

2024 PBR Unleash The Beast Kubota PBR Houston Presented by Michelob ULTRA Toyota Center – Houston, Texas Friday, January 26 at 7:45 p.m. CST Saturday, January 27 at 6:45 p.m. CST

HOUSTON, WE HAVE A BUCK OFF – This weekend, PBR's elite 2024 Unleash The Beast heads to the Toyota Center in Houston, Texas. The ninth stop of the 24-event 2024 individual season will mark the first time the premier series has bucked into Houston since 2019 and the seventh time overall. The Lone Star State will host the PBR for two days of action on Friday, January 26, at 7:45 p.m. CST and Saturday, January 27, at 6:45 p.m. CST.

SOMETHING IN THE WATER – Already the home of three of the best rides in PBR history, Tulsa was once again a must-watch weekend of bull riding. Heading into BOK Center, riders had posted 10 90-point rides throughout the season. Last weekend, the world's best bull riders put up nine 90-pointers, including seven in the championship round. Those seven 90-point rides were the most in a short round since Worcester, Massachusetts, in 2008. Overall, the forty cowboys on the top tour have been on fire the past two weeks. Since riding below 30 percent as a pack for the first time at an event this season in Madison Square Garden during the first weekend of January, the world's best bull riders have bounced back in a big way. In Chicago, riders went 39-for-96 (40.63%), the second-highest riding percentage of the season, and followed that up by going 35-for-91 (38.46%) in Tulsa last weekend, the third-best performance during the 2024 campaign. So far this season, four events have had riding percentages better than 35% after only six events surpassed that mark in 2023.

VETERAN VIEIRA'S VICTORY— At the age of 39, Joao Ricardo Vieira went a perfect 3-for-3 to win in Tulsa last weekend, tying Gary Richards as the oldest man to win a PBR premier series event. The grizzled veteran began his perfect weekend by topping Whiplash for 86.75 points to tie for fourth place in Round 1. Now in a groove, the Brazilian rode Bamboozle for 87.75 points in Round 2, earning the pick of the pen in the championship round. Choosing Flyin Wired as his final animal athlete opponent, Vieira stormed out of the chutes in the final out and secured the walk-off victory with a monstrous, round-winning, 91.75-point masterpiece. The ride tied for the highest-marked ride of the 2024 season to net Vieira his first Unleash The Beast event win since March of 2022 and put a stamp on the remarkable final round in Tulsa that featured an incredible seven 90-point rides.

The perennial gold buckle contender is coming off a PBR Teams Championship with the Texas Rattlers, where he was named event MVP in the playoffs, and his walk-off ride in Tulsa was his 39th 90-point premier series ride and his second of the season. A staple on the premier series since making his debut on the top tour in 2013, Vieira is currently 8-for-16, tied for eighth in riding percentage heading into Houston. One of the toughest athletes on the planet, Vieira has competed in at least 10 premier series events in each of his 11 seasons, finishing inside the Top 5 of the gold buckle race an incredible seven times, including three runner-up finishes in 2014, 2015, and 2020. The Brazilian is slated to face Coca Cola Cowboy in Round 1 on Friday.

DIAS EXTENDS LEAD ATOP THE STANDINGS – No. 1 Cassio Dias went 2-for-3 and finished sixth in Tulsa, Oklahoma, to extend his lead over No. 2 Austin Richardson in the 2024 gold buckle race. The Brazilian cowboy covered Lansky for 87.75 points in Round 1 at BOK Center but was bucked off by Norse God in 4.43 seconds in Round 2. Showing the resilience that has helped propel him to the No. 1 spot, Dias bounced back in the championship round with his premier series-leading fourth 90-point ride, posting 90.75 points on the back-to-back reigning World Champion Bull, Ridin' Solo.

After sitting atop the standings for a month, No. 1 Cassio Dias briefly lost his hold on the top spot to Richardson after the Texan won back-to-back titles in the Empire State at the beginning of the new year. However, Dias bounced back in Chicago, going a

perfect 3-for-3 and winning his premier series-leading third event of the season. The MVP runner-up for the Kansas City Outlaws in the Camping World Teams Series, Dias finished tied for fourth in the first round with an 87-point ride on IHOP. Now on a roll, the Brazilian tied for second in Round 2, scoring 86.75 points on Grey Fox to earn the second pick in the championship pen heading into the final round. Choosing Do Dat Eddie, Dias saved his best for last, storming out of the gates for an event-high-tying 89 points to overtake Cort McFadden, who was making his PBR debut, in the event standings. After the young Texan was bucked off Polar Express in 5.26 seconds, Dias knew he was back on top in the race for a gold buckle. The phenomenal young rookie looks to extend his lead in the standings by riding Show Me in Round 1 on Friday.

NOTHING WRONG WITH BEING NEW – While the oldest man on the roster may have stolen the show in Tulsa, rookies continued to shine in the early race for a gold buckle, as seven sit in the Top 20 of the Unleash The Beast standings: No. 1 Cassio Dias, No. 10 Julio Cesar Marques, No. 11 Kaiden Loud, No. 13 John Crimber, No. 16 Sage Kimzey, No. 18 Caden Bunch and No. 20 Felipe Furlan. While Dias just missed out on his fifth Top 5 finish in Tulsa, he wasn't the only rookie to wow the crowd in Oklahoma, as two other rookies turned in 90-point rides in the championship round.

Crimber briefly took the top spot in the event standings by topping Chateau Montelena's Montana Jacket for a career-high 91.5 points and finished second after Vieira claimed his 18th premier series victory in the final out. The son of legendary PBR bull rider and recently christened Florida Freedom head coach Paulo Crimber, the young phenom was vying for not only his first premier series victory but also his second event buckle of the week after he tied for the event win at the weekly PBR Stockyards Showcase in Fort Worth, Texas, on Thursday. He is covering 46% of his bulls on the top tour this year and faces The Judge in Round 1 on Friday.

After being shut out in his Unleash The Beast debut in Chicago, Clay Guiton bounced back in a big way in Tulsa, posting two 90-point rides. Despite bucking off Triple Aught in 2.17 seconds in Round 1, the North Carolinian battled back, topping Punchy Pete for 90 seconds in Round 2 to earn a spot in his first championship round. Seemingly unfazed at facing the world's rankest bulls, Guiton rocketed out of the gate and topped Bandito Bug for 90.25 points, pushing him to fifth in the event. Guiton takes on Washita Red in Round 1 in Houston.

Two other rookies to watch this weekend are Marco Rizzo and Callum Miller, who are currently ranked No. 1 and No. 2 in the Pendelton Whisky Velocity Tour standings and make their Unleash The Beast debuts in Houston.

Rizzo credits both his father and PBR Ring of Honor member Robson Palermo for his career in bull riding. Growing up with and competing against both Crimber and Guiton, Rizzo has taken the Velocity Tour by storm, placing second in his tour debut in Lexington, Kentucky, before recording his first career PBR victory in Charleston, West Virginia. The red-hot Georgian joins the top tour after finishing third in Grand Rapids, Michigan, last weekend, and he is currently 6-for-10 on the Velocity Tour this season. He takes on Wall Street Train in Round 1 on Friday.

Miller joins fellow Australian Brady Fielder on the premier series after winning the Velocity Tour event in Reno, Nevada, last weekend, going a perfect 3-for-3. A staple in Canada during the past two seasons where he finished inside the Top 25 in the national standings, Miller made his premier series debut with the Missouri Thunder in 2022 but was shut out in eight outs. He heads to Houston after going 4-for-6 on the Velocity Tour to share a chute with Hard Candy in Round 1.

NOTABLES – Here are several other notable stats and storylines:

- **Don't Get it Twisted:** Dana White's Twisted Steel looms in the pen in Houston this weekend to the chagrin of bull riding's best. The powerful bovine competitor has allowed just one ride in his eight premier series outs (88% buckoff percentage) dating back to the beginning of the 2023 PBR Teams season and has bucked off both riders who have faced him during the 2024 Unleash The Beast campaign. Last weekend in Tulsa, Twisted Steel shed Vitor Losnake in two seconds flat, the second straight out he has bested the Brazilian cowboy. Set to buck in Round 2, the rank animal athlete is looking unstoppable leading into his celebrity showdown with UFC Hall of Famer, Donald "Cowboy" Cerrone.
- Branton's Wild Ride: After winning in his home state of Oregon at the Pendleton Whisky Velocity Tour event in Portland, Dawson Branton was unable to join the premier series in Chicago despite qualifying due to inclement weather. Undeterred, Branton headed to Spokane, Washington, as a last-minute replacement at the Velocity Tour event,

going 1-for-2 and finishing third. Now on fire, the Oregonian rejoined the premier series in Tulsa, going 2-for-3, including a 91.25-point ride on Hunting Trip in the championship round, to finish sixth. He dances with Mighty Mike in Round 1 in Houston.

- On the Rise: Several riders made massive leaps in the standings following the action in Tulsa, highlighted by Wingson Henrique da Silva and John Crimber. Silva, the 2023 PBR Rookie of the Year runner-up, surged from No. 34 to No. 19 after his bronze finish in Tulsa. Dias's teammate on the Kansas City Outlaws, Silva went a perfect 3-for-3 at BOK Center, highlighted by a 90-point ride on Ricky Vaughn in the championship round. He takes on Bison in Round 1 on Friday. Crimber, who also went 3-for-3, catapulted from No. 32 to No. 13 in the standings.
- Mr. 90-Pointer Does it Again: Despite a relatively mundane start to his 2024 season, Dalton Kasel rocketed back into the Top 5 of the Unleash The Beast standings, going 2-for-3 and finishing fourth in Tulsa. The Texas cowboy bucked off Uncle Jim in 7.47 seconds in Round 1 Friday before catching fire on Saturday. Winning Round 2 by covering Doze You Down for an event-high-tying 91.75 points, Kasel carried his success into the championship round, riding UTZ BesTex Smokestack for 91.5 points, his thirtieth 90-point ride on the premier series. The pairing has emerged as one to watch, as Kasel previously covered Smokestack for 91.25 points in Little Rock, Arkansas, last March.

FAMILIAR WATERS – Round 1 of the 2024 PBR event in Houston, Texas, will feature eight rematches.

- Boudreaux Campbell is locked in a chute with Border Crisis for a second time after not being able to get out the gate on the animal athlete in Nashville, Tennessee, in August of 2022.
- Caden Bunch takes on Boomerang for the second time after being bucked off in 2.93 seconds in their first matchup in Johnstown, Pennsylvania, in December.
- Cort McFadden battles Nightmare once again after covering him for 86.75 points in Chicago earlier this month.
- Ednelio Almeida and Hoka Hey run it back for the first time since the pair danced for 87 points in St. Louis, Missouri, in December.
- Eli Vastbinder squares off against Ninja Cowboy for the second time after being bucked off in 4.16 seconds in Chicago earlier in the month.
- Joao Henrique Lucas dances with Crazy Times once again. The bovine competitor bucked his cowboy compatriot off in 5.03 seconds the first time the two met in Guthrie, Oklahoma, in May of 2020.
- Kaique Pacheco duels the aptly named Moon Walk in Round 1 in Houston. The 2018 PBR World Champion topped him for 79 points in Albuquerque, New Mexico, in March of 2022.
- Wingson Henrique da Silva tries to ride Bison for a second time after making the 8 for 86 points at the PBR World Finals in Fort Worth, Texas, last May.

PAST HOUSTON EVENT WINNERS – This weekend's event in Houston will mark the first regular-season premier series event in H-town since 2019 when Jess Lockwood went a perfect 3-for-3 to extend his lead in the World Championship standings. The Montanan topped Fist City for 85.25 points in Round 1 before covering Church Bells for 85.5 points in Round 2. Sitting in fourth, the two-time PBR World Champion catapulted to the top of the event standings after converting aboard Budakon for 88.75 points. While he would eventually lose the No. 1 spot in the standings later that year, Lockwood roared back at the 2019 World Finals to claim his second gold buckle, joining Cody Hart (1999) as the second bull rider to claim a title in Houston and a gold buckle in the same season. PBR World Champions Chris Shivers (1998) and Justin McBride (2001) have also claimed a victory in Space City.

2019 Jess Lockwood 2012 Chase Outlaw 2001 Justin McBride 2000 Ross Coleman 1999 Cody Hart 1998 Chris Shivers WORLD CHAMPION BULL RACE – The 2024 YETI PBR World Champion Bull race has been dominated by Man Hater with just five months left in the year-long campaign. Spanning back to the 2023 PBR Camping World Team Series' season, the powerful bovine competitor has bucked off all 15 of his cowboy opponents and he currently holds a 1.35-point lead over UTZ BesTex Legend in the standings. After being marked 46.25 points for his buck-off of Brady Fielder in the championship round in Tulsa, Man Hater currently boasts seven of the Top 10 bull scores this season and he has won the Bull of the Event title seven times. Putting that into perspective, the reigning back-to-back World Champion Bull, Ridin' Solo, was named the Bull of the Event just five times during the 2023 campaign and no other animal athlete has won the award more than once this season. After surrendering an 88.5-point ride to Alan de Souza in St. Louis, Missouri, Legend has put together a five-out buck-off streak to somewhat close the gap on Man Hater. A member of the 2023 PBR Stock Contractor of the Year Blake Sharp's pen, Legend has bucked off 14 of the 15 riders he has faced so far. Right behind him in the standings is Flyin Wired, who sits 1.44 points back of the leader. While he has given up two rides in his six outs, both went for 90 or more points, as Wingson Henrique da Silva covered him for 92.5 points at the PBR Teams Championship in Las Vegas while Joao Ricardo Vieira topped him for 91.75 points to win the event in Tulsa last weekend. Flyin Wired is the only bull of the three in the pen for this weekend's event in Houston.

2024 POINTS TABLES – The 2024 PBR Unleash The Beast season keeps the same point structure as 2023 but adds PBR Majors while removing 15/15 Bucking Battles and having two separate aggregates at the PBR World Finals. The 2024 World Champion will be the rider who earns the most points only at Unleash The Beast (UTB) events, including at the 2024 PBR World Finals on May 10-19 in the Dallas-Fort Worth Metroplex. The three PBR Majors in New York City (January 5-7, won by Austin Richardson), Sacramento, California (February 2-4), and Albuquerque, New Mexico (March 22-24), will offer increased payouts and points. There will be three PBR tours in the U.S. in action for the first half of 2024: PBR Unleash The Beast (November 10 – May 19); Pendleton Whisky Velocity Tour (Jan. 5 – May 4) and PBR Touring Pro Division (Oct. 19 – May 19). Points accumulated in non-UTB events domestically, as well as PBR's international tours, will be tallied as Velocity Global points. Velocity Global points, which will also be used to crown the 2024 PBR Pendleton Whisky Velocity Tour Champion, will help determine the athletes who can earn a future draw spot on the elite Unleash The Beast following the tour's first four events.

Those with the most points earned during their four most recent Velocity Global or Unleash The Beast events will join the UTB, replacing riders who had fallen to the bottom of the pack during select cuts throughout the season. Riders ranked in the No. 36-40 range in the UTB standings will be subject to being cut. During each cut, the open positions will first be filled with those riders having injury exemptions, followed by the Premier Series Qualifier List, based on Velocity Global points. Following each cut, these riders will take the place of the demoted riders in the sport's top series to make up the 40-rider field heading into the next event. Riders ranked No. 1-35 on the UTB will remain on the PBR's elite tour. Following the initial cut after the event in Manchester, New Hampshire, subsequent cuts will be held every two weeks. The second cut will drop the bottom six riders from UTB, the third cut will drop the bottom seven riders, and the fourth and remaining cuts will remove the bottom eight riders from UTB.

Points will be awarded as follows for the Unleash The Beast, including World Finals, as well as Tier 1 Velocity Global events:

Bonus points are awarded across all levels of PBR competition. A rider who scores 70-79.75 points will earn 7 bonus points, 80-89.75 8 bonus points and 90-99.75 9 bonus points. The exception is if a contestant declines a re-ride due to an inferior bull. In that case, he does not earn bonus points.

THIS WEEKEND'S FORMAT – Kubota PBR Houston, presented by Michelob ULTRA, the ninth Unleash The Beast event of the 2024 season, will feature three rounds of bull riding. Each of the 40 competing riders will get on one bull in Round 1 on Friday and Round 2 on Saturday. The 12 bull riders with the top combined ride scores following Rounds 1 and 2 will then advance to the championship round following Round 2 on Saturday.

NEXT UP – The PBR Unleash The Beast next travels to Golden 1 Center in Sacramento, California, for the PBR Wrangler Long Live Cowboys Classic, the second PBR Major of the 2024 season. The event is on Friday, February 2, at 7:45 p.m. PST, Saturday, February 3, at 6:45 p.m. PST and Sunday, February 4, at 1:45 p.m. PST.

VELOCITY TOUR, INTERNATIONAL AND TOURING PRO DIVISION POINTS – All non-Unleash The Beast (UTB) events award Velocity Global points, including Pendleton Whisky Velocity Tour events, Touring Pro Division events and events held internationally in Australia, Brazil, Canada, and Mexico. The only exception is National Finals held abroad, which will only award national points, not Velocity Global points. The point system at each event is tiered based on added money in USD, and other factors determined by the PBR. Each event, depending on the tier will get points in accordance with the tables below.

- Tier 1 Events \$20,000 or more USD in added money.
- Tier 2 Events \$10,000 \$19,999 USD in added money.
- Tier 3 Events \$9,999 USD or less in added money.

Additionally, riders at all events receive bonus points via their ride score. A rider who scores 70-79.75 points will earn 7 bonus points, 80-89.75 8 bonus points and 90-99.75 9 bonus points.
