



GitHub Enterprise Server Product Specific Terms

The Agreement consists of these GitHub Enterprise Server Product Specific Terms (which may be updated), the General Terms that Customer accepted, and any additional terms GitHub or its Affiliates present when an order is placed.

1. License specifics.

License Key. The Software is deemed delivered when the License Key is made available for download.

Updates. GitHub will make Updates and Releases available for download. Customer must update the Software at least once per year.

Verifying compliance. Customer will provide GitHub with a Software-generated report upon 30 days' notice, verifying that its use is in accordance with the Agreement. For any unlicensed use, Customer will order sufficient licenses within 30 days to cover the period of its unlicensed use.

Third-party components. The Software includes components licensed to GitHub by third parties, including software whose licenses require GitHub to make the source code for those components available. The source code for such components will be provided upon request.

Additional Products and Features. Customer's use of Additional Products and Features may be subject to additional terms.

3. Definitions.

"Additional Products and Features" means additional offerings and features that GitHub may make available as listed on github.com/additional-products-and-features-terms.

"License Key" means the data file that permits Customer to install and use the Software.

"Release" means a Software release that GitHub makes generally available to its customers, along with Product documentation, containing enhancements, new features, or new functionality.

"Software" means GitHub Enterprise Server on-premises software, Releases and Updates.

"Support" means GitHub's support programs described at github.com/support-enterprise.

"Update" means a Software release that GitHub makes generally available to its customers, along with Product documentation, containing error corrections or bug fixes.
