Peloton Cross Training Tread+ Giveaway Official Rules

Eligibility:

Timing:

You will receive 1 entry into the Sweepstakes.

Entry Limits:

Limit of 1 entry per person during the Promotion Period. Multiple entrants are not permitted to share the same email address. In the event of a dispute as to the identity of an entrant, Sponsor and Administrator will rely on the information submitted by the entrant to register for this Sweepstakes.
