



## 2024 PBR Unleash The Beast PBR Wrangler Long Live Cowboys Classic Golden 1 Center – Sacramento, California Friday, February 2 at 7:45 p.m. PST Saturday, February 3 at 6:45 p.m. PST Sunday, February 4 at 1:45 p.m. PST

**CALIFORNIA BUCKIN’** – This weekend, for the 21<sup>st</sup> time ever, PBR’s elite 2024 Unleash The Beast travels to Sacramento, California, for the PBR Wrangler Long Live Cowboys Classic, the tenth event of the 24-event 2024 individual season and second of three majors. The Big Tomato will host the PBR for three days of action on Friday, February 2, starting at 7:45 p.m. PST; Saturday, February 3, starting at 6:45 p.m. PST; and Sunday, February 4, starting at 1:45 p.m. PST.

**WINGSON SOARS INTO THE TOP 10** – After having his back against the cut line heading into Tulsa, Oklahoma, Wingson Henrique da Silva has caught fire – riding seven of his last ten UTB bulls including the last six in a row – to break into the Top 10 for the first time this season. The 2023 Rookie of the Year runner-up won his first individual premier series event in Houston last weekend, going a perfect 3-for-3, to continue his six-for-six tear. He began his flawless performance in Texas by covering Bison for 78.25 points in Round 1 and Mighty Mike for 85.25 points in Round 2. Saving his best out for last, the Brazilian rocketed out of the gates on I’m Legit Too in the championship round and converted for 90 points by virtue of being marked three points above the bull. After the dust had settled, Silva was the only rider to post a perfect weekend, and his victory netted him 112 points in the Unleash The Beast standings to propel him to the No. 9 spot in the standings.

A teammate of No. 1 Cassio Dias on the Kansas City Outlaws in the separate PBR Camping World Team Series, Silva made a statement by placing second at the PBR World Finals in Fort Worth, Texas, last year. Proving his success was no fluke, the Brazilian cowboy then placed inside the Top 10 of the 2024 PBR Teams MVP race, going 11-for-20 throughout the regular season. Again showing he has what it takes to perform under pressure, Silva converted for 92.5 points aboard Flyin Wired in the second last-chance game in Las Vegas during the PBR Teams Championship, but Kansas City was unable to overcome the upstart Missouri Thunder. Despite a slow start to his individual campaign in 2024, Silva is starting to find his groove as the race for the gold buckle enters February. He attempts to make the 8 for the seventh straight out aboard Bruisin’ in Round 1 on Friday.

**GUITON’S GREAT START** – Amid the John Crimber hoopla, let’s not forget another blazing teenage talent. After being shut out in his Unleash The Beast debut in Chicago, Clay Guiton bounced back in a big way in Tulsa in January, posting two 90-point rides. He’s now 4-for-8 at the UTB. Despite bucking off Triple Aught in 2.17 seconds in Round 1, the North Carolinian battled back, topping Punchy Pete (only the second rider to do so) for 90 seconds in Round 2 to earn a spot in his first championship round. Seemingly unfazed at facing the world’s rankest bulls, Guiton rocketed out of the gate and topped Bandito Bug for 90.25 points, pushing him to fifth in the event. Guiton’s ability away from his hand is special, being marked 3.25 points above Bandito Bug from Blake Sharp and partners during the championship round in Tulsa. He carried his success over to Houston, going 2-for-3 and finishing third. Topping Washita Red for 86.5 points in Round 1 and Renegade for 82.5 points in Round 2, he earned the pick of the pen heading into the championship round. Selecting UTZ BesTex Smokestack as his final animal athlete opponent, the young cowboy catapulted out of the chutes but was bucked off in a heart-breaking 7.44 seconds. Guiton, now successful in four of his last six, looks to stay hot on No Cigar in Round 1 Friday.

**THE RETURN OF THE KASEL** – As the PBR’s Unleash The Beast heads to California for the first of two events in Golden State this season, nobody should be more excited than No. 5 Dalton Kasel. In the Texan’s 19 premier series outs in California, he has posted a remarkable 15 rides (68.18%). While he was shut out in Sacramento last season during the regular rounds, he won the separate 15/15 Bucking Battle by topping Chiseled for 88.25 points. He then bounced back in Los Angeles

later that February, netting his fifth 90-point ride in California aboard WSM's Time In A Bottle in Round 1 and winning the event, finishing 2-for-3. With the Austin Gamblers during the 2024 PBR Camping World Team Series season, Kasel continued to roll on the West Coast, going 1-for-2 in Anaheim in August. While he was shut out in Houston last weekend, the Texan has started to round into form as the season progresses, as he put together his best performances of the year in New York and Tulsa, going a combined 5-for-7 and finishing second and fourth, respectively, in the event standings. Living up to his nickname, the Muleshoe, Texas, product is second on tour this season with three 90-point premier series rides and looks to add to his total atop Time Bomb in Round 1 on Friday.

**DIAS MAINTAINS LEAD ATOP THE STANDINGS** – Despite being shut out in Houston last weekend, No. 1 Cassio Dias maintained his hold on the top spot in the standings with No. 2 Austin Richardson out due to injury. Dias went 2-for-3 and finished sixth the previous weekend in Tulsa to extend his lead. The Brazilian cowboy covered Lansky for 87.75 points in Round 1 at BOK Center but was bucked off by Norse God in 4.43 seconds in Round 2. Showing the resilience that has helped propel him to the No. 1 spot, Dias bounced back in the championship round with his premier series-leading fourth 90-point ride, posting 90.75 points on the back-to-back reigning World Champion Bull, Ridin' Solo.

After sitting atop the standings for a month, Dias briefly lost his hold on the top spot to Richardson after the Texan won back-to-back titles in the Empire State at the beginning of the new year. However, Dias bounced back in Chicago, going a perfect 3-for-3 and winning his premier series-leading third event of the season. The MVP runner-up for the Kansas City Outlaws in the Camping World Teams Series, Dias finished tied for fourth in the first round with an 87-point ride on IHOP. Now on a roll, the Brazilian tied for second in Round 2, scoring 86.75 points on Grey Fox to earn the second pick in the championship pen heading into the final round. Choosing Do Dat Eddie, Dias saved his best for last, storming out of the gates for an event-high-tying 89 points to overtake Cort McFadden, who was making his PBR debut, in the event standings. After the young Texan was bucked off Polar Express in 5.26 seconds, Dias knew he was back on top in the race for a gold buckle. The phenomenal young rookie looks to bounce back in Sacramento, California, on Red Smoke in Round 1 on Friday.

**ROOKIES STILL ROLLING** – Rookies continued to shine in the early race for a gold buckle, as six sit in the Top 20 of the Unleash The Beast standings: No. 1 Dias, No. 11 Julio Cesar Marques, No. 13 Felipe Furlan, No. 15 Kaiden Loud, No. 16 Caden Bunch and No. 17 John Crimber. Four rookies also finished inside the Top 10 in Houston last weekend, as the aforementioned Guiton, Furlan, Bunch and Marco Rizzo all had strong outings.

Furlan was the second rookie to finish inside the Top 10, as he tied for a Round 1 win by riding Joker's Alibi for 88.5 points in Round 1. His ride snapped a six-out buck-off streak and garnered him a crucial 40 points in the standings. The Brazilian is now 8-for-20 on the young season, and he faces off against Big Twist in Round 1 in Sacramento.

The final rookie to finish inside the Top 10 was Caden Bunch, who finished 1-for-3. The Oklahoman started his rookie campaign by winning the season opener in Tucson, Arizona, but then toiled through a 17-out buck-off streak before finally breaking through in Houston aboard Don't Come Easy for 86.75 points. The ninth-place finish earned him 18.3 points in the standings and pushed him to No. 16.

In his UTB debut, Marco Rizzo, the No. 1 ranked rider in the Pendleton Whisky Velocity Tour standings, was the last rookie to finish inside the Top 10, tying Bunch. The Georgian cowboy showed no nerves in his first out, sitting tall atop Wall Street Train for 86.75 in Round 1. In search of his first premier series event win, he thundered out of the gate aboard Risky Business in Round 2 but was unseated after 3.87 seconds. He shares a chute with Sharp Shooter in Round 1.

**NOTABLES** – Here are several other notable stats and storylines:

- **Cody Can:** After finishing fifth in front of his home state Arizona fans in Tucson, Cody Jesus has been a constant presence inside the Top 10 of the UTB standings. Jesus went 2-for-3 and finished second in Houston last weekend, topping Flatliner for 88.5 points in Round 1 and winning the championship round with a monstrous 91.25-point dance on Chateau Montelena's Montana Jacket. He is now 9-for-20 on the young season and he is tied for third among all premier series riders with two 90-point rides.
- **Tetz Returns:** Nick Tetz returns to the chutes for the first time since suffering a setback in Albany, New York, in December in his first out of the season. He has a favorable matchup in Round 1 in Sacramento, as he takes on Happy Hour who has been ridden in each of his last five premier series outs. The Canadian cowboy went 10-for-25 with the

Arizona Ridge Riders on the PBR Camping World Team Series, leading the team in MVP points (883), 90-point rides (1) and riding percentage (40%).

**FAMILIAR WATERS** – Round 1 of the 2024 PBR event in Sacramento, California, will feature four rematches.

- Bob Mitchell was unseated by Off Campus in Glendale, Arizona, in 2.47 seconds in October of 2022.
- Boudreaux Campbell was bucked off by Oilfield Outlaw's Yellow Feather in 4.74 seconds in Nashville, Tennessee, in August of 2021.
- Brady Fielder takes on Pearl's Ghost for the second time after he was unseated in 4.77 seconds in Anaheim, California, in August of 2022.
- Koltin Hevalow duels Night Hawk once again after he was bucked off in 2.39 seconds at the PBR World Finals in Fort Worth, Texas, in May of 2023.

**PAST SACRAMENTO EVENT WINNERS** – For the second consecutive year, four riders posted flawless weekends in Sacramento in 2023, topped by Jose Vitor Leme's 3-for-3 masterclass. Ranked No. 2 in the standings entering February, the two-time PBR World Champion rocketed out of the chutes on Havoc in Round 1 for 85.5 points. He then followed that up by covering Lil Hott for 89.5 points in Round 2, putting him in third entering the championship round. Leme selected The Right Stuff and the powerful bovine competitor delivered on his moniker, as the pair danced in perfect time for 87.5 points to take the event lead. After Jesse Petri and Tyler Manor were bucked off, Leme won his third event of the 2023 season and catapulted to the top of the Unleash The Beast standings. In addition to Leme, Keyshawn Whitehorse, Cooper Davis and Ramon de Lima had perfect performances.

In 2022, Mauricio Gulla Moreira barely eked out a victory over 2021 winner Dalton Kasel. Moreira started with an impressive 89.25-point cover of Cold Shot in Round 1 before delivering equally sound performances on Delbert Sr. (87.5 points) in Round 2 and Redginator (88.25 points) in Round 3. With multiple riders striving for the first-place finish, Moreira put on his best performance of the weekend in the championship round, dancing with WSM's Jive Turkey to a tune of 91.75 points, pushing him just .75 points over Dalton Kasel. Luciano De Castro and Eli Vastbinder also went perfect on the weekend.

**WORLD CHAMPION BULL RACE** – The 2024 YETI PBR World Champion Bull race has been dominated by Man Hater with just a few months left in the year-long campaign. Spanning back to the 2023 PBR Camping World Team Series' season, the powerful bovine competitor has bucked off all 15 of his cowboy opponents and he currently holds a 1.35-point lead over UTZ BesTex Legend in the standings. After being marked 46.25 points for his buck-off of Brady Fielder in the championship round in Tulsa, Man Hater currently boasts seven of the Top 10 bull scores this season and he has won the Bull of the Event title seven times. Putting that into perspective, the reigning back-to-back World Champion Bull, Ridin' Solo, was named the Bull of the Event just five times during the 2023 campaign. Last week in Houston, Red Demon became the first animal athlete other than Man Hater to claim more than one Bull of the Event title this season, marked an impressive 47 points for bucking off Joao Ricardo Vieira in 2.3 seconds in the championship round to rise to sixth in the standings. After surrendering an 88.5-point ride to Alan de Souza in St. Louis, Missouri, Legend has put together a five-out buck-off streak to somewhat close the gap on Man Hater. A member of the 2023 PBR Stock Contractor of the Year Blake Sharp's pen, Legend has bucked off 14 of the 15 riders he has faced so far. Right behind him in the standings is Flyin Wired, who sits 1.61 points back of the leader. While he has given up two rides in his six outs, both went for 90 or more points, as Wingson Henrique da Silva covered him for 92.5 points at the PBR Teams Championship in Las Vegas while Joao Ricardo Vieira topped him for 91.75 points to win the event in Tulsa.

**2024 POINTS TABLES** – The 2024 PBR Unleash The Beast season keeps the same point structure as 2023 but adds PBR Majors while removing 15/15 Bucking Battles and having two separate aggregates at the PBR World Finals. The 2024 World Champion will be the rider who earns the most points only at Unleash The Beast (UTB) events, including at the 2024 PBR World Finals on May 10-19 in the Dallas-Fort Worth Metroplex. The three PBR Majors in New York City (January 5-7, won by Austin Richardson), Sacramento, California (February 2-4), and Albuquerque, New Mexico (March 22-24), will offer increased payouts and points. There will be three PBR tours in the U.S. in action for the first half of 2024: PBR Unleash The Beast (November 10 – May 19); Pendleton Whisky Velocity Tour (Jan. 5 – May 4) and PBR Touring Pro Division (Oct. 19 – May 19). Points accumulated in non-UTB events domestically, as well as PBR’s international tours, will be tallied as Velocity Global points. Velocity Global points, which will also be used to crown the 2024 PBR Pendleton Whisky Velocity Tour Champion, will help determine the athletes who can earn a future draw spot on the elite Unleash The Beast following the tour’s first four events.

Those with the most points earned during their four most recent Velocity Global or Unleash The Beast events will join the UTB, replacing riders who had fallen to the bottom of the pack during select cuts throughout the season. Riders ranked in the No. 36-40 range in the UTB standings will be subject to being cut. During each cut, the open positions will first be filled with those riders having injury exemptions, followed by the Premier Series Qualifier List, based on Velocity Global points. Following each cut, these riders will take the place of the demoted riders in the sport’s top series to make up the 40-rider field heading into the next event. Riders ranked No. 1-35 on the UTB will remain on the PBR’s elite tour. Following the initial cut after the event in Manchester, New Hampshire, subsequent cuts will be held every two weeks. The second cut will drop the bottom six riders from UTB, the third cut will drop the bottom seven riders, and the fourth and remaining cuts will remove the bottom eight riders from UTB.

Points will be awarded as follows for the Unleash The Beast, including World Finals, as well as Tier 1 Velocity Global events:

Bonus points are awarded across all levels of PBR competition. A rider who scores 70-79.75 points will earn 7 bonus points, 80-89.75 8 bonus points and 90-99.75 9 bonus points. The exception is if a contestant declines a re-ride due to an inferior bull. In that case, he does not earn bonus points.

**THIS WEEKEND'S FORMAT** – PBR Wranglers Long Live Cowboys Classic, the tenth Unleash The Beast event of the 2024 season and second of three majors, will feature four rounds of bull riding. Each of the 40 competing riders will get on one bull in Round 1 on Friday and Round 2 on Saturday. Every contestant who has a qualified ride in the first two rounds will be eligible to compete in Round 3 on Sunday. If there are fewer than 30 riders with a qualified ride after two rounds, Round 3 will fill the remaining spots to get to the 30-man minimum based on the UTB Standings entering the event. The 12 bull riders with the top combined ride scores following Rounds 1, 2, and 3 will then advance to the championship round following Round 3 on Sunday.

**NEXT UP** – The PBR Unleash The Beast next travels to Delta Center in Salt Lake City, Utah, for PBR Salt Lake City. The event is on Friday, February 9, at 7:45 p.m. MST, and Saturday, February 10, at 6:45 p.m. MST.

**VELOCITY TOUR, INTERNATIONAL AND TOURING PRO DIVISION POINTS** – All non-Unleash The Beast (UTB) events award Velocity Global points, including Pendleton Whisky Velocity Tour events, Touring Pro Division events and events held internationally in Australia, Brazil, Canada, and Mexico. The only exception is National Finals held abroad, which will only award national points, not Velocity Global points. The point system at each event is tiered based on added money in USD, and other factors determined by the PBR. Each event, depending on the tier will get points in accordance with the tables below.

- Tier 1 Events – \$20,000 or more USD in added money.
- Tier 2 Events – \$10,000 - \$19,999 USD in added money.
- Tier 3 Events – \$9,999 USD or less in added money.

Additionally, riders at all events receive bonus points via their ride score. A rider who scores 70-79.75 points will earn 7 bonus points, 80-89.75 8 bonus points and 90-99.75 9 bonus points.
