### Role Overview

Creative Energy is looking for a Regulatory Affairs Manager to lead and support the regulatory projects and approvals required to implement low carbon district energy projects in BC and to establish and maintain rates that are fair and reasonable for the nature and quality of service that our customers demand. The role is dynamic, requiring collaborative and cross-functional engagement to develop and synthesize regulatory strategy, to advise and manage the development of business cases and evidence that advances our utility objectives and obligations, and to anticipate, monitor and resolve emergent regulatory issues and compliance matters. The position requires a good understanding of public utility regulation and a proven ability to build and maintain strong working relations with internal staff, customers, stakeholders, and key external entities, such as the BC Utilities Commission and government agencies. The role will include opportunities to work directly with customers and stakeholders to understand their needs and to build support and momentum for our proposals.

### Key Responsibilities

Reporting to the Director, Regulatory Affairs and Customer Relations, the role is responsible for the development and successful delivery of regulatory applications and compliance filings related to thermal energy utility rate design, revenue requirements, capital projects and long-term resource planning. The role will support the finance, project, and operations teams by providing expert regulatory advice and by managing the development of applications to the BC Utilities Commission. This position will also be responsible for managing regulatory processes and compliance requirements.

- A Bachelor's degree in a subject matter relevant to the regulation of energy utility services, such as engineering, economics, business, finance, or public policy
- Excellent written and oral communication skills, with the ability to distill complex matters with precision and persuasion to a depth appropriately targeted to varied audiences

- Exceptional collaborative and interpersonal skills
