

How to...

Make a bunny Macrame bead garland

You will need

Trimits Macramé Beads: 30mm - **CF425.50**
Trimits Macramé Beads: 25mm - **CF424.50**
Trimits Natural Macramé Cord - 2mm x 50m – **TMC2X6 \ NAT**
Trimits White Chenille's – **CF106**
Glue Gun - **MG100**
Scissors
Black Finesline Pen



Step one

Measure 20cm of a white chenille stem and cut. Fold the chenille into a bunny ear shape.



Step two

Add glue to the inside of the smaller macramé bead. Stick the chenille bunny ears inside and hold until the glue has dried.



Step three

Glue the 25mm macramé bead with the bunny ears onto the larger 30mm bead using the glue gun.

Step Four

Curl the remaining chenille stem into bunny feet and glue to the bottom of the larger macramé bead using the glue gun.

Step five

Cut 30cm of macramé cord. Fold the cord in half and glue to the back of the bunny ears.



Step six

Use the black fineline pen to draw a face and whiskers onto the bunny. Repeat these six steps as many times as you wish.

Step Seven

Thread the 30mm macramé beads onto the macramé cord to form a garland and add the bunny decorations. Secure with a knot either side of the garland.

Step Eight

Hang your garland wherever you wish in your home!
