*To add your results to your portfolio, go to your Volunteering Portfolio > +Add Box > Add from myBlueprint > Who Am I and click the survey result you would like to add






PORTFOLIO CHECKLIST

Reflection prompt ideas:

OCCUPATION

Add an occupation to your Volunteering Portfolio* that relates to your volunteering opportunity. Include a reflection.



Reflection prompt ideas:

How does this occupation relate to your volunteering experience? List three skills needed to excel in the occupation and that you could develop during your time volunteering.

*To search for and add an Occupation, on the left-hand navigation menu go to Work > Occupations > Use the filters & keyword search to find an Occupation. To add to portfolio, click on the Occupation > Click Add to Portfolio (button under Occupation name)

SHOW EVIDENCE OF YOUR VOLUNTEERING

Upload a photo... (with permission)
Of your volunteering experience. Add a reflection outlining your progress and show the excellent work you have been doing so far

Upload a video... (with permission) of you learning or practicing a skill during your volunteering experience, or an interview with your supervisor.

PORTFOLIO CHECKLIST

LINK TO A RELATED WEB

Add a link to a website/URL related to your volunteering organization. Add a Reflection sharing why this link is relevant and any key learnings that can be found on the website.

REFLECTION

Following the volunteer opportunity, reflect on your experience. +Add Box > Add Journal, Title: Journal #3. Write 5-8 sentences using the following prompts:



- Explain your volunteering experience (what is the organization, what did you do while you were there).
- What skills did you learn?
- What was your favourite part?
- Were there any parts you did not enjoy?
- Would you like to do this volunteer activity again?
- What are your plans for future volunteering?

SHARE YOUR VOLUNTEERING PORTFOLIO



At the top right of your portfolio click Slideshow > Play and present your portfolio to your class, or to a small group of your classmates. Before presenting, take time to practice and review your portfolio!

[OPTIONAL] EXTENSIION ACTIVITY

RESUMI

Create your myBlueprint resume (left-hand navigation menu > Work > Resume) and add it to your portfolio. Be sure to add your volunteer opportunity and the new skills you developed.

TIP:

Add the individual skills to your portfolio and reflect on the following questions: How did you develop these skills? How will you use these newly developed skills in a future occupation?

*To add Skills, go to your Volunteering Portfolio > Add Box > Add from myBlueprint > Resume > Add any 'Skills & Abilities' boxes

COVER LETTER

Create your myBlueprint cover letter (left-hand navigation menu > Work > Cover Letter), customized for a future volunteer or job opportunity related to this volunteering experience. Add it to your portfolio.
