



2024 PBR Unleash The Beast PBR Albuquerque Ty Murray Invitational The Pit – Albuquerque, New Mexico Friday, March 22 at 7:45 p.m. MST Saturday, March 23 at 6:45 p.m. MST Sunday, March 24 at 1:45 p.m. MST

BUCKOFF IN THE PIT – This weekend, for the 26th time and third consecutive season, PBR's elite 2024 Unleash The Beast travels to Albuquerque, New Mexico, for the PBR Albuquerque Ty Murray Invitational, the seventeenth event of the 24-event 2024 individual season and the final of three majors. Duke City will host the PBR for three days of action on Friday, March 22, starting at 7:45 p.m. MST, Saturday, March 23, starting at 6:45 p.m. MST and on Sunday, March 24, at 1:45 p.m. MST.

TIME TO MAKE A RUN – No. 11 Cody Jesus, 18 Daylon Swearingen, No. 22 Boudreaux Campbell and No. 27 Jose Vitor Leme all return from injury this weekend looking to catapult up the standings at the final major of the 2024 season. Jesus entered the chutes in Jacksonville, Florida, in February, where he went 1-for-3 and finished ninth. Competing just a few hours from his home in Window Rock, Arizona, Jesus is currently 10-for-28 (35%) on the premier series this season and has held a spot inside the Top 15 for the entire season after starting the campaign a perfect 6-for-6. Jesus looks to catch fire once again on Bamboozle in the opening round.

2022 PBR World Champion Daylon Swearingen last left the chutes in Milwaukee, Wisconsin, two weekends ago, going 1-for-2 and placing 11th in the event standings. The New York cowboy is currently 12-for-38 (31%) and has finished inside the Top 15 in his last four events, highlighted by a season-high fourth-place finish in Jacksonville, Florida, where he went 2-for-3. He takes on Bugatti in Round 1 on Friday.

Close on his spurs is 2020 Rookie of the Year Campbell, who also last rode in Milwaukee. The Texan is trying to find his stride as he hasn't placed inside the Top 10 since his season-best fifth-place finish in Sacramento, California, at the second PBR Major of the season. In the Big Tomato, the newest member of the Missouri Thunder on the separate PBR Camping World Team Series went 2-for-4, netting a crucial 71 points in the standings to rise to No. 14. Now holding inside the Top 25, Campbell looks to begin a late season run on Umm in Round 1 Friday evening.

Two-time PBR World Champion Jose Vitor Leme also makes his return in Duke City after missing the past four events. In his last showing in Los Angeles, California, Leme went 1-for-2 and finished sixth. Despite competing in just four events this season, he has held a spot inside the Top 35 for the entire year by placing Top 15 in all four events, highlighted by his perfect 3-for-3 performance in Tucson, Arizona, to begin the year, where he finished fourth. The Brazilian superstar is 6-for-8 (75%) and, with the extra points available in Albuquerque this weekend, is poised to surge up the standings to compete for a third gold buckle. He faces Big Worm in Round 1 on Friday.

DIAS EXTENDS HOLD ON NO. 1 RANKING WITH FIFTH EVENT WIN – Dias once again stood victorious in Little Rock, Arkansas, hoisting his fifth event buckle after going a perfect 3-for-3. The burgeoning superstar flew out of the gate on T-Wrecks for a modest 83 points, placing him eighth in the event standings entering the final day of competition. Dias then locked in, winning Round 2 by covering Tulsa Time for 89.25 points to punch his ticket to the championship round. There, the Brazilian roared out of the chutes on Dark Thoughts for an event-high 90.5 points, his premier-series-leading sixth 90-point ride.

After being shut out for just the third time this season in Indianapolis, Dias rebounded in Round 1 in Milwaukee the following weekend, topping Trump Train for 86.75 points. While he was bucked off by Reinstate Hank in 2.91 seconds and Cy Young in 5.98 seconds in the final two rounds, his opening-round performance was enough to net Dias his tenth finish inside the Top 10. Last month in Los Angeles, the Brazilian cowboy had extended his lead, going 2-for-3 to win his fourth event of the season. The rising superstar topped Hell Storm for 87.25 points in Round 1, the second-best score of the evening, but was dispatched by

Ghost Face in 3.04 seconds in Round 2 on Saturday. Knowing he most likely needed a monstrous score to take over the No. 1 spot, Dias showed no fear and selected the 2024 YETI PBR World Champion Bull frontrunner, Man Hater, who hadn't been covered before. The dynamic duo burst out of the gate in the championship round in front of a roaring Crypto.com Arena, posting a mind-boggling, 94.75-point score, the highest-marked ride since Jose Vitor Leme topped Ridin' Solo for 94.75 points in Oklahoma City in February of 2022 and the highest ride in PBR history in California. With the Top-50 ride in premier series history, Dias put a stamp on his season that could end with a gold buckle.

After sitting atop the standings for a month early in the season, Dias briefly lost his hold on the top spot to Austin Richardson after the Texan won back-to-back titles in the Empire State at the beginning of the new year. However, Dias bounced back in Chicago, going a perfect 3-for-3 and winning his premier series-leading third event of the season. The MVP runner-up for the Kansas City Outlaws in the PBR Camping World Team Series, Dias finished tied for fourth in the first round with an 87-point ride on IHOP. Now on a roll, the Brazilian tied for second in Round 2, scoring 86.75 points on Grey Fox to earn the second pick in the championship pen. Choosing Do Dat Eddie, Dias saved his best for last, storming out of the gates for an event-high-tying 89 points to overtake Cort McFadden, who was making his PBR debut, in the event standings. After the young Texan was bucked off Polar Express in 5.26 seconds, Dias knew he was back on top in the race for a gold buckle. Dias tries to win his first PBR Major this weekend and takes on Mahan in Round 1 on Friday.

WELCOME TO THE SHOW – Each year, the Ty Murray Invitational extends an invitation to the Indian National Finals Rodeo (INFR) Champion, a title won by 22-year-old JaCauy Hale of Ganado, Arizona, this season Making his PBR debut on I'm Legit Too in Round 1 this weekend, Hale finished with 216 points in the INFR standings, 54 points ahead of Latrell Long, who finished second, and 135 points ahead of PBR veteran Dakota Louis, who finished fifth. One of just two riders to make the 8, he finished second at the INFR Championship. Last year, Robbie Taylor earned the nod, but he was shut out in his two attempts.

NOTABLES – Here are several other notable stats and storylines:

- **Rank n' Ready:** The event in Albuquerque this weekend will feature each of the Top 3 bulls in the World Champion Bull race, as No. 1 Man Hater, No. 2 UTZ BesTex Legend and No. 3 Flyin Wired all sit in the championship pen for the second-straight weekend. The trio was perfect in Little Rock last weekend, as Man Hater dispatched Eduardo Aparecido in 6.62 seconds, Legend bested Whitehorse in 1.99 seconds and Flyin Wired shed Caden Bunch for 4.65 seconds. Proving their dominance, all three also received bull scores of 45 or better, with Legend and Flyin Wired tying for their second Bull of the Event title of the season, earning 45.25-point scores. In addition to the Top 3, No. 6 UTZ BesTex Smokestack and No. 7 Mike's Motive are also heading to The Pit this weekend.
- **Don't Get it Twisted:** Dana White's Twisted Steel heads to The Pit this weekend after bucking off Koltin Hevalow in 5.39 seconds in Jacksonville, Florida, in February. The powerful bovine competitor has allowed just one ride in his ten premier series outs (90% buckoff percentage) dating back to the beginning of the 2023 PBR Teams season and has bucked off all four riders who have faced him during the 2024 Unleash The Beast campaign. In Tulsa, Oklahoma, in January, Twisted Steel shed Vitor Losnake in two seconds flat, the second straight out he bested the Brazilian cowboy. Later that month, he unseated Eli Vastbinder in 3.2 seconds in Houston, Texas. This weekend, the rank animal athlete seeks revenge against Andrew Alvidrez in Round 1, the lone rider who has made the 8 aboard Twisted Steel this season. The Texan covered the powerful bovine competitor for 88 points at the PBR Teams Championship in Las Vegas, Nevada, last October. If the bull can settle the score, he will seem virtually unstoppable leading into his celebrity showdown with UFC Hall of Famer, Donald "Cowboy" Cerrone.
- **Back with a Bang(or):** Speaking of Alvidrez, the Texas veteran returns to the premier series this weekend after catching fire on the Pendleton Whisky Velocity Tour, winning back-to-back weekends in Bangor, Maine, and Wheeling, West Virginia, to punch his ticket back to the top tour. The Missouri Thunder veteran went 4-for-7 (57.14%) over that stretch, highlighted by an event-high 88.5 points on Pneu-Dart's Chief Wahoo to win the championship round in Bangor.

FAMILIAR WATERS – Round 1 of the 2024 PBR event in Albuquerque, New Mexico, will feature six rematches.

- Andrew Alvidrez takes on Dana White's Twisted Steel for the second time after riding the powerful bovine competitor for 88 points in Las Vegas, Nevada, last year in October.

- Bob Mitchell tries to remain perfect aboard Highwire after covering him during their first pairing in Houston, Texas, earlier this January for 84.75 points.
- Cassio Dias has bucked off in both previous matchups with Mahan, losing the rope in 3.37 seconds in Oklahoma City, Oklahoma, in September and in 3.47 seconds in Ridgedale, Missouri, the following weekend.
- Dener Barbosa shares a chute with Black Gold for the second time after bucking off in 3.16 seconds in Kansas City, Missouri, in March of 2022.
- Jesse Petri battles Punchy Pete once again after bucking off in 2.6 seconds in New York during the first PBR Major of the 2024 season in January.
- Paulo Eduardo Rossetto steps into the chutes on Cy Young for the first time since he was unseated in 1.88 seconds in Houston, Texas, in January.

PAST ALBUQUERQUE EVENT WINNERS – One of the longest-running premier series events, Colten Fritzlan took over the pit the last time the PBR bucked into Albuquerque in 2023. The Colorado cowboy topped Pearl’s Ghost in Round 1 for 87.25 points, tying for fifth in the opening round, and then overtook the lead by riding Prime Tested for 85 points in Round 2. Despite being bucked off by UTZ BesTex Smokestack in 4.88 seconds in the championship round, Fritzlan’s 2-for-3 performance was enough to take home his second career premier series event buckle.

Right behind him was Kaique Pacheco, who also finished 2-for-3. The Ice Man was ironically on fire in March of last year, recording four Top-15 finishes, highlighted by an event win in Milwaukee, Wisconsin. He roared out of the gates at The Pit aboard Tested’s Viper for 84.5 points in Round 1 and then rode Kevin for 86.75 points in the second round. While he came up just short of the event victory last season, he looks to take home the buckle in Albuquerque this year, battling Chupacabra in Round 1 on Friday.

WORLD CHAMPION BULL RACE – The 2024 YETI PBR World Champion Bull race has been dominated by Man Hater with just a couple months left in the year-long campaign. Spanning back to the 2023 PBR Camping World Team Series’ season, the powerful bovine competitor had bucked off all 15 of his cowboy opponents until Cassio Dias covered him for a season-high 94.75 points in the championship round in Los Angeles to take the event title. Man Hater currently holds a 1.28-point lead over UTZ BesTex Legend in the standings. After being marked 46.25 points for his buck-off of Brady Fielder in the championship round in Tulsa, Man Hater currently boasts seven of the Top 10 bull scores this season and he has won the Bull of the Event title eight times. Putting that into perspective, the reigning back-to-back World Champion Bull, Ridin’ Solo, was named the Bull of the Event just five times during the 2023 campaign. In Houston, Red Demon became the first animal athlete other than Man Hater to claim more than one Bull of the Event title this season, marked an impressive 47 points for bucking off Joao Ricardo Vieira in 2.3 seconds in the championship round, and has risen to fourth in the standings. After surrendering an 88.5-point ride to Alan de Souza in St. Louis, Missouri, Legend has put together a six-out buck-off streak to somewhat close the gap on Man Hater. A member of the 2023 PBR Stock Contractor of the Year Blake Sharp’s pen, Legend has bucked off 15 of the 16 riders he has faced so far. Right behind him in the standings is Flyin Wired, who sits 1.61 points back of the leader. While he has given up two rides in his seven outs, both went for 90 or more points, as Wingson Henrique da Silva covered him for 92.5

points at the PBR Teams Championship in Las Vegas while Joao Ricardo Vieira topped him for 91.75 points to win the event in Tulsa.

2024 POINTS TABLES – The 2024 PBR Unleash The Beast season keeps the same point structure as 2023 but adds PBR Majors while removing 15/15 Bucking Battles and having two separate aggregates at the PBR World Finals. The 2024 World Champion will be the rider who earns the most points only at Unleash The Beast (UTB) events, including at the 2024 PBR World Finals on May 10-19 in the Dallas-Fort Worth Metroplex. The three PBR Majors in New York City (January 5-7, won by Austin Richardson), Sacramento, California (February 2-4, won by Leonardo Castro Ferreira), and Albuquerque, New Mexico (March 22-24), offer increased payouts and points. There will be three PBR tours in the U.S. in action for the first half of 2024: PBR Unleash The Beast (November 10 – May 19); Pendleton Whisky Velocity Tour (Jan. 5 – May 4) and PBR Touring Pro Division (Oct. 19 – May 19). Points accumulated in non-UTB events domestically, as well as PBR’s international tours, will be tallied as Velocity Global points. Velocity Global points, which will also be used to crown the 2024 PBR Pendleton Whisky Velocity Tour Champion, will help determine the athletes who can earn a future draw spot on the elite Unleash The Beast following the tour’s first four events.

Those with the most points earned during their four most recent Velocity Global or Unleash The Beast events will join the UTB, replacing riders who had fallen to the bottom of the pack during select cuts throughout the season. Riders ranked in the No. 36-40 range in the UTB standings will be subject to being cut. During each cut, the open positions will first be filled with those riders having injury exemptions, followed by the Premier Series Qualifier List, based on Velocity Global points. Following each cut, these riders will take the place of the demoted riders in the sport’s top series to make up the 40-rider field heading into the next event. Riders ranked No. 1-35 on the UTB will remain on the PBR’s elite tour. Following the initial cut after the event in Manchester, New Hampshire, subsequent cuts will be held every two weeks. The second cut will drop the bottom six riders from UTB, the third cut will drop the bottom seven riders, and the fourth and remaining cuts will remove the bottom eight riders from UTB.

Points will be awarded as follows for the Unleash The Beast, including World Finals, as well as Tier 1 Velocity Global events:

Bonus points are awarded across all levels of PBR competition. A rider who scores 70-79.75 points will earn 7 bonus points, 80-89.75 8 bonus points and 90-99.75 9 bonus points. The exception is if a contestant declines a re-ride due to an inferior bull. In that case, he does not earn bonus points.

THIS WEEKEND’S FORMAT – The PBR Albuquerque Ty Murray Invitational, the seventeenth Unleash The Beast event of the 2024 season and third major, will feature four rounds of bull riding. Each of the 40 competing riders will get on one bull in Round 1 on Friday and Round 2 on Saturday. Every contestant who has a qualified ride in the first two rounds will be eligible to compete in Round 3 on Sunday. If there are less than 30 riders with a qualified ride after two rounds, Round 3 will fill the remaining spots to get to the 30-man minimum based on the UTB Standings entering the event. The 12 bull riders with the top combined ride scores following Rounds 1, 2, and 3 will then advance to the championship round following Round 3 on Sunday.

NEXT UP – The PBR Unleash The Beast next travels to Nampa, Idaho, for PBR Nampa, presented by Cooper Tires. The event is on Thursday, March 28, at 7:45 p.m. MDT, Friday, March 29, at 6:45 MDT and Saturday, March 30, at 6:45 p.m. MDT.

The point system at each event is tiered based on added money in USD, and other factors determined by the PBR. Each event, depending on the tier will get points in accordance with the tables below.

- Tier 1 Events – \$20,000 or more USD in added money.
- Tier 2 Events – \$10,000 - \$19,999 USD in added money.
- Tier 3 Events – \$9,999 USD or less in added money.

Additionally, riders at all events receive bonus points via their ride score. A rider who scores 70-79.75 points will earn 7 bonus points, 80-89.75 8 bonus points and 90-99.75 9 bonus points.
