the Bull of the Event title eight times. Putting that into perspective, the reigning back-to-back World Champion Bull, Ridin' Solo, was named the Bull of the Event just five times during the 2023 campaign. In Houston, Red Demon became the first animal athlete other than Man Hater to claim more than one Bull of the Event title this season, marked an impressive 47 points for bucking off Joao Ricardo Vieira in 2.3 seconds in the championship round, and has risen to fourth in the standings. After surrendering an 88.5point ride to Alan de Souza in St. Louis, Missouri, Legend has put together a five-out buck-off streak to somewhat close the gap on Man Hater. A member of the 2023 PBR Stock Contractor of the Year Blake Sharp's pen, Legend has bucked off 14 of the 15 riders he has faced so far. Right behind him in the standings is Flyin Wired, who sits 1.64 points back of the leader. While he has given up two rides in his six outs, both went for 90 or more points, as Wingson Henrique da Silva covered him for 92.5 points at the PBR Teams Championship in Las Vegas while Joao Ricardo Vieira topped him for 91.75 points to win the event in Tulsa.

2024 POINTS TABLES – The 2024 PBR Unleash The Beast season keeps the same point structure as 2023 but adds PBR Majors while removing 15/15 Bucking Battles and having two separate aggregates at the PBR World Finals. The 2024 World Champion will be the rider who earns the most points only at Unleash The Beast (UTB) events, including at the 2024 PBR World Finals on May 10-19 in the Dallas-Fort Worth Metroplex. The three PBR Majors in New York City (January 5-7, won by Austin Richardson), Sacramento, California (February 2-4, won by Leonardo Castro Ferreira), and Albuquerque, New Mexico (March 22-24), offer increased payouts and points. There will be three PBR tours in the U.S. in action for the first half of 2024: PBR Unleash The Beast (November 10 - May 19); Pendleton Whisky Velocity Tour (Jan. 5 - May 4) and PBR Touring Pro Division (Oct. 19 - May 19). Points accumulated in non-UTB events domestically, as well as PBR's international tours, will be tallied as Velocity Global points. Velocity Global points, which will also be used to crown the 2024 PBR Pendleton Whisky Velocity Tour Champion, will help determine the athletes who can earn a future draw spot on the elite Unleash The Beast following the tour's first four events.

Those with the most points earned during their four most recent Velocity Global or Unleash The Beast events will join the UTB, replacing riders who had fallen to the bottom of the pack during select cuts throughout the season. Riders ranked in the No. 36-40 range in the UTB standings will be subject to being cut. During each cut, the open positions will first be filled with those riders having injury exemptions, followed by the Premier Series Qualifier List, based on Velocity Global points. Following each cut, these riders will take the place of the demoted riders in the sport's top series to make up the 40-rider field heading into the next event. Riders ranked No. 1-35 on the UTB will remain on the PBR's elite tour. Following the initial cut after the event in Manchester, New Hampshire, subsequent cuts will be held every two weeks. The second cut will drop the bottom six riders from UTB, the third cut will drop the bottom seven riders, and the fourth and remaining cuts will remove the bottom eight riders from UTB.

Points will be awarded as follows for the Unleash The Beast, including World Finals, as well as Tier 1 Velocity Global events:

Bonus points are awarded across all levels of PBR competition. A rider who scores 70-79.75 points will earn 7 bonus points, 80-89.75 8 bonus points and 90-99.75 9 bonus points. The exception is if a contestant declines a re-ride due to an inferior bull. In that case, he does not earn bonus points.

THIS WEEKEND'S FORMAT – PBR Milwaukee, presented by Cooper Tires, the fifteenth Unleash The Beast event of the 2024 season, will feature three rounds of bull riding. Each of the 37 competing riders will get on one bull in Round 1 on Saturday and Round 2 on Sunday. The 12 bull riders with the top combined ride scores following Rounds 1 and 2 will then advance to the championship round following Round 2 on Sunday.

NEXT UP – The PBR Unleash The Beast next travels to Simmons Bank Arena in North Little Rock, Arkansas, for PBR Little Rock. The event is on Friday, March 15, at 7:45 p.m. CDT, and Saturday, March 16, at 6:45 p.m. CDT.

VELOCITY TOUR, INTERNATIONAL AND TOURING PRO DIVISION POINTS – All non-Unleash The Beast (UTB) events award Velocity Global points, including Pendleton Whisky Velocity Tour events, Touring Pro Division events and events held internationally in Australia, Brazil, Canada, and Mexico. The only exception is National Finals held abroad, which will only award national points, not Velocity Global points. The point system at each event is tiered based on added money in USD, and other factors determined by the PBR. Each event, depending on the tier will get points in accordance with the tables below.

- Tier 1 Events \$20,000 or more USD in added money.
- Tier 2 Events \$10,000 \$19,999 USD in added money.
- Tier 3 Events \$9,999 USD or less in added money.

Additionally, riders at all events receive bonus points via their ride score. A rider who scores 70-79.75 points will earn 7 bonus points, 80-89.75 8 bonus points and 90-99.75 9 bonus points.
