GEM STATE HOEDOWN – This weekend, for the 27th time and 13th consecutive season, PBR’s elite 2024 Unleash The Beast travels to Nampa, Idaho, for PBR Nampa, presented by Cooper Tires, the eighteenth event of the 24-event 2024 individual season. Nampa will host the PBR for three days of action on Thursday, March 28, starting at 7:45 p.m. MDT, Friday, March 29, starting at 7:45 p.m. MDT and on Saturday, March 30, at 6:45 p.m. MDT.

NO. 1 DIAS BESTS MAN HATER ONCE AGAIN TO EXTEND LEAD – While Cassio Dias may have come up just short of winning his sixth event buckle of the season, he still managed to extend his lead over No. 2 John Crimber with a masterful 3-for-4 performance in Albuquerque, New Mexico. A breakout star for the Kansas City Outlaws on the separate PBR Camping World Team Series, the 22-year-old Brazilian bounced back after bucking off Mahan in 3.32 seconds, riding Show-Off for 85.5 points in Round 2 and I’m Your Daddy for 86.75 points in Round 3 to punch his ticket to the championship round. Choosing Man Hater, the 2024 YETI PBR World Champion Bull frontrunner, as his final animal athlete opponent once again, Dias stormed out of the gates in perfect time with the rank bovine for a monstrous 93.25 points, his premier-series-leading seventh 90-point ride this season. That pairing is quickly becoming must-watch television, as the Brazilian cowboy is still the only rider to cover Man Hater this year. In their first dance, the duo burst out of the gate in the championship round in front of a roaring Crypto.com Arena, posting a mind-boggling, 94.75-point score, the highest-marked ride since Jose Vitor Leme topped Ridin’ Solo for 94.75 points in Oklahoma City in February of 2022 and the highest ride in PBR history in California.

In Little Rock, Arkansas, in March, Dias was once again victorious, hoisting his fifth event buckle after going a perfect 3-for-3. The burgeoning superstar flew out of the gate on T-Wrecks for a modest 83 points, placing him eighth in the event standings entering the final day of competition. Dias then locked in, winning Round 2 by covering Tulsa Time for 89.25 points to punch his ticket to the championship round. There, the Brazilian roared out of the chutes on Dark Thoughts for an event-high 90.5 points.

After sitting atop the standings for a month early in the season, Dias briefly lost his hold on the top spot to Austin Richardson after the Texan won back-to-back titles in the Empire State at the beginning of the new year. However, Dias bounced back in Chicago, going a perfect 3-for-3 and winning his premier series-leading third event of the season. The MVP runner-up for the Kansas City Outlaws in the PBR Camping World Team Series, Dias finished tied for fourth in the first round with an 87-point ride on IHOP. Now on a roll, the Brazilian tied for second in Round 2, scoring 86.75 points on Grey Fox to earn the second pick in the championship pen. Choosing Do Dat Eddie, Dias saved his best for last, storming out of the gates for an event-high-tying 89 points to overtake Cort McFadden, who was making his PBR debut, in the event standings. After the young Texan was bucked off Polar Express in 5.26 seconds, Dias knew he was back on top in the race for a gold buckle. Dias tries to extend his ride streak to four on Tricked Out in Round 1 on Thursday.

AMAZING APARECIDO FLAWLESS IN THE PIT – A staple inside the Top 10 of the standings all season, No. 4 Eduardo Aparecido put on a show in Albuquerque, New Mexico, last weekend, going a perfect 4-for-4 to win the final PBR Major of the 2024 season. The Arizona Ridge Riders veteran got off to a strong start, riding Centerfold for 84 points in the opening round and Joy’s Bang Bang for 85.25 points in Round 2. Now on a roll, the Brazilian rocketed out of the gate on Wild Card for 87.75 points to secure a spot in the championship round. In search of his first victory of the season, Aparecido paired himself with Mike’s Motive. Brimming with confidence, he gave the nod and stormed out of the chutes for 89.25 points to overtake Dias and Dalton Kasel for the event lead. The masterful performance netted Aparecido an incredible 216.5 points to push him to No. 4 in the standings, 514.33 points behind No. 1 Dias, en route to earning a six-figure payout.

While it may be the Brazilian cowboy's first event win, he has been one of the best bull riders on the premier series all season, posting six Top-10 finishes. Aparecido is proving that consistency is just as important as lighting up the leaderboard, as he only has two 90-point rides but has made the 8 at least once in 13 of his 15 events. He is currently 21-for-44 (47%) on the top tour and hasn't been bucked off more than four times in a row throughout 2024. Incredibly, Aparecido has also gotten stronger as of late as the grueling campaign enters the final month, covering 8 of his last 10 animal athlete opponents.

Aparecido has been one of the most productive riders in PBR history and is quickly approaching 400 qualified rides in his career. His 384 rides rank ninth all-time, and he has finished inside the Top 10 five times in his career. The Brazilian has also found success in Nampa, finishing inside the Top 10 of the event standings three times, including his first career premier series victory in 2014. He looks to stay red-hot aboard Medicine Red in Round 1 on Thursday evening.

THE TORTOISE AND THE HARE – Aparecido isn't the only rider inside the Top 10 who has taken the "slow and steady" path to success this season, as No. 6 Koltin Hevalow has taken the approach to the extreme. After bucking off in his first five outs of the campaign, the Missourian hasn't bucked off more than three consecutive times. Despite not posting a single 90-point ride, the Kansas City Outlaws rider has steadily climbed the standings by making the 8 at least once in 13 of his next 15 events. Hevalow has ridden a bull in each of his last eight events and is currently 20-for-45 on the season (44%). Despite going just 1-for-6 in championship rounds, Hevalow has posted five Top-5 finishes, including his first premier series victory in Salt Lake City, Utah, in February. Should the Missouri cowboy be able to find a way to start consistently converting in his final outs, he is poised to be a serious contender for a gold buckle inside AT&T Stadium in May. Hevalow shares a chute with Devil's Revenge in Round 1 in Nampa.

On the flip side of the equation is No. 2 John Crimber, who is second only to Dias with four 90-point rides. While the young phenom has been shut out in four events this season, he has made the most of his 19 rides. The 18-year-old Texan took this strategy to great success in Albuquerque last weekend, going 2-for-4 but recording two 90-point rides to finish fifth. Crimber won Round 1, his fifth round win of the season, by moving in perfect time with Whiskey Trip for 90 points. Despite bucking off Boomerang and Sneaky Situation in the middle rounds, the young gun roared out of the chutes on Bamboozle for 91.5 points in the championship round to net his fifth Top 5 finish of the season. Crimber dances with Wishful Thinking in the opening round on Thursday.

NOTABLES – Here are several other notable stats and storylines:

- **Buckin' with Blake:** The event in Nampa this weekend will feature 27 bulls from the 2023 Stock Contractor of the Year, Blake Sharp. Boasting one of the rankest pens in the PBR, Sharp currently has three bulls inside the Top 10 of the 2024 YETI PBR World Champion Bull race: No. 2 UTZ BesTex Legend, No. 6 UTZ BesTex Smokestack and No. 7 Mike's Motive, two of whom (Legend and Mike's Motive) are set to buck this weekend. In addition, the Mississippian has three more animal athletes inside the Top 20 he is trucking to Idaho, as No. 14 Cy Young, No. 16 Dark Thoughts and No. 17 Bandito Bug are all ready to face the best bull riders in the world.
- **Finding Their Groove:** No. 15 Keyshawn Whitehorse and No. 17 Kaique Pacheco head to the Gem State after stellar weekends in Albuquerque, New Mexico. Whitehorse went 2-for-4 and finished sixth in the pit last weekend, pushing him 67 points up the standings. The Arizona Ridge Riders veteran is now 14-for-25 across all tours since finishing fifth in Salt Lake City, Utah, including five Top 10 finishes on the top tour. Pacheco is also rounding into form as the 2024 season enters the championship stretch, as the Ice Man went 3-for-4 and finished fourth in Albuquerque last weekend. The breakout performance ended a rare nine-out buck-off streak for the Brazilian and was his second Top 5 finish of the season. Pacheco takes on Dropping Gears in Round 1 while Whitehorse faces Burning Man.
- **Great Gem State Performances:** It seems there is something in the water in Nampa, as riders have combined for 75 90+ point rides and 66 bulls have been marked 46 points or higher in the PBR's 26 trips to the Heart of Treasure Valley. Several notable performances include Michael Gaffney's 96.5-point masterpiece aboard Little Yellow Jacket in 2004, three-time PBR World Champion Silvano Alves going 4-for-4 to win his premier series debut in 2010 and Jess Lockwood riding Heartbreak Kid for 94 points in 2019.
- **Home Cooking:** Trace Redd competes in his home state for the second time in his PBR career, and first time on the premier series. The Gem State cowboy won the Challenger Series event in Twin Falls last March, going 1-for-2. Despite being bucked off by Brown Whiskey in six seconds in Round 2, Redd's 86-point ride aboard Little Big Horn in

the opening round was enough to secure him the victory. With his spot on the top tour in jeopardy, Redd looks to punch his way back into the Top 30 this weekend, taking on Regulator in Round 1.

FAMILIAR WATERS – Round 1 of the 2024 PBR event in Nampa, Idaho, will feature two rematches.

- Alex Cerqueira takes on Flapjack for the second time after the powerful bovine competitor bested him in 1.71 seconds in Oklahoma City, Oklahoma, in September.
- Mauricio Gulla Moreira looks to cover Tijuana Two-Step once again after making the 8 for 88.75 points in the pair's first matchup in Madison Square Garden this past January.

PAST NAMPA WINNERS – For the second consecutive season, Ramon de Lima won the elite tour's stop in Nampa, going a perfect 3-for-3. The Brazilian roared out of the chutes in Round 1 for 86.5 points aboard Fowl Play, and then topped Drago for 86.75 points in the second round to secure himself an out in the championship round. There, the wily veteran hung on to a wayward Fastfire for 61.25 points and declined his re-ride option to give himself the lead. The decision proved to be the right one, as after Tate Pollmeier was bucked off in the final out by Ricky Vaughn, Lima had hung on for his first event buckle of the season.

In 2022, Lima was one of two riders to go a perfect 3-for-3, securing his third classic premier series event win. The Austin Gamblers' veteran began the weekend by lasting the 8 on Bubba G for 87 points in Round 1 before posting an impressive 87.5-point romp on WSM's Nasty Wishes in Round 2. Knowing he needed a solid ride to secure his first event buckle of the season, Lima put on a show for the Nampa faithful atop Top Shelf, dancing with his animal athlete compatriot for 89.75 points, the second-highest marked ride of the event. His first event win since 2020 catapulted him from No. 31 to No. 18 in the World Standings, all but securing his qualification for the World Finals in Fort Worth, Texas. Right on his spurs was Colten Fritzlan, who was the only other rider to have a perfect weekend, finishing just 22.75 points behind the Brazilian cowboy.

Looking beyond the 2022 event, in 2004, Michael Gaffney rode Little Yellow Jacket for a historic 96.5 points in Nampa. The ride was tied for the top score in PBR history until 2021 when Jose Vitor Leme shattered the record twice aboard Woopaa, first marked 97.75 points during the July Bucking Battle in Tulsa, Oklahoma, and then an unprecedented 98.75 points during the championship round of the World Finals.

Four different Nampa winners ride in the Gem State this weekend, as Kaique Pacheco (2021), Joao Ricardo Vieira (2020), Dalton Kasel (2019) and Eduardo Aparecido (2014) all return to the Ford Idaho Center. In addition, Donald Owens (1998) will be one of the judges for this weekend's action.

WORLD CHAMPION BULL RACE – The 2024 YETI PBR World Champion Bull race has been dominated by Man Hater with just over a month left in the year-long campaign. Spanning back to the 2023 PBR Camping World Team Series' season, the powerful bovine competitor had bucked off all 15 of his cowboy opponents until Cassio Dias covered him for a season-high 94.75 points in the championship round in Los Angeles to take the event title. Seeking his revenge, the elite animal athlete sought his revenge in Albuquerque, New Mexico, but Dias once again made the 8, this time for a monstrous 93.25 points. Despite the two rides, Man Hater currently holds a 1.28-point lead over UTZ BesTex Legend in the standings. After being

marked 46.25 points for his buck-off of Brady Fielder in the championship round in Tulsa, Man Hater currently boasts seven of the Top 10 bull scores this season and he has won the Bull of the Event title an incredible nine times. Putting that into perspective, the reigning back-to-back World Champion Bull, Ridin' Solo, was named the Bull of the Event just five times during the 2023 campaign. In Houston, Red Demon became the first animal athlete other than Man Hater to claim more than one Bull of the Event title this season, marked an impressive 47 points for bucking off Joao Ricardo Vieira in 2.3 seconds in the championship round, and has risen to fourth in the standings. After surrendering an 88.5-point ride to Alan de Souza in St. Louis, Missouri, Legend has put together a seven-out buck-off streak to somewhat close the gap on Man Hater. A member of the 2023 PBR Stock Contractor of the Year Blake Sharp's pen, Legend has bucked off 16 of the 17 riders he has faced so far. Right behind him in the standings is Flyin Wired, who sits 1.72 points back of the leader. While he has given up two rides in his eight outs, both went for 90 or more points, as Wingson Henrique da Silva covered him for 92.5 points at the PBR Teams Championship in Las Vegas while Joao Ricardo Vieira topped him for 91.75 points to win the event in Tulsa.

2024 POINTS TABLES – The 2024 PBR Unleash The Beast season keeps the same point structure as 2023 but adds PBR Majors while removing 15/15 Bucking Battles and having two separate aggregates at the PBR World Finals. The 2024 World Champion will be the rider who earns the most points only at Unleash The Beast (UTB) events, including at the 2024 PBR World Finals on May 10-19 in the Dallas-Fort Worth Metroplex. The three PBR Majors in New York City (January 5-7, won by Austin Richardson), Sacramento, California (February 2-4, won by Leonardo Castro Ferreira), and Albuquerque, New Mexico (March 22-24, won by Eduardo Aparecido), offer increased payouts and points. There will be three PBR tours in the U.S. in action for the first half of 2024: PBR Unleash The Beast (November 10 – May 19); Pendleton Whisky Velocity Tour (Jan. 5 – May 4) and PBR Touring Pro Division (Oct. 19 – May 19). Points accumulated in non-UTB events domestically, as well as PBR's international tours, will be tallied as Velocity Global points. Velocity Global points, which will also be used to crown the 2024 PBR Pendleton Whisky Velocity Tour Champion, will help determine the athletes who can earn a future draw spot on the elite Unleash The Beast following the tour's first four events.

Those with the most points earned during their four most recent Velocity Global or Unleash The Beast events will join the UTB, replacing riders who had fallen to the bottom of the pack during select cuts throughout the season. Riders ranked in the No. 36-40 range in the UTB standings will be subject to being cut. During each cut, the open positions will first be filled with those riders having injury exemptions, followed by the Premier Series Qualifier List, based on Velocity Global points. Following each cut, these riders will take the place of the demoted riders in the sport's top series to make up the 40-rider field heading into the next event. Riders ranked No. 1-35 on the UTB will remain on the PBR's elite tour. Following the initial cut after the event in Manchester, New Hampshire, subsequent cuts will be held every two weeks. The second cut will drop the bottom six riders from UTB, the third cut will drop the bottom seven riders, and the fourth and remaining cuts will remove the bottom eight riders from UTB.

Points will be awarded as follows for the Unleash The Beast, including World Finals, as well as Tier 1 Velocity Global events:

Bonus points are awarded across all levels of PBR competition. A rider who scores 70-79.75 points will earn 7 bonus points, 80-89.75 8 bonus points and 90-99.75 9 bonus points. The exception is if a contestant declines a re-ride due to an inferior bull. In that case, he does not earn bonus points.

THIS WEEKEND’S FORMAT – PBR Nampa, presented by Cooper Tires, the eighteenth Unleash The Beast event of the 2024 season, will feature four rounds of bull riding. Each of the 37 competing riders will get on one bull in Round 1 on Thursday and Round 2 on Friday. Every contestant who has a qualified ride in the first two rounds will be eligible to compete in Round 3 on Saturday. If there are less than 30 riders with a qualified ride after two rounds, Round 3 will fill the remaining spots to get to the 30-man minimum based on the UTB Standings entering the event. The 12 bull riders with the top combined ride scores following Rounds 1, 2, and 3 will then advance to the championship round following Round 3 on Saturday.

NEXT UP – The PBR Unleash The Beast next travels to Sioux Falls, South Dakota, for the First Premier Bank PBR Sioux Falls, presented by Cooper Tires. The event is on Friday, April 5, at 7:45 p.m. CDT, Saturday, April 6 at 6:45 p.m. CDT and Sunday, April 7, at 2:45 p.m. CDT.

VELOCITY TOUR, INTERNATIONAL AND TOURING PRO DIVISION POINTS – All non-Unleash The Beast (UTB) events award Velocity Global points, including Pendleton Whisky Velocity Tour events, Touring Pro Division events and events held internationally in Australia, Brazil, Canada, and Mexico. The only exception is National Finals held abroad, which will only award national points, not Velocity Global points. The point system at each event is tiered based on added money in USD, and other factors determined by the PBR. Each event, depending on the tier will get points in accordance with the tables below.

- Tier 1 Events – \$20,000 or more USD in added money.
- Tier 2 Events – \$10,000 - \$19,999 USD in added money.
- Tier 3 Events – \$9,999 USD or less in added money.

Additionally, riders at all events receive bonus points via their ride score. A rider who scores 70-79.75 points will earn 7 bonus points, 80-89.75 8 bonus points and 90-99.75 9 bonus points.
