



## **2024 PBR World Finals: Unleash The Beast Eliminations**

**Fort Worth, Texas – Cowtown Coliseum**

**CROWNING A CHAMPION** – The PBR World Finals returns to the Dallas-Fort Worth Metroplex for the third consecutive season but with a brand new three-stage format that begins with Eliminations May 9-12 and Ride For Redemption May 15-16 at Cowtown Coliseum in Fort Worth, Texas, before concluding with the PBR World Finals: Championship inside AT&T Stadium in Arlington, Texas, May 18-19.

The first stage of the PBR World Finals at Cowtown Coliseum, Eliminations, begins Thursday, May 9, at 7:45 p.m. CDT, Friday, May 10, at 6:45 p.m. CDT, Saturday, May 11 at 6:45 p.m. CDT and Sunday, May 12, at 1:45 p.m. CDT.

The action inside the historic arena where the PBR hosted its first event in 1993 continues with the brand-new Ride For Redemption on Wednesday, May 15, at 7:45 p.m. CDT and Thursday, May 16, at 7:45 p.m. CDT.

Then, following Kid Rock’s Rock N Rodeo on Friday, May 17, the PBR World Finals: Championship takes over the home of the Dallas Cowboys in Arlington beginning Saturday, May 18, at 7:45 p.m. CDT and Sunday, May 19, at 1:45 p.m. CDT.

The World Finals is the richest bull riding event in the sport, which includes a \$1 million bonus awarded to the rider who is crowned the PBR World Champion, and the 2024 event will award a record-setting \$3.13 million in prize money.

**THIS WEEKEND’S FORMAT** – For the first time in history, the PBR World Finals will be broken down into three stages: Eliminations, Ride For Redemption and Championship.

For Eliminations, all 45 qualifiers will compete in four long rounds, and at the end of those four long rounds, the Top-15 in the Unleash The Beast standings and the Top-5 in the four-round aggregate not already qualified through the standings will advance to the Championship Rounds at AT&T Stadium next week. Those who do not meet the criteria will have a chance to redeem themselves in the Ride For Redemption rounds on May 15-16. One rider can earn a maximum of 556 Unleash The Beast points during Eliminations, netting 36 points should they score 90+ point rides in each round, 80 points for each round win and 200 points for winning the aggregate. During Eliminations, more than \$770,000 will be paid out, with the top scorer daily collecting \$35,000, and the winner of the four rounds netting \$150,000.

The second leg is Ride For Redemption, featuring the 25 riders who didn’t qualify for the Championship in the first four days of competition joined by 15 riders in a selection process to be announced. All 40 riders will attempt one bull each night, and those contenders with the Top 5 scores in the Ride For Redemption aggregate will earn a berth to the PBR World Finals Championship in Arlington. While no Unleash The Beast points will be awarded during Ride For Redemption, the event will award nearly \$23,000 each night.

The 2024 PBR World Finals will come to a climactic end with the Championship event at AT&T Stadium from May 18-19, featuring the 20 advancing riders from Eliminations and the five competitors who punched their tickets via Ride For Redemption. Each day of competition will feature two rounds, with Rounds 1-2 on Saturday, May 18, followed by Rounds 3-4 on Sunday, May 19. While the 20 riders who earned a berth via Eliminations are guaranteed to compete in all four Championship rounds, the five contenders who advanced via Ride For Redemption must record a score in Round 1 or Round 2 to remain in the World Finals Championship for Rounds 3-4. After Round 4 at the 2024 PBR World Finals Championship, the

new World Champion will be the No. 1-ranked rider in the Unleash The Beast standings. The 2024 PBR World Finals event winner will be the rider with the top aggregate score across the final four rounds of action.

Inside AT&T Stadium, one rider can earn a maximum of 756 Unleash The Beast points, netting 36 points should they score 90+ point rides in each round, 80 points for each round win and 400 points for winning the aggregate. Across those two days, the PBR will award over \$2.31 million, including the \$1 million bonus to the 2024 PBR World Champion, \$350,000 to the World Finals event winner and \$50,000 to each of the four Championship round winners.

**DOMINANT DIAS ENTERS COWTOWN RANKED NO. 1** – Cassio Dias’ dominant 2024 regular season is being called the best rookie season by many. Despite having the No. 1 spot in the standings heading into the PBR World Finals locked up with several events remaining in the regular season, Dias didn’t take his foot off the gas, winning his seventh event of the season in Louisville, Kentucky, one short of the single-season record of eight held by Justin McBride and Jose Vitor Leme. In Round 1, the Brazilian topped Let’s Roll for 86.75 points, good enough for third heading into the final two rounds. After bucking off Smooth Steel in 3.79 seconds, Dias rallied back as he has all season, riding Do Dat Eddie for a clutch 88.75 points in the championship round to take the lead. The victory netted him 115 points in the Unleash The Beast standings and heading into World Finals he leads No. 2 John Crimber by 560.5 points.

Now having spent more than half the season holding the No. 1 spot in the standings, the Brazilian cowboy is currently 11-for-16 (68.75%) in Championship Rounds, the second-highest riding percentage in the final round for all riders with multiple championship round performances, trailing only No. 11 Kaique Pacheco (3-for-4, 75%). Dias’s eleven rides are more than any other rider has outs in the championship round other than No. 5 Alan de Souza, who is 7-for-12 (58.33%). Dias looks to finish strong at his first career PBR World Finals on Sava in Round 1 on Thursday

Before his victory in Louisville, Dias last won in Sioux Falls, South Dakota, the first weekend of April, his sixth event title of the season, with a 3-for-4 performance. In Round 1 in Sioux Falls, Dias roared out of the gates on Miller Time but was bucked off in 6.26 seconds. Undeterred, the Brazilian rebounded and recorded three straight rides, sitting tall atop Medicine Red for 84.5 points in Round 2 and Blown Away for 87 points in Round 3. Now in top form, Dias stole the show with a monstrous, round-winning, event-high 90.5 points on Ricky Vaughn, his eighth 90-point ride of the season, twice as many as the second most (Crimber: 4).

Before a rare shutout in Nampa, Idaho, Dias dazzled the previous weekend in Albuquerque, New Mexico, putting together a stellar 3-for-4 performance in The Pit. A breakout star for the Kansas City Outlaws on the separate PBR Camping World Team Series, the 22-year-old Brazilian bounced back after bucking off Mahan in 3.32 seconds, riding Show-Off for 85.5 points in Round 2 and I’m Your Daddy for 86.75 points in Round 3 to punch his ticket to the championship round. Choosing Man Hater, the 2024 YETI PBR World Champion Bull frontrunner, as his final animal athlete opponent once again, Dias stormed out of the gates in perfect time with the rank bovine for a monstrous 93.25 points, at the time his premier-series-leading seventh 90-point ride this season. That pairing has become must-watch television, as the Brazilian cowboy is still the only rider to cover Man Hater this year. In their first dance, the duo burst out of the gate in the championship round in front of a roaring Crypto.com Arena, posting a mind-boggling, 94.75-point score, the highest-marked ride since Jose Vitor Leme topped Ridin’ Solo for 94.75 points in Oklahoma City in February of 2022 and the highest ride in PBR history in California.

In Little Rock, Arkansas, in March, Dias was once again victorious, hoisting his fifth event buckle after going a perfect 3-for-3. The burgeoning superstar flew out of the gate on T-Wrecks for a modest 83 points, placing him eighth in the event standings entering the final day of competition. Dias then locked in, winning Round 2 by covering Tulsa Time for 89.25 points to punch his ticket to the championship round. There, the Brazilian roared out of the chutes on Dark Thoughts for an event-high 90.5 points.

After sitting atop the standings for a month early in the season, Dias briefly lost his hold on the top spot to Austin Richardson after the Texan won back-to-back titles in the Empire State at the beginning of the new year. However, Dias bounced back in Chicago, going a perfect 3-for-3 and winning his then-premier-series-leading third event of the season. The MVP runner-up on the separate PBR Camping World Team Series, Dias finished tied for fourth in the first round with an 87-point ride on IHOP. Now on a roll, the Brazilian tied for second in Round 2, scoring 86.75 points on Grey Fox to earn the second pick in the championship pen. Choosing Do Dat Eddie, Dias saved his best for last, storming out of the gates for an event-high-tying 89 points to overtake Cort McFadden, who was making his PBR debut, in the event standings. After the young Texan was bucked off Polar Express in 5.26 seconds, Dias knew he was back on top in the race for a gold buckle.

**THE YEAR OF THE ROOKIE** – After Rafael Jose de Brito became the first rookie in PBR history to win a gold buckle in 2023, two rookies top the standings heading into the 2024 PBR World Finals. While Dias has dominated most of the season, No. 2 John Crimber has put together arguably the best season ever by an 18-year-old. The son of 10-time PBR World Finals qualifier Paulo Crimber has won 11 rounds in the regular season after going 1-for-3 and winning Round 2 in Louisville, Kentucky, putting him just two behind Dias’s 13. Crimber’s eleven round wins in the regular season are more than any rider posted in 2023. He became the second youngest rider in PBR history since 2000 to win an elite tour event with his first career premier series victory in Jacksonville, Florida, in February, surpassing Jess Lockwood and trailing only L.J. Jenkins, who won in Columbus, Ohio, in October of 2005, just three months after his 18th birthday.

But Crimber and Dias are not the only rookies who have put together a strong campaign, as there are currently 14 rookies competing in this year’s World Finals, making up 31% of the field. Last year, only eight rookies competed at the PBR World Finals, excluding Joao Lucas Campos, who was making his premier series debut. As a unit, rookies have won an incredible eleven of the twenty-three events, and a rookie has been on top of the Unleash The Beast standings for all but one week throughout the season, as No. 10 Caden Bunch began the Year of the Rookie by winning the first event of the season in Tucson, Arizona, before Cassio Dias took over, giving up the No. 1 spot just once before quickly retaking it. Proving the PBR is in good hands for years to come, at least two rookies have competed in all twenty-three championship rounds this season.

**COOL WHIP TIES HEARTBREAK KID, CLOSES IN ON BUSHWACKER** – Currently ranked No. 24 in the 2024 YETI PBR World Champion Bull race, Cool Whip has now bucked off 40 consecutive riders on the premier series after unseating Jesse Petri in 3.20 seconds in the Championship Round in Tacoma, Washington, in April, bringing him just two buck offs short of Bushwacker’s historic 42-out run. That buck-off streak was the longest in premier series history, spanning from November 1, 2009, to August 16, 2013, and was ended by two-time PBR World Champion J.B. Mauney, who made the 8 for a monstrous 95.25 points in Tulsa, Oklahoma. Cool Whip’s streak dates back to May 12, 2022, when he bucked off the soon-to-be-crowned World Champion Daylon Swearingen in 3.91 seconds. After finishing fourth in the 2023 PBR World Champion Bull race, the powerful animal athlete has bucked off all ten riders he has faced on the elite Unleash The Beast this season. After competing twice in Washington state in April, the rank bovine took a well-deserved break in preparation for chasing down history at the PBR World Finals in Fort Worth, Texas, though he will have to earn it. The elite animal athlete is guaranteed one out at the PBR World Finals in Round 2 on Friday, May 10, and should he buck off his opponent and perform well enough, can earn a second out for a chance of tying Bushwacker’s storied 42-out buck-off record.

**WORLD CHAMPION BULL RACE** – The 2024 YETI PBR World Champion Bull race has been dominated by Man Hater with just one event remaining in the year-long campaign. Spanning back to the 2023 PBR Camping World Team Series season, the powerful bovine competitor had bucked off all 15 of his cowboy opponents until Cassio Dias covered him for a season-high 94.75 points in the championship round in Los Angeles to take the event title. The elite animal athlete sought his revenge in Albuquerque, New Mexico, but Dias once again made the 8, this time for a monstrous 93.25 points. Despite the two rides, Man Hater currently holds a 1.22-point lead on The Intimidator, who joined the ranks of the Top 10 after an impressive 2.24-second buck off of Kyler Oliver for 45.5 points in his 2024 debut to take the No. 2 spot in the standings. After being marked 46.25 points for his buck-off of Brady Fielder in the championship round in Tulsa, Man Hater currently boasts seven of the Top 10 bull scores this season and he has won the Bull of the Event title an incredible nine times. Putting that into perspective, the reigning back-to-back World Champion Bull, Ridin’ Solo, was named the Bull of the Event just five times during the 2023 campaign. In Houston, Red Demon became the first animal athlete other than Man Hater to claim more than one Bull of the Event title this season, marked an impressive 47 points for bucking off Joao Ricardo Vieira in 2.3 seconds in the championship round, rising to fourth in the standings. In Sioux Falls, the powerful bovine competitor won his third Bull of the Event title, bucking off Sage Kimzey in 3.07 seconds. After surrendering an 88.5-point ride to Alan de Souza in St. Louis, Missouri, No. 3 UTZ BesTex Legend put together a ten-out buck-off streak to somewhat close the gap and is currently sitting 1.28 points behind the top spot. A member of the 2023 PBR Stock Contractor of the Year Blake Sharp’s pen, Legend has bucked off 19 of the 21 riders he has faced this year after giving up a monstrous 91.5-point ride to Sage Kimzey in Tacoma, Washington.

**VELOCITY ADDITIONS** – Five qualifiers from the Pendleton Whisky Velocity Tour Finals will join the other 40 qualifiers for the PBR World Finals Eliminations. Those five riders are Grayson Cole, Dener Barbosa, Claudio Montanha Jr., Qynn Andersen and Jean Fernandes Perreira.

Cole qualified for his second PBR World Finals as the 2024 Velocity Tour Champion. Throughout the regular season, Cole posted eight Top 5 finishes, including two victories in Bridgeport, Connecticut, and Grand Forks, North Dakota, to take the No. 2 spot in the standings entering the PBR Pendleton Whisky Velocity Tour finals 17.5 points behind No. 1 Ederson Santos. After being bucked off by Smoke Show in 3.04 seconds in Round 1, the Pennsylvanian rallied for a clutch 89.25-point conversion aboard Pearl Snap to win the second round. While he would buck off Game Over in 2.4 seconds, his 1-for-3 performance placed him ninth in the event, catapulting him to the No. 1 spot in the standings.

Dener Barbosa and Jean Fernandes Pereira finished third and fifth, respectively, to claim the remaining two spots at Eliminations based on the Velocity Global standings. While it is Pereira's first career World Finals appearance, it is Barbosa's eighth, as he finished 176.5 Velocity Global points behind Cole after going 1-for-2 last weekend.

Claudio Montanha Jr. went 2-for-3 and finished sixth at the finals in Corpus Christi, Texas, to earn his eighth world finals appearance as the top performer not already qualified at the event. Rounding out the final five invitees is Australia's Qynn Andersen, who earned his spot by being the highest-placing international invite not already qualified at the event, finishing 12<sup>th</sup> with a 1-for-2 outing.

**ABBI CLASSIC ROUND** – The first round of Eliminations will feature an American Bucking Bull Inc. (ABBI) Classic event. There will be 44 bulls competing for a prize purse of nearly \$40,000 with the winning bull collecting more than \$8,000. The four-year-old bulls competing in Fort Worth have been approved by the Livestock Director and are deemed the best young bulls in the nation to try their ability against the best bull riders in the world. This weekend will be the fourth major ABBI Classic competition of the season held in conjunction with the elite Unleash The Beast.

Currently ranked first in the ABBI Classic World Standings, Fast Flow shares a chute with Julio Cesar Marques on Thursday evening. Fast Flow is a perfect 4-for-4 inside the PBR, bucking off Joao Lucas Campos in 1.89 seconds in Louisville, Kentucky, Felipe Furlan in 3.07 seconds in Little Rock, Arkansas, and Silvano Alves in 4.49 seconds in Tulsa, Oklahoma, during the 2024 Unleash The Beast season after unseating Joao Paulo Fernandes in 2.78 seconds in his PBR debut on the Challenger Series in Pilesgrove, New Jersey.

Rip, the son of long-time PBR mainstay Canadian Mist, will share a chute with Alan de Souza in Round 1. In his Unleash The Beast debut, Rip unseated Mauricio Gulla Moreira in 3.74 seconds in Little Rock, Arkansas, before dispatching Thiago Salgado in 5.73 seconds in Little Rock, Arkansas, in April, posting a bull score of 44 points.

Two other bovine competitors to keep an eye on are Goin Solo, in search of his third-consecutive Classic event title, and TBR's Buffalo Joe, who is currently ranked fifth in the ABBI Classic World Standings. The son of two-time PBR World Champion bull Ridin Solo, Goin Solo has yet to be ridden inside the PBR, besting both Briggs Madsen and Wyatt Rogers on the top tour in Tulsa, Oklahoma, and Little Rock, Arkansas. TBR's Buffalo Joe is also perfect in his lone Unleash The Beast out, unseating Dalton Kasel in 2.16 seconds in Little Rock. Goin Solo takes on Jake Morinec while TBR's Buffalo Joe roars out of the gate beneath Jean Fernandes Pereira.

Finally, Precious Pup, full brother of three-time World Finals competitor Manaba, will make his Unleash The Beast debut inside the historic Cowtown Coliseum on Thursday evening. Locked in a chute with Mason Taylor, the powerful bovine competitor has four outs on the Pendleton Whisky Velocity Tour where he was ridden just once by Brady Fielder for 87.5 points at the Pendleton Whisky Velocity Tour finals in Corpus Christi, Texas, during the first weekend of May.

**FAMILIAR WATERS** – Round 1 of Eliminations in Fort Worth, Texas, features three rematches.

- Callum Miller is locked in with Fire Zone for the second time after the animal athlete bested him in 2.41 seconds in Louisville, Kentucky, in April.
- Felipe Furlan squares off with Snoop Dog after covering him for 88 points in Sacramento, California, in February.
- Paulo Eduardo Rossetto battles King Tut in the final rematch of Round 1 after being bucked off in both previous outings. The powerful bovine competitor unseated him in 1.95 seconds in Los Angeles, California, in February and in 5.02 seconds in Little Rock, Arkansas, in March.

**WORLD CHAMPIONS** – The PBR World Champion is the bull rider who earns the most PBR Unleash The Beast points throughout the regular season and the PBR World Finals. In 2023, Rafael Jose de Brito took the bull riding world by storm after a strong rookie campaign on the separate PBR Camping World Team Series. The Brazilian got off to a red-hot start, finishing Top 5 in his first three events in December, but then wouldn't tack on another until his first premier series event title in Eugene, Oregon, in February. The event win not only propelled Brito to No. 5 in the Unleash The Beast standings but focused the rookie. Brito added three more Top 5 finishes to close out the regular season before going 4-for-8 to win the PBR World Finals and become the first rider in history to win a gold buckle in his rookie season and the eighth rider in history to win both the World Finals event title and be crowned PBR World Champion in the same season. Brito is the 21st different rider – and eighth Brazilian – to claim the PBR World Champion gold buckle. His title is the 13th time a rider from Brazil has won what's been called the most difficult individual championship in professional sports. Here is a complete list of PBR World Champions:

**WORLD FINALS EVENT WINNER** – The PBR World Finals event winner is the rider with the most event points after eight rounds of competition. Just eight riders have won the World Finals event and World Championship in the same season – Rafael Jose de Brito in 2023, Daylon Swearingen in 2022, Jose Vitor Leme in 2021, Jess Lockwood in 2019, Silvano Alves in 2014, J.B. Mauney in 2013, Renato Nunes in 2010 and Mike Lee in 2004. Only Robson Palermo has won the event in consecutive years (2011, 2012); he is also the only man to win the event three times (2008, 2011 and 2012). In 2023, the 30<sup>th</sup> anniversary PBR World Finals was held in Dickies Arena in Fort Worth, Texas, where Rafael Jose de Brito went 4-for-8 to claim the event title and become the first rookie to win the PBR World Championship. He is also just the seventh rookie in history to win the PBR World Finals in his rookie season, joining Ronnie Kitchens (1996), Luke Snyder (2001), Jody Newberry (2003), Leme (2017) and Boudreaux Campbell (2020). **ROOKIES OF THE YEAR** – The Rookie of the Year award is presented to the bull rider who earns the most PBR Unleash The Beast points during his first PBR season. From 2003-12, the award was presented to the bull rider who earned the most money during his first PBR season. In 2023, Rafael Jose de Brito put together arguably the greatest rookie season the PBR has ever seen (until the 2024 season) by becoming the first rider in history to complete the trifecta of winning the World Finals while being crowned the PBR Rookie of the Year and World Champion in the same season. A staple on the premier series after a solid rookie campaign with the Texas Rattlers during the inaugural PBR Camping World Team Series season, Brito caught fire towards the end of the season, winning his first individual title on the top tour in Eugene, Oregon, in February, surpassing Daniel Keeping in the Rookie of the Year race and catapulting him to No. 5 in the Unleash The Beast standings. He would just increase his lead over the last two months of the season, finishing by going 4-for-8 at the PBR World Finals in Fort Worth, Texas, in May to complete his clean sweep of the Rookie of the Year, PBR World Champion and PBR World Finals Champion awards.
