

2024 PBR Unleash The Beast Wrangler PBR Billings Presented by Cooper Tires First Interstate Arena at MetraPark – Billings, Montana Friday, April 12 at 7:45 p.m. MDT Saturday, April 13 at 6:45 p.m. MDT Sunday, April 14 at 1:45 p.m. MDT

MAGIC CITY BUCKOFF – This weekend, for the 29th consecutive season, PBR's elite 2024 Unleash The Beast travels to Billings, Montana, for Wrangler PBR Billings, presented by Cooper Tires, the twentieth event of the 24-event 2024 individual season. First Interstate Arena at MetraPark will host the PBR for three days of action on Friday, April 12 at 7:45 p.m. MDT, Saturday, April 13, at 6:45 p.m. MDT and Sunday, April 14 at 1:45 p.m. MDT.

DIAS DOMINATES IN SIOUX FALLS – No. 1 Cassio Dias lit up the scoreboard once again in Sioux Falls, South Dakota, winning his sixth event of the season with a 3-for-4 performance. Justin McBride and Jose Vitor Leme are tied with eight event wins for the most in a season. Dias now has a 580.5-point lead over No. 2 John Crimber. In Round 1 in Sioux Falls, Dias roared out of the gates on Miller Time but was bucked off in 6.26 seconds. Undeterred, the Brazilian rebounded and recorded three straight rides, sitting tall atop Medicine Red for 84.5 points in Round 2 and Blown Away for 87 points in Round 3. Now in top form, Dias stole the show with a monstrous, round-winning, event-high 90.5 points on Ricky Vaughn, <u>his eighth 90-point ride of the season, twice as many as the second most (Crimber: 4)</u>. With four events left in the season, Dias is just a few points shy of clinching the No. 1 ranking heading into the PBR World Finals in May.

Before a rare shutout in Nampa, Idaho, Dias dazzled the previous weekend in Albuquerque, New Mexico, putting together a stellar 3-for-4 performance in The Pit. A breakout star for the Kansas City Outlaws on the separate PBR Camping World Team Series, the 22-year-old Brazilian bounced back after bucking off Mahan in 3.32 seconds, riding Show-Off for 85.5 points in Round 2 and I'm Your Daddy for 86.75 points in Round 3 to punch his ticket to the championship round. Choosing Man Hater, the 2024 YETI PBR World Champion Bull frontrunner, as his final animal athlete opponent once again, Dias stormed out of the gates in perfect time with the rank bovine for a monstrous 93.25 points, at the time his premier-series-leading seventh 90-point ride this season. That pairing is quickly becoming must-watch television, as the Brazilian cowboy is still the only rider to cover Man Hater this year. In their first dance, the duo burst out of the gate in the championship round in front of a roaring Crypto.com Arena, posting a mind-boggling, 94.75-point score, the highest-marked ride since Jose Vitor Leme topped Ridin' Solo for 94.75 points in Oklahoma City in February of 2022 and the highest ride in PBR history in California.

In Little Rock, Arkansas, in March, Dias was once again victorious, hoisting his fifth event buckle after going a perfect 3-for-3. The burgeoning superstar flew out of the gate on T-Wrecks for a modest 83 points, placing him eighth in the event standings entering the final day of competition. Dias then locked in, winning Round 2 by covering Tulsa Time for 89.25 points to punch his ticket to the championship round. There, the Brazilian roared out of the chutes on Dark Thoughts for an event-high 90.5 points.

After sitting atop the standings for a month early in the season, Dias briefly lost his hold on the top spot to Austin Richardson after the Texan won back-to-back titles in the Empire State at the beginning of the new year. However, Dias bounced back in Chicago, going a perfect 3-for-3 and winning his premier series-leading third event of the season. The MVP runner-up for the Kansas City Outlaws in the PBR Camping World Team Series, Dias finished tied for fourth in the first round with an 87-point ride on IHOP. Now on a roll, the Brazilian tied for second in Round 2, scoring 86.75 points on Grey Fox to earn the second pick in the championship pen. Choosing Do Dat Eddie, Dias saved his best for last, storming out of the gates for an event-high-tying

89 points to overtake Cort McFadden, who was making his PBR debut, in the event standings. After the young Texan was bucked off Polar Express in 5.26 seconds, Dias knew he was back on top in the race for a gold buckle.

Now enjoying his thirteenth consecutive week occupying the No. 1 spot in the standings, <u>the Brazilian cowboy is currently 10-for-14 (71.43%) in Championship Rounds</u>, the second-highest riding percentage in the final round for all riders with multiple championship round performances, trailing only No. 11 Kaique Pacheco (3-for-4, 75%). Dias looks to seal the No. 1 spot in the regular season in Billings this weekend, beginning his quest on Gucci in Round 1.

AUSSIE, AUSSIE, **AUSSIE** – For the first time since the tour competed in Los Angeles, California, in February 2020, this weekend's Unleash The Beast features three riders from down under, as No. 10 Brady Fielder, No. 38 Callum Miller and Ben Bode are all set to ride in Billings.

Fielder has been a staple in and around the Top 10 of the 2024 Unleash The Beast standings since winning his first career premier series event in Manchester, New Hampshire, in December. Tacking on six more Top 10 finishes, Fielder is now 18-for-50 (36%) on the season, including two 90-point rides. The Aussie is also heating up as the regular season comes to a close, recording back-to-back Top 10 finishes in Nampa, Idaho, and Sioux Falls, South Dakota, over the past two weekends. He takes on Jersey Tuff in Round 1 on Friday evening.

Hailing from Warwick, Queensland, Miller has split his time between the elite Unleash The Beast and the Pendleton Whisky Velocity Tour. Making the most of his opportunity on the premier series in Sacramento, California, in February, Miller went 3-for-4 and placed third at the second PBR Major of the season. However, apart from those three rides, the Australian cowboy has been unable to make the 8 on the top tour. Now with another opportunity as he replaces the injured Caden Bunch in Billings, Miller is ready to cement his spot on the premier series, taking on Miller Time in Round 1.

The final cowboy from the Sunburnt Country to compete in Billings is 20-year-old Ben Bode, who is making his Unleash The Beast debut. Bode made his PBR debut in December of 2022 in Rockhampton, Queensland, before heading to the United States to further his career. Returning to his homeland for the start of the 2024 season, Bode is currently No. 3 in the PBR Australia Standings, sitting 89 points behind No. 1 Boston Leather. He takes on Highwire in his first premier series out on Friday.

FROM CORY TO CORT – No. 18 Cort McFadden is one of many rookies who has taken the premier series by storm this season. He has been kept off the scoreboard just once in 12 events this season, going 0-for-2 in Houston, Texas, in just his third career Unleash The Beast event in January. Since then, McFadden hasn't bucked off more than three consecutive times, and he has finished inside the Top 10 four times this year, highlighted by a career-best third-place finish in Salt Lake City, Utah, in February. The young Texan is now 14-for-35 (40%) on the season heading into Billings, where his father, Cory McFadden, recorded the highest ride score in Billings history, posting a legendary, 95.5-point ride on Little Yellow Jacket in 2002. Recently acquired by the Oklahoma Wildcatters from the Austin Gamblers as part of a blockbuster trade during the 2024 PBR Teams Expansion Draft, the younger McFadden shares a chute with Big Cannon in Round 1 on Friday.

FAMILIAR WATERS - Round 1 of the 2024 PBR event in Billings, Montana, will feature seven rematches.

- Alex Cerqueira takes on Border Crisis for the second time after he was bucked off in 4.04 seconds in Little Rock, Arkansas, earlier this year in March.
- Andrew Alvidrez shares a chute with Mr. Nasty for the third time. The animal athlete bested Alvidrez in 1.57 seconds in their first meeting in March of 2023 in Albuquerque, New Mexico, before the Texas cowboy got his revenge in Greensboro, North Carolina, later that year in September, covering him for 88.25 points.
- Eduardo Aparecido and Wild Card dueled for the first time earlier this year in Albuquerque in March. The duo posted an 87.75-point outing at the final PBR Major of the 2024 season.
- Felipe Furlan tries to make the 8 for the first time aboard Jersey Mike after bucking off in 3.09 seconds in Salt Lake City, Utah, in February.
- Mauricio Gulla Moreira dances with Manaba for the first time since being bucked off in 5.03 seconds the PBR World Finals in Fort Worth, Texas, in May of 2022.

- Paulo Eduardo Rossetto tries to ride Let's Roll for the second time after he was bucked off in 4.04 seconds last weekend in Sioux Falls, South Dakota.
- Vitor Losnake looks to make the 8 on Flapjack for the first time after being bucked off in 3.5 seconds in Belton, Texas, in September of 2022.

PAST BILLINGS EVENT WINNERS – Cooper Davis went an impressive 3-for-4 to win the Billings event buckle in 2023. The 2016 PBR World Champion began his weekend aboard Taylor's Cowtown Throwdown, making the 8 for 88.75 points. Now in a groove, the Texan roared out of the gates on Toasted in Round 2 for 87 points. He then matched that outing in the following round, scoring another 87 points on Savage to earn his pick of the pen heading into the championship round. Choosing Ricky Vaughn as his final animal athlete opponent, Davis shot out of the gate in search of a perfect 4-for-4 performance but was denied by the powerful bovine competitor in just three seconds. His 12th career premier series victory propelled him to No. 4 in the Unleash The Beast standings.

No. 1 ranked Kaique Pacheco finished second to Davis, also going 3-for-4. The Brazilian rallied back after bucking off DirtyBru in Round 1 to record three consecutive rides, topping Fajita for 86 points in Round 2, Whatever for 85.5 points in Round 3 and Pookie Holler for 86.25 points in his final out. While his late-event surge wasn't enough to overtake Davis, he did extend his lead in the 2023 Unleash The Beast standings to 118.5 points over the injured Jose Vitor Leme.

WORLD CHAMPION BULL RACE - The 2024 YETI PBR World Champion Bull race has been dominated by Man Hater with just over a month left in the year-long campaign. Spanning back to the 2023 PBR Camping World Team Series season, the powerful boyine competitor had bucked off all 15 of his cowboy opponents until Cassio Dias covered him for a season-high 94.75 points in the championship round in Los Angeles to take the event title. The elite animal athlete sought his revenge in Albuquerque, New Mexico, but Dias once again made the 8, this time for a monstrous 93.25 points. Despite the two rides, Man Hater currently holds a 1.28-point average score lead over UTZ BesTex Legend in the standings. After being marked 46.25 points for his buck-off of Brady Fielder in the championship round in Tulsa, Man Hater currently boasts seven of the Top 10 bull scores this season and he has won the Bull of the Event title an incredible nine times. Putting that into perspective, the reigning back-to-back World Champion Bull, Ridin' Solo, was named the Bull of the Event just five times during the 2023 campaign. In Houston, Red Demon became the first animal athlete other than Man Hater to claim more than one Bull of the Event title this season, marked an impressive 47 points for bucking off Joao Ricardo Vieira in 2.3 seconds in the championship round, rising to fourth in the standings. In Sioux Falls, the powerful bovine competitor overtook Flyin Wired for third in the standings by winning his third Bull of the Event title, bucking off Sage Kimzey in 3.07 seconds. After surrendering an 88.5point ride to Alan de Souza in St. Louis, Missouri, Legend has put together an eight-out buck-off streak to somewhat close the gap on Man Hater. A member of the 2023 PBR Stock Contractor of the Year Blake Sharp's pen, Legend has bucked off 17 of the 18 riders he has faced so far.

2024 POINTS TABLES – The 2024 PBR Unleash The Beast season keeps the same point structure as 2023 but adds PBR Majors while removing 15/15 Bucking Battles and having two separate aggregates at the PBR World Finals. The 2024 World Champion will be the rider who earns the most points only at Unleash The Beast (UTB) events, including at the 2024 PBR World Finals on May 10-19 in the Dallas-Fort Worth Metroplex. The three PBR Majors in New York City (January 5-7, won by

Austin Richardson), Sacramento, California (February 2-4, won by Leonardo Castro Ferreira), and Albuquerque, New Mexico (March 22-24, won by Eduardo Aparecido), offer increased payouts and points. There will be three PBR tours in the U.S. in action for the first half of 2024: PBR Unleash The Beast (November 10 - May 19); Pendleton Whisky Velocity Tour (Jan. 5 - May 4) and PBR Touring Pro Division (Oct. 19 - May 19). Points accumulated in non-UTB events domestically, as well as PBR's international tours, will be tallied as Velocity Global points. Velocity Global points, which will also be used to crown the 2024 PBR Pendleton Whisky Velocity Tour Champion, will help determine the athletes who can earn a future draw spot on the elite Unleash The Beast following the tour's first four events.

Those with the most points earned during their four most recent Velocity Global or Unleash The Beast events will join the UTB, replacing riders who had fallen to the bottom of the pack during select cuts throughout the season. Riders ranked in the No. 36-40 range in the UTB standings will be subject to being cut. During each cut, the open positions will first be filled with those riders having injury exemptions, followed by the Premier Series Qualifier List, based on Velocity Global points. Following each cut, these riders will take the place of the demoted riders in the sport's top series to make up the 40-rider field heading into the next event. Riders ranked No. 1-35 on the UTB will remain on the PBR's elite tour. Following the initial cut after the event in Manchester, New Hampshire, subsequent cuts will be held every two weeks. The second cut will drop the bottom six riders from UTB, the third cut will drop the bottom seven riders, and the fourth and remaining cuts will remove the bottom eight riders from UTB.

Points will be awarded as follows for the Unleash The Beast, including World Finals, as well as Tier 1 Velocity Global events:

Bonus points are awarded across all levels of PBR competition. A rider who scores 70-79.75 points will earn 7 bonus points, 80-89.75 8 bonus points and 90-99.75 9 bonus points. The exception is if a contestant declines a re-ride due to an inferior bull. In that case, he does not earn bonus points.

THIS WEEKEND'S FORMAT – Wrangler PBR Billings, presented by Cooper Tires, the twentieth Unleash The Beast event of the 2024 season, will feature four rounds of bull riding. Each of the 38 competing riders will get on one bull in Round 1 on Friday and Round 2 on Saturday. Every contestant who has a qualified ride in the first two rounds will be eligible to compete in Round 3 on Sunday. If there are fewer than 30 riders with a qualified ride after two rounds, Round 3 will fill the remaining spots to get to the 30-man minimum based on the UTB Standings entering the event. The 12 bull riders with the top combined ride scores following Rounds 1, 2, and 3 will then advance to the championship round following Round 3 on Sunday.

NEXT UP – The PBR Unleash The Beast next travels to Everett, Washington, for PBR Everett. The event is on Wednesday, April 17, at 7:45 p.m. PDT, and Thursday, April 18 at 7:45 p.m. PDT at Angel of the Winds Arena.

VELOCITY TOUR, INTERNATIONAL AND TOURING PRO DIVISION POINTS – All non-Unleash The Beast (UTB) events award Velocity Global points, including Pendleton Whisky Velocity Tour events, Touring Pro Division events and events held internationally in Australia, Brazil, Canada, and Mexico. The only exception is National Finals held abroad, which will only award national points, not Velocity Global points. The point system at each event is tiered based on added money in USD, and other factors determined by the PBR. Each event, depending on the tier will get points in accordance with the tables below.

- Tier 1 Events \$20,000 or more USD in added money.
- Tier 2 Events \$10,000 \$19,999 USD in added money.
- Tier 3 Events \$9,999 USD or less in added money.

Additionally, riders at all events receive bonus points via their ride score. A rider who scores 70-79.75 points will earn 7 bonus points, 80-89.75 8 bonus points and 90-99.75 9 bonus points.
