

2024 PBR Unleash The Beast PBR Albany

MVP Arena – Albany, New York Friday, December 29, at 7:45 p.m. EST Saturday, December 30, at 6:45 p.m. EST

EMPIRE STATE OF MIND – This weekend, PBR's elite 2024 Unleash The Beast returns to Albany, New York, at MVP Arena. The fifth stop of the 24-event 2024 individual season will mark the third time in history and the second consecutive season the premier series has traveled to Albany. New York's capital will host the PBR for two days of action on Friday, December 29, at 7:45 p.m. EST and Saturday, December 30, at 6:45 p.m. EST.

FIELDER BREAKS THROUGH, HOLDS OFF ICEMAN – Now ranked No. 4 in the Unleash The Beast standings, Brady Fielder broke through and won the first individual premier series event of his career by going a perfect 3-for-3 in Manchester, New Hampshire, two weeks ago, becoming the first Australian to win on the top tour since 2015. Fielder began his weekend by covering Tucker for 83 points in Round 1 and coming in second in Round 2 with an 86.25-point outing on Air Shift. Now in first place in the event, Fielder selected UTZ BesTex Smokestack and thundered out of the gate for a monstrous, career-high-tying 91 points, his third career 90-point ride on the premier series. Catapulting back to the top of the leaderboard, the Aussie edged out Kaique Pacheco, who was flawless in his return to action and finished second. The Ice Man, who is now ranked No. 10 in the standings after his perfect debut, topped Squealin' Cat for 84.25 points in Round 1 in his first PBR action since early September. He moved into second in the event by scoring 84.75 points on One Man Gang in Round 2 before briefly taking the event lead by making the 8 on Lapua for 85.75 points in the championship round. Pacheco takes on Tucker in Round 1 on Friday while Fielder battles Little Hornet.

DIAS MAINTAINS NO. 1 RANK – Cassio Dias held onto the No. 1 spot in the Unleash The Beast standings despite being shut out for the first time this season in Manchester, New Hampshire, going 0-for-2. Prior to the event in Manchester, Dias had continued his red-hot start to the 2024 Unleash The Beast season by going 3-for-4 and winning his second-straight event in Johnstown, Pennsylvania. In Round 1, the Brazilian topped The Judge for 89.25 points and tied for third entering the second day of action. On Saturday, the Kansas City Outlaws' rising superstar in the separate PBR Teams league was unseated for the first time in 2024, as Train Station shook him off the track to perfection in 4.07 seconds. Undeterred, Dias stormed back, making the 8 for 86.25 points on Strong Arm in Round 3 and winning the championship round with a monstrous, career-high, 91.75 points on Cy Young to overtake the lead. Dias is matched with Nighttime Crime in Round 1 on Friday.

The Brazilian first moved into the No. 1 spot in the Unleash The Beast standings in St. Louis, Missouri, during the first weekend of December. After finishing sixth in Tucson, Arizona, Dias continued his strong start to the season by topping Buzz for 87.5 points in Round 1. Remaining flawless courtesy of a Round 2 ride aboard Hunted Down for 86.25 points, the Brazilian won his second round of the season in the championship round, covering Mike's Motive for a monstrous 90.5 points.

FAMILIAR WATERS – Round 1 of the 2024 PBR event in Albany, New York, will feature three rematches.

- Guilherme Valleiras takes on Devaronian for the second time after besting the animal athlete for 82.25 points in their first matchup in Sioux Falls, South Dakota, in April.
- Lucas Divino shares a chute with Crossover for the fourth time. The Brazilian has bucked off in all three of his previous attempts, including 3.59 seconds in Arlington, Texas, in November of 2020, 5.83 seconds in Lincoln, Nebraska, in October of 2021 and in 5.34 seconds in Kansas City, Missouri, this past August.

- Nick Tetz battles Heater once again after the Canadian cowboy was unseated in 4.48 seconds in their first duel in Albuquerque, New Mexico, earlier this year in March.

PAST ALBANY EVENT WINNERS – The PBR Unleash The Beast will return to Albany for the second-consecutive season after Texan Andrew Alvidrez went a perfect 3-for-3 to win his second-straight event and overtake Cooper Davis for the No. 1 spot in the Unleash The Beast standings. Alvidrez began his weekend by topping Skull Crusher for 87.5 points in Round 1 and Red Mosquito for 87.75 points in Round 2. Sporting five rides in his last five outs, Alvidrez cruised aboard Pickle Moonshine for 89.25 points in the final round to win the second event buckle of his career.

WORLD CHAMPION BULL – The 2024 YETI PBR World Champion bull will be determined by both the 2023 PBR Camping World Team Series season and the 2024 Unleash The Beast (UTB) season. The 2024 World Champion Bull will be determined by their Top 8 outs during the Team Series and UTB regular season and two outs at the PBR World Finals. The Top 7 eligible bulls at the end of the PBR UTB regular season shall be entered into the World Finals and be guaranteed three outs. In the event two or more bulls are tied based on the scoring criteria after the World Finals, the World Champion Bull shall be awarded to the bull who has achieved the highest average score from their two best outs at the World Finals. If a tie still exists after a review of the scores described in the preceding sentence, the bulls will share the title of World Champion Bull, and the prize money will be evenly distributed among the stock contractors who own said bulls.

For avoidance of doubt, if the score that is dropped from the World Finals is higher than the lowest regular season out, the score at World Finals will still be dropped. The top eight (8) regular season outs, and top two (2) World Finals outs are to remain in the calculations for the World Champion Bull award.

MAJORS RETURN – The 2024 PBR Unleash The Beast season keeps the same point structure as 2023 but adds PBR Majors while removing 15/15 Bucking Battles and having two separate aggregates at the PBR World Finals. The 2024 World Champion will be the rider who earns the most points only at Unleash The Beast (UTB) events, including at the 2024 PBR World Finals on May 10-19 in the Dallas-Fort Worth Metroplex. The three PBR Majors in New York City (January 5-7), Sacramento, California, (February 2-4) and Albuquerque, New Mexico, (March 22-24) will offer increased payouts and points. There will be three PBR tours in the U.S. in action for the first half of 2024: PBR Unleash The Beast (November 10 – May 19); Pendleton Whisky Velocity Tour (Jan. 5 – May 4) and PBR Touring Pro Division (Oct. 19 – May 19). Points accumulated in non-UTB events domestically, as well as PBR's international tours, will be tallied as Velocity Global points. Velocity Global points, which will also be used to crown the 2024 PBR Pendleton Whisky Velocity Tour Champion, will help determine the athletes who can earn a future draw spot on the elite Unleash The Beast following the tour's first four events.

Those with the most points earned during their four most recent Velocity Global or Unleash The Beast events will join the UTB, replacing riders who had fallen to the bottom of the pack during select cuts throughout the season. The first rider cut takes place after the fourth UTB event in Manchester, New Hampshire, on Dec. 15-16. Riders ranked in the No. 36-40 range in the UTB standings will be subject to being cut. During each cut, the open positions will first be filled with those riders having injury exemptions, followed by the Premier Series Qualifier List, based on Velocity Global points. Following the first cut, these riders will take the place of the demoted riders in the sport's top series to make up the 40-rider field heading into Albany, New York, on Dec. 29-30. Riders ranked No. 1-35 on the UTB will remain on the PBR's elite tour. Following the initial cut, subsequent cuts will be held every two weeks. The second cut will drop the bottom six riders from UTB, the third cut will drop the bottom seven riders, and the fourth and remaining cuts will remove the bottom eight riders from UTB.

Points will be awarded as follows for the Unleash The Beast, including World Finals, as well as Tier 1 Velocity Global events:

Bonus points are awarded across all levels of PBR competition. A rider who scores 70-79.75 points will earn 7 bonus points, 80-89.75 8 bonus points and 90-99.75 9 bonus points. The exception is if a contestant declines a re-ride due to an inferior bull. In that case, he does not earn bonus points.

THIS WEEKEND'S FORMAT – PBR Albany, the fifth Unleash The Beast event of the 2024 season, will feature three rounds of bull riding. Each of the 40 competing riders will get on one bull in Round 1 on Friday and Round 2 on Saturday. The 12 bull riders with the top combined ride scores following Rounds 1 and 2 will then advance to the championship round following Round 2 on Saturday.

NEXT UP – The PBR Unleash The Beast next travels to Madison Square Garden in New York, New York, for PBR Monster Energy Buck Off at the Garden, Presented by Ariat, the first PBR Major of the season. The event is on Friday, January 5, at 7:45 p.m. ET, Saturday, January 6, at 6:45 p.m. ET and Sunday, January 7, at 1:45 p.m. ET.

VELOCITY TOUR, INTERNATIONAL AND TOURING PRO DIVISION POINTS – All non-Unleash The Beast (UTB) events award Velocity Global points, including Pendleton Whisky Velocity Tour events, Touring Pro Division events and events held internationally in Australia, Brazil, Canada, and Mexico. The only exception is National Finals held abroad, which will only award national points, not Velocity Global points. The point system at each event is tiered based on added money in USD, and other factors determined by the PBR. Each event, depending on the tier will get points in accordance with the tables below.

- Tier 1 Events \$20,000 or more USD in added money.
- Tier 2 Events \$10,000 \$19,999 USD in added money.
- Tier 3 Events \$9,999 USD or less in added money.

Additionally, riders at all events receive bonus points via their ride score. A rider who scores 70-79.75 points will earn 7 bonus points, 80-89.75 8 bonus points and 90-99.75 9 bonus points.
