

# 2024 PBR Unleash The Beast PBR Monster Energy Buck Off at The Garden, presented by Ariat – UTB Major Madison Square Garden – New York City, New York Friday, January 5 at 7:45 p.m. EST Saturday, January 6 at 6:45 p.m. EST Sunday, January 7 at 1:45 p.m. EST

**BUCKING INTO THE GARDEN** – This weekend, PBR's elite 2024 Unleash The Beast returns to New York City at Madison Square Garden. The sixth stop of the 24-event 2024 individual season will mark the 17th time in history and the third consecutive season the premier series has traveled to the World's Most Famous Arena. New York City will host the PBR for three days of action on Friday, January 5, at 7:45 p.m. EST, Saturday, January 6, at 6:45 p.m. EST and Sunday, January 7, at 1:45 p.m. EST.

RICHARDSON RISES TO NO. 2 – Austin Richardson surged to the No. 2 spot in the Unleash The Beast standings courtesy of a flawless 3-for-3 performance in Albany, New York, during the final weekend of 2023. The Dallas, Texas, native kicked off a perfect ending to the year by covering Martini Houdini for a round-high-tying 86.5 points in the opening round. The 23-year-old cowboy then locked in on championship Saturday, winning Round 2 with a then event-high 88 points on Magic Trick, before completing the clean-sweep of the event and winning the final round with an event-high 88.75 points on Ivy League. Claiming at least a share of the top spot in every single round, Richardson became the first rider this season to win multiple rounds in an event. Richardson's third premier series event win netted him a staggering 157 points in the standings and he is now just 73 points behind No. 1 Cassio Dias. Looking to remain red-hot, Richardson takes on Moonlight Party in Round 1 on Friday.

**BACK TO BUCKING** – Three of the Top 10 ranked riders return to action in New York City after not competing in Albany last weekend, as No. 3 Alan de Souza, No. 4 Cody Jesus and No. 8 Sage Kimzey are all set to ride inside Madison Square Garden. Souza, who also missed the first event of the year in Tucson, Arizona, has placed in the Top 10 in every event he has competed in this season, including a second-place finish in St. Louis, Missouri, and a third-place result in Manchester, New Hampshire. The young Brazilian is sporting an incredible 90% ride percentage, going 9-for-10 to start the season, and takes on Hoka Hey in Round 1 on Friday.

Jesus, who wowed his fellow Arizonans by going a perfect 3-for-3 and finishing fifth in Tucson to begin the year, is facing a three-out buckoff streak after starting the campaign 6-for-6. In an odd twist, this streak matches his Madison Square Garden buckoff streak, which is also three, after he started a flawless 3-for-3 in his New York City debut in 2019. He finished that event seventh, going 3-for-4, and looks to once again shine under the bright lights of the Garden as he dances with Moon Juice in Round 1.

Kimzey is also returning to competition after missing the last two events in the veteran's quest for his first gold buckle. The Oklahoman has gone 5-for-6 on the season, finishing second in Tucson and sixth in St. Louis. Drafted with the first overall pick in the 2023 PBR Teams Draft by the Carolina Cowboys, Kimzey quickly made waves in his return to the PBR by posting three 90-point rides in just 12 outs with the Cowboys. He looks to add to that total in his New York City PBR debut, sharing a chute with Shew Bubby in Round 1 Friday evening.

**DIAS HOLDS STRONG AT NO. 1** – Cassio Dias continued his dominant hold of the No. 1 spot in the Unleash The Beast standings, going 1-for-3 and tying for 11th in Albany last weekend. After being shut out in Manchester, the resilient cowboy bounced back immediately in Round 1, covering Nighttime Crime for 85.75 points. Unable to make the 8 with a heartbreaking 7.99-second buckoff of Black Squirrel in Round 2, Dias couldn't rebound in the championship round, but he had done enough to maintain his No. 1 ranking in the early race for a gold buckle. He faces Red Mosquito in his Madison Square Garden debut in Round 1 on Friday.

Before Manchester, Dias went 3-for-4 and won his second-straight event in Johnstown, Pennsylvania. In Round 1, the Brazilian topped The Judge for 89.25 points and was tied for third entering the second day of action. On Saturday, the Kansas City Outlaws' rising superstar in the separate PBR Teams league was unseated for the first time in 2024, as Train Station shook him off the track to perfection in 4.07 seconds. Undeterred, Dias stormed back, making the 8 for 86.25 points on Strong Arm in Round 3 and winning the championship round with a monstrous, career-high 91.75 points on Cy Young to overtake the lead.

The Brazilian first moved into the No. 1 spot in the Unleash The Beast standings in St. Louis, Missouri, during the first weekend of December. After finishing sixth in Tucson, Dias continued his strong start to the season by topping Buzz for 87.5 points in Round 1. Remaining flawless courtesy of a Round 2 ride aboard Hunted Down for 86.25 points, the Brazilian won his second round of the season in the championship round, covering Mike's Motive for a monstrous 90.5 points.

**FAMILIAR WATERS** – Round 1 of the 2024 PBR event in New York City, New York, will feature eleven rematches.

- Alex Cerqueira takes on Preachers Kid for the second time after being bucked off in 5.4 seconds in Nashville, Tennessee, in August.
- Brady Oleson attempts to convert aboard Mike's Motive for the first time after he was flung off in 3.05 seconds in the pair's first meeting in Greensboro, North Carolina, in September.
- Ednelio Almeida has unfinished business with Sky's The Limit after the animal athlete bested him in 3.27 seconds in Nashville, Tennessee, in August.
- Eduardo Aparecido shares a chute with Smooth Over it for the second time after he was unseated in 2.3 seconds in Tucson, Arizona, in November.
- Joao Ricardo Vieira and Peal Snapped are set for a trilogy bout as the powerful bovine competitor has bested the grizzled veteran in both previous matchups last month, in 3.29 seconds in St. Louis, Missouri, and in 2.11 seconds in Manchester, New Hampshire.
- Kaiden Loud dances with Copenhagen Wild Smile for the second time after being bucked off in 2.3 seconds in Johnstown, Pennsylvania, last December.
- Kaique Pacheco takes on Exodus after the cowboy was forcefully dismounted in 2.08 seconds in Sioux Falls, South Dakota, last April.
- Keyshawn Whitehorse squares off with Centerfold for the third time in search of his first qualified ride on the animal athlete after bucking off in 3.3 seconds in Tacoma, Washington, last April and in 1.91 seconds in Ridgedale, Missouri, the following September.
- Mauricio Gulla Moreira looks to ride Kodiac for the first time after being bested in 5.41 seconds during their first matchup in Manchester, New Hampshire, last month.
- Rafael dos Santos bucked off Whiplash in 4.18 seconds in Greensboro, North Carolina, in September during the duo's only previous meeting.
- Silvano Alves takes on Problem Child for the second time in his illustrious career. The three-time PBR World Champion was unseated in 4.6 seconds in Milwaukee, Wisconsin, in February of 2022.

**PAST NEW YORK CITY EVENT WINNERS** – When the PBR Unleash The Beast last bucked into Madison Square Garden in January 2023, two-time PBR World Champion Jose Vitor Leme rode supreme, going 3-for-4 in his 2023 UTB debut. Showing no rust, the Brazilian easily topped Pickle Moonshine for 87.75 points in Round 1 before covering Bad Decisions for 86.5 points in Round 2. Proving he was human, Leme was unseated by Choc Tease in 3.00 seconds in Round 3, but immediately bounced back to take home the event buckle with a monstrous 92-point ride aboard Cliff Hanger in the championship round. Leme became just the fourth PBR World Champion to win inside the world's most famous arena, joining Jess Lockwood, J.B. Mauney and Guilherme Marchi.

WORLD CHAMPION BULL – The 2024 YETI PBR World Champion bull will be determined by both the 2023 PBR Camping World Team Series season and the 2024 Unleash The Beast (UTB) season. The 2024 World Champion Bull will be determined by their Top 8 outs during the Team Series and UTB regular season and two outs at the PBR World Finals. The Top 7 eligible bulls at the end of the PBR UTB regular season shall be entered into the World Finals and be guaranteed three outs. In the event two or more bulls are tied based on the scoring criteria after the World Finals, the World Champion Bull shall be awarded to the bull who has achieved the highest average score from their two best outs at the World Finals. If a tie still exists after a review of the scores described in the preceding sentence, the bulls will share the title of World Champion Bull, and the prize money will be evenly distributed among the stock contractors who own said bulls.

For avoidance of doubt, if the score that is dropped from the World Finals is higher than the lowest regular season out, the score at World Finals will still be dropped. The top eight (8) regular season outs, and top two (2) World Finals outs are to remain in the calculations for the World Champion Bull award.

**MAJORS RETURN** – The 2024 PBR Unleash The Beast season keeps the same point structure as 2023 but adds PBR Majors while removing 15/15 Bucking Battles and having two separate aggregates at the PBR World Finals. The 2024 World Champion will be the rider who earns the most points only at Unleash The Beast (UTB) events, including at the 2024 PBR World Finals on May 10-19 in the Dallas-Fort Worth Metroplex. The three PBR Majors in New York City (January 5-7), Sacramento, California, (February 2-4) and Albuquerque, New Mexico, (March 22-24) will offer increased payouts and points. There will be three PBR tours in the U.S. in action for the first half of 2024: PBR Unleash The Beast (November 10 – May 19); Pendleton Whisky Velocity Tour (Jan. 5 – May 4) and PBR Touring Pro Division (Oct. 19 – May 19). Points accumulated in non-UTB events domestically, as well as PBR's international tours, will be tallied as Velocity Global points. Velocity Global points, which will also be used to crown the 2024 PBR Pendleton Whisky Velocity Tour Champion, will help determine the athletes who can earn a future draw spot on the elite Unleash The Beast following the tour's first four events.

Those with the most points earned during their four most recent Velocity Global or Unleash The Beast events will join the UTB, replacing riders who had fallen to the bottom of the pack during select cuts throughout the season. Riders ranked in the No. 36-40 range in the UTB standings will be subject to being cut. During each cut, the open positions will first be filled with those riders having injury exemptions, followed by the Premier Series Qualifier List, based on Velocity Global points. Following each cut, these riders will take the place of the demoted riders in the sport's top series to make up the 40-rider field heading into the next event. Riders ranked No. 1-35 on the UTB will remain on the PBR's elite tour. Following the initial cut after the event in Manchester, New Hampshire, subsequent cuts will be held every two weeks. The second cut will drop the bottom six riders from UTB, the third cut will drop the bottom seven riders, and the fourth and remaining cuts will remove the bottom eight riders from UTB.

Points will be awarded as follows for the Unleash The Beast, including World Finals, as well as Tier 1 Velocity Global events:

Bonus points are awarded across all levels of PBR competition. A rider who scores 70-79.75 points will earn 7 bonus points, 80-89.75 8 bonus points and 90-99.75 9 bonus points. The exception is if a contestant declines a re-ride due to an inferior bull. In that case, he does not earn bonus points.

**THIS WEEKEND'S FORMAT** – PBR Monster Energy Buck Off at the Garden, the sixth Unleash The Beast event of the 2024 season and first of three majors, will feature four rounds of bull riding. Each of the 46 competing riders will get on one bull in Round 1 on Friday and Round 2 on Saturday. Every contestant who has a qualified ride in the first two rounds will be eligible to compete in Round 3 on Sunday. If there are less than 30 riders with a qualified ride after two rounds, Round 3 will fill the remaining spots to get to the 30-man minimum based on the UTB Standings entering the event. The 12 bull riders with the top combined ride scores following Rounds 1, 2, and 3 will then advance to the championship round following Round 3 on Sunday.

**NEXT UP** – The PBR Unleash The Beast next travels to Allstate Arena in Rosemont, Illinois, for Tractor Supply Co. PBR Chicago. The event is on Friday, January 12, at 7:45 p.m. CT and Saturday, January 13, at 6:45 p.m. CT.

**VELOCITY TOUR, INTERNATIONAL AND TOURING PRO DIVISION POINTS** – All non-Unleash The Beast (UTB) events award Velocity Global points, including Pendleton Whisky Velocity Tour events, Touring Pro Division events and events held internationally in Australia, Brazil, Canada, and Mexico. The only exception is National Finals held abroad, which will only award national points, not Velocity Global points. The point system at each event is tiered based on added money in USD, and other factors determined by the PBR. Each event, depending on the tier will get points in accordance with the tables below.

- Tier 1 Events \$20,000 or more USD in added money.
- Tier 2 Events \$10,000 \$19,999 USD in added money.
- Tier 3 Events \$9,999 USD or less in added money.

Additionally, riders at all events receive bonus points via their ride score. A rider who scores 70-79.75 points will earn 7 bonus points, 80-89.75 8 bonus points and 90-99.75 9 bonus points.
