DERBY CITY CHUTE OUT – This week, for the second consecutive season and sixth time overall, PBR’s elite 2024 Unleash The Beast travels to Louisville, Kentucky, for Cooper Tires PBR Louisville, presented by Pneu-Dart, the twenty-third event of the 24-event 2024 individual season. KFC YUM! Center will host the PBR for two days of action on Friday, April 26 at 7:45 p.m. EDT and Saturday, April 27 at 6:45 p.m. EDT.

DIAS MAINTAINS HOLD OF NO. 1 SPOT – For the 15th consecutive week, Cassio Dias holds the top spot in the Unleash The Beast standings after going 1-for-2 in Tacoma, Washington. Once again getting off to a strong start, Dias rode Sky Walker for 85.25 points in Round 1 but had his bid for a seventh event win halted by Wishful Thinking in 5.6 seconds in Round 2. Tying for 17th, Dias allowed No. 2 John Crimber to close the gap to a still-distant 494.5 points with one event left in the regular season after the 18-year-old phenom posted back-to-back Top-10 finishes in Washington. Despite a 1-for-4 week in the Evergreen State, Dias has already done enough to secure the top spot in the Unleash The Beast standings heading into the Elimination Rounds of the PBR World Finals and a chance to ride for the PBR Championship inside AT&T Stadium the following weekend.

Dias lit up the scoreboard once again in Sioux Falls, South Dakota, the first weekend of April, winning his sixth event of the season with a 3-for-4 performance. The victory puts him two behind Justin McBride and Jose Vitor Leme, who are tied with eight event wins for the most in a season. In Round 1 in Sioux Falls, Dias roared out of the gates on Miller Time but was bucked off in 6.26 seconds. Undeterred, the Brazilian rebounded and recorded three straight rides, sitting tall atop Medicine Red for 84.5 points in Round 2 and Blown Away for 87 points in Round 3. Now in top form, Dias stole the show with a monstrous, round-winning, event-high 90.5 points on Ricky Vaughn, his eighth 90-point ride of the season, twice as many as the second most (Crimber: 4).

Before a rare shutout in Nampa, Idaho, Dias dazzled the previous weekend in Albuquerque, New Mexico, putting together a stellar 3-for-4 performance in The Pit. A breakout star for the Kansas City Outlaws on the separate PBR Camping World Team Series, the 22-year-old Brazilian bounced back after bucking off Mahan in 3.32 seconds, riding Show-Off for 85.5 points in Round 2 and I’m Your Daddy for 86.75 points in Round 3 to punch his ticket to the championship round. Choosing Man Hater, the 2024 YETI PBR World Champion Bull frontrunner, as his final animal athlete opponent once again, Dias stormed out of the gates in perfect time with the rank bovine for a monstrous 93.25 points, at the time his premier-series-leading seventh 90-point ride this season. That pairing has become must-watch television, as the Brazilian cowboy is still the only rider to cover Man Hater this year. In their first dance, the duo burst out of the gate in the championship round in front of a roaring Crypto.com Arena, posting a mind-boggling, 94.75-point score, the highest-marked ride since Jose Vitor Leme topped Ridin’ Solo for 94.75 points in Oklahoma City in February of 2022 and the highest ride in PBR history in California.

In Little Rock, Arkansas, in March, Dias was once again victorious, hoisting his fifth event buckle after going a perfect 3-for-3. The burgeoning superstar flew out of the gate on T-Wrecks for a modest 83 points, placing him eighth in the event standings entering the final day of competition. Dias then locked in, winning Round 2 by covering Tulsa Time for 89.25 points to punch his ticket to the championship round. There, the Brazilian roared out of the chutes on Dark Thoughts for an event-high 90.5 points.

After sitting atop the standings for a month early in the season, Dias briefly lost his hold on the top spot to Austin Richardson after the Texan won back-to-back titles in the Empire State at the beginning of the new year. However, Dias bounced back in Chicago, going a perfect 3-for-3 and winning his then-premier-series-leading third event of the season. The MVP runner-up on

the separate PBR Camping World Team Series, Dias finished tied for fourth in the first round with an 87-point ride on IHOP. Now on a roll, the Brazilian tied for second in Round 2, scoring 86.75 points on Grey Fox to earn the second pick in the championship pen. Choosing Do Dat Eddie, Dias saved his best for last, storming out of the gates for an event-high-tying 89 points to overtake Cort McFadden, who was making his PBR debut, in the event standings. After the young Texan was bucked off Polar Express in 5.26 seconds, Dias knew he was back on top in the race for a gold buckle.

Now having spent more than half the season holding the No. 1 spot in the standings, the Brazilian cowboy is currently 10-for-15 (66.67%) in Championship Rounds, the second-highest riding percentage in the final round for all riders with multiple championship round performances, trailing only No. 11 Kaique Pacheco (3-for-4, 75%). Dias continues his incredible season on Let's Roll in Round 1 on Friday.

ALAN DE SOUZA GOES BACK-TO-BACK IN WASHINGTON – No. 5 Alan de Souza became just the third rider to win back-to-back events this season after taking home two event buckles in the Evergreen State last week, joining No. 1 Cassio Dias (St. Louis, Johnstown) and No. 7 Austin Richardson (Albany, New York City).

Souza started his 6-for-6 trip to the Northwest by going a perfect 3-for-3 in Everett, covering Get At Me for a modest 83.25 points in Round 1. Following that up with an 86.75-point dance with Smoke Down in Round 2, Souza knew he needed to convert to jump to the top of the leaderboard in the final round, eventually roaring out of the chutes on Centerfold for 85.5 points to take the lead. After no other rider was able to make the 8 in the Championship Round, Souza was victorious. The win in Everett was his second career premier series victory and his first since Minneapolis, Minnesota, in October of 2019.

Now seemingly unstoppable, Souza conquered Fort Knox for 81.5 points in the opening round in Tacoma and punched his ticket to Sunday's Championship Round by riding Hell Bound for 80.75 points. Ranked sixth in the event standings, the Brazilian once again chose Centerfold as his final animal athlete opponent knowing he needed to convert to take home another victory. Nearly matching the ride in Everett stride-for-stride, the pair once again moved in perfect time and the 84.75-point performance was enough to overtake No. 21 Sage Kimzey, who finished second.

The second-place finish was Kimzey's best since returning from elbow surgery that caused him to miss most of February and all of March. The Oklahoman was dispatched by The Judge in 6.50 seconds in the opening round in Tacoma before rallying back to win the final two rounds, topping Tijuana Two-Step for 88 points to split Round 2 with No. 4 Dalton Kasel and UTZ BesTex Legend for a monstrous, event-high, 91.5 points in the final round to take the second spot on the podium. Kimzey shares a chute with Sweet Move in Round 1 in Louisville Friday night, while Souza looks to extend his ride streak to seven aboard Mercy.

COOL WHIP TIES HEARTBREAK KID, CLOSSES IN ON BUSHWACKER – Currently ranked No. 23 in the 2024 YETI PBR World Champion Bull race, Cool Whip has now bucked off 40 consecutive riders on the premier series after unseating Jesse Petri in 3.20 seconds in the Championship Round in Tacoma, Washington, last weekend, bringing him just two buck offs short of Bushwacker's historic 42-out run. That buck-off streak was the longest in premier series history, spanning from November 1, 2009, to August 16, 2013, and was ended by two-time PBR World Champion J.B. Mauney, who made the 8 for a monstrous 95.25 points in Tulsa, Oklahoma. Cool Whip's streak dates back to May 12, 2022, when he bucked off the soon-to-be-crowned World Champion Daylon Swearingen in 3.91 seconds. After finishing fourth in the 2023 PBR World Champion Bull race, the powerful animal athlete has bucked off all ten riders he has faced on the elite Unleash The Beast this season. After competing twice in Washington state last week, the rank bovine is taking a well-deserved break in preparation for chasing down history at the PBR World Finals in Fort Worth, Texas.

NOTABLES – Here are several other notable stats and storylines:

- **Don't Get it Twisted:** Dana White's Twisted Steel returns to action this weekend after Keyshawn Whitehorse hung on to the powerful bovine competitor for 88.75 points in Albuquerque, New Mexico, in March. The powerful bovine competitor has allowed just two rides in his twelve premier series outs (83.33 buckoff percentage) dating back to the beginning of the 2023 PBR Teams season and has bucked off five of the six riders who have faced him during the 2024 Unleash The Beast campaign. Before being ridden by Whitehorse, Twisted Steel got his revenge against the only rider who had covered him previously in his twelve outs, dispatching Andrew Alvidrez in 3.09 seconds in Albuquerque. In Tulsa, Oklahoma, in January, Twisted Steel shed Vitor Losnake in two seconds flat, the second straight out he bested the Brazilian cowboy. Later that month, he unseated Eli Vastbinder in 3.2 seconds in Houston, Texas. The rank animal athlete awaits the PBR's best in Round 2 on Saturday.
- **Missouri Iron Men** The Head Coach of the Kansas City Outlaws, J.W. Hart, has clearly passed on his "Iron Man" mentality to the Kansas City Outlaws, as No. 1 Cassio Dias and No. 6 Koltin Hevalow will become two of just three riders who have competed at every event in the 2024 Unleash The Beast regular season on Friday. The third, No. 27 Paulo Rossetto, competes for the in-state rival Missouri Thunder, proving there must be something in the water in the Show-Me State. In addition to Dias and Hevalow, both No. 14 Julio Cesar Marques and No. 31 Bob Mitchell will have competed in 22 of the 23 events after the regular season comes to a close this weekend.

ABBI CLASSIC ROUND – The first round of the Louisville Unleash The Beast event will feature an American Bucking Bull Inc. (ABBI) Classic event. There will be 36 bulls competing for a prize purse of nearly \$30,000 with the winning bull collecting more than \$6,000. The four-year-old bulls competing in Louisville have been approved by the Livestock Director and are deemed the best young bulls in the nation to try their ability against the best bull riders in the world. This weekend will be the third major ABBI Classic competition of the season held in conjunction with the elite Unleash The Beast.

The first matchup to watch Friday evening is Ice Tray making his Unleash The Beast debut against veteran Boudreaux Campbell. A product of Andrews Rodeo Co, he was chosen to buck at the Wrangler National Finals Rodeo as a three-year-old in 2023 but has not yet bucked in the PBR.

Moving on to two bulls who have proven themselves on bull riding's biggest stage, Rip, the son of long-time PBR mainstay Canadian Mist, is set to take on Thiago Salgado while Magic Moves battles Kaiden Loud. Both powerful animal athletes were perfect in their Unleash The Beast debuts, as Rip unseated Mauricio Gulla Moreira in 3.74 seconds in Little Rock, Arkansas, while Magic Moves dispatched Jesse Petri in 1.09 seconds and Ezekiel Mitchell in 1.97 seconds in Sioux Falls, South Dakota.

The last two bovine competitors to keep an eye on are Old Testament, who shares a chute with Keyshawn Whitehorse, and Fast Flow, who dances with Joao Lucas Campos. Old Testament is the son of Old Fort Days and a daughter of King Lopez, giving the K Bar C product six PBR World Finals qualifications in his pedigree. After bucking off Lucas Divino in 6.37 seconds his Unleash The Beast debut in Indianapolis in March, the animal athlete has stayed perfect in the PBR, unseating Ramon de Lima in 5.51 seconds and Jake Morinec in 2.26 seconds in Dayton, Ohio, on the Pendleton Whisky Velocity Tour. Fast Flow is also a perfect 3-for-3 inside the PBR, bucking off Felipe Furlan in 3.07 seconds in Little Rock, Arkansas, and Silvano Alves in 4.49 seconds in Tulsa, Oklahoma, during the 2024 Unleash The Beast season after unseating Joao Paulo Fernandes in 2.78 seconds in his PBR debut on the Challenger Series in Pilesgrove, New Jersey.

PAST LOUISVILLE EVENT WINNERS – Last year in Louisville, Dener Barbosa went a perfect 3-for-3 to win the final event of the 2023 Unleash The Beast regular season. Beginning strong aboard I'm Legit Too for 89.5 points, the Brazilian continued rolling in the final two rounds, topping Crunch Time for 85.75 points in Round 2 before dancing with Blue Duck for

a monstrous, event-sealing, 90.25 points in the championship round. The victory propelled him from No. 9 to No. 5 in the Unleash The Beast standings heading into the PBR's 30th Anniversary World Finals in Fort Worth, Texas.

WORLD CHAMPION BULL RACE – The 2024 YETI PBR World Champion Bull race has been dominated by Man Hater with just two events left in the year-long campaign. Spanning back to the 2023 PBR Camping World Team Series season, the powerful bovine competitor had bucked off all 15 of his cowboy opponents until Cassio Dias covered him for a season-high 94.75 points in the championship round in Los Angeles to take the event title. The elite animal athlete sought his revenge in Albuquerque, New Mexico, but Dias once again made the 8, this time for a monstrous 93.25 points. Despite the two rides, Man Hater currently holds a 1.28-point average score lead over UTZ BesTex Legend in the standings. After being marked 46.25 points for his buck-off of Brady Fielder in the championship round in Tulsa, Man Hater currently boasts seven of the Top 10 bull scores this season and he has won the Bull of the Event title an incredible nine times. Putting that into perspective, the reigning back-to-back World Champion Bull, Ridin’ Solo, was named the Bull of the Event just five times during the 2023 campaign. In Houston, Red Demon became the first animal athlete other than Man Hater to claim more than one Bull of the Event title this season, marked an impressive 47 points for bucking off Joao Ricardo Vieira in 2.3 seconds in the championship round, rising to fourth in the standings. In Sioux Falls, the powerful bovine competitor won his third Bull of the Event title, bucking off Sage Kimzey in 3.07 seconds. After surrendering an 88.5-point ride to Alan de Souza in St. Louis, Missouri, Legend put together a ten-out buck-off streak to somewhat close the gap on Man Hater. A member of the 2023 PBR Stock Contractor of the Year Blake Sharp’s pen, Legend has bucked off 19 of the 21 riders he has faced so far after giving up a monstrous 91.5-point ride to Sage Kimzey in Tacoma, Washington.

2024 POINTS TABLES – The 2024 PBR Unleash The Beast season keeps the same point structure as 2023 but adds PBR Majors while removing 15/15 Bucking Battles and having two separate aggregates at the PBR World Finals. The 2024 World Champion will be the rider who earns the most points only at Unleash The Beast (UTB) events, including at the 2024 PBR World Finals on May 10-19 in the Dallas-Fort Worth Metroplex. The three PBR Majors in New York City (January 5-7, won by Austin Richardson), Sacramento, California (February 2-4, won by Leonardo Castro Ferreira), and Albuquerque, New Mexico (March 22-24, won by Eduardo Aparecido), offer increased payouts and points. There will be three PBR tours in the U.S. in action for the first half of 2024: PBR Unleash The Beast (November 10 – May 19); Pendleton Whisky Velocity Tour (Jan. 5 – May 4) and PBR Touring Pro Division (Oct. 19 – May 19). Points accumulated in non-UTB events domestically, as well as PBR’s international tours, will be tallied as Velocity Global points. Velocity Global points, which will also be used to crown the 2024 PBR Pendleton Whisky Velocity Tour Champion, will help determine the athletes who can earn a future draw spot on the elite Unleash The Beast following the tour’s first four events.

Those with the most points earned during their four most recent Velocity Global or Unleash The Beast events will join the UTB, replacing riders who had fallen to the bottom of the pack during select cuts throughout the season. Riders ranked in the No. 36-40 range in the UTB standings will be subject to being cut. During each cut, the open positions will first be filled with those riders having injury exemptions, followed by the Premier Series Qualifier List, based on Velocity Global points. Following each cut, these riders will take the place of the demoted riders in the sport’s top series to make up the 40-rider field heading into the next event. Riders ranked No. 1-35 on the UTB will remain on the PBR’s elite tour. Following the initial cut after the event in Manchester, New Hampshire, subsequent cuts will be held every two weeks. The second cut will drop the bottom six riders from UTB, the third cut will drop the bottom seven riders, and the fourth and remaining cuts will remove the bottom eight riders from UTB.

Points will be awarded as follows for the Unleash The Beast, including World Finals, as well as Tier 1 Velocity Global events:

Bonus points are awarded across all levels of PBR competition. A rider who scores 70-79.75 points will earn 7 bonus points, 80-89.75 8 bonus points and 90-99.75 9 bonus points. The exception is if a contestant declines a re-ride due to an inferior bull. In that case, he does not earn bonus points.

VELOCITY TOUR, INTERNATIONAL AND TOURING PRO DIVISION POINTS – All non-Unleash The Beast (UTB) events award Velocity Global points, including Pendleton Whisky Velocity Tour events, Touring Pro Division events and events held internationally in Australia, Brazil, Canada, and Mexico. The only exception is National Finals held abroad, which will only award national points, not Velocity Global points. The point system at each event is tiered based on added money in USD, and other factors determined by the PBR. Each event, depending on the tier will get points in accordance with the tables below.

- Tier 1 Events – \$20,000 or more USD in added money.
- Tier 2 Events – \$10,000 - \$19,999 USD in added money.
- Tier 3 Events – \$9,999 USD or less in added money.

Additionally, riders at all events receive bonus points via their ride score. A rider who scores 70-79.75 points will earn 7 bonus points, 80-89.75 8 bonus points and 90-99.75 9 bonus points.
