LIGHTS, CAMERA, CHUTE – This weekend, for the fifth time ever and the third consecutive season, PBR’s elite 2024 Unleash The Beast travels to Los Angeles, California, for the Michelob ULTRA PBR Los Angeles, presented by Ariat, the twelfth event of the 24-event 2024 individual season. Crypto.com Arena will host the PBR for two days of action on Friday, February 16, starting at 7:45 p.m. PST, and Saturday, February 17, starting at 6:45 p.m. PST.

HEVALOW EARNS FIRST CAREER PREMIER SERIES TITLE – Koltin Hevalow joined his home state Kansas City Chiefs in the winning column last weekend, going 2-for-3 to win his first Unleash The Beast event title in Salt Lake City, Utah. The Smithville, Missouri, native began his weekend by covering Taz for 85.5 points in the opening round before earning his pick of the pen in the championship round by topping Baldy for 85.25 points. Despite bucking off Chateau Montelena’s Montana Jacket, Hevalow, a rider for the Kansas City Outlaws on the separate PBR Camping World Team Series, had done enough to secure the victory. The golden finish rocketed him 106 points up the standings to No. 3, his highest-ever ranking. The Missourian is the sixth different rider to win their first Unleash The Beast event this season, joining Caden Bunch, Cassio Dias, Brady Fielder, Wingson Henrique da Silva and Leonardo Castro. The young cowboy looks to repeat his success in Los Angeles, taking on Big Twist in Round 1 on Friday, who has never been covered by a left-handed rider.

Hevalow wasn't the only Outlaw who found success in Salt Lake City, however, as Utahn Kyler Oliver also went 2-for-3 and finished fourth in front of his home state fans. Julio Cesar Marques also tied for fifth place with a 1-for-3 performance. Oliver began his weekend by riding High Plains Drifter for 83 points in Round 1 before hanging onto Cocky for 80.75 points in Round 2. Marques tied with three other riders for his second-round win of the season in the opening round, topping Devil’s Revenge for 88.25 points. Marques squares off against Fort Knox in Round 1 on Friday, while Oliver battles Taz.

DIAS INCREASES LEAD ATOP THE STANDINGS – Following his 2-for-4 performance in Sacramento with his eighth Top 10 finish, Dias once again distanced himself from the rest of the field in the Unleash The Beast standings in Salt Lake City last weekend. Rebounding after being bucked off by Badger in the opening round, the No. 1 ranked Dias stormed out of the gates on Black Tie for 87 points to punch his ticket to the championship round. While he was denied a fourth event title after being bested by Snake Eyes in a thrilling 3.45 seconds, the ninth-place finish was enough to increase his lead with Austin Richardson out due to injury.

After sitting atop the standings for a month, Dias briefly lost his hold on the top spot to Richardson after the Texan won back-to-back titles in the Empire State at the beginning of the new year. However, Dias bounced back in Chicago, going a perfect 3-for-3 and winning his premier series-leading third event of the season. The MVP runner-up for the Kansas City Outlaws in the Camping World Team Series, Dias finished tied for fourth in the first round with an 87-point ride on IHOP. Now on a roll, the Brazilian tied for second in Round 2, scoring 86.75 points on Grey Fox to earn the second pick in the championship pen heading into the final round. Choosing Do Dat Eddie, Dias saved his best for last, storming out of the gates for an event-high-tying 89 points to overtake Cort McFadden, who was making his PBR debut, in the event standings. After the young Texan was bucked off Polar Express in 5.26 seconds, Dias knew he was back on top in the race for a gold buckle. The phenomenal young rookie hopes to keep rolling aboard Hell Storm in Round 1 in Los Angeles.

ROOKIES STILL ROLLING – Rookies make up almost half of the Top 30 of this year’s championship race, as 13 sit in the Top 30 of the Unleash The Beast standings. Three currently sit in the Top 10 of the Unleash The Beast standings (No. 1 Cassio Dias, No. 5 John Crimber and No. 10 Leonardo Castro), and five finished inside the Top 10 in Salt Lake City.

The best rookie performance last weekend was from Cort McFadden. A member of the Austin Gamblers, McFadden topped Desperado for 83 points in the opening round before remaining perfect heading into the championship round aboard Pearl’s Ghost for 85.25 points. In search of his first premier series event buckle, the young Texan roared out of the chutes on Manaba but was dismounted after 4.16 seconds. His 2-for-3 performance netted him a career-best third-place finish and 57 points, pushing him inside the Top 20 of the standings. McFadden shares a chute with Whack Attack in Round 1 Friday evening.

Julio Cesar Marques moved to 9-for-29 on the season in Utah with his aforementioned 1-for-3 performance. Currently ranked No. 15, the Brazilian has been one of the most consistent rookies on tour this season, recording four Top 5 finishes. Fellow rookie Clay Guiton was one of the riders who matched Marques in the opening round, covering Blackstone for 88.25 points. Since being shut out in his Unleash The Beast debut, the North Carolina cowboy has skyrocketed up to No. 20 in the standings, going an impressive 7-for-13. Guiton is paired with the aptly named West Coast in Crypto.com Arena for Round 1.

Barely besting Dias’s ninth-place finish was Kaiden Loud, who also went 1-for-3. Proving his resilience, the Nashville Stampede’s Loud bounced back after bucking off Big Worm in 2.94 seconds in Round 1 to top Lapua for 87.5 points in Round 2. His eighth-place performance in Salt Lake City was the young Texan’s second-best on the season and the third time in his past four events he has broken into the Top 20. Loud takes on Bouchon in Los Angeles Friday night.

NOTABLES – Here are several other notable stats and storylines:

- **Leme Finding His Groove:** After missing a majority of the Unleash The Beast season with a lower body injury, two-time PBR World Champion Jose Vitor Leme went 1-for-2 and finished 11th in Salt Lake City last weekend. The Brazilian legend was bucked off in just 1.91 seconds by DirtyBru in Round 1 but managed to make the 8 for 86.5 points on Pam’s Dream in Round 2. Leme looks to continue to gain steam and make a run at a third gold buckle aboard Hoof Stock Genetics Mud Train in Round 1 in Los Angeles.
- **Bulls Smelled Salt:** For the first time since the event in Sioux Falls last season, the ranked bulls in the world posted a shutout in the short round in Salt Lake City. With the return of Man Hater in Los Angeles this weekend, the world’s best riders will once again have their hands full if they can punch their ticket to the championship round in Crypto.com Arena.

FAMILIAR WATERS – Round 1 of the 2024 PBR event in Los Angeles, California, will feature three rematches.

- Eduardo Aparecido shares a chute with Top Shelf for the fourth time. Aparecido was awarded a re-ride after covering the animal athlete in the pairing’s first meeting in Cheyenne, Wyoming, in July of 2019 but was bucked off in his next to outs. Top Shelf bested the Brazilian in Corpus Christ in 2.62 seconds in September of 2021 and in 3.54 seconds in Las Vegas during the 2021 PBR World Finals.
- Koltin Hevalow faces off with Big Twist for the second time after he was bucked off in 5.11 seconds in their first matchup in Tacoma, Washington, last April.
- Wingson Henrique da Silva looks to remain perfect aboard Bison. The Brazilian made the 8 in both previous matchups, posting 86 points in Fort Worth, Texas, at the PBR’s 30th Anniversary World Finals last May and scoring 78.25 points in Houston, Texas, in January.

PAST LOS ANGELES EVENT WINNERS – The PBR King of Cali, Dalton Kasel, rode supreme in 2023 inside a raucous Crypto.com Arena, going 2-for-3 to win the event. Mr. 90-point lived up to his name in the opening round, covering WSM’s Time In A Bottle for 90 points. Now on a roll, the Texan then rode Kid Knapper for 89.75 points to win Round 2. Choosing the always-rank Cool Whip in the championship round, the duo rocketed out of the gates in tandem before the powerful bovine competitor got the upper hand and unseated Kasel after 2.83 seconds. However, Kasel had already done enough to win the event buckle, staving off Boudreaux Campbell. The vivacious cowboy in Campbell, who

posted an event-high 91.25-point ride on Shameless in the opening round, faces Jasper in Round 1 on Friday in an attempt to once again put on a show under the bright Hollywood spotlight.

WORLD CHAMPION BULL RACE – The 2024 YETI PBR World Champion Bull race has been dominated by Man Hater with just a few months left in the year-long campaign. Spanning back to the 2023 PBR Camping World Team Series’ season, the powerful bovine competitor has bucked off all 15 of his cowboy opponents and he currently holds a 1.35-point lead over UTZ BesTex Legend in the standings. After being marked 46.25 points for his buck-off of Brady Fielder in the championship round in Tulsa, Man Hater currently boasts seven of the Top 10 bull scores this season and he has won the Bull of the Event title seven times. Putting that into perspective, the reigning back-to-back World Champion Bull, Ridin’ Solo, was named the Bull of the Event just five times during the 2023 campaign. In Houston, Red Demon became the first animal athlete other than Man Hater to claim more than one Bull of the Event title this season, marked an impressive 47 points for bucking off Joao Ricardo Vieira in 2.3 seconds in the championship round, and has risen to fifth in the standings. After surrendering an 88.5-point ride to Alan de Souza in St. Louis, Missouri, Legend has put together a five-out buck-off streak to somewhat close the gap on Man Hater. A member of the 2023 PBR Stock Contractor of the Year Blake Sharp’s pen, Legend has bucked off 14 of the 15 riders he has faced so far. Right behind him in the standings is Flyin Wired, who sits 1.61 points back of the leader. While he has given up two rides in his six outs, both went for 90 or more points, as Wingson Henrique da Silva covered him for 92.5 points at the PBR Teams Championship in Las Vegas while Joao Ricardo Vieira topped him for 91.75 points to win the event in Tulsa. This weekend in Los Angeles, Man Hater rejoins the Short Round pen after not competing since Tulsa in January.

2024 POINTS TABLES – The 2024 PBR Unleash The Beast season keeps the same point structure as 2023 but adds PBR Majors while removing 15/15 Bucking Battles and having two separate aggregates at the PBR World Finals. The 2024 World Champion will be the rider who earns the most points only at Unleash The Beast (UTB) events, including at the 2024 PBR World Finals on May 10-19 in the Dallas-Fort Worth Metroplex. The three PBR Majors in New York City (January 5-7, won by Austin Richardson), Sacramento, California (February 2-4, won by Leonardo Castro Ferreira), and Albuquerque, New Mexico (March 22-24), offer increased payouts and points. There will be three PBR tours in the U.S. in action for the first half of 2024: PBR Unleash The Beast (November 10 – May 19); Pendleton Whisky Velocity Tour (Jan. 5 – May 4) and PBR Touring Pro Division (Oct. 19 – May 19). Points accumulated in non-UTB events domestically, as well as PBR’s international tours, will be tallied as Velocity Global points. Velocity Global points, which will also be used to crown the 2024 PBR Pendleton Whisky Velocity Tour Champion, will help determine the athletes who can earn a future draw spot on the elite Unleash The Beast following the tour’s first four events.

Those with the most points earned during their four most recent Velocity Global or Unleash The Beast events will join the UTB, replacing riders who had fallen to the bottom of the pack during select cuts throughout the season. Riders ranked in the No. 36-40 range in the UTB standings will be subject to being cut. During each cut, the open positions will first be filled with those riders having injury exemptions, followed by the Premier Series Qualifier List, based on Velocity Global points. Following each cut, these riders will take the place of the demoted riders in the sport’s top series to make up the 40-rider field heading into the next event. Riders ranked No. 1-35 on the UTB will remain on the PBR’s elite tour. Following the initial cut after the event in Manchester, New Hampshire, subsequent cuts will be held every two weeks. The second cut will drop the bottom six riders from UTB, the third cut will drop the bottom seven riders, and the fourth and remaining cuts will remove the bottom eight riders from UTB.

Points will be awarded as follows for the Unleash The Beast, including World Finals, as well as Tier 1 Velocity Global events:

Bonus points are awarded across all levels of PBR competition. A rider who scores 70-79.75 points will earn 7 bonus points, 80-89.75 8 bonus points and 90-99.75 9 bonus points. The exception is if a contestant declines a re-ride due to an inferior bull. In that case, he does not earn bonus points.

THIS WEEKEND’S FORMAT – The Michelob ULTRA PBR Los Angeles, presented by Ariat, the twelfth Unleash The Beast event of the 2024 season, will feature three rounds of bull riding. Each of the 37 competing riders will get on one bull in Round 1 on Friday and Round 2 on Saturday. The 12 bull riders with the top combined ride scores following Rounds 1 and 2 will then advance to the championship round following Round 2 on Saturday.

NEXT UP – The PBR Unleash The Beast next travels to Vystar Veterans Memorial Arena in Jacksonville, Florida, for the U.S. Border Patrol PBR Jacksonville. The event is on Friday, February 23, at 7:45 p.m. EST, and Saturday, February 24, at 6:45 p.m. EST.

VELOCITY TOUR, INTERNATIONAL AND TOURING PRO DIVISION POINTS – All non-Unleash The Beast (UTB) events award Velocity Global points, including Pendleton Whisky Velocity Tour events, Touring Pro Division events and events held internationally in Australia, Brazil, Canada, and Mexico. The only exception is National Finals held abroad, which will only award national points, not Velocity Global points. The point system at each event is tiered based on added money in USD, and other factors determined by the PBR. Each event, depending on the tier will get points in accordance with the tables below.

- Tier 1 Events – \$20,000 or more USD in added money.
- Tier 2 Events – \$10,000 - \$19,999 USD in added money.
- Tier 3 Events – \$9,999 USD or less in added money.

Additionally, riders at all events receive bonus points via their ride score. A rider who scores 70-79.75 points will earn 7 bonus points, 80-89.75 8 bonus points and 90-99.75 9 bonus points.
