## Cozy flower patchwork cushion

## TENSION

1 large flower $=12 \times 12 \mathrm{~cm}$
STITCHES AND ABBREVIATIONS
ch: chain
st: stitch/es
sl st: slip stitch
dc: double crochet
htr: half treble crochet
tr: treble crochet
dtr: double treble crochet
2 tr together: make 2 uncomplete tr stitches in the same st, then yo and pull through all loops on the hook.
3 tr together: make 3 uncomplete tr stitches in the same st, then yo and pull through all loops on the hook.

## NOTE

The crocheted flowers are joined together with sl st.

## INSTRUCTIONS

Make 18 large flowers. For the first large flower, ch 8, join to work in the round and follow chart. For each large flower follow the colour sequence of the diagram and colours key. Change colour after the 1st and after the 2nd round. When knitting the 1st large flower, do not make the sl sts that join the flowers petals (red on the chart). When you are working the last
round of 2 nd flower join it with sl st to the first flower. Join the subsequent flowers in the same way, following the diagram for placement.
When all 18 large flowers have been joined, continue with the small flowers. For the 1st small flower, chain 5, join to work in the round and follow chart 2 and colour sequence, joining to the large flowers, following the diagram for placement. Change colour after the 1st round.
Then make 4 corner flowers in shade 00048 for the lower edge following chart 3 and diagram.

FINISHING
To close the top and bottom edges of the cushion, sew the tips of the flowers of the cushion front to the tips of cushion back (follow slip stitch markings on crochet chart). Before sewing the last 2-3 flowers together, slide in the inner cushion. Carefully sew in all the threads.

## TIP

For a beautiful colour result, you can sew an inner cushion in matching colour from lining taffeta or thin cotton fabric.

## How to make it:

Cut 2 squares with $37 \times 37 \mathrm{~cm}$, place right sides together and sew together with 1 cm seam allowance, leaving a turning opening of approx. 8 cm . Trim corners and neaten the edges. Turn the cushion over and stuff with approx. 150 g of batting, then close the opening with small hand stitches.

## WASHING ADVICE

- Always wash in as warm a water temperature as possible - up to the temperature recommended, with a short spin. Use a lot of water if hand washing. For darker colours we recommend the use of discolouration sheets.
- Do not bleach.
- Do not tumble dry. Drip-dry on a horizontal surface.
- Iron at a low temperature using a damp cloth.
- Professional dry cleaning in tetrachloroethylene.
- Do not use optical brighteners (or any detergent containing optical brighteners).
