



## 2024 PBR Unleash The Beast PBR Salt Lake City Delta Center – Salt Lake City, Utah Friday, February 9 at 7:45 p.m. MST Saturday, February 10 at 6:45 p.m. MST

**SALT LAKE CITY SHOWDOWN** – This weekend, for the fifth time ever and the first time since 2020, PBR’s elite 2024 Unleash The Beast travels to Salt Lake City, Utah, for PBR Salt Lake City, the eleventh event of the 24-event 2024 individual season. Delta Center will host the PBR for two days of action on Friday, February 9, starting at 7:45 p.m. MST, and Saturday, February 10, starting at 6:45 p.m. MST.

**LEME IS BACK** – Several notable names return to action on the elite Unleash The Beast this weekend, headlined by two-time PBR World Champion Jose Vitor Leme. The Brazilian superstar began his season going a perfect 3-for-3 in Tucson, Arizona, capped with an incredible 90.75-point ride on Highwire in the championship round, before continuing his flawless start in Round 1 in St. Louis, Missouri, in December. However, Leme suffered a lower-body injury during his 86.25-point ride on Buffalo Chip, sidelining him for the next two months. After missing the first couple of months of the season in 2023, the former World Champion showed no rust, winning his first two events of the year in New York and Chicago. The Brazilian cowboy, who won the event the last time the top tour bucked into Salt Lake City, is tasked with Modified Ride in Round 1 on Friday.

In addition to Leme returning from injury, Kyler Oliver, Keyshawn Whitehorse, Ezekiel Mitchell and Daniel Keeping punched their tickets back to the top tour courtesy of standout efforts in recent Pendleton Whisky Velocity Tour (PWVT) events.

Hailing from Roy, Utah, Oliver went 1-for-7 to start the season and was cut from the elite Unleash The Beast. Undeterred, the resilient cowboy re-found his form on the Pendleton Whisky Velocity Tour, going 5-for-10 and recording three Top-10 finishes in five events over the last month, including winning the event in Spokane, Washington. Fellow Utah native Whitehorse also struggled to start the year but returned to form at the PWVT event in Bakersfield, California, going a perfect 2-for-2 to win the event. Oliver battles High Plains Drifter in the opening round in front of his home-state crowd while Whitehorse shares a chute with Lapua.

Mitchell, who started the season 1-for-9, also proved why he has been a staple among bull riding’s best. Undeterred by a four-out buck-off streak on the PWVT, the ebullient cowboy bounced back and caught fire. He has covered five of his last six bulls, finishing seventh in Reno, Nevada, before going a perfect 3-for-3 to win the PWVT event in Greenville, North Carolina. Another Texan joins him back on the premier series, as Keeping went 2-for-3 and finished second in Laredo, Texas, to earn an invite to Salt Lake City. Mitchell faces off with Trump Train in Round 1 while Keeping takes on Dropping Gears.

**OUTSTANDING OUTLAWS** – Something might be in the water in Kansas City, as the Chiefs return to the Super Bowl and the Kansas City Outlaws currently have five riders in the Top 15 of the Unleash The Beast standings, headlined by No. 1 Cassio Dias and now-No. 10 Leonardo Castro Ferreira, who was the only rider to go a perfect 4-for-4 to take home the victory in Sacramento, California, last weekend.

Ferreira, in search of his first career premier series event win, roared out of the chutes on Pookie Holler for 87 points in Round 1 before hanging on to First String for 58 points in Round 2. After covering Blackstone for 86.5 points in Round 3, the rookie held the second spot in the standings entering the championship round. Choosing HomeBru as his final animal athlete opponent, Ferreira thundered out of the gate and took the event lead with an 87-point ride. After fellow rookie Callum Miller had his event buckle bid ended by Manaba in 2.2 seconds, Ferreira was crowned the second PBR Major victor, propelling him a massive 220

points up the standings into the Top 10. The young Brazilian, who was taken in the second round of the 2023 Protected Roster Draft by the Outlaws and went 7-for-14 for the team last season, shares a chute with Monstrosity in Round 1 on Friday.

Three of the Top-10 duo's teammates sit just behind them in the gold buckle race, as No. 11 Wingson Henrique da Silva, No. 12 Koltin Hevalow and No. 15 Julio Cesar Marques have all had a stellar start to the 2024 season and each made the 8 last weekend.

After having his back against the cut line heading into Tulsa, Oklahoma, Silva has returned to form. The 2023 Rookie of the Year runner-up won his first individual premier series event in Houston, going a perfect 3-for-3, to continue a six-out ride streak. He began his flawless performance in Texas by covering Bison for 78.25 points in Round 1 and Mighty Mike for 85.25 points in Round 2. Saving his best out for last, the Brazilian rocketed out of the gates on I'm Legit Too in the championship round and converted for 90 points by being marked three points above the bull. Silva extended his ride streak to seven in Round 1 in Sacramento, riding Bruisin' for 76 points, but he was bucked off in his final two outs. He takes on Reinstate Hank Friday evening in Utah.

Hevalow also went 1-for-3 in Sacramento, topping Lights Out for 81.25 points in the opening round. The level-headed Missourian has covered 10 of his 25 animal athlete opponents this season after starting the year 0-for-5. In that stretch, he has only been bucked off three times in a row once and recorded two Top-10 finishes in Johnstown, Pennsylvania, and New York City. In the Quaker State, Hevalow caught fire, ending his five-out buck-off streak to start the season by topping Sandman for 85.5 points in Round 2. Now in a groove, he topped Tijuana Two-Step for 88 points in Round 3 and took advantage of a re-ride opportunity in the championship round to cover Whiskey Trip for 89 points, rocketing him up to fourth in the mid-December event. In Madison Square Garden in January, Hevalow proved he was built for the bright lights, riding his first three bovine competitors. While he was bucked off Red Scorpion in the championship round, he finished third in his first career PBR Major. Hevalow faces Taz in Round 1 in Salt Lake City.

A fellow rookie like Dias and Ferreira, Marques is the last of the Kansas City squad to sit in the Top 15. Posting three Top 10 finishes in Johnstown, Albany and New York City, the young Brazilian is 8-for-26 this year on the top tour. Last weekend in Sacramento, Marques proved his resiliency, as he rallied back to top Dirty Dave for 85.5 points in Round 3 after being kept off the board in his first two outs. While his 1-for-3 performance wasn't enough to earn a spot in the championship round, the young gun showed he had re-found his form, posting a solid 3.0 rider over bull score. He shares a chute with Devil's Revenge in Round 1 this weekend.

**DIAS INCREASES LEAD ATOP THE STANDINGS** – After being shut out in Houston, No. 1 Cassio Dias increased his lead in the standings with No. 2 Austin Richardson out due to injury by going 2-for-4 and finishing seventh in Sacramento. Dias started strong, topping Manaba for 83 points in the opening round. After being bucked off by Brusta in 2.21 seconds in Round 2, the Brazilian proved his mettle, rebounding and covering Big Red for 85.5 points to punch his ticket to the championship round. While he was bucked off by Erik The Red in 2.37 seconds, Dias netted 45.3 UTB points to increase his lead over Richardson in the gold buckle race as the mid-point of the season approaches.

After sitting atop the standings for a month, Dias briefly lost his hold on the top spot to Richardson after the Texan won back-to-back titles in the Empire State at the beginning of the new year. However, Dias bounced back in Chicago, going a perfect 3-for-3 and winning his premier series-leading third event of the season. The MVP runner-up for the Kansas City Outlaws in the Camping World Team Series, Dias finished tied for fourth in the first round with an 87-point ride on IHOP. Now on a roll, the Brazilian tied for second in Round 2, scoring 86.75 points on Grey Fox to earn the second pick in the championship pen heading into the final round. Choosing Do Dat Eddie, Dias saved his best for last, storming out of the gates for an event-high-tying 89 points to overtake Cort McFadden, who was making his PBR debut, in the event standings. After the young Texan was bucked off Polar Express in 5.26 seconds, Dias knew he was back on top in the race for a gold buckle. The phenomenal young rookie hopes to keep rolling in Salt Lake City, Utah, on Badger in Round 1 on Friday.

**ROOKIES STILL ROLLING** – Rookies make up almost half of the Top 30 of this year's championship race, as 13 sit in the Top 30 of the Unleash The Beast standings. Three currently sit in the Top 10 of the Unleash The Beast standings (No. 1 Cassio Dias, No. 4 John Crimber and No. 10 Leonardo Castro Ferreira), and seven finished inside the Top 10 in Sacramento.

In addition to Dias and Ferreira's stellar performances in the Big Tomato, Crimber also had his best outing of the season. Despite bucking off Smooth Steel in Round 1, the young phenom rallied, covering Sky Walker for 86.75 points in Round 2.

Now on a roll, the Texan won the final two rounds, topping Regulator for 88.25 points in Round 3 and Chateau Montelena's Montana Jacket for an event-high 89.75 points in the championship round, catapulting him atop the event standings. While Ferreira would eventually overtake him, Crimber's second-place finish and two round wins garnered 192 points and pushed him into the Top 5 of the Unleash The Beast standings. The teenage cowboy is now one of just five riders with three or more round wins this season and one of just four riders to record two round wins in the same event in 2024, joining Dias, Austin Richardson and Cody Jesus. Crimber squares off with Gangster Time in Round 1.

In just his second premier series event, Callum Miller held the event lead heading into the championship round after starting 3-for-3 last weekend. The Australian cowboy rode Trump Train for 86.5 points in Round 1 before topping California Hearthrob for 85.75 points in Round 2. The rookie then earned his pick of the pen in the championship round by making the 8 for 85.25 points on Sharp Shooter in Round 3. Choosing Manaba as his final animal athlete opponent, Miller briefly sat tall atop the powerful bovine before being flung to the dirt after 2.2 seconds. Miller dances with Cocky to begin the weekend in Salt Lake City.

No. 13 Caden Bunch also had a strong showing in Sacramento, beginning his weekend by riding Regulator for 87.75 points in Round 1 and Dream Walkin for 84.25 points in Round 2. While he was bucked off by Full Throttle in 5.19 seconds in Round 3 and Ricky Vaughn in 5.5 seconds in the championship round, the Oklahoman's 2-for-4 performance placed him fourth in the aggregate. His two rides also showed a return to form for the rookie who was mired in a seventeen-out buck-off streak after winning the first event of the season in Tucson, as Bunch posted a 2.5 ride over bull score in Sacramento. Bunch takes on Concho in Round 1 on Friday.

No. 26 Cort McFadden and No. 30 Clay Guiton also went 2-for-4, finishing sixth and ninth, respectively. McFadden was bucked off I'm Him in 4.96 seconds in Round 1 but rallied to ride Trump Train for 83 points in Round 2 and Boo Ray in Round 3. Unfortunately, Bull of the Event winner Johnny Smooth bested the young Texan in 1.62 seconds in the championship round to close out his weekend. Guiton, looking to stay hot after two straight Top-5 finishes, also bounced back after a Round 1 buck-off at the hooves of No Cigar in 3.86 seconds. The North Carolinian rode Candy Cane for 82 points and Top Shelf for 82.5 points before being unseated by Brusta in 2.39 seconds in the championship round. McFadden battles Desperado in Round 1 while Guiton duels Blackstone.

**FAMILIAR WATERS** – Round 1 of the 2024 PBR event in Salt Lake City, Utah, will feature three rematches.

- Boudreaux Campbell takes on Ah Hell for the first time since he was unseated in 4.21 seconds in Tucson, Arizona, in 4.21 seconds.
- Caden Bunch tries to repeat his success on Concho, who he covered for 89.25 points in the championship round in Tucson, Arizona, to cap a walk-off victory, the Oklahoma cowboy's first career premier series victory.
- Kaiden Loud battles Big Worm for the second time after he was bucked off in 3.6 seconds in Sacramento, California, last weekend.

**PAST SALT LAKE CITY WINNERS** – When the elite Unleash The Beast last bucked into Salt Lake City in August of 2020, Jose Vitor Leme went a perfect 3-for-3 to win his fifth event of the season. He began the weekend by tying for a round 1 win, covering War Party for 88.25 points. The Brazilian superstar followed that up by riding Rudy Can Do for 87.5 points, earning the second selection in the championship round, right behind Daylon Swearingen. Leme, now seemingly unstoppable, rocketed out of the gates aboard Chiseled for a monstrous, round-winning, event-high 94 points to seize the event lead. Swearingen attempted to respond on Sky Harbor, but he was flung to the dirt in 2.98 seconds. Leme went on to win his first of two gold buckles that season.

**WORLD CHAMPION BULL RACE** – The 2024 YETI PBR World Champion Bull race has been dominated by Man Hater with just a few months left in the year-long campaign. Spanning back to the 2023 PBR Camping World Team Series' season, the powerful bovine competitor has bucked off all 15 of his cowboy opponents and he currently holds a 1.35-point lead over UTZ BesTex Legend in the standings. After being marked 46.25 points for his buck-off of Brady Fielder in the championship

round in Tulsa, Man Hater currently boasts seven of the Top 10 bull scores this season and he has won the Bull of the Event title seven times. Putting that into perspective, the reigning back-to-back World Champion Bull, Ridin' Solo, was named the Bull of the Event just five times during the 2023 campaign. In Houston, Red Demon became the first animal athlete other than Man Hater to claim more than one Bull of the Event title this season, marked an impressive 47 points for bucking off Joao Ricardo Vieira in 2.3 seconds in the championship round to rise to sixth in the standings. After surrendering an 88.5-point ride to Alan de Souza in St. Louis, Missouri, Legend has put together a five-out buck-off streak to somewhat close the gap on Man Hater. A member of the 2023 PBR Stock Contractor of the Year Blake Sharp's pen, Legend has bucked off 14 of the 15 riders he has faced so far. Right behind him in the standings is Flyin Wired, who sits 1.61 points back of the leader. While he has given up two rides in his six outs, both went for 90 or more points, as Wingson Henrique da Silva covered him for 92.5 points at the PBR Teams Championship in Las Vegas while Joao Ricardo Vieira topped him for 91.75 points to win the event in Tulsa.

**2024 POINTS TABLES** – The 2024 PBR Unleash The Beast season keeps the same point structure as 2023 but adds PBR Majors while removing 15/15 Bucking Battles and having two separate aggregates at the PBR World Finals. The 2024 World Champion will be the rider who earns the most points only at Unleash The Beast (UTB) events, including at the 2024 PBR World Finals on May 10-19 in the Dallas-Fort Worth Metroplex. The three PBR Majors in New York City (January 5-7, won by Austin Richardson), Sacramento, California (February 2-4), and Albuquerque, New Mexico (March 22-24), will offer increased payouts and points. There will be three PBR tours in the U.S. in action for the first half of 2024: PBR Unleash The Beast (November 10 – May 19); Pendleton Whisky Velocity Tour (Jan. 5 – May 4) and PBR Touring Pro Division (Oct. 19 – May 19). Points accumulated in non-UTB events domestically, as well as PBR's international tours, will be tallied as Velocity Global points. Velocity Global points, which will also be used to crown the 2024 PBR Pendleton Whisky Velocity Tour Champion, will help determine the athletes who can earn a future draw spot on the elite Unleash The Beast following the tour's first four events.

Those with the most points earned during their four most recent Velocity Global or Unleash The Beast events will join the UTB, replacing riders who had fallen to the bottom of the pack during select cuts throughout the season. Riders ranked in the No. 36-40 range in the UTB standings will be subject to being cut. During each cut, the open positions will first be filled with those riders having injury exemptions, followed by the Premier Series Qualifier List, based on Velocity Global points. Following each cut, these riders will take the place of the demoted riders in the sport's top series to make up the 40-rider field heading into the next event. Riders ranked No. 1-35 on the UTB will remain on the PBR's elite tour. Following the initial cut after the event in Manchester, New Hampshire, subsequent cuts will be held every two weeks. The second cut will drop the bottom six riders from UTB, the third cut will drop the bottom seven riders, and the fourth and remaining cuts will remove the bottom eight riders from UTB.

Points will be awarded as follows for the Unleash The Beast, including World Finals, as well as Tier 1 Velocity Global events:

Bonus points are awarded across all levels of PBR competition. A rider who scores 70-79.75 points will earn 7 bonus points, 80-89.75 8 bonus points and 90-99.75 9 bonus points. The exception is if a contestant declines a re-ride due to an inferior bull. In that case, he does not earn bonus points.

Each of the 35 competing riders will get on one bull in Round 1 on Friday and Round 2 on Saturday. The 12 bull riders with the top combined ride scores following Rounds 1 and 2 will then advance to the championship round following Round 2 on Saturday.
