TENSION

17 treble crochet x 11 rows = $10 \times 10 \text{ cm}$

ABBREVATIONS

r(s) row(s)
ch chain
st(s) stitch(es)
sl st slip stitch
dc double crochet
tr treble crochet
dtr double treble crochet

BASIC PATTERN

Chain. Slip stitch. Double crochet. Treble crochet. Double treble crochet. Long double crochet: dc made two rows below.

Two treble crochet cluster: two tr without closing in the same arch yarn over, and draw through all loops on hook.

HOW TO MAKE

FLOWERS

Make a total of 8 flowers, following **chart 1 FLOWER**. Two using colour B, two in colour C, two in colour D and two in colour E.

Cut yarn, wave ends in and reserve the pieces.

Using colour F make nine leaves following **chart 2. LEAF A** and two more following **chart 3. LEAF B.** Cut yarn, wave ends in and reserve the pieces.


ASSEMBLE

Join the flowers following the colour sequence shown in **chart 4. COLOUR SEQUENCE**.


To do so, join new thread colour F into the first Leaf B, make a dc into the first Leaf A, make 10 ch and continue joining pieces as you make the ch of R1 of **chart 5. ASSEMBLE**. Finish R1 joining the last Leaf A and Leaf B.

Finally, end the green cord making R2 and R3 of the same chart. Cut yarn and weave ends in.


1 - FLOWER

3 - LEAF B (X2)



WASHING ADVICE

Always wash in as warm a water temperature as possible - up to the temperature recommended, with a short spin. Use a lot of water if hand washing. For darker colours we recommend the use of discolouration sheets. Do not bleach.

Do not tumble dry. Drip-dry on a horizontal surface.

Iron on a hot temperature setting using a damp cloth.

Professional dry cleaning in tetrachloroethylene.

Do not use optical brighteners (or any detergent containing optical brighteners). We recommend to use a softener to preserve the natural softness of the yarn.
