QUEEN CITY BUCKOFF – This weekend, for the fourth consecutive year and ninth time overall, PBR's elite 2024 Unleash The Beast travels to Sioux Falls, South Dakota, for the First Premier Bank PBR Sioux Falls, presented by Cooper Tires, the nineteenth event of the 24-event 2024 individual season. Denny Sanford Premier Center will host the PBR for three days of action on Friday, April 5 at 7:45 p.m. CDT, Saturday, April 6, at 6:45 p.m. CDT and Sunday, April 7 at 2:45 p.m. CDT.

TERRIFIC THIAGO WINS FIRST CAREER PREMIER SERIES EVENT IN NAMPA – Thiago Salgado rode supreme in Nampa, Idaho, last weekend, putting together an immaculate 4-for-4 performance to win his first premier series title and rise to No. 17 in the Unleash The Beast standings as the gold buckle race enters the championship stretch. Finding his groove, the Brazilian topped Rockville for 86 points in Round 1 on Thursday before hanging on to Time Bomb in Round 2 for 68.5 points. He then became the first ride to three qualified rides in Round 3, sitting tall atop Bubba G for 83.25 points. Choosing Brusta as his final animal athlete opponent, Salgado rocketed out of the gate for 88.75 points to complete his perfect weekend and take home his first victory on the top tour. The Brazilian cowboy faces Doze You Down in Round 1.

Right on Salgado's spurs was No. 7 Alan de Souza, who went 3-for-4. The Brazilian rode Sweet Train for 87.25 points in Round 1 before being bucked off by Sweatlodge Testified in 3.15 seconds in the second round. Undeterred, Souza bounced back on championship Saturday, covering Pam's Dream for 84.75 points in Round 3 to punch his ticket to the final round. In his fourth out, Souza thundered out of the chutes on Dark Thoughts for 88 points. He takes on Red Scorpion in Round 1 Friday evening.

NO. 1 DIAS MAINTAINS LEAD – While Cassio Dias was shut out in Nampa last weekend, he maintained his hold on the top spot over No. 2 John Crimber. The previous weekend in Albuquerque, New Mexico, Dias put together a stellar 3-for-4 performance in The Pit. A breakout star for the Kansas City Outlaws on the separate PBR Camping World Team Series, the 22-year-old Brazilian bounced back after bucking off Mahan in 3.32 seconds, riding Show-Off for 85.5 points in Round 2 and I'm Your Daddy for 86.75 points in Round 3 to punch his ticket to the championship round. Choosing Man Hater, the 2024 YETI PBR World Champion Bull frontrunner, as his final animal athlete opponent once again, Dias stormed out of the gates in perfect time with the rank bovine for a monstrous 93.25 points, his premier-series-leading seventh 90-point ride this season. That pairing is quickly becoming must-watch television, as the Brazilian cowboy is still the only rider to cover Man Hater this year. In their first dance, the duo burst out of the gate in the championship round in front of a roaring Crypto.com Arena, posting a mind-boggling, 94.75-point score, the highest-marked ride since Jose Vitor Leme topped Ridin' Solo for 94.75 points in Oklahoma City in February of 2022 and the highest ride in PBR history in California.

In Little Rock, Arkansas, in March, Dias was once again victorious, hoisting his fifth event buckle after going a perfect 3-for-3. The burgeoning superstar flew out of the gate on T-Wrecks for a modest 83 points, placing him eighth in the event standings entering the final day of competition. Dias then locked in, winning Round 2 by covering Tulsa Time for 89.25 points to punch his ticket to the championship round. There, the Brazilian roared out of the chutes on Dark Thoughts for an event-high 90.5 points.

After sitting atop the standings for a month early in the season, Dias briefly lost his hold on the top spot to Austin Richardson after the Texan won back-to-back titles in the Empire State at the beginning of the new year. However, Dias bounced back in Chicago, going a perfect 3-for-3 and winning his premier series-leading third event of the season. The MVP runner-up for the Kansas City Outlaws in the PBR Camping World Team Series, Dias finished tied for fourth in the first round with an 87-point ride on IHOP. Now on a roll, the Brazilian tied for second in Round 2, scoring 86.75 points on Grey Fox to earn the second pick in the championship pen. Choosing Do Dat Eddie, Dias saved his best for last, storming out of the gates for an event-high-tying 89 points to overtake Cort McFadden, who was making his PBR debut, in the event standings. After the young Texan was bucked off Polar Express in 5.26 seconds, Dias knew he was back on top in the race for a gold buckle. Dias looks to bounce back from his 0-for-4 performance on Miller Time in the opening round.

FINDING THEIR FORM – No. 11 Kaique Pacheco and No. 40 Andrew Alvidrez have started to find their groove, as both went 3-for-4 and finished third and fourth, respectively, last weekend in Nampa.

Pacheco rode Sugar Smack for 84.25 points in Round 1 before suffering his lone buck off of the weekend at the hooves of Kamikaze, who unseated the veteran in 1.99 seconds. Undeterred, the Ice Man rallied, riding Blackstone for 84 points in Round 3 to earn a spot in the final round. Cool under pressure, he gave the nod and roared out of the chutes on Ricky Vaughn for a round-winning 89 points to rise to third in the event standings. The Brazilian is now 6 of his last 8 and moved to 14-for-31 (45%) on the season. The 2018 PBR World Champion is poised to make a run at a second gold buckle, sharing a chute with Nefarious in Round 1 in Sioux Falls.

Alvidrez was bucked off in Round 1 by War Train in 3.21 seconds but proved his mettle, finishing 3-for-3. The Texan thundered out of the chutes on Buck Cherry in Round 2 for 86.75 points before topping Koulee's Pet for 84.5 points in Round 3. The former powerlifter was now in top form, covering Manaba for 85.5 points in the final round to record his first Top-5 finish of the season. His Round 2 ride snapped a 16-out ride streak on the premier series and his fourth-place finish pushed him up to No. 40 in the standings, giving him the last qualifying spot for the PBR World Finals if the season ended today. He looks to continue his late-season surge on Blown Away in Round 1.

NOTABLES – Here are several other notable stats and storylines:

- **Exciting Debut:** Jose de Castro makes his debut on U.S. soil this weekend in Sioux Falls. The 25-year-old is currently the No. 1 ranked rider in Brazil, where he has gone an incredible 35-50 (75%) over the past two seasons. Already declared for the 2024 PBR Teams New Rider Draft, Castro is ready to show teams and fans alike what he has to offer in the final month of the premier series season. His first out will be aboard Whiskey Trip in the opening round on Friday.
- <u>Sage Returns:</u> After being out since the second major of the season in Sacramento, California, while recovering from elbow surgery, No. 34 Sage Kimzey returns to action in Sioux Falls. The Oklahoman started the season strong, recording two Top-10 finishes in Tucson, Arizona, and St. Louis, Missouri, but then lost his rhythm as he battled injury, sliding to 6-for-17 (35%) on the season. Finally healthy, Kimzey is ready to make up for lost time by taking on Sweet Train in Round 1.

FAMILIAR WATERS – Round 1 of the 2024 PBR event in Sioux Falls, South Dakota, will feature six rematches.

- Alex Cerqueira shares a chute with Do Dat Eddie for the first time since he was bucked off in 2.84 seconds in Duluth, Georgia, in January of 2023.
- Conner Halverson takes on Baldy once again after being bucked off in 4.25 seconds in Los Angeles, California, earlier this year in February.
- Eli Vastbinder was offered a re-ride in his first matchup with Mike's Magic after he lost the rope in 2.38 seconds.
- Jesse Petri and Flapjack have danced on three previous occasions. The powerful bovine competitor is perfect against the Texan, bucking him off in 4.48 seconds in New Orleans, in 1.22 seconds in Sioux Falls in March of 2023 and in 3.55 seconds last October in Glendale. Arizona.

- Keyshawn Whitehorse battles Pick Up Man for the second time after covering him for 85.5 points in Decatur, Texas, in June of 2018.
- Leonardo Castro seeks revenge aboard Bo Man who bucked him off in 5.81 seconds in Anaheim, California, last August.

PAST SIOUX FALLS WINNERS – Guilherme Valleiras rode to his first premier series title in Sioux Falls in 2023, going 2-for-3. The only rider to make the 8 more than once, Valleiras roared out of the chutes for 82.25 points on Devaronian in Round 1. Competing in just his second Unleash The Beast event, the Brazilian showed no fear, converting for 76.5 points on Soul Train in Round 2 to take the lead entering the final round. Despite being bucked off by Mr. Right Now in five seconds, Valleiras had done enough to hold off the surging Rafael Jose de Brito, who would go on to be crowned the 2023 PBR World Champion and Rookie of the Year after finishing second in Queen City last year.

WORLD CHAMPION BULL RACE - The 2024 YETI PBR World Champion Bull race has been dominated by Man Hater with just over a month left in the year-long campaign. Spanning back to the 2023 PBR Camping World Team Series' season, the powerful bovine competitor had bucked off all 15 of his cowboy opponents until Cassio Dias covered him for a season-high 94.75 points in the championship round in Los Angeles to take the event title. Seeking his revenge, the elite animal athlete sought his revenge in Albuquerque, New Mexico, but Dias once again made the 8, this time for a monstrous 93.25 points. Despite the two rides, Man Hater currently holds a 1.28-point lead over UTZ BesTex Legend in the standings. After being marked 46.25 points for his buck-off of Brady Fielder in the championship round in Tulsa, Man Hater currently boasts seven of the Top 10 bull scores this season and he has won the Bull of the Event title an incredible nine times. Putting that into perspective, the reigning back-to-back World Champion Bull, Ridin' Solo, was named the Bull of the Event just five times during the 2023 campaign. In Houston, Red Demon became the first animal athlete other than Man Hater to claim more than one Bull of the Event title this season, marked an impressive 47 points for bucking off Joao Ricardo Vieira in 2.3 seconds in the championship round, and has risen to fourth in the standings. After surrendering an 88.5-point ride to Alan de Souza in St. Louis, Missouri, Legend has put together an eight-out buck-off streak to somewhat close the gap on Man Hater. A member of the 2023 PBR Stock Contractor of the Year Blake Sharp's pen, Legend has bucked off 17 of the 18 riders he has faced so far. Right behind him in the standings is Flyin Wired, who sits 1.72 points back of the leader. While he has given up two rides in his eight outs, both went for 90 or more points, as Wingson Henrique da Silva covered him for 92.5 points at the PBR Teams Championship in Las Vegas while Joao Ricardo Vieira topped him for 91.75 points to win the event in Tulsa.

2024 POINTS TABLES – The 2024 PBR Unleash The Beast season keeps the same point structure as 2023 but adds PBR Majors while removing 15/15 Bucking Battles and having two separate aggregates at the PBR World Finals. The 2024 World Champion will be the rider who earns the most points only at Unleash The Beast (UTB) events, including at the 2024 PBR World Finals on May 10-19 in the Dallas-Fort Worth Metroplex. The three PBR Majors in New York City (January 5-7, won by Austin Richardson), Sacramento, California (February 2-4, won by Leonardo Castro Ferreira), and Albuquerque, New Mexico (March 22-24, won by Eduardo Aparecido), offer increased payouts and points. There will be three PBR tours in the U.S. in action for the first half of 2024: PBR Unleash The Beast (November 10 – May 19); Pendleton Whisky Velocity Tour (Jan. 5 – May 4) and PBR Touring Pro Division (Oct. 19 – May 19). Points accumulated in non-UTB events domestically, as well as PBR's international tours, will be tallied as Velocity Global points. Velocity Global points, which will also be used to crown the 2024 PBR Pendleton Whisky Velocity Tour Champion, will help determine the athletes who can earn a future draw spot on the elite Unleash The Beast following the tour's first four events.

Those with the most points earned during their four most recent Velocity Global or Unleash The Beast events will join the UTB, replacing riders who had fallen to the bottom of the pack during select cuts throughout the season. Riders ranked in the No. 36-40 range in the UTB standings will be subject to being cut. During each cut, the open positions will first be filled with

those riders having injury exemptions, followed by the Premier Series Qualifier List, based on Velocity Global points. Following each cut, these riders will take the place of the demoted riders in the sport's top series to make up the 40-rider field heading into the next event. Riders ranked No. 1-35 on the UTB will remain on the PBR's elite tour. Following the initial cut after the event in Manchester, New Hampshire, subsequent cuts will be held every two weeks. The second cut will drop the bottom six riders from UTB, the third cut will drop the bottom seven riders, and the fourth and remaining cuts will remove the bottom eight riders from UTB.

Points will be awarded as follows for the Unleash The Beast, including World Finals, as well as Tier 1 Velocity Global events:

Bonus points are awarded across all levels of PBR competition. A rider who scores 70-79.75 points will earn 7 bonus points, 80-89.75 8 bonus points and 90-99.75 9 bonus points. The exception is if a contestant declines a re-ride due to an inferior bull. In that case, he does not earn bonus points.

THIS WEEKEND'S FORMAT – First Premier Bank PBR Sioux Falls, presented by Cooper Tires, the nineteenth Unleash The Beast event of the 2024 season, will feature four rounds of bull riding. Each of the 38 competing riders will get on one bull in Round 1 on Friday and Round 2 on Saturday. Every contestant who has a qualified ride in the first two rounds will be eligible to compete in Round 3 on Sunday. If there are less than 30 riders with a qualified ride after two rounds, Round 3 will fill the

remaining spots to get to the 30-man minimum based on the UTB Standings entering the event. The 12 bull riders with the top combined ride scores following Rounds 1, 2, and 3 will then advance to the championship round following Round 3 on Sunday.

NEXT UP – The PBR Unleash The Beast next travels to Billings, Montana, for Wrangler PBR Billings, presented by Cooper Tires. The event is on Friday, April 12, at 7:45 p.m. MDT, Saturday, April 13 at 6:45 p.m. MDT and Sunday, April 14, at 1:45 p.m. MDT.

VELOCITY TOUR, INTERNATIONAL AND TOURING PRO DIVISION POINTS – All non-Unleash The Beast (UTB) events award Velocity Global points, including Pendleton Whisky Velocity Tour events, Touring Pro Division events and events held internationally in Australia, Brazil, Canada, and Mexico. The only exception is National Finals held abroad, which will only award national points, not Velocity Global points. The point system at each event is tiered based on added money in USD, and other factors determined by the PBR. Each event, depending on the tier will get points in accordance with the tables below.

- Tier 1 Events \$20,000 or more USD in added money.
- Tier 2 Events \$10,000 \$19,999 USD in added money.
- Tier 3 Events \$9,999 USD or less in added money.

Additionally, riders at all events receive bonus points via their ride score. A rider who scores 70-79.75 points will earn 7 bonus points, 80-89.75 8 bonus points and 90-99.75 9 bonus points.
