



2024 PBR Unleash The Beast Ariat PBR Indianapolis Gainbridge Fieldhouse - Indianapolis, Indiana Saturday, March 2 at 6:45 p.m. EST Sunday, March 3 at 1:45 p.m. EST

NAPTOWN SHOWDOWN – This weekend, for the fifth time ever and third consecutive season, PBR’s elite 2024 Unleash The Beast travels to Indianapolis, Indiana, for the Ariat PBR Indianapolis, the fourteenth event of the 24-event 2024 individual season. Gainbridge Fieldhouse will host the PBR for two days of action on Saturday, March 2, starting at 6:45 p.m. EST, and Sunday, March 3, starting at 1:45 p.m. EST.

CRIMBER PERFECT IN JACKSONVILLE TO WIN FIRST PREMIER SERIES EVENT – Young phenom John Crimber overtook Austin Richardson for the No. 2 spot in the Unleash The Beast standings with a perfect 3-for-3 performance in Jacksonville, Florida, last weekend. Crimber roared out of the chutes to tie for the event lead with 87 points on Flatliner. The 18-year-old cowboy made the 8 for 87.75 points, the second-best score of the round, to hold the event lead heading into the championship round. Choosing Doze You Down as his final animal athlete opponent, Crimber stormed out of the chutes one last time, converting for an event-high 91 points to net his first premier series victory, flinging his helmet towards the heavens in celebration in front of a roaring VyStar Veterans Memorial Arena crowd. Throughout his perfect weekend, the Texan showed incredible mastery of his animal athlete opponents, posting an impressive rider over bull (ROB) score of 3.08.

With the victory, Crimber recorded his fourth Top 2 finish in his last six events and is now 295 points behind No. 1 Cassio Dias. He became the seventh different rider to win their first career premier series event this season and the second youngest rider in PBR history since 2000 to win an elite tour event, surpassing Jess Lockwood and trailing only L.J. Jenkins, who won in Columbus, Ohio, in October of 2005, just three months after his 18th birthday. Crimber pushed his riding percentage over 50% for the season as well, as he is now 14-for-27 (51%) on the top tour, currently the sixth-best percentage this season. He looks to continue his pursuit for a gold buckle on Strong Arm in Round 1 on Saturday.

DIAS MAINTAINS NO. 1 RANKING – While John Crimber may have closed the gap, No. 1 Cassio Dias still holds a commanding lead in the gold buckle race after going 1-for-2 and finishing 26th in Jacksonville. The Brazilian rookie bounced back after bucking off Big Worm in 1.92 seconds in the opening round, riding Hunted Down for 82.5 points in Round 2. However, it wasn’t enough to punch a ticket to his eleventh championship round, so he had to watch from the sidelines as fellow-rookie Crimber took home the buckle. In Los Angeles, the Brazilian cowboy had extended his lead, going 2-for-3 to win his fourth event of the season. The rising superstar topped Hell Storm for 87.25 points in Round 1, the second-best score of the evening, but was dispatched by Ghost Face in 3.04 seconds in Round 2 on Saturday. Knowing he most likely needed a monstrous score to take over the No. 1 spot, Dias showed no fear and selected the 2024 YETI PBR World Champion Bull frontrunner, Man Hater, who hadn’t been covered before. The dynamic duo burst out of the gate in the championship round in front of a roaring Crypto.com Arena, posting a mind-boggling, 94.75-point score, the highest-marked ride since Jose Vitor Leme topped Ridin’ Solo for 94.75 points in Oklahoma City in February of 2022 and the highest ride in PBR history in California. With the Top-50 ride in premier series history, Dias put a stamp on his season that could end with a gold buckle.

After sitting atop the standings for a month early in the season, Dias briefly lost his hold on the top spot to Austin Richardson after the Texan won back-to-back titles in the Empire State at the beginning of the new year. However, Dias bounced back in Chicago, going a perfect 3-for-3 and winning his premier series-leading third event of the season. The MVP runner-up for the Kansas City Outlaws in the PBR Camping World Team Series, Dias finished tied for fourth in the first round with an 87-point ride on IHOP. Now on a roll, the Brazilian tied for second in Round 2, scoring 86.75 points on Grey Fox to earn the second pick in the championship pen. Choosing Do Dat Eddie, Dias saved his best for last, storming out of the gates for an event-high-tying 89 points to overtake Cort McFadden, who was making his PBR debut, in the event standings. After the young Texan was

bucked off Polar Express in 5.26 seconds, Dias knew he was back on top in the race for a gold buckle. Despite missing the championship round in Jacksonville, the young gun's 10 championship round outs lead the field by a wide margin, as the next highest rider has just seven. Dias looks to return to the championship round in Indianapolis this weekend, first sharing a chute with Cracker Jack in Round 1.

VETERAN SAVVY – While the rookies have been the predominant story of the 2024 season, several veterans filled the ranks behind Crimber in the standings last weekend in Jacksonville.

In second place was Dalton Kasel, who went 3-for-3 and recorded his third Top 5 finish of the season. After being shut out in Salt Lake City and missing the event in Los Angeles due to injury, Kasel roared back in Florida, showing no rust by riding Mama's Boy for 87 points in the opening round. Finding his groove, the Texan then topped Don't Come Easy for 84.25 points in Round 2 and UTZ BesTex Smokestack for 89.5 points in the championship round to net second place and rise to No. 4 in the standings. Kasel shares a chute with Dream Walkin in Round 1.

Kasel wasn't the only veteran to get rolling in the Sunshine State, as Joao Ricardo Vieira rebounded after a Round 1 buck off of Hoka Hey to finish third, going 2-for-3. The grizzled cowboy rode Doze Off for a round-winning 89 points in Round 2 before covering Red Demon for a monstrous 90 points in the championship round. With the bronze finish, the 2023 PBR Teams Championship MVP for the champion Texas Rattlers catapulted up to No. 5 in the event standings. Vieira rematches against La Grande in Round 1 at Gainbridge Fieldhouse.

Rounding out the Top 5 was 2022 PBR World Champion Daylon Swearingen and Ednelio Almeida, who both also went 2-for-3. Swearingen was unseated by Flashbang in 3.28 seconds in Round 1 but bounced back in a big way, riding Lost Pearl for 86 points in Round 2 and Hoka Hey for 87.25 points in the championship round. Almeida converted in his first two outs, sitting tall atop Mr. Nasty for 84.75 points in Round 1 and Highwire for 86.75 points in Round 2 to punch his ticket to the championship round. However, he was unable to remain perfect, as he was unseated by I'm Legit Too after a thrilling 3.95 seconds. Almeida takes on Big Worm in Round 1, while Swearingen battles Unhinged.

Also of note was veteran Michael Lane, who finished eighth, going 2-for-3. The Virginia cowboy scored 84.75 points aboard Risky Business in Round 1 and then hung on to Chanler's Dream for 75 points in Round 2. Trying to take advantage of an unusual three re-ride opportunities, Lane roared out of the chutes on Whiplash but was bucked off in 4.96 seconds. It was the veteran's first Top 10 finish on the premier series since 2019 and his first ride on the top tour since he went 1-for-2 in Jacksonville in May of 2021. Lane squares off with Coca Cola Cowboy in Round 1 on Saturday.

FAMILIAR WATERS – Round 1 of the 2024 PBR event in Indianapolis, Indiana, will feature four rematches, all of which feature cowboys who are perfect against their familiar animal athlete opponents.

- Cort McFadden takes on Crazy Times for the second time after the pair posted 87.5 points in Denver, Colorado, in January.
- Joao Ricardo Vieira and La Grande share a chute once again after the veteran cowboy rode the animal athlete for 88.5 points in Newark, New Jersey, in September.
- Silvano Alves battles Falcon Eddie for the third time on Saturday. The three-time PBR World Champion made the 8 in both previous matchups, riding Falcon Eddie for 85.25 points in Kansas City, Missouri, in August of 2023 and for 88.25 points in Las Vegas, Nevada, later that year in October.
- Wingson Henrique da Silva rode Tchoupitoulas for 86 points in the duo's first matchup in Greensboro, North Carolina, in September of 2023.

PAST INDIANAPOLIS EVENT WINNERS – The PBR's premier Unleash The Beast has travelled to Indianapolis five times prior, most recently in January of 2023, when Daniel Keeping went 2-for-3 to take home his second event title of the Texan's rookie campaign. Keeping got off to a strong start, riding Casper for 87.75 points in Round 1. Now in a groove, the mustached marauder roared out of the chutes aboard Renegade for 88.75 points to earn him the pick of the pen in the championship round. There, with his victory already guaranteed, he rocketed out of the gate on UTZ BesTex Smokestack, but

was unable to make the 8 one last time. In 2022, Mason Taylor won the New Year’s Day event as he was just one of two riders to go a perfect 2-for-2 in the single-day contest, including an event high-tying 90.75-point ride in Round 1 on Casper.

WORLD CHAMPION BULL RACE – The 2024 YETI PBR World Champion Bull race has been dominated by Man Hater with just a few months left in the year-long campaign. Spanning back to the 2023 PBR Camping World Team Series’ season, the powerful bovine competitor had bucked off all 15 of his cowboy opponents until Cassio Dias covered him for a season-high 94.75 points in the championship round in Los Angeles to take the event title. Man Hater currently holds a 1.38-point lead over UTZ BesTex Legend in the standings. After being marked 46.25 points for his buck-off of Brady Fielder in the championship round in Tulsa, Man Hater currently boasts seven of the Top 10 bull scores this season and he has won the Bull of the Event title eight times. Putting that into perspective, the reigning back-to-back World Champion Bull, Ridin’ Solo, was named the Bull of the Event just five times during the 2023 campaign. In Houston, Red Demon became the first animal athlete other than Man Hater to claim more than one Bull of the Event title this season, marked an impressive 47 points for bucking off Joao Ricardo Vieira in 2.3 seconds in the championship round, and has risen to fourth in the standings. After surrendering an 88.5-point ride to Alan de Souza in St. Louis, Missouri, Legend has put together a five-out buck-off streak to somewhat close the gap on Man Hater. A member of the 2023 PBR Stock Contractor of the Year Blake Sharp’s pen, Legend has bucked off 14 of the 15 riders he has faced so far. Right behind him in the standings is Flyin Wired, who sits 1.64 points back of the leader. While he has given up two rides in his six outs, both went for 90 or more points, as Wingson Henrique da Silva covered him for 92.5 points at the PBR Teams Championship in Las Vegas while Joao Ricardo Vieira topped him for 91.75 points to win the event in Tulsa.

2024 POINTS TABLES – The 2024 PBR Unleash The Beast season keeps the same point structure as 2023 but adds PBR Majors while removing 15/15 Bucking Battles and having two separate aggregates at the PBR World Finals. The 2024 World Champion will be the rider who earns the most points only at Unleash The Beast (UTB) events, including at the 2024 PBR World Finals on May 10-19 in the Dallas-Fort Worth Metroplex. The three PBR Majors in New York City (January 5-7, won by Austin Richardson), Sacramento, California (February 2-4, won by Leonardo Castro Ferreira), and Albuquerque, New Mexico (March 22-24), offer increased payouts and points. There will be three PBR tours in the U.S. in action for the first half of 2024: PBR Unleash The Beast (November 10 – May 19); Pendleton Whisky Velocity Tour (Jan. 5 – May 4) and PBR Touring Pro Division (Oct. 19 – May 19). Points accumulated in non-UTB events domestically, as well as PBR’s international tours, will be tallied as Velocity Global points. Velocity Global points, which will also be used to crown the 2024 PBR Pendleton Whisky Velocity Tour Champion, will help determine the athletes who can earn a future draw spot on the elite Unleash The Beast following the tour’s first four events.

Those with the most points earned during their four most recent Velocity Global or Unleash The Beast events will join the UTB, replacing riders who had fallen to the bottom of the pack during select cuts throughout the season. Riders ranked in the No. 36-40 range in the UTB standings will be subject to being cut. During each cut, the open positions will first be filled with those riders having injury exemptions, followed by the Premier Series Qualifier List, based on Velocity Global points. Following each cut, these riders will take the place of the demoted riders in the sport’s top series to make up the 40-rider field heading into the next event. Riders ranked No. 1-35 on the UTB will remain on the PBR’s elite tour. Following the initial cut after the event in Manchester, New Hampshire, subsequent cuts will be held every two weeks. The second cut will drop the bottom six riders from UTB, the third cut will drop the bottom seven riders, and the fourth and remaining cuts will remove the bottom eight riders from UTB.

Points will be awarded as follows for the Unleash The Beast, including World Finals, as well as Tier 1 Velocity Global events:

Bonus points are awarded across all levels of PBR competition. A rider who scores 70-79.75 points will earn 7 bonus points, 80-89.75 8 bonus points and 90-99.75 9 bonus points. The exception is if a contestant declines a re-ride due to an inferior bull. In that case, he does not earn bonus points.

Each of the 35 competing riders will get on one bull in Round 1 on Saturday and Round 2 on Sunday. The 12 bull riders with the top combined ride scores following Rounds 1 and 2 will then advance to the championship round following Round 2 on Sunday.

VELOCITY TOUR, INTERNATIONAL AND TOURING PRO DIVISION POINTS – All non-Unleash The Beast (UTB) events award Velocity Global points, including Pendleton Whisky Velocity Tour events, Touring Pro Division events and events held internationally in Australia, Brazil, Canada, and Mexico. The only exception is National Finals held abroad, which will only award national points, not Velocity Global points. The point system at each event is tiered based on added money in USD, and other factors determined by the PBR. Each event, depending on the tier will get points in accordance with the tables below.

- Tier 1 Events – \$20,000 or more USD in added money.
- Tier 2 Events – \$10,000 - \$19,999 USD in added money.
- Tier 3 Events – \$9,999 USD or less in added money.

Additionally, riders at all events receive bonus points via their ride score. A rider who scores 70-79.75 points will earn 7 bonus points, 80-89.75 8 bonus points and 90-99.75 9 bonus points.
