# Little roses headband

#### **ABBREVIATIONS**

ch: chain tr: treble crochet htr: half treble crochet dc: double crochet

# **INSTRUCTIONS FLOWERS**

Crochet 9 flowers with the 2 mm hook, 3 of each size:

**Small flowers:** ch 22 + 3 for the 1st tr, follow **chart 1**. Last row: 3 ch (count as 1 tr) + 3 tr into the first space of 2 ch, 5 tr into next 3 spaces of 2 ch, 7 tr into next 2 spaces of 2 ch, 9 tr into next 3 spaces of 2 ch. Then roll up as shown in steps 1 - 3 an sew at the bottom. Leave a 15 cm long tail and cut.

Medium flowers: ch 28 + 3, follow chart 1, except for the last row: 3 tr 1x, 5 tr 2x, 7 tr 3x, 9 tr 4x into the space of 2 ch.

Large flowers: ch 46 + 3, follow chart 1, except for the last row: 3 tr 1x, 5 tr 5x, 7 tr 5x, 9 tr 6x into the space of 2 ch.

#### **LEAVES**

With 1,5 mm hook, crochet 22 leaves following chart 2. Leave a tail of around 15 cm.


#### **RIBBON**

Ch 83 + 4 (count as 1st double tr. Crochet along the ch: 19 double tr, 15 triple treble, 15 quadruple tr, 15 triple tr, 20 double tr. Cut yarn leaving a 200 cm tail

Place the flowers and leaves on the ribbon and sew. Then place the ribbon on the hairband and secure with safety pins. Use the long tail to sew the ribbon to the circlet. On one side insert your needle into two stitches, go under the hairband and insert the needle into two stitches on the opposite of the ribbon.

# **WASHING ADVICE**

• Always wash in as warm a water temperature as possible - up to the

recommended, with a short spin. Use a lot of water if hand washing. For darker colours we recommend the use of discolouration sheets.

- Do not bleach.
- Do not tumble dry. Drip-dry on a horizontal surface.
- Iron at a low temperature using a damp cloth.
- Professional dry cleaning in tetrachloroethylene.
- Do not use optical brighteners (or any detergent containing optical brighteners).
